DAY 1 – YOUR WORDS ARE CONNECTED TO WHAT YOU BELIEVE

Your life is directed by two things: what you believe and what you say. What you say comes from what you believe. When you change your beliefs, your words will change.

STUDY IT

- To be successful, you must live by faith in God.
- The Holy Spirit came *into you* when you were born again.
 - The Holy Spirit wants to come *on you* for power when you receive the Baptism in the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:8).
- What you believe in your heart will be what you say (Matthew 12:34-37).
 - Jesus has made Himself the High Priest of what you say. He will take your words that agree with God's WORD and make them happen (Hebrews 4:14).
 - Say to problems, "Move!" and they will—if you believe (Mark 11:22-24).
 - Say what God says, not what you feel—"I am strong, not weak" (Joel 3:10).
- No one can control his own tongue by himself (James 3:8).
 - It takes the power of God to make the tongue only speak what you want it to say.
- Practice saying what God says about you. Practice saying His WORD (Philippians 4:19).
- God's promises are blood-sworn covenant words that He will keep (2 Corinthians 1:20).

DAY 2 – SAY WHAT YOU BELIEVE

Believe God's WORD. Then, discipline your words to agree with what you believe in your heart.

STUDY IT

- Summon those things that do not exist yet, as though they do (Romans 4:17).
 - Disregard your weakness and declare strength with your words of faith (Joel 3:10).
- If you speak God's WORD, you'll get what He promised. If you speak other than what's in God's WORD, you'll get what you fear.
- Increase comes from the words of your mouth (Proverbs 18:20).
- God listens and works according to your words, unless you speak against Him. You can stop God with your words (Malachi 3:13).
 - Be confident that God hears you, and listen for His response (John 11:42).
- God has given *you* authority over certain things in life (Proverbs 18:21).
- Receive and use the power of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1-4).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

When you are ready to use your faith, write down what you are believing for. Find and write scriptures that support the truth that it is God's will to give you what you believe. Get quiet before The LORD and make your petition to Him. Take Communion over the covenant that God will give you what you need. Continue to speak that it is done. Wait in thanksgiving until you see it.

DAY 3 – WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO SPEAK IN TONGUES?

When you are baptized in the Holy Spirit, you're given the ability to speak in a language you haven't been taught. That's the evidence you're baptized in the Holy Spirit; you can "speak in tongues."

STUDY IT

- The Holy Spirit is *within* you the instant you receive Jesus as Savior and LORD.
 - The Holy Spirit's power and ability comes *upon* you when you are baptized in the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1-4).
- Jesus was baptized in water and the Holy Spirit. Afterward, He was able to do miracles (Mark 1:9-11).
- Your words must be changed to match what you believe (Mark 11:22-24).
 - The Holy Spirit works with your words in agreement with God's WORD..
- As you begin to speak out loud (while also believing God will speak through you), the Holy Spirit supplies the words.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Are you ready to speak in an unknown language by the power of the Holy Spirit? Pray this prayer with us and then simply begin to speak, expecting the Holy Spirit to give you the syllables and sounds.

Heavenly Father, I am Your child. I have confessed that Jesus is LORD. Now, baptize me with Your Holy Spirit. I will speak, and You will put the words on my tongue. I am baptized in the Holy Spirit, and I do speak in tongues! In Jesus' Name, Amen.

DAY 4 – PRAYING IN THE SPIRIT, YOUR SPIRITUAL EQUIPMENT

Praying in the spirit, which is available to any believer who will accept it, is a supernatural weapon that the devil cannot defeat.

STUDY IT

- God's WORD is a seed, and in that seed is the life and nature of Jesus (1 Peter 1:23).
- The most powerful miracle occurs when a person accepts Jesus as his/her LORD and Savior.
 - The Spirit of God—not the flesh of man—gives life (John 6:63).
- God used faith to give you salvation.
 - You can use God's faith to get anything you need (Mark 11:22-24).
- The devil has no defense for the work of the Holy Spirit—His work is all supernatural (Mark 16:15-18).
 - When you pray in the spirit, the devil cannot understand what you are saying, therefore he cannot defeat the plans of God (1 Corinthians 14:2).
- Praying in an unknown language, in the spirit, causes you to tap into the will and power of God for yourself and others.

DAY 5 – PRAY IN THE SPIRIT ALL THE TIME

Pray in the spirit, in other tongues, to build yourself up and prepare yourself for coming events (Jude 20).

STUDY IT

- The disciples had Jesus as their guide. When Jesus ascended into heaven, He sent the Holy Spirit to guide us.
- When you're baptized in the Holy Spirit, you're filled with the supernatural power of God.
 - One of the gifts of the Holy Spirit is the ability to speak in a language unknown to you.
 - You must do the speaking. The Holy Spirit puts the words into your mouth.
 - Speaking in tongues is an act of your will; it's your choice to do it, or not.
 - Speaking in tongues is valuable:
 - You are speaking directly to God.
 - You speak out mysteries—things that have not yet been revealed (1 Corinthians 14:2).
 - You give yourself rest and rejuvenation (Isaiah 28:11-12).
