DAY 1 –THE DEFINITION OF GRACE

In the Greek language, there are 17 definitions of “grace.” We need to determine what definition is appropriate in each scripture to get the full intent and meaning. Here are a few of them.

STUDY IT

- *Grace* can mean *thanksgiving* (1 Corinthians 10:30).
- *Grace* can mean *acceptable* (Colossians 4:6).
- *Grace* can mean the *manifestation of the power of God* (2 Corinthians 12:9).
- *Grace* can mean *benefit of life* (1 Peter 3:7).
- *Grace* can mean *covered over* (John 1:14).
- The *Anointing of God* is the *grace of God* (Philippians 1:7).
- *Grace* can mean the *effective working of His power* (Ephesians 3:6).
- *Grace* can mean the *work of God* (Acts 11:22-23).

DAY 2 – GREAT GRACE

The disciples of Jesus Christ desired to work with God using His grace to heal and demonstrate signs and wonders to anyone who would receive it. The words *grace*, *mercy* and *righteousness* have different meanings, but the concepts work together to bring the will of God into our lives.

STUDY IT

- When studying scripture, identify the meaning of the word *grace* in the particular scripture you are using.
- Definitions of the word *grace* include: graciousness, thanksgiving, acceptable, benefit, favor, gift, joy, liberality, pleasure, thankworthy, assistance from God, the anointing, the manifested measure of the Holy Spirit, result of the Holy Spirit, work of God, thankful and thankfulness.
- Grace is the Anointing of God manifesting itself, and it can produce results through any of these definitions.
- Great grace, that is, assistance from God, was on all the believers.
 - *And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all (Acts 4:33).*

DAY 3 – QUALIFIED BY GRACE

Being observant of the specific definitions of grace helps us know more about Jesus and what He has provided for us. Our faith in God's grace rises like a tide and makes receiving from God easier and easier.

STUDY IT

- Grace qualifies us for the gift of being right with God and accessing His power.
- The believers prayed, were in unity and accepted the word of grace, so the power of God was evident in their lives.
 - *And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all (Acts 4:33).*
- The power of God is offered by grace and received by faith.
- The more we learn about Jesus, the more grace is multiplied.
 - *Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord (2 Peter 1:2).*

DAY 4 – IN YOUR PLACE OF GRACE

STUDY IT

- Seeking first the kingdom of God and the grace that comes with being in your place in His kingdom makes everything easy.
 - *But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you (Matthew 6:33).*
- God's grace is working through each of us for the benefit of all.
- God is able to make all grace overflow to you, so you will have enough to do what you are called to do.
 - *And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work (2 Corinthians 9:8).*

STUDY IT

- When we get God's plan on our minds, we get in unity and forget about our differences.

- Unity and prayer are essential to have a supernatural move of God.
 - *These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brethren (Acts 1:14).*
- When the Spirit of God is evident and the Word is preached, people will come to be saved (Acts 2:37-39).

DAY 3 – QUALIFIED BY GRACE
