

## HOW TO RECEIVE YOUR HEALING BY FAITH

### DAY 1 – GOD'S INSTRUCTION FOR RECEIVING YOUR HEALING BY FAITH

Jesus always comes to Healing School, ready to train you to be healed. Your spiritual senses can be trained just like your physical senses. Believe you receive, and you shall have what you desire. The Bible, specifically the writing of the Apostle John, is a good source to teach us what Jesus wants us to know. God gave us an instruction and prescription for receiving anything by faith, specifically healing.

#### STUDY IT

- I. Jesus always comes to Healing School, because wherever He is, healing and salvation are there.
  - Salvation and healing are a person, and His Name is Jesus! He always comes, but He is not always received.
  - To receive what Jesus offers, just believe! Say: "I believe I receive!"
  
- II. Your spiritual senses can be trained just like your physical senses.
  - Your flesh can be trained to resist what it used to crave.
    - The training to recognize and choose good from evil comes by exercise and use (Hebrews 5:12-14).
    - The more you are listening, the more you hear.
  - God is not an absentee father. He is always talking, leading and guiding.
    - It's like a radio station. It's always broadcasting whether your radio can receive it or not.
    - There's nothing wrong with the sender, the problem is on the receiving end.
    - You need to tune in to His voice.
  
- III. Believe you receive, and you shall have what you desire.
  - The WORD of God that you get excited about is the one that works for you.
  - Speak and believe that healing is happening for you!
  - One definition of *hope* is "a white-hot expectance with an outstretched neck."
    - Make sure your hope isn't just wishing. Healing doesn't come by wishing.
  - Jesus said we should have the faith of God (Mark 11:22).
  - Don't say that you are "praying for it," or that you "want it." Jesus said to "have it!"



- God sent His WORD, and when they received it, they were healed (Psalm 107:20).

IV. The writing of the Apostle John is a good source to teach us what Jesus wants us to know.

- We are told that John, speaking for Jesus, *wished* above all things that you should prosper and be in health as your soul prospers (3 John 2).
  - The *New King James Version* says John *prayed* above all things.
- God wants you to be healed.

V. God gave us an instruction and prescription for receiving anything by faith, specifically healing (Proverbs 4:20-22).

- Jesus repeated that God's WORD is spirit and life (John 6:63).
- Attend to God's WORD, incline your ear to God's sayings, don't let them depart from your eyes and keep them in the middle of your heart. God's WORDS are life to all who find them, and health (medicine) to all your flesh. Whatever your flesh needs, it's in God's WORD.
  - Attend, or tend, to The WORD of God first. Make it your first priority.
  - When The WORD of God becomes your priority and standard of life, your days of debt, sickness and disease are over.

VI. Incline your ear to God's WORD, no matter what the cost.

- When listening to Brother Kenneth E. Hagin, Kenneth and Gloria made a commitment: Whenever they see something in God's WORD, they put that WORD into their lives.
  - They don't alter The WORD to fit their lifestyle; they choose to alter their lifestyle to fit God's WORD.
  - Every time they hear what God's WORD says to them, that's what they do.
- You can make the same commitment.

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

Write down the date and time of your commitment to believe God's WORD, and with His help, change your lifestyle to fit His commands.

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### DAY 2 – GOD'S WORD AND HEALING—THE LIVING CONNECTION

There is a living connection between God's WORD and healing! Get a vision of yourself healed. Your sickness and pain will try to talk to you; talk back to it in faith. Develop your faith to receive healing by continually feeding on The WORD of God. Jesus bore your sickness and disease, and it's your job to resist them.

#### STUDY IT

- I. Get a vision of yourself healed.
  - The vision of life is in God's WORD; it gives you life.
  - Don't let God's WORD depart from your eyes (Proverbs 4:20-23).
  - You need to actually *read* healing scriptures. Let them go into your eyes, so you can see yourself healed and prosperous.
  - If you've been looking at yourself in the mirror of your own mind, there's no vision of healing there.
  - See yourself doing whatever you couldn't do before you were healed.
- II. Your sickness and pain will try to talk to you; talk back to them in faith.
  - The fig tree talked to Jesus. We know that because Jesus answered the tree (Mark 11:12-14).
  - You need to learn how to talk back when you are attacked.
  - Years ago, Kenneth Copeland's leg was talking to him.
    - When he was preaching, he didn't feel any pain, because he was in the anointing.
    - When he was not preaching, the pain was intense.
  - When he sought help, The LORD said, *You are not reading the Scripture, you are just quoting it.*
    - Quoting scriptures is not the same as reading the scriptures.
    - The memory of a potato will not nourish you. You have to get it into your system for it to nourish you.
    - Medicine doesn't do any good in the bottle; you've got to get it into your system.
- III. Develop your faith to receive healing by continually feeding on The WORD of God.
  - God's WORD feeds the human spirit the way natural food feeds the physical body.
  - Man does not live by bread alone (Matthew 4:4).



- You eat physical food that produces physical strength. As you use strength, you have to replenish your body.
- You have to feed on The WORD of God to produce a spiritual strength called faith (Romans 10:17).
- Put that WORD in your eyes and ears; let it come out of your mouth until it gets into your heart. Then protect it—keep your heart with all diligence for out of it flow the forces of life.
  - The forces of life are spiritual forces that your flesh must have in order to live.
  - You must protect your heart by listening to and speaking faith.
- Do we have to study faith, again? Yes! If you only ate food when you went to church, you'd starve!
  - You feed your body three hot meals a day; you feed your spirit one snack a week.
- Read scriptures on healing and meditate on them for at least an hour. Continually feed your faith.
- Here are some scriptures to feed your faith.
  - "Strengthen ye the weak hands, and confirm the feeble knees...behold, your God will come with vengeance, [now that Jesus has come, we can say our God has come] even God with a recompense; he will come and save you" (Isaiah 35:3-6).
  - Your life span should be a least 120 years (Genesis 6:3).
  - The memory of the just is blessed (Proverbs 10:7). That's you!
  - Jesus bore our griefs, sorrows, sicknesses, diseases, weaknesses and pains (see Isaiah 53:4).

#### IV. Jesus bore your sickness and disease, and your job is to resist them.

- Jesus suffered when He was tempted. He had never been tempted before in all His existence. But when He took upon Himself flesh, He suffered temptation.
  - Jesus learned obedience by what He suffered (Hebrews 5:8).
- You are not qualified to bear what Jesus bore on the cross, but you suffer when you are tempted.
- The suffering of the born-again child of God is to resist everything that Jesus bore on the cross, steadfast in faith (1 Peter 5:9).
  - He bore sin, we resist it. He bore sickness and disease, we resist them.

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

Make this declaration with us:

*Jesus went to the cross and bore all of the curse for me. Now, I refuse to put up with or be tormented by ANY part of the curse! Jesus has redeemed me from the curse, so I am free! Praise The LORD Jesus Christ!*





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### DAY 3 – A JOURNEY THROUGH SCRIPTURES FOR YOUR HEALING

Take a journey through scriptures for your healing! Every day, read healing scriptures aloud to feed your faith on God's WORD. The source of faith is The WORD of God!

#### STUDY IT

- I. Every day, read healing scriptures aloud to feed your faith.
  - Kenneth Copland had a physical exam in 2016. The tests showed some plaque in his arteries.
  - As he was reading his daily healing scriptures, his eyes were drawn to a specific scripture.
    - Ephesians 5:26 tells us we are cleansed by the washing of the water of The WORD.
    - He spoke to the plaque according to Mark 11:23-24 for it to leave his body and to be cast into the sea. He spoke, and he believed in his heart, so he knew he would receive.
    - Each time he thought about that plaque, he reminded the plaque it was just a memory. His arteries had had a bath, a washing, and they were, and still are, cleansed by faith!
  - In 2017 he had another, very comprehensive physical that showed no plaque anywhere in his body.
  
- II. Let's go through some healing scriptures to feed our faith on God's WORD.
  - Faith comes by hearing and hearing by The WORD of God.
    - Some people think it's not God's will to heal them, but that's not true.
    - God will not promise you something that is not His will to do.
  - Jesus said He was willing to heal the leper; therefore, He's willing to heal you (Matthew 8:2-3).
  - Jesus and the apostles in the book of Acts did not tell anyone to keep their sickness, or wait for their healing. They were healed right away.
  - Jesus said the daughter of the covenant should be loosed *today* from the bondage of the devil (Luke 13:16).
  - You are a partaker of the covenant; therefore, you should be healed and loosed from bondage, *today* (Galatians 3:29)!

III. The WORD of God is the source of faith.

- Thomas believed with his natural mind when he saw Jesus (John 20:24-29). There was no faith there.
- We can have faith in our natural mind when we are in church, doing all the things we are supposed to do, but we are not growing spiritually. Our soul is being developed.
- Your spirit cannot grow without faith growing. You must believe that your faith grows, *before* you see any evidence.

Think of something you are praying to receive. Write two scriptures you will use to feed your faith, as you speak God’s will concerning your need.

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### DAY 4 – THE HEALING POWER OF GOD IS IN YOU

The healing power of God is in you! God has given us instructions on how to receive anything by faith, and specifically, how to receive healing. Faith comes first, then you see results. The WORD of God is the source of faith. Faith works by saying. Kenneth Copeland prays through the authority he has been given as a prophet of God by the Head of the Church, Jesus Christ of Nazareth.

### STUDY IT

- I. God has given us instructions on how to receive anything by faith, and specifically, how to receive healing (Proverbs 4:20-22).
  - God said we should pay attention to His WORDs. Listen to His sayings with your ears, and read them with your eyes.
  - We are to meditate on His WORD, for it gives us life and health (medicine) for our bodies and souls (our flesh).
    - Whatever your flesh needs is in God's WORD.
  - Faith will come as you hear God's WORD (Romans 10:17).
  - Put God's WORD first; pay attention to it.
    - Read healing scriptures every day. They will cause your faith to grow.
    - For starters, read these: Romans 8:11, 28; Hebrews 13:8; Mark 16:15-20; James 5:14-15, 1:4; 3 John 2; 1 John 4:4; Mark 11:23-24.
- II. Faith comes first; then you see results.
  - Thomas did not have faith to believe that after Jesus was crucified, He was alive.
  - Thomas in effect said: I will not believe until I see (John 20:24-25).
  - Jesus told him: Thomas, be not faithless. Because you have seen Me, you have believed (verses 26-29).
  - That experience caused Thomas to believe that Jesus had been raised from the dead.
  - Thomas waited until he saw, then he believed. There's no faith in that.
- III. The WORD of God is the source of faith.
  - It is possible for your faith to grow (2 Thessalonians 1:3).
  - You grow spiritually only when your faith grows.





- Some people read God's WORD, but they doubt their faith is growing, because they don't see any change.
  - It takes faith to believe your faith is growing.
  - When will you believe your faith is growing? After you feel it? No, that's not faith.

IV. Faith works by saying.

- Whosoever shall say and not doubt and believe that what he says will come to pass shall have it. Therefore I say... (paraphrase of Mark 11:23-24).
- Jesus said it! Once Jesus says it, it is forever, and it's for whomever (Hebrews 13:8).
- Jesus said this to me: *What things you desire.... When you pray, start believing immediately.*
- Don't wait to believe until after the pain is gone. Believe now to get rid of the pain.
- Brother Hagin spoke of a woman who had worn glasses all of her life. Thinking she was acting on faith, she took her glasses off and said, "I'm healed."
  - Even though she couldn't see, she wanted to act in faith. Remember, driving without glasses if your license says you need glasses, is breaking the law.
  - Brother Hagin said, "Put your glasses back on so you can drive safely."
  - Every morning before you put your glasses on say, "I believe I receive my healing for my eyes." Say it every time you think about your eyes.
  - She did what he said, and by the end of nine months, she could see without her glasses. Upon examination, the doctor said she had 20/20 vision.

V. Kenneth Copeland prays through the authority he has been given as a prophet of God by the Head of the Church, Jesus Christ of Nazareth.

- He takes authority over the curse of the law, sin, demons and fear, sickness and disease, and anything Jesus bore for us. He takes authority in the Name of Jesus and commands them to get out, and take their hands off of God's property.
- He also speaks to habits, worry, addiction to prescription drugs, cancer and lung disease to be bound and to leave. Every cancer cell must die!
- Brother Copeland instructs those with problems in their ears to say: "I believe I receive my healing for my ears. I believe I receive my healing from tinnitus. Tinnitus is a sickness. It is under the curse, therefore I am redeemed from tinnitus. I say it by faith. The ringing is gone. Ear noise be removed and cast into the sea."

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

Write your prayer of faith regarding anything that has attacked your body.

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### DAY 5 – HEAR AND ACT ON GOD'S WORD TO RECEIVE YOUR HEALING

Hear and act on God's WORD to receive your healing! Feed and grow your faith all the time to be healed and to stay healed. Open your eyes and ears to the words of the kingdom of God. Jesus commanded us to use His power and authority by using His Name—so use it!

#### STUDY IT

- I. Feed and grow your faith all the time to be healed and to stay healed.
  - To continue to grow, you must spend time every day listening to God and His WORD.
  - Take in God's WORD like food, and act on His WORD that you have received.
  - Next year, believe for more than you are believing for this year.
  - Learn how to come to the place where you are not getting sick then getting healed over and over again. Get healed and stay that way.
  - Take care of your body. Take care of your mind.
  - We have the mind of Christ (1 Corinthians 2:16). The anointing on Jesus' mind is available to us.
  
- II. Open your eyes and ears to the words of the kingdom of God.
  - Jesus said we should open our eyes and ears. We can choose to open or close them. It's an obedience decision (Matthew 13:15-19).
    - Any time we open our eyes and ears to the kingdom of God, we can understand and be converted.
    - Allow The WORD of the Kingdom to change the way you think, talk and act.
    - If you keep your ears and eyes on Jesus, you will be healed.
    - Because we see and hear Jesus, we are blessed.
  
- III. Jesus commanded us to use the authority of His Name (Matthew 28:18).
  - We have been given all things by God, the Father of The LORD Jesus Christ (Ephesians 1:16-23).
  - Also, we have been raised up and made to sit together with Christ far above everything that is named in heaven, on earth and under the earth (Ephesians 2:6).
    - Cancer is a name, and we are sitting in authority far above that name.



- Poverty is a name, and we have far more power and authority over that curse than we know.
- We sit on the throne of grace in authority right next to the Advocate General, Royal Commander in Chief of the universe.
- We are to come boldly to God. We are not to crawl or be sassy or beg. We belong at the throne; we have a place there (Hebrews 4:16).

#### IV. The Name of Jesus contains His power and authority—use it!

- We have been given Jesus' Name, which is above every name. At that Name, every knee must bow, and every voice proclaim that Jesus is LORD (Philippians 2:9-11)!
- When you speak the Name of Jesus, every demon in hell has to bow their knee; but they know when you're speaking in faith with authority, and when you aren't.
- The devil can smell when you have fear; he won't bow to fear.
- Remind the devil of what God has given you by saying: "I refuse to fear, I have the spirit of power, love and a sound mind" (See 2 Timothy 1:7).
- Resist the devil, and he will run (1 Peter 5:9).
- You are a believer; you're not a doubter!

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

Confess this with Kenneth Copeland:

*I receive healing in my head, ears, eyes, nose and sinuses, mouth, throat, chest, stomach, back, kidneys, all my internal organs, my insides and my outsides, hips, legs (I have the dance in my legs), knees, thighs and calves and my feet are full of joy.*

*From the crown of my head to the soles of my feet, I am bold in The LORD. I'm in God's camp. His angels are encamped around me. I'm strong in The LORD and the power of His might. I'm ready, able and willing, and He's ready, able and willing; and together we have the victory!*
