My eyes will be open and my ears attentive to every prayer made in this place. (2 Chronicles 7:14-15, NLT).

DAY 2 - PRAY, OBEY AND THE GLORY COMES

The model for revival is this: You pray, you obey God and God sends His glory!

STUDY IT

- The disciples were in the upper room in prayer, and the power of God came. They immediately went into action telling others the good news (Acts 2:1-6).
- The disciples were praying the scriptures and the power of God shook the place. The apostles went out and led others to minister to people in the streets (Acts 4:23-31).
- When revival comes to the United States, believers will have a responsibility to disciple new believers.
- We have a choice as a nation to share with others the blessings of God we have been enjoying all this time.
 - Finally, they said to each other, "This is not right. This is a day of good news, and we aren't sharing it with anyone! If we wait until morning, some calamity will certainly fall upon us. Come on, let's go back and tell the people at the palace" (2 Kings 7:9, NLT).
- Believers must stop being the observers, and, instead, we must jump into the role of participants.

DAY 3 - CHOOSE TO DO RIGHT

As a believer, you should do what God tells you to do in faith—believing God will bring results. You must keep doing the right thing, because it's right before God. This obedience brings great reward.

STUDY IT

- A born-again believer is not just one person without influence—each of us is a major part in everything God does.
- We are the Body of Christ, and each of us has a deliberate, specific function.
- Across the course of time, it's the littlest things that make the biggest differences—small decisions can have huge consequences.
- *Choose* is a word of great significance. You've got to make the right choices.
- Another word of significance is *discipline*. Discipline yourself to follow the choices you make.
 - For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ (2 Corinthians 10:4-5, NKJV).
- Choose to receive the glory of God into your church.

DAY 4 - YOUR ROLE IN HEALING THE LAND

God is guiding you to your calling to take care of God's earth with a servant's heart. You have just as much glory in your spirit as anyone else.

STUDY IT

- We have been created and ordained to be involved in keeping and taking care of God's Creation. That's what the Body of Christ is assigned to do.
 - Then the Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend and keep it (Genesis 2:15, NKJV).
- There's a lot more to being in the family of God than just being born-again.
- People need to know how to live as Christians, how to put the power of God to work in their families, how to depend on the Spirit of God at work, at play, at the grocery store and more.
- A calling simply means you see a need and take care of it.
- Like Isaiah, just say, "I'll go." You can be God's representative.
 - Then I heard the Lord asking, "Whom should I send as a messenger to this people? Who will go for us?" I said, "Here I am. Send me" (Isaiah 6:8, NLT).

Take the initiative to do what you see needs doing. Be ready and willing to help new believers.

STUDY IT

- God sent Peter to Cornelius because Cornelius obeyed God, had a heart to give and obeyed God.
- Peter was rewarded for his ministry to Cornelius. And, all the people Cornelius ministered to for the rest of his life, brought rewards to Peter, also.
- Paul has rewards for all the people he taught who listened to his preaching and who read the letters he wrote to the churches.
- Ananias, and others who are not named ministered to Paul. They received rewards for what they did and for all that Paul did for the kingdom of God.
- Jesus said we should make disciples, not just get people converted.

DAY 4 - YOUR ROLE IN HEALING THE LAND
