DAY 1 – THE BENEFITS OF THE BLESSING

THE BLESSING of the Lord is the most potent empowerment God has given us. THE BLESSING has benefits that we need to remember and access by faith, because they are promised to those who believe in Him.

STUDY IT

- Psalm 103 is a prophetic psalm that was also a promise. It was active in the Old Covenant, but it was prophetic to the New Covenant (Psalm 103:1-2).
- God gave man the ability to be fruitful, to multiply, to replenish, to have dominion over the earth and the authority to subdue it by speaking His Word (Genesis 1:26-28).
- God blessed Abraham and his seed, and that blessing came all the way down to us.
- Christ was made a curse for us, so that, through Him we might receive the blessing of Abraham.
 - *But Christ has rescued us from the curse pronounced by the law.... Through Christ Jesus, God has blessed the Gentiles with the same blessing he promised to Abraham...through faith (Galatians 3:13-14, NLT).*
- Like King David, tell yourself to remember God's blessing and benefits.
- Make sure Jesus is your source.

DAY 2 – JESUS IS OUR SOURCE

Jesus has promised to be your source of supply. The kingdom of God is in you and is available to you to meet your needs. Use your God-given authority to choose God and believe His Word.

STUDY IT

- You are an heir of Abraham because you are in Christ, and therefore eligible for God's promises to be real in your life (Galatians 3:29).
- If you obey the voice of the Lord and follow His Word by faith, all the blessings—and *none* of the curses—will overtake you (Deuteronomy 28).
- The blessing of the Lord makes you rich, and He doesn't demand that you toil to get it!
 - *The blessing of the LORD makes a person rich, and he adds no sorrow with it* (Proverbs 10:22, *NLT*).
- Receive Jesus as Savior and Lord, today.

DAY 3 – ACTIVATE YOUR BENEFITS

God wants you to remember the benefits He offers you. He wants you healed, delivered, satisfied with good things, enjoying a long life and crowned with His protection.

STUDY IT

- The benefits of being in God's family: He redeems you from sickness and destruction, satisfies you with good, renews your youth like the eagle and crowns you with covenant protection (Psalm 103:1-5).
- God satisfies your mouth with good things (good words) so that your youth is renewed like the eagle (Psalm 103:5).
- By the words you speak, you literally choose life, death, blessing or cursing (Deuteronomy 30:19).
- The primary purpose of words is to create. The secondary purpose is to communicate.
- God's words have the delegated power to do the work.
- One of the benefits is to speak God's words and watch those words change things.

DAY 4 – SPEAK THE BLESSING

Your words set in motion certain spiritual laws. Therefore, you must change your words to match God's Word, so that you can receive the benefits He offers you.

STUDY IT

- You are to seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness.
 - *Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need (Matthew 6:33, NLT).*
- It's your choice to receive, or not receive, each of God's benefits (Deuteronomy 30:19).
- Change your thinking and believing to what God says.
- When you make a negative confession like, "That just makes me sick! I can't believe they just did that!" you are really saying, "I can't believe God's Word, either!"
- Find the place God called you to be and get in His protection and glory.

DAY 5 – THE PROTECTION OF THE BLESSING WALL

THE BLESSING makes a wall between you and danger or distress when you walk by faith.

STUDY IT

- Every person has the opportunity to know God (Romans 1:20).
- God gives us His Word—it's up to us to obey (Matthew 7:24-27).
- God blesses us so we can be a witness to His goodness.
- Study God's Word so you will know how to talk.
- Pray for government leaders (1 Timothy 2:2).
- Live and walk by faith in God.
- Believe what you say, and you will have it (Mark 11:23-24).
- Like a farmer, sow faith-filled words and harvest one-hundredfold return in this life and also in the life to come (Mark 10:30).
