# DAY 1 - HOW TO DEVELOP YOUR FAITH IN THE NAME OF JESUS

Jesus, who is in us, is greater than he that is in the world, and Jesus has given us His Name. Faith in God and in the Name of Jesus must be nourished. Developing faith in the authority of the Name of Jesus is of vital importance when it comes to getting results in the kingdom of God and against the kingdom of darkness. Peter used faith in the Name of Jesus to heal a lame man.

- I. Jesus, who is in us, is greater than he that is in the world (1 John 4:4), and Jesus has given us His Name.
  - The Name of Jesus can become too familiar to believers. It's possible to use the Name, but have no faith in it. Mental agreement is not faith.
  - Brother Kenneth E. Hagin said many times, "No faith in the Name of Jesus, no results. A little faith in the Name of Jesus, a little result. A lot of faith in the Name of Jesus, amazing results."
  - Faith in God only comes one way—by hearing The WORD of God (Romans 10:17).
  - Faith is a vital part of your spirit being, and it became yours the moment you were born again. The WORD by which you received Jesus as your Savior brought faith.
  - You were born again by grace through faith in God's WORD. (Ephesians 2:8). Which is the gift of God? Both grace and faith are the gift of God.
- II. Faith in God and in the Name of Jesus must be nourished.
  - God designed and created everything to be nourished, and He took the responsibility to provide food.
  - The physical body has to be fed with physical food. Food produces strength.
    - As you use the energy in your body, you have to replace the energy with food. If you don't eat, eventually, you won't have any strength.
  - The same thing is true of your spirit. Faith is the strength. Faith comes by feeding on The WORD of God, by hearing it. As you use your faith, it gets used up.
  - The sign your spirit needs spiritual food is when you're not getting results when you try to use your faith.





- III. Developing faith in the authority of the Name of Jesus is of vital importance when it comes to getting results in the kingdom of God and against the kingdom of darkness.
  - In Jesus, the answer to your prayer is yes and amen (2 Corinthians 1:20).
  - The leper said to Jesus, "I know You can heal me, if You will." Jesus said, "Of course I will" (Mark 1:40-41, *TPT*).
  - Jesus told us to go and preach. He who believes in Jesus shall be saved. He who does not believe shall be condemned (Mark 16:15-18).
  - The supernatural signs that follow preaching have to do with the curse of the law (Galatians 3:13).
    - Jesus said, "In My Name shall they cast out devils. They shall speak with new tongues."
      - Even speaking in tongues has to do with the curse of the law.
        - □ When Adam sinned, he lost his supernatural communication with God.
        - On the day of Pentecost, we got it back!
    - Jesus said we could take up serpents or drink any deadly thing without being hurt. We shall lay hands on the sick, and the sick shall recover.
- IV. Peter used faith in the Name of Jesus to heal a lame man.
  - Jesus and His disciples gave the lame man something every time they walked into the Temple (Mark 11:11, 19).
  - When the lame man saw Peter and John, he recognized them. He expected to receive something from them, just like the other times (Acts 3:1-16).
    - Peter said, "I have something to give you." Peter didn't pray. He just spoke, "In the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk."
    - Peter took the man's hand, lifted him up and immediately the man's bones received strength. He was able to walk and jump.
    - This miracle was done in public. It was a sign. People wanted to know how it happened.
    - Peter was quick to say, "It's not our power or holiness that made this man walk.
       It's the Name of Jesus, and faith in the Name of Jesus that made this man strong."
  - Faith worked for Peter, not because he was an apostle, but because he was a believer.

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## DAY 2 - USING THE POWERFUL NAME OF JESUS

The Name of Jesus contains all the power of God. We must not be too lax or too familiar with the Name of Jesus. Jesus said that whatever we ask the Father in His Name, the Father will give it to us. Use the powerful Name of Jesus and see results.

- I. The Name of Jesus contains all the power of God.
  - Peter preached and demonstrated the power of the Name of Jesus (Acts 4:10).
    - By the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom they crucified, whom God raised from the dead, the lame man was made whole.
  - The apostles were told to stop preaching the Name of Jesus (Acts 4:17).
  - The apostles prayed together in agreement—in one accord (Acts 4:24-30).
  - The powerful prayer of the disciples:
    - o They acknowledged that God was God and began to rehearse His mighty works.
    - o They spoke God's WORD back to Him.
      - Acknowledging God's powerful work and speaking His WORD back to Him will bring God's power into your life and church.
    - o They prayed for boldness to speak God's WORD.
      - We need to have boldness to minister signs and wonders to the Church.
- II. We must not be too lax or too familiar with the Name of Jesus.
  - The phrase "in the Name" can become too common.
  - The power is in the Name of Jesus; but it takes faith in the Name to do the works.
    - Signs and wonders are done by the Name of Jesus.
    - When The WORD is preached under the Anointing, faith comes.
  - The Name of The LORD is a place of safety; the righteous know to stay there (Proverbs 18:10).
  - Jesus prayed just moments before His arrest: "While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Thy Name" (John 17:12).
  - Jesus kept them in the tower, inside the Name of The LORD.
  - Paul said God's whole family in heaven and earth is named for Jesus Christ (Ephesians 3:14-15).
    - o That's our name!





- III. Jesus said that whatever we ask the Father in His Name, the Father will give it to us (John 16:23).
  - Jesus didn't mention "whatever we believe;" we are just to ask and receive.
  - Does Gloria Copeland have to have faith in the name of Copeland to use it? No, that's her name.
    - o If she needs to, she can use the name of Copeland as far as Kenneth Copeland can go, based on his financial worth, physical strength, etc.
  - The Name of Jesus also belongs to Gloria Copeland by covenant of His blood—by the new birth.
  - You don't have to have faith in Jesus' Name to go before the Father or Jesus.
    - o Jesus is your Brother, your Savior, your Healer and your Financier.
    - o But, to go before satan and command him, you have to have faith in Jesus' Name.
- IV. Use the powerful Name of Jesus and see results.
  - Kenneth Copeland preached in Jamaica about the greatness of the Name of Jesus.
    - He was preaching in an area with no electricity, and it was dark. By faith, he knew there were people there listening, but he couldn't see very many.
    - A man walked up and said, "Brother Copeland, lay hands on me in the Name of Jesus."
    - o There were many people there outside the circle of the lantern light, and Brother Copeland prayed for them, in the Name of Jesus.
    - o Afterward, a woman approached and told him she had been blind, but since he prayed for her in the Name of Jesus, she could see.
    - o A physical miracle was performed by the powerful Name of Jesus.

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## DAY 3 - ASK IN THE NAME OF JESUS

Jesus ministered on the earth by teaching, preaching and healing. We can expect to do the works that Jesus did—and do greater works. Peter made a demand on the Name of Jesus, and the lame man was healed. The Name of Jesus is a power tool in the hand of a believer.

- I. Jesus ministered on the earth in a specific way.
  - Jesus taught The WORD, then He preached The WORD, and then He ministered miracles (Matthew 4:23).
  - Jesus didn't normally just come to town and start healing everyone. Their faith had to be raised by hearing God's WORD (Romans 10:17).
  - Kenneth Copeland learned from Brother Oral Roberts how to pray for the sick.
    - o First, the people had to hear God's WORD, so faith would come.
      - Then, Brother Roberts would minister healing.
    - Brother Copeland was assigned to minister in the invalid room. He had been studying under the teaching of Kenneth E. Hagin and had begun learning about the power of the Name of Jesus.
      - Oral Roberts came in and told Brother Copeland, "You're going to do the praying and you're going to lay hands. Don't worry! If you make a mistake, I'll fix it."
      - Then Brother Roberts said, "Don't touch them until you are ready to release your faith."
      - A woman had a tumor in her stomach. When Brother Copeland reached out and said, "In the Name of Je..." Oral Roberts shouted, "In the Name of Jesus, whose I am and whom I serve, get your hands off of God's property!"
      - She spit that tumor out on the ground.
    - Another time, Brother Roberts and Brother Copeland were in Detroit at a healing crusade. So many people were in attendance that Brother Copeland was set up with his own prayer line.
      - The first person in line was a lady with a tumor on her face. Brother Copeland said, "In the Name of Jesus," and when he touched her, the tumor disappeared.





- II. We can expect to do the works that Jesus did, and do greater works (John 14:12).
  - Jesus said it is the Father who dwells within who does the works (John 14:10).
  - "In that day"—we are in that day; the day that if you ask anything in the Name of Jesus, He will do it, that your joy may be made full (John 16:23-24).
  - The Greek word translated *ask*, means "to ask, to demand" or "to require of."
  - That's the reason we need the Name of Jesus, so that our lives can be filled with joy.
  - When Jesus went to the Father, He prayed that the Father would send the Holy Spirit to the believers (John 14:16).
    - Being baptized in the Holy Spirit is the gateway to the miraculous (Acts 2:1-4). The anointing for ministry service will be in you and on you.
      - Jesus didn't do anything miraculous until He was filled with the Holy Spirit (Mark 1:10).
- III. Peter made a demand on the Name of Jesus, and the lame man was healed (Acts 3:1-8).
  - Why was the man born crippled? Because of the devil.
  - If God crippled the man, how dare Peter and John go against God's will by healing him?
  - God does not bring a curse on people (Deuteronomy 28:15-68).
    - o Consider what God said about the Passover.
      - God said when He saw the blood, the destroyer would not be allowed to enter (Exodus 12:23). The death angel is not an angel of God. He's a killer.
    - Why is it blasphemous and profane to link God's Name with "damn"? God is not the damner; the devil is the killer.
    - God only sent one person to hell, and His Name was Jesus. God doesn't send people to hell.
      - The only sin that sends people to hell is not having Jesus Christ as their LORD and Savior. When they reject Him, and they are hell-bound.
  - The power and authority of death and life are in the words we speak (Proverbs 18:21).
- IV. The Name of Jesus is a power tool in the hand of a believer.
  - We have to have a weapon, even though Colossians 1:13 says we have been delivered from darkness and translated into the kingdom of God's dear Son.
    - Even though we have the power of God, we still live in a world dominated by the devil. He is the god of this world (2 Corinthians 4:4), the prince of the power of the air (Ephesians 2:2).
  - The most powerful weapon we have is the mighty Name of Jesus.
  - Whatever you bind or loose on earth is bound or loosed in heaven. If any two agree, it shall be done. Where two or three are gathered in the Name of Jesus, He is there (Matthew 18:18-20).

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

Make this declaration with Kenneth Copeland:

I declare in the Name that's above every name, The LORD Jesus Christ, my Savior, my LORD, my Healer, my Deliverer has made me free. I am free from sin. I am free from sickness. I am free from disease. I am free from lack and debt.

I declare in the Name that's above every name, satan, bow your knee in my presence, take your hand off me and take your hand off my body. Take your hand off my mind; take your hand off my family. Take your hand off all my financial affairs. Take your hand off my church. Take your hand off my business. I'll tell you who you are. You are a being. You are a fallen being. And you are subject to the mighty Name of Jesus. And you're subject before me.

I'm a believer; I'm not a doubter. I have faith in that Name. I'm born of that Name. I wear that Name. It's been given unto me. I have it. I have faith in it. I rejoice in it. I worship my Father in that Name. And I bind you, satan, on the earth, in that Name and with that Name. Therefore, Jesus has bound you in heaven on my behalf. You're bound on earth and in heaven. Get out of my presence. Hallelujah!





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## DAY 4 - THERE'S DELIVERANCE IN THE NAME OF JESUS

The Name of Jesus and supernatural power in that Name belong to every believer. The power and authority that were invested in Jesus' Name came after He was raised from the dead. The Name of Jesus can do anything Jesus can do.

- I. The Name of Jesus and supernatural power in that Name belong to every believer.
  - All these supernatural things can work in your life (Mark 16:15-18).
  - The special anointing to lay hands on the sick is yours, because you are a believer.
    - Every apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor and teacher are believers first, before he or she are called to ministry leadership.
    - Expect people to recover when a believer lays hands on them in the Name of Jesus.
  - There is an anointing for people to be healed when elders pray and anoint them with oil in the Name of The LORD. The prayer of faith shall save the sick, and The LORD shall raise him up (James 5:14-15).
    - o It's not *maybe* they will be healed; they *shall* be healed! The prayer of faith shall save the sick.
    - The prayer of faith is praying in the Name of Jesus. Get stirred up over that Name.
    - Before you pray, go through your Name-of-Jesus scriptures. Refresh yourself in the power of that Name.
    - o Say: "The Spirit of the living God is dwelling in me and on me."
    - o We've been named after that Name; it's a family name—the Name of Jesus.
    - Every name must bow its knee to the Name of Jesus.
- II. Power and authority were invested in Jesus' Name after He was raised from the dead.
  - Peter and John didn't pray for the lame man; they spoke Jesus' Name (Acts 3:1-8).
    - o Peter said, "What I have, I'll give to you." He *had* the power in the Name of Jesus.
  - We need the power and authority that Jesus gave us.
  - Jesus said, "Go in My Name." He went into heaven and left His authority with us.





- Whatever you use your authority to bind on earth is bound in heaven. It can't work any other way. Whatever you bind on earth, Jesus will bind in heaven (Matthew 18:18-20).
- God gave authority on earth to Adam, but he gave it away to satan.
  - When Jesus was raised from the dead, He got the authority back. Jesus is the second and the last Adam (1 Corinthians 15:45, 47).
- III. The Name of Jesus can do anything Jesus can do.
  - Jesus said, "Whatever you ask (demand) in My Name, I'll back it—I'll do it" (John 14:12-14, 16:23).
  - Peter made a demand on the Name of Jesus, and expected the lame man to walk.
  - The power is in the Name of Jesus.
  - Of course, all the power of heaven is accessible through the Name of Jesus.

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## DAY 5 - THERE'S AUTHORITY IN THE NAME OF JESUS

We need to use our authority and faith in the Name of Jesus. He gave us His authority and power, and put Himself in us. Jesus received His powerful Name (that we have the right to use) in three ways: inheritance, confirmation and conquest.

- I. We need to use our authority and faith in the Name of Jesus.
  - Peter told the people who had seen the miracle that Jesus' Name, through faith in His Name, made this man strong (Acts 3:6, 16).
  - We are to rise above trouble to a safe place—the Name of The LORD (Proverbs 18:10).
  - Inside the Name of Jesus, we have authority.
    - Jesus said that all authority had been given to Him; so you go (Matthew 28:18-19).
    - Jesus' authority has been invested into the Body of Christ.
  - We have been delivered from the power of darkness and translated into the kingdom of God's Son, Jesus (Colossians 1:12-13).
    - Even though darkness has no authority over us, we live in a world dominated by the devil.
  - Refuse to allow a spirit of darkness to rule your household. It's time to get your
    righteous indignation stirred up, take authority over every demon that doesn't
    belong in your house, and cast him out; even the demons that came through the TV.
    - Say: "Satan, you're not coming into my house. God has given me the responsibility of my house, and you're not coming in here."
- II. Jesus gave us His authority and power, and put Himself in us.
  - You have the power of God that was given to Jesus.
    - o If you're going to measure the power that's in Jesus' Name, you're going to have to measure the power of God, because Jesus inherited God's Names.
    - o God has ultimate power. We don't fully understand it.
  - You have the mind of Christ.
    - You have to let this mind be in you which was in Christ Jesus, who [was]...equal with God (Philippians 2:5-6).





- o Through Jesus, you are equal with Jesus and equal with God.
- Meditate on the truth that you are actually born again.
- o No man can say Jesus is LORD, except by the Holy Ghost.
- You have been made the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus.
  - o In Jesus Christ, I am righteous (2 Corinthians 5:21).
- III. Jesus received His powerful Name (that we have the right to use) in three ways:
  - 1. Jesus **inherited** the Name.
    - Jesus took the form of a servant and was made in the likeness of man. He humbled Himself and became obedient unto the death of the cross. God highly exalted Him and gave Him a Name (should be—'His Name') that is above every Name. Things (should be—beings) at the Name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven, in earth and under the earth (Philippians 2:7-11, *Darby*).
  - 2. Jesus' Name was **conferred** upon Him (Philippians 2:9; Hebrews 1:4)
  - 3. Jesus received the greatness of His Name in **conquest** (Colossians 2:9-15).
    - Jesus won His Name in combat, in hell itself.
    - Jesus rose up out and said, "I was dead, but I'm alive, and I've got the keys" (Revelation 1:18). Jesus took the keys of hell and death away from the devil.
      - o A key represents authority. Jesus took the keys and gave them to us!
    - The Name of Jesus will open every door. It will open the treasure house (1 Corinthians 1:30).

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

Make this declaration boldly with Brother Copeland:

I am a believer; I am not a doubter. I believe with all my heart Jesus has been raised from the dead. I believe that Jesus is alive and lives in me right now. I'm a believer; I'm not a doubter. I now know and understand more about the victory in that Name. The battle was Jesus'; the victory is mine. I have His Name. I'm born of His Name. He lives in me. His Spirit is alive within me. I believe in that Name. I cherish that Name. Satan, hear me. All of hell, hear me. Take your hands off my life. Take your hands off my family. Take your hands off my church. Take your hands off my affairs: all my ministry affairs; all my business affairs; all my social affairs. Take your hands off of my president, my vice-president and all members of Congress.

In Jesus' Name, I receive my healing. I receive my financial breakthrough. I receive everything that's missing in my life. I receive it returned with interest, in Jesus' Name. You bring it back, devil, sevenfold. You bring it back right now. You're the thief.

I rejoice in the victory of that Name. I am a new creature. I am in Christ Jesus. I am robed in His righteousness. What belongs to Him, belongs to me. What belongs to me, belongs to Him. I'm rising up. I'm going to a new place. I'm going higher and higher and higher and





higher in the kingdom of His righteousness and in the realm of the spirit. Be it done unto me as You have spoken, LORD Jesus. Your will be done in my life on earth as it is in heaven.

I rejoice. I'm victorious. I'm a new creature. I am a believer. Whoever heard of a believer who doesn't believe? I have faith in God and I say to this mountain, "Be thou removed. Be thou cast into the sea." I do not doubt in my heart, but I believe that those things that I say, come to pass. Therefore, I have what I say when I speak in the Name that's above every name, the mighty Name of Jesus!
