

## HEALING COMPASSION OF THE FATHER

#### DAY 1 – TRUST GOD'S LOVE TO HEAL

Learn to trust God and His love for your healing. When you're born again, you have a large spiritual capacity to contain all the fullness of God. God is the author of compassion and mercy, and He freely gives it to us.

#### STUDY IT

- I. Learn to trust God and His love for your healing.
  - Jesus met a man who was possessed by one devil (Mark 5:1-20).
    - That one devil was connected to a large group, a legion, of evil spirits that were ruling the whole geographical region. The demon-possessed man acted like he had super-powers and frightened everyone away with his ferocity.
    - Jesus cast that devil out the moment He saw the man. "Come out of the man, you unclean spirit!" said Jesus.
    - The unclean spirit forced the man to run to Jesus and fall down and worship Him. The devil was forced by the power of Almighty God to worship Jesus, because he was in the presence of the Most High God, and he knew it.
    - Jesus allowed the demons to go into 2,000 pigs. That doesn't mean there were 2,000 devils.
      - The hierarchy of the demon realm is listed in Ephesians 6:12.
    - The people asked Jesus to leave the area. They didn't understand someone who was greater than the demonic influence they had been under.
    - The man who was free from the devil wanted to go with Jesus, but Jesus told him to stay and be a witness of the compassion of God.
    - Jesus later came back to the region and was welcomed as Healer and Deliverer (Mark 6:53-56).
- II. When you are born again, you have a large spiritual capacity to contain all the fullness of God.
  - One man had the spiritual capacity to house what more than 2,000 pigs couldn't stand (Mark 5:13).
  - When a man gets born again, he has the spiritual capacity to contain **all** the fullness of God (Ephesians 3:19).
  - Look at yourself in the mirror and say, "God's in there! God's in me!"



III. God is the author of compassion and mercy, and He freely gives it to us.

- Compassion is more than a feeling—it's a Person—and His Name is Jesus!
- Jesus was often moved by compassion (Matthew 9:36).
- God, who is Love, is **filled** with compassion (Psalm 86:15).

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### DAY 2 – BE HEALED AND MADE WHOLE

Renew your mind to the healing compassion of God by speaking God's WORD to yourself. When Jesus walked the earth, He was moved with compassion to heal. Jesus was anointed to heal, and that same anointing power is in you, now!

### STUDY IT

- I. Renew your mind to the healing compassion of Jesus by speaking God's WORD to yourself.
  - Tell your soul that Jesus is compassionate. Tell your mind not to forget God's love and benefits (Psalm 103:1-3).
  - Bless The LORD with your words, and thank Him because He is full of compassion.
  - Talk to yourself and speak God's WORD to yourself.
  
- II. When Jesus walked the earth, He was moved with compassion to heal.
  - The compassion of Jesus took over when a man's friends lowered him down through the roof to receive healing (Mark 2:1-12).
  - The first thing Jesus told the sick man was to cheer up (Matthew 9:2, *TLB*).
  - Then, Jesus told the sick man his sins were forgiven.
  - The religious people there were angry that Jesus would tell the man his sins were forgiven, because they knew only God could forgive sins, and they didn't know or believe that Jesus was the Son of God.
  - Jesus knew what they were thinking and let them know that the same power of God that healed, was the same power that forgave sin—and Jesus had plenty of that power.
  
- III. Jesus was anointed to heal, and the same anointed power is in you, now!
  - Two blind men cried out for Jesus to heal them (Matthew 20:30-34).
  - When Jesus healed these men, they were able to follow Him. They didn't have to relearn how to walk. They were totally healed.
    - When you are healed by the power of God, you won't have to re-learn anything. You'll be able to walk, talk, see and everything else.



- Jesus announced that He was anointed. He specifically mentioned giving sight to the blind (Luke 4:18-19).
  - Each miraculous gift Jesus mentioned was a specific anointing in His earthly ministry.
- Jesus Christ, and that same anointed power, is in you, now!

Additional scriptures: Matthew 14:14; Psalm 86:15; Acts 3:1-8; Mark 5:25-34

Read Luke 4:18-19. The Anointing of Jesus was active when He was on the earth, and it can also be active now in your life. List how Jesus' Anointing applies to you.

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## HEALING COMPASSION OF THE FATHER

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### DAY 3 – SIMPLY RECEIVE YOUR HEALING

Jesus is easily touched with the feeling of our infirmities, and He will heal all who come to Him in faith. He was moved with compassion and performed many miracles during His earthly ministry, and He is still moved with compassion for you today. Simply receive your healing!

### STUDY IT

- I. Jesus is easily touched with the feeling of our infirmities (Hebrews 4:15), and He will heal all who come to Him in faith.
  - A leper came and asked Jesus to heal him. He said that if Jesus wanted to, He could heal him (Mark 1:38-42).
    - The leper believed that Jesus could heal him, he was just unsure that Jesus wanted to heal him.
    - The leper was about to die with the disease. He had not had human contact since he was diagnosed. No one had touched him. His only companions were others who were hopeless and dying with leprosy.
    - God had provided healing many years previously. But the preachers of the day were not preaching the compassion of the Law, but the importance of keeping every rule.
    - These people were not hearing THE BLESSING of God.
    - But this man had enough faith to go to Jesus, and find out if His compassion was real.
    - Jesus settled it forever. Jesus said, "I will."
    - Jesus' compassion moved Him to touch the man, and he was healed.
- II. Jesus was moved with compassion and performed many miracles during His earthly ministry. He is still moved with compassion for you today.
  - Jesus was going into a town and a funeral procession was coming out of the town (Luke 7:11-16).
  - Jesus told the mother not to cry. His compassion was activated by her loss.
    - Even now, compassion looks at the tears of a mother and tells her to not cry.
  - Then Jesus spoke powerful words. He told the young man who was dead to get up.
  - The man who was dead sat up in the coffin and began to speak.



Additional scriptures: John 5:16, 19

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

Jesus' compassion is as real today as it was when He ministered on the earth. Make this declaration with us:

*Jesus loves me with a powerful love. He has compassion toward me. He sees my need, and He has given me His WORD to speak over my need.*

*"\_\_\_\_\_ (fill in your area of need)! I say to you, based on the compassion of Jesus found in Luke 7:11-15, to come alive, be healed, restored and perfected for my good, in Jesus' Name!"*



## HEALING COMPASSION OF THE FATHER

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### DAY 4 - WHERE HEALING CAN BE FOUND

Psalm 91 is a foundational psalm of protection for every believer, where instructions for entering God's secret place of healing can be found. To enter God's secret place, you must believe in your heart and speak with your mouth. Jesus promises that if you put your trust in God, He will carry out this supernatural protection for you.

### STUDY IT

- I. Psalm 91 is a foundational psalm of protection for every believer, where instructions for entering God's secret place of healing can be found.
  - Psalm 91 reflects God's compassion in operation.
  - This is the soldier's psalm for every soldier in the military and in the army of God.
  - The words of this psalm must be enforced. You must say and believe them on a daily basis!
  
- II. To enter God's secret place, you must believe in your heart and speak with your mouth.
  - Psalm 91 has three speakers. The first speaker is the believer—the writer, you and me (verses 1-2).
  - You must say who God is to you. Say He is your refuge, your fortress and your God.
    - Say that you trust in Him, you trust in His love, and you trust in His compassion.
  - You get into the secret place of God by believing in your heart and saying with your mouth The WORD of God (Romans 10:9-10).
  
- III. Jesus makes declarations and promises to the one who has put his trust in God, and He will cause them to happen for you!
  - The second speaker is Jesus (Psalm 91:3-13).
  - The LORD will:
    - Deliver you from the fowler and from pestilence
    - Cover you and give you refuge like a powerful, gentle eagle
    - Give you the shield and armor of truth that lies cannot penetrate
    - Remove fear of terror, attack, disease or destruction.
  - The wicked will fall, but you will not.
  - Because God is your refuge and dwelling place, no evil shall befall you nor plague come near your house.





- Angels are agents of the Most High that have built THE BLESSING wall around you while the attacks are coming against you.

IV. Jesus will carry out this protection for you.

- The final speaker is God the Father (Psalm 91:14-16).
- The Father talks to Jesus about you.
  - Because you have set your love on the Father, He will deliver you because you know His Name.
  - The Father will answer you when you call on Him. He will be with you in trouble, deliver you, honor you, satisfy you with long life and show you His salvation.

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

Practice believing and speaking Psalm 91, and pray this prayer:

*Father God, Most High God, thank You for Your WORD. I speak Psalm 91 over myself and believe it includes Your promises to care for me and deliver me from all evil. I receive these promises given by Your compassion into my life, now! In Jesus' Name. Amen!*



## HEALING COMPASSION OF THE FATHER

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### DAY 5 – JESUS CAME TO HEAL YOU

Jesus came to redeem you from the curse, so you can live healed, prosperous and blessed!  
You can pray confidently for healing based on the authority of Scripture.

### STUDY IT

- I. Jesus came to heal you. You can pray confidently for healing based on Scripture (Mark 16:14-20).
  - Out of the mouth of two or three witnesses, that is two or three scriptures, let everything be established (2 Corinthians 13:1).
  - First witness: Jesus bore our griefs and carried our sorrows (Isaiah 53:4-5).
    - The words *grief* and *sorrow* can also be translated *sickness, disease, weakness, pain* and *toiling*.
    - The word *wounded* is also translated *tormented*.
    - Jesus was tormented, bruised, beaten and afflicted with our sins, sicknesses and diseases.
  - Second witness: Jesus healed people and drove out demons (Matthew 8:14-17).
    - Sickness and disease don't belong to God, and therefore they can't belong to you as a born-again believer.
    - The devil is the agent behind sickness and disease. They belong to him. The devil is a legalist and a serial killer.
    - Don't pray for a person's sickness.
    - Don't claim a sickness or illness as your own. It's not yours. It doesn't belong to you. Jesus bore it, so you don't have it any more.
  - Third witness: In the Old Testament, Isaiah said you **are** healed, so it's now in the past. The New Testament says you **were** healed (1 Peter 2:24).
    - Jesus made you whole in the past, He makes you whole now, and He keeps you whole in the future.
    - If you are dead to sin, then you are dead to sickness and death (Romans 6:11).
