DAY 1 – HEALING IS FOR YESTERDAY, TODAY AND FOREVER

Welcome to Healing School! Our golden scripture this week is “Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today and forever” (Hebrews 13:8). Faith begins where the will of God is known.

STUDY IT

- I. Welcome to Healing School!
 - Gloria Copeland has said, “Jesus always comes to Healing School.”
 - Low back problems are being healed right now. Go ahead and take a new spine.
 - One of Brother Copeland’s friends, Gary Wood, was in a car wreck. His sister continued to speak and pray for him to live. He died and was in heaven. He came to a room filled with body parts. An angel told him this is the parts room. When people call on God for new body parts by faith, the angels deliver these to their bodies. That’s where people get miraculous new hearts.
 - Gary had planned to have a ministry as a singer, but his larynx and vocal cords were destroyed in the accident. When he came back to life, he preached, sang and brought glory to the kingdom of God without vocal chords! That’s a sign and wonder.
 - A sign points you to something, and a wonder makes you wonder.
 - Don’t spend time trying to figure out why things are not working; turn it around and say, “What a wonder how quickly I’m getting healed.” That’s a praise to God.
 - Get a new heart today. It is being distributed here. Receive a new spine, new eardrums and new joints by calling on Jesus by faith.
- II. Our golden scripture this week is “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever” (Hebrews 13:8).
 - God and His WORD never change.
 - Speak this confession: “Jesus Christ, the same, yesterday, today and forever.”
 - Jesus taught, preached and healed. He’s still teaching today.
 - With Jesus there is no shadow of turning (James 1:17). This verse refers to a sundial. It doesn’t keep time in the dark! God’s shadow never moves. He doesn’t vary from day to day or time to time. He is totally unchangeable!
 - God’s WORD and His Name never change.





- If God healed yesterday, He heals today. Just like salvation, healing is always available.
- If God doesn't heal today, you can't believe Him to save you today.
- How do you know God heals today? You learned it from God's WORD.
- The same saving Jesus is the same healing Jesus.
- Jesus read, "The Spirit of The LORD is upon me...." (Luke 4:18-19). Jesus is still teaching, preaching and healing today
- Jesus is the same—He does not change.

III. Faith begins where the will of God is known.

- A leper worshipped Jesus and said, "LORD, if You will, You can make me clean." Jesus said, "I will" (Matthew 8:2-3).
- Faith begins where the will of God is known. When you're not sure of God's will about a certain thing, you can't have faith for that. You cannot have faith beyond your knowledge of God's will, His WORD, His motives, His ideas and His concepts.
- Faith comes by hearing The WORD of God (Romans 10:17).
- When you hear The WORD, receive it. If it's for anybody, it's for you. God is the same yesterday, today and forever.
- God's WORD will still be true forever, even after sickness and disease have been eradicated from the face of this planet, and the devil slung out into that lake of fire. We'll still be celebrating this leper's faith and healing. Then, the leper will tell his side of the story!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Pray this prayer with us:

LORD Jesus, thank You for being my Healer. Thank You for bearing sin, sicknesses, diseases, weaknesses, pains, poverty and all the curse for me. Every place where You abide is filled with Your glorious, miraculous power. The healing anointing is here.





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DAY 2 – TODAY IS YOUR DAY FOR HEALING

A description of the healing of a leper is found in Matthew, Mark and Luke. Jesus is as ready to heal today as He was then. The centurion had faith for the healing of his servant because of what he heard about Jesus. We can receive with joy as we use our faith.

STUDY IT

- I. A description of the healing of a leper is found in Matthew, Mark and Luke.
 - Jesus moved with compassion to heal the leper. Jesus touched the leper and healed him (Mark 1:40-42).
 - The same account regarding the leper is in Matthew (Matthew 8:1-3). Jesus put forth His hand and touched him saying, "I will; be thou clean." Immediately, the leprosy departed from him.
 - We also have a diagnosis from a physician of the leper's serious condition (Luke 5:12-13). The man was full of leprosy—stage four—dying. The man knelt before Jesus and then fell on his face asking to be cleansed.
- II. Jesus is as ready to heal today as He was then.
 - Jesus rebuked the fever in Peter's mother-in-law. The fever heard Him and left (Matthew 8:14-15).
 - Don't ask, "Please pray for my arthritis." Prayer won't help because you have taken ownership of it by saying "*my* arthritis." That's not your arthritis, your migraine, your earache or your sinus problem.
 - Jesus bore every sickness. He carried it and took it away. He went to hell over it and destroyed its power over you.
- III. The centurion had faith for the healing of his servant because of what he heard about Jesus.
 - When the centurion heard of Jesus, he sent the Jews to ask for healing for his servant (Luke 7:1-9).
 - The centurion had faith in The WORD. His faith required no physical evidence, just the authority of that WORD itself.



- The centurion built a synagogue for the Jews. That's the synagogue over which Jairus was the leader.
- The centurion's servant was sick with palsy. Jesus said, "I will come and heal him" (Matthew 8:5-7).
- Every word Jesus spoke, and everything Jesus did was the will of the living God Himself. Jesus is the Healer.
- Not one time did Jesus or any apostle ever say to anybody, "You'll have to keep this awhile, because you're being taught something out of it." No! Today is your day for healing.

IV. We can receive with joy as we use our faith.

- Brother Copeland had to take hold of the joy of recording daily television.
 - He was obeying God, but not with joyfulness and gladness of heart (Deuteronomy 28:47).
 - He had to make an adjustment in his attitude. By faith he had to say, "I love daily television."
 - When Brother Copeland became willing, the anointing during the recordings of daily TV programs became stronger.
 - He made a decision—a quality decision about which there is no argument and from which there is no retreat.
- The joy of The LORD is your strength (Nehemiah 8:10). One reason Brother Copeland was tired was that his joy level was low.

V. Jesus is The WORD Himself.

- The WORD of God is alive and powerful and sharper than a two-edged sword. It will divide the soul and spirit and the joints and marrow. It is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Hebrews 4:12).
- The WORD is a person. Jesus is alive. The WORD is God.
- Receive from God through faith in God's WORD.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Do you have areas in your life that need more joy? Are you obedient, but not actually willing? It's time to change. God has a reward for you as you obey Him with joy. Write some scriptures that will help you increase your joy and your strength (hint: Isaiah 1:19; Philippians 4:4; Hebrews 11:6).



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DAY 3 – THE POWER THAT FORGIVES IS THE POWER THAT HEALS

The LORD Jesus, our Healer, went to the cross and bore our judgment, so we can be forgiven. The WORD of God that assures us of forgiveness is not just words on a page. It is alive! Jesus doesn't need to do something else for you to be healed. He's already done it all. Jesus forgave and healed a man who had leprosy. Obey the royal law to forgive and love your neighbor as yourself.

STUDY IT

- I. The LORD Jesus, our Healer, went to the cross and bore our judgment so we can be forgiven.
 - We can receive by faith what God promised—forgiveness, salvation and healing.
 - Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever (Hebrews 13:8).
 - The same Jesus who saves us is the Jesus who heals us.
 - The Bible said Jesus taught, preached and healed. He's still doing it today.
- II. The WORD of God that assures us of forgiveness is not just words on a page. It is alive and is sharper than any two-edged sword (Hebrews 4:12-13). The WORD *is* God.
 - You can receive your healing from God through His WORD. That's not the only way, but it's the best way.
 - The gifts of the Spirit are available, and they bring miraculous healing (1 Corinthians 12:7-11).
 - If you have some serious problem in your life, something that is carrying death with it, don't wait for a miracle. Get in God's WORD, and receive help right now.
- III. Jesus doesn't need to do something else for you to be healed. He's already done it all. He's right there in you by His Spirit performing His WORD.
 - Every time you say, "He was wounded for my transgressions," something is happening. Faith comes when you speak it. Faith is coming.
 - You can't feel faith with your physical body. Faith is a spiritual force.





- You have God's oath that when you hear His WORD, faith comes (Romans 10:17). Faith always comes! As you hear and speak, you are building! Faith is coming!
 - Jesus bought and paid for your healing. You have The WORD of the living God on it; and in the Name of Jesus, you are healed!
- IV. Jesus forgave and healed a man who had leprosy (Matthew 9:1-8; Mark 2:1-12).
- First, Jesus told the leper, "Thy sins are forgiven."
 - Jesus had power on earth to forgive sins.
 - The listeners were not hostile. They came to Jesus' house to hear. Jesus saw their faith. When Jesus said to the man, "Be healed," they didn't have any problem.
 - But when Jesus said, "Your sins are forgiven," some with religious training were distracted and turned their focus away from what Jesus was saying.
 - Jesus was teaching the truth—the same power that forgives, heals.
 - Say this: "The same power that forgives, heals."
- V. Obey the royal law to forgive, and love your neighbor as yourself (James 2:8).
- If someone has hurt you, forgive them because God has forgiven you.
 - Jesus saves *and* heals—yesterday, today and forever.
 - People who believe Jesus doesn't heal today, should be concerned that He doesn't save today.
 - Not you! You learned from the Bible that you can be born again. You found out about it, you believed it, and you spoke it. You have full assurance that you are saved.
 - Have that same confidence that Jesus has saved you *and* healed you!

Additional scripture: Isaiah 61:1

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Make this confession:

Heavenly Father, in obedience to Your WORD, I forgive. If I have offense against any, it stops right now. My body is ready to receive its healing, in Jesus' Name! I am washed and cleansed by The WORD of God.



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DAY 4 – HEALING POWER IS ALWAYS HERE

Healing power is always here. Obey the commandment of God to forgive, and your healing will be unhindered. Jesus was teaching and preaching, and the power of God was there to heal.

STUDY IT

- I. Healing power is always here.
 - That's why God put the account of the man with palsy, lowered down through the roof and being healed, in three gospels (Matthew 9:1-8; Mark 2:3-12; Luke 5:17-26).
 - The people at Jesus' house didn't have trouble believing Jesus could say with authority for the man to take up his bed and walk.
 - They knew he would be healed, because they had heard Jesus say He was Anointed (Isaiah 61:1). The power of The LORD was present to heal.
 - But when Jesus told the man, "Your sins be forgiven thee" they were surprised.
 - Jesus was teaching that the same power that forgives will heal.
 - Jesus knew what they were thinking and asked them which is easier, to forgive sin or to heal the body?
 - Jesus wanted them to know that He had the power to forgive sins and minister healing. It's the same power!
- II. Obey the commandment of God to forgive, so your healing will be unhindered.
 - God has forgiven you, so you should forgive others. This fulfills the Law and the prophets. It's the "royal law" (James 2:8).
 - Little tiny grains of unforgiveness can build up on the inside. As you repent, you are washed with the water of The WORD (Ephesians 5:26).
 - In order to move into healing, be picky about what you allow yourself to say. Be careful when someone gets ready to dump their criticism of someone else onto you. Your ears were not created to be garbage pails.





- III. Jesus was teaching and preaching (Luke 5:17-26). The power of God was there to heal them.
- When the man was lowered into Jesus' house and was healed, the people were all amazed and glorified God.
 - Brother Copeland thought that only the one man got healed. The word of The LORD said to him, *What do you think was going on when they all were glorifying Me?*
 - The power of God started moving in there, and many were healed as they glorified God.
 - Receive your healing now!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

The forgiving, healing power of God is always available to you. Make a list of the healings you need in your life. Then, speak over every item in your list that Jesus Christ healed and made people whole yesterday, and He will heal and make *you* whole today. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever.



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DAY 5 – KEEP THE SWITCH OF FAITH TURNED ON TO BE HEALED

Faith begins where the will of God is known. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever. Kenneth Copeland reads scriptures from Keith Moore's book *God's Will to Heal*. Keep the switch of faith turned on!

STUDY IT

- I. Faith begins where the will of God is known.
 - When you're not sure about God's will, you can't have faith for that. You cannot have faith beyond your knowledge. You've got to have knowledge of His will, knowledge of His WORD, knowledge of His motives and His ideas and His concepts. God's WORD is His will. He doesn't will one thing and say another.
 - Brother Copeland recommends Keith Moore's book *God's Will to Heal*. You can go to his website, moorelife.org, and download this book.
 - Keith Moore graduated from Rhema Bible Training Center. Afterward, he stayed, taught Healing School and assisted Brother Kenneth E. Hagin for 17 years.
- II. Our golden text is Hebrews 13:8. "Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today and forever."
 - How do we know whether it's God's will to heal us? God is no respecter of persons, and He never changes. So what Jesus said yesterday, He's still saying today.
 - What did God say? Kenneth Copeland reads aloud the 101 scriptures about healing from Keith Moore's book *God's Will to Heal*.
 - Exodus 15:26; Genesis 6:3, 15:15; Job 5:26; Exodus 12:13, 23:25-26; Deuteronomy 7:15, 11:9, 21, 23:5, 28:61, 33:25; Nehemiah 13:2; Galatians 3:13; Job 33:24-25; Psalm 30:1-2, 29:11, 41:2, 3, 43:5, 91:10, 16, 103:3, 107:20, 118:17, 147:3.
 - Proverbs 4:10, 3:8, 4:22, 15:30, 16:24, 17:22; Nehemiah 8:10; Isaiah 32:3, 35:5-6, 32:4, 38:16, 20, 40:29, 31, 41:10, 46:4, 53:4-5, 10, 57:19, 58:8; Jeremiah 30:17, 33:6; Ezekiel 34:16, 37:5, 14, 47:9; Amos 5:4, 6; Malachi 4:2.
 - Matthew 8:3, 17, 9:12, 29, 14:14, 4:23, 10:1.



- Matthew 12:15; Hebrews 13:8, Jesus healed them all, and Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever!
- Matthew 14:36, 15:26; Luke 9:1; Mark 7:37, 9:23, 11:23-24, 16:18; Luke 4:18; Isaiah 10:27, 61:1; Luke 9:11, 56, 10:19, 13:16; 2 Corinthians 6:2; John 1:4, 6:33, 35, 63; John 10:10, 11:25, 14:14; Acts 3:16, 4:30.
- Acts 9:34, Jesus Christ makes you whole. Say: I (put your name) receive it!
- Acts 10:38, 19:12; Romans 8:2, 11; 1 Corinthians 6:15, 19-20, 11:29-31, 12:9; 2 Corinthians 4:10-11, 1:10; Ephesians 1:21-22, 6:3; Colossians 1:13; 2 Timothy 4:18; Ephesians 5:26; Hebrews 2:9, 14-15, 10:22, 12:12-13; James 5:14-16; 1 Peter 2:24; 2 Peter 1:3; Revelation 22:17; 3 John 2.
- Give The LORD praise and thanksgiving for His WORD.
