DAY 1 – FAITH IS A CURRENCY

We use our faith like a currency to access all that God's love wants to give us. The beginning of spiritual growth is when you receive a revelation about the truth of spiritual laws, and recognize they always work! These spiritual laws are what caused Jesus, and us, to be born from above. Jesus *is* the firstborn from the dead, and He made it possible for us to also be born from death to life

STUDY IT

- I. We use our faith like a currency to access all that God's love wants to give us.
 - God's love is something we must believe and put our faith into (Mark 11:22).
 - We must know and believe that God loves us (1 John 4:16).
 - When Jesus taught on faith, He used the word *say* three times and the word *believe* one time (Mark 11:23-24).
 - Jesus put the emphasis on what a man *says* rather than on the believing part.
 - Jesus didn't need to emphasize *believing*, because when you believe something in your heart, you're going to say it (Matthew 12:34).
 - Pin-point your faith on God's love, and His desire to give you what you're saying and believing for.

- II. The beginning of spiritual growth is when you receive a revelation about the truth of spiritual laws, and recognize they always work!
 - The laws of physics that govern the physical realm were created by a higher law that governs the spiritual and physical realms.
 - God created all matter using the spiritual force of faith, which was released in His WORD by the Holy Spirit, which released into being physical laws.
 - The spiritual law of faith states we are right before God *by faith*; we are not justified by keeping a law (Romans 3:27-28).
 - In order to grow spiritually, you have to grow your faith. Mental assent is not enough.

- III. The new birth that caused us, including Jesus, to be born from above, came to pass because of the spiritual law that governed it.
 - We were born from above. Jesus was born from above.





- This spiritual law is: Believe in your heart that God raised Jesus from the dead, and say with your mouth that Jesus is LORD, and you are born again (Romans 10:9-10).
- When you believe and say, or “confession is made unto,” you activate a spiritual law that performs the greatest miracle known—the new birth!
- This unheard-of miracle of the recreation of a spirit being happened to Jesus first.
- Jesus was manifested in the flesh and justified in the Spirit (1 Timothy 3:16).
 - Jesus took on flesh in Bethlehem (Luke 1:35, 2:4-7).
 - Jesus was justified, or made alive, in the Spirit in hell when He suffered for us.
 - Jesus was made to be sin with our sin. He never committed sin.
 - The moment you received the new birth, you became a new creation, and received Jesus’ righteousness.
 - When Jesus suffered in hell, He never let go of God’s WORD; He kept praising God.
 - Jesus bore all of hell and sin. There are no words to describe to what extent He suffered.
 - Jesus kept speaking God’s WORD. Suddenly, those words of power of the Spirit of the living God hovered over Jesus in hell, and a holy thing was conceived.
 - Jesus was born again. One born-again human man, Jesus, defeated hell all by Himself.
 - We have the same spiritual DNA as Jesus. We have the same Holy Spirit. We have a measure of the same faith.

IV. Jesus *is* the firstborn from the dead, and He made it possible for us to also be born from death to life.

- Jesus was the first, *not the only*, but *the first one* born from the dead. God said that Jesus was His Son, and God is Jesus’ Father (Hebrews 1:5-6).
- When you accepted Jesus, you were born from above, or born again, and seated with Jesus in heavenly places.
- You are a citizen of heaven, now. You are seated there, now (Ephesians 2:6).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

The currency of heaven is available to you. Deposit into your heavenly bank account, by believing and speaking by faith. Then, as necessary, use your faith to draw out of what God has given you.

DAY 2 - FAITH RECEIVES GRACE

Jesus taught us how to have and use faith effectively by believing, speaking and forgiving. Learning to walk in faith and grace requires training, and the best way to get that training is to study the ministry of Jesus. When Jesus taught, the power of God was present to heal. Everything Jesus did was in line with The WORD of God.

STUDY IT

- I. Jesus taught us how to have and use faith (Mark 11:23-24).
 - In verses 23 and 24, Jesus uses the word *say* three times.
 - Jesus uses the word *believe* only one time.
 - Therefore, Jesus put the emphasis on *saying*.
 - If you *believe* and don't *say*, you haven't released your faith.

- II. To use your faith effectively, you must receive forgiveness by faith (Mark 11:25).
 - Your sins were forgiven when Jesus paid the price for them on the cross. The handwriting that was against you, the list of your sins, was blotted out by the blood of Jesus (Colossians 2:13-14).
 - Jesus has already forgiven us (Isaiah 43:25).
 - You're forgiven by God, but you must *receive* the forgiveness by faith.
 - It's not that God *won't* forgive your sin, it's that He *can't* until you receive forgiveness by faith.
 - You have to be *in Christ* to get all that's prepared for you, including forgiveness.

- III. Learning to walk in faith and grace requires training.
 - We are in training. We must take authority over our tongues.
 - The tongue cannot be tamed with natural force. But faith in The WORD of God will tame your tongue (James 3:8).
 - We must learn to use our words correctly.
 - We shouldn't say anything that's contrary to God and His WORD.
 - Don't say anything you don't want to happen.
 - Ask for forgiveness from each other.



IV. When Jesus taught, the power of God was present to heal (Luke 5:17-25).

- Men tried to bring their friend to be healed, but there were so many people, they couldn't get in the door. So, they climbed on the roof and let their friend down through the ceiling.
 - Jesus *saw* their faith when they brought their friend who needed help.
 - Jesus *saw* their faith and told the sick man to cheer up (Matthew 9:2).
- Jesus demonstrated speaking by faith when He said, "I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house" (Mark 2:11, *NKJV*).
- The religious people were angry, because Jesus was forgiving sins. That's something only God can do. Jesus said the same power it takes to heal someone is the same power it takes to forgive sins.
- If you think your problems are still here because of your sin, the solution is to repent (1 John 1:9)!
- If you have wronged someone, go to them and ask forgiveness. That's the love walk.

V. Everything Jesus did was in line with The WORD of God.

- There is much power, dominion and authority in God's WORD.
- Micah prophesied that a ruler would come out of Bethlehem 715 years before Jesus was born. The Messiah was coming (Micah 5:2)!
- And it happened! Caesar decreed that taxes would be paid from a man's hometown. Mary and Joseph journeyed to Bethlehem, and God's Son was born.
- God is always right!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Jesus put the emphasis on what you say, so speak God's WORD! Determine an area of your life you want changed, and then write a positive confession of what you will say about the situation. Remember to put the Scripture promise you are using to get your answer.

DAY 3 – THE POWER OF ANOINTED FAITH

The Spirit of God was upon Jesus. He was anointed to heal the sick and more. Jesus was called *Christ*, which can be translated, “the Anointed One and His Anointing.” This same anointing from the Holy Spirit is in and on you. Like Jesus, you have the anointed power of God inside you to forgive and heal. The Holy Spirit came inside of you when you were born again, giving you the ability to pray in the spirit and access the power of God.

STUDY IT

- I. The Spirit of God was upon Jesus. He was anointed to heal the sick and more.
 - The power of God was there to heal, because Jesus was there preaching God’s WORD.
 - Jesus preached the same message everywhere He went (Isaiah 61:1-2).
 - Jesus told the man with palsy “Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you” (Matthew 9:2-6, *NKJV*).
 - Jesus called him, “Son,” as in “son of Abraham.”
 - You have rights, because you are the seed of Abraham, and because you are in Christ.
 - Since you are Abraham’s seed and an heir according to the promise, you ought to be loosed from your sickness and bondage, today (Galatians 3:29)!

- II. Jesus was called *Christ*, which can be translated, “the Anointed One and His Anointing.” The same anointing from the Holy Spirit is in and on you.
 - *Christ* was not Jesus’ last name, it is His title.
 - Jesus was and is the Messiah.
 - Jesus Christ was anointed with the Spirit of God.
 - *Christ*, or *Messiah*, means “Anointed One” or “anointing.”
 - To *anoint* means “to pour, to smear, or to rub into.”
 - The burden of satan has been destroyed by the anointing (Isaiah 10:27).
 - The Holy Spirit poured Himself out *on* Jesus and *in* Him.
 - The Holy Spirit came *in* you when you were born again.
 - The Holy Spirit came *on* you for service when you were baptized in the Holy Spirit.
 - Kenneth Copeland gave a visual example using water poured *on* a glass and water poured *in* a glass.



- III. Like Jesus, you have the anointed power of God inside you to forgive and heal.
- Jesus proved that the power to forgive and the power to heal are one and the same.
 - God's power resides in you. You have the power of God.
 - Unforgiveness is the desire to hold something against someone more than your desire to obey God.
 - If Jesus is in you, the power of forgiveness is in you, because the love of God is in your heart by the Spirit of the living God (Romans 5:5).
 - God is in you! His love is in you! God is the Forgiver! Therefore, you have the power to forgive!
 - You have the weapons you need, so you can forgive (2 Corinthians 10:4-6).
 - Forgiveness is not a feeling! Compassion is a person! Grace is a person!
- IV. The Holy Spirit came inside of you when you were born again giving you the ability to pray in the spirit and access the power of God.
- You *can* pray in the spirit. Don't think the Holy Spirit is not inside you.
 - When someone suggests that the group pray in the spirit, it's a good time for you to join in, open your mouth and begin to speak.
 - Praying in the spirit is yours, because it's one of the signs that follow those who believe (Mark 16:17-18).
 - The Father wants to give you the Holy Spirit (Luke 11:13).
 - The only thing holding you back from speaking in tongues is fear.
 - Ask, believe and then speak with new tongues in the spirit.

DAY 4 – FAITH WILL ALWAYS COME

When you put God's WORD in your mouth in the form of words, faith will always come. Begin to talk faith. Begin to preach faith. Keep listening to God's WORD, and faith will come to you.

STUDY IT

- I. When you put God's WORD in your mouth in the form of words, faith will always come.
 - God has done all that needs to be done for you.
 - God's WORD is near you; it's in your mouth (Romans 10: 8).
 - Jesus said we should believe those things that we say will come to pass (Mark 11:23).
 - Paul said the same thing when he said he preached The WORD of faith (Romans 10:8-17).
 - Righteousness speaks faith from a believing heart (Romans 10:6).
 - The emphasis in Romans 10 is on the preached WORD, yet The WORD we read and speak is also full of faith.
- II. Begin to talk faith. Begin to preach faith.
 - In your life, you have what you say. In your church, you have what you preach.
 - Read and study the Bible to learn what you need to know, so you can preach God's WORD in your church.
 - Tap into The WORD of God, and depend on the Holy Spirit to help you.
 - Be sure your faith is growing!
- III. Kenneth Copeland gives the account of when he kicked the ottoman and broke his toe.
 - He spoke only words of faith, and it was supernaturally healed!
 - The first words out of your mouth in a situation have great power.
 - Whatever is in your heart in abundance, will come out of your mouth (Matthew 12:34).
 - Words are the starter button to your life.
 - Stay out of "look and see" business. Don't be moved by what you see, or what you hear. Be moved by what you believe—God's WORD.



- Don't look for sympathy from others for your situation. It will cause you to speak the problem instead of the solution.
- Speak faith; speak what you believe. Say: "I believe I receive my healing."
- This is living by faith—walking by faith and not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7).

IV. Keep listening to God's WORD of faith, and faith will come to you.

- There's no such thing as faith that does not come when you put it in your eyes and mouth (Proverbs 4:20-21).
- Faith is automatic. When you keep feeding it, it comes.
- Be assured: Faith is coming!

Additional Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 2:16, 1:30

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Say these words daily:

I have the mind of Christ. I have understanding. Jesus is made unto me wisdom, knowledge and understanding. I receive it. Thank You, LORD, for opening my eyes.

DAY 5 – THE YOKE IS DESTROYED BY FAITH

The yoke of the devil can be destroyed by faith in the anointing. The Spirit of The LORD anointed Jesus with power! Just as the curse against us was threefold, our Redemption is also threefold.

STUDY IT

- I. The yoke of the devil can be destroyed by faith in the anointing (Isaiah 10:24-27).
 - The devil's yoke will not be just broken; it is destroyed, because of the anointing.
 - Something broken can be fixed, but something destroyed cannot be put back together.
 - The yoke of the devil is made of iron (Deuteronomy 28:48).
 - Rust corrodes iron, until there is nothing left, like the anointing completely destroys the power of the devil.

- II. The Spirit of The LORD anointed Jesus with power (Isaiah 11:1-3)!
 - Jesus' custom was to go to the synagogue or Temple and preach the same message. "The Spirit of The LORD is upon Me, because He hath anointed me..." (Luke 4:14-19).
 - Peter reinforced this, explaining that Jesus preached the same message everywhere He went (Acts 10:34-38).
 - Everywhere Jesus went, He preached the message that the Spirit of God was upon Him to bring in the acceptable year of The LORD, which is the Year of Jubilee!
 - Jesus is a Preacher and called to preach (Luke 4:18).
 - Jesus is also an Apostle (Hebrews 3:1).
 - Jesus is here! Poor man, you don't have to be poor anymore.
 - Brokenhearted man, you don't have to be brokenhearted anymore. Jesus is here!
 - You, who are captive and bound up, broken, addicted and in bondage to worry, you don't need to be carrying any kind of care. Jesus, your Deliverer, is here!
 - Blind man, you don't have to be blind anymore!
 - Jesus sets at liberty those who are bruised, grieving and sorrowful, those who are sick and in pain. Jesus is here! Be healed and free!
 - You have Jubilee living inside of you!

III. Just as the curse against us was threefold, so our Redemption is threefold.

- The three components of the curse are: spiritual death (to be separated from God), sickness and poverty (including debt) (Deuteronomy 28:15-68).
- The three parts of Redemption are: the new birth, healing by Jesus' bruises and divine prosperity.
