



ACTIVATING YOUR COVENANT WITH GOD

DAY I – PUTTING YOUR HEALING COVENANT INTO ACTION

Being in covenant with God gives us a position to comprehend what we've been given—**THE Name of God**. We activate our healing covenant by putting it into action using our faith in Jesus and our words. Actions of faith are hindered by unforgiveness.

STUDY IT

- I. Our guest, Dr. Greg Stephens, is a professor at Kenneth Copeland Bible College®, and teaches on the first covenant.
 - It's not enough to know and believe God's WORD. We must put our covenant of healing and abundant life into action.
 - In the past, gentiles were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world: But now in Christ Jesus, gentiles have been brought into God by the blood of Christ (see Ephesians 2:11-13).
- II. The Name of God is such a holy Name that the Jewish people do not speak it out loud.
 - It's **THE Name of God**, and in Hebrew it's spelled *Yod Heh Vav Heh*.
 - In reality, it's no more holy than *Yeshua*, or Jesus; *Yeshua Hamashiach*—Jesus the Messiah.
 - The Name of God in English in the Old Testament is written LORD or Jehovah.
 - God changed Abram's name to **Abraham**—the Hebrew letter *Heh* was inserted indicating that God was in Abraham, and Abraham was in God.
 - If you are in Abraham, which you are because of Jesus, you have God's Name in you.
 - THE Name of God in English is abbreviated *YHVH*.
 - In Paleo Hebrew, which gives picture symbols for each letter, *Yod* is an "open hand," *Heh* is "to behold," *Vav* is a "nail," and *Heh* is "to behold."
 - That is, "Behold the hand, behold the nail." It all points to one person—Jesus.
 - The moment Thomas saw the nail prints in Jesus' hands, he never doubted again. He realized Jesus was *YHVH*, the Messiah.





- “Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father” (Philippians 2:9-11).
- Brother Copeland gives a better translation of Philippians 2:9-11.
 - In verse 9, “a” should be marked out. It should say, “given him *His Name (YHVH)* which is above every name.”
 - Continuing to verses 10-11: “That at the Name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things, beings, names in heaven; things, beings, names in earth; and things, beings names under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is *Yod Hey Vav Hey* to the glory of *Yod Hey Vav Hey*, His Father.”
- Jesus Christ is *Yod Heh Vav Heh*.
- Brother Copeland asked The LORD to teach him *Yod Heh Vav Heh*. It was such a holy moment that he shook and tears came to his eyes.
 - God said to Brother Copeland, “I will,” and He has.
 - Even the thought of that Name causes Brother Copeland’s faith to shoot up to new heights. When he speaks the Name, his lips are blessed.
- Not only did Jesus receive THE Name, the whole family on earth is named after God (Ephesians 3:14-15).
- Your name is equal to *Yod Heh Vav Heh* by the covenant of blood.

III. We who believe in Jesus are to do greater works.

- Jesus said that whoever believes in Him would do greater works because He was going to the Father (John 14:12).
- Here are the greater works written in Ephesians 3:16-21.
 - God will dwell in your heart by faith.
 - You will comprehend—have working knowledge—of God’s ways.
 - You will know the love of Christ and be filled with the fullness of *Yod Hey Vav Hey* Himself.
 - God will do exceeding abundantly above all that you ask or think—through you.
 - You will be a witness of God by your health. *Yod Hey Vav Hey*. THE God is being expressed through you.
 - We are going to press into God to see greater miracles than we have seen before.

IV. There’s a difference between knowledge and comprehension.

- It’s like the difference between being a passenger in an airplane and flying the plane yourself.



- It's like flying an airplane by trusting the instruments rather than trusting what you can see out the window.
 - When we comprehend the covenant, everything we read in God's WORD points to the certainty of the covenant we have in Christ.
 - We don't even think without our dependence on the covenant, and the reminder of THE Name, *Yod Hey Vav Hey*, renews our resolve.
 - Professor Greg Stephens began praying daily over 25 years ago, "LORD, reveal Yourself to me today." And He does!
 - The LORD reveals Himself by activating Greg's understanding of the covenant. Greg sees The LORD throughout the Bible.
 - The comprehension of the covenant has become a part of Greg, part of his arsenal to resist sickness because it's in the curse.
- V. Being in covenant with God is a positional reality.
- We are told to come boldly to the throne of grace (Hebrews 4:16) and take our position.
 - Where do you see yourself when you come to the throne of grace?
 - Brother Copeland said that for years when he came to the throne of grace, in his mind, he saw himself bowed down on his face.
 - One day, Jesus said, "Kenneth, get up from there. You are seated with Me in heavenly places. Now, come over here at My right hand. I sit at My Father's right hand. You have My authority, My Name and My WORD. My God is your God. Now sit here" (see Ephesians 1:20, 2:6).
 - You have the power of the blood of Jesus and THE Name, *Yod Hey Vav Hey*.
- VI. We have been given healing, but there are some hindrances to receiving it.
- Our doubts, our *ifs*, must be overcome.
 - When the devil tempted Jesus, he used the word *if* to try to instill doubt.
 - The leper who came to Jesus said, "*If* You are willing, You can heal me" (Luke 5:12-13).
 - Jesus told us, "*If* ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you" (John 15:7).
 - God said, "*If* My people, which are called by My name...then will I hear from heaven, forgive their sin, and will heal their land" (2 Chronicles 7:14).
 - That promise is to God's people, those who are in position to receive the covenant promise.
 - Our Founding Fathers were in covenant with God about this land. Through their words and our faith, we can receive the covenant promise. God will forgive the sins of this nation and heal our land.



VII. Forgiveness and healing come from the same Source—Jesus.

- The woman with the issue of blood spoke her faith, and she was made whole (Mark 11:23-24).
- Healing has not passed away. God still heals when we approach Him by faith in His WORD.
- Faith has not passed away. If it had, no one could be born again, for we are born again by grace through faith (Ephesians 2:8).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Jesus promised we would see and do greater works than He did on the earth.

Write what you expect to see and do as the greater works manifest in your church and in your life.



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DAY 2 – EVERY COVENANT MUST BE ACTIVATED

Every covenant must be activated. If we don't activate the covenant with joyfulness and gladness of heart for the abundance of all things, we open ourselves to the curse. You have an angel to help you; Jesus said so.

STUDY IT

- I. Every covenant must be activated.
 - We who were gentiles have been brought near to God through the blood of Jesus (Ephesians 2:11-13).
 - We are in covenant with God and have access to His power by the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
 - Brother Copeland has covenant Partners. His agreement is that he prays for them every day.
 - By his prayers, Brother Copeland activates his part of the covenant. The Partners activate their part with prayer and finances.
 - Brother Copeland is not pastor of a church, but he still has a congregation. It's located all over the world.
 - The first partner service Brother Copeland attended was when he was a driver for Oral Roberts. Brother Roberts said if anyone would become his partner, he would pray for them every day.
 - The partnership, the covenant, had to be activated.
 - Brother Copeland pledged to give \$10 a month, but since he didn't have \$10, he put a pencil in the giving envelope that was passed out in the meeting.
 - Immediately, a woman behind him said, "Hey, you!" and gave him \$10. So he retrieved the pencil and put the \$10 in the envelope.
- II. If we don't activate the covenant with joyfulness and gladness of heart for the abundance of all things, we open ourselves to the curse (Deuteronomy 28:45-47).
 - Years ago, The LORD told Brother Copeland to have a daily television broadcast. He said the country needs a daily broadcast to learn how to walk by faith.
 - During this time the news was filled with stories of TV-preacher scandals.



- Brother Copeland was already exhausted from two weeks of meetings in Australia. He didn't want to add another broadcast to his already full schedule, but he agreed to do the daily broadcast.
- Later, some serious problems developed in this ministry. The LORD said, *You'd better get your house in order.*
- Brother Copeland said, "I'm standing on Isaiah 1:19 that says, 'If you are willing and obedient, you will eat the good of the land' for help." The LORD said, *You don't qualify for that promise. You obeyed Me to do the daily broadcast, but you have not had one good thing to say about it, not one time. You are not willing.*
- Brother Copeland determined to change his attitude. He began saying, "I love daily television." When he confessed his wrong attitude on the broadcast and spoke that he loved daily television, the joy of The LORD came into his heart and he ran around the table!

III. You must activate the covenant in your life. Your religious tradition can make the covenant of no effect.

- The LORD asked Brother Copeland to live to be 120 years old (Genesis 6:3).
 - He agreed and now he is well and strong. First, he dropped from 40% to 30% body fat. His ideal body fat is 15%, and now he measures at 14.7%.
 - At 83, The LORD has balanced his body to where he wanted to be when he was 30.
- Brother Copeland activates his covenant daily by reading God's WORD, praying and announcing it to the devil, demons and the angels in the room.
 - He is convinced that is the reason he is in good physical condition.
- Jesus said, "Whatever you ask in My Name, I will do it" (John 14:14).
- A friend who reads and speaks 32 languages told Brother Copeland that in the Greek, it says, "Whatever you ask in My Name, if I don't have it, I will create it."

IV. You have an angel to help you; Jesus said so (Matthew 18:10).

- As your life and ministry increases, that angel becomes the boss angel of your life and ministry, and upon further growth, God will assign other angels to help.
- God promises to bless your bread and water (Exodus 23:25), and your angel watches over what you eat and drink.
 - It's possible to bind your angel from taking sickness away from your food by saying things like, "This stuff makes me sick."
- Brother Copeland demonstrates how we bind our angels from helping us.
 - He coughs, then says, "I am coming down with something." The angel thinks, *All right, because of his words, I am helpless to be his protector. He won't let me.*



- Brother Copeland gives another demonstration. He feels a pain in his side and says, "I wonder what that is?" The devil says, "Would you believe cancer?"
- Your angel says, "Get in God's WORD. Renew your faith in your covenant of healing and refuse sickness."

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Our covenant with the Father and Jesus needs to be activated by our words and actions of faith. Let's pray together that God would teach us how to activate the covenant in a greater way.

Heavenly Father, we ask You to help us. We want to activate our covenant with You in a greater way. Teach us, please, what to say, what to do and what to expect. As we take, we receive, and we activate our covenant with You. Thank You, Sir. In Jesus' Name. Amen.



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DAY 3 – FAITH COMES BY HEARING THE COVENANT OF GOD

Faith comes by hearing The WORD, the covenant of God. It's so good to have a faith partner to help you watch your words. Your healing is tied to your words. Forgiveness must be important because Jesus forgave while He was hanging on the cross.

STUDY IT

- I. Faith comes by hearing The WORD, the covenant of God (Romans 10:17).
 - Men and women are saved, healed and filled with the Holy Spirit by hearing words.
 - When you believe and say it with your mouth, you activate the covenant in your life.
 - Plan your life around the promises of the covenant, not around failure.
 - When they first got saved, Gloria would pray in tongues at the grocery store to have enough money to buy what she needed.
 - They saw themselves prosperous back then and never changed that covenant image.
 - In the early days, Brother Copeland realized that Jesus was his blood Brother.
 - He and Gloria would agree on something, and in their spirits, they saw it done the moment they said it.
 - They determined never to ask for money and never to ask for a place to preach. They haven't.
 - The moment you accept covenant provision, it becomes a reality.
- II. It's so good to have a faith partner to help you watch your words.
 - Professor Greg and his wife put a sign on their refrigerator with which to answer each statement. "...and that's exactly the way we want it." For example, "I don't feel well...and that's exactly the way we want it."
 - Adding those few words caused them to compare what they were saying to God's WORD. Repentance came!
 - Brother Copeland gave an example from when he was first learning the power of his words.



- He and Gloria lived in a little project house in Tulsa. They decided to paint the house.
 - While he was painting, a bristle fell out, and he said, "This thing is coming all to pieces." Every bristle came out of the brush and stuck on the wall.
 - God demonstrated right there the power of words.
 - We are to act, talk and walk like Christ.
- III. Gentiles who didn't have any covenant have become a chosen generation (1 Peter 2:9-10, 21-24).
- We follow Christ as our example.
 - He didn't sin and didn't have any guile or deception in Him
 - Jesus kept His mouth shut and did not threaten.
 - The ministry of the Church is to build up the Body of Christ, speaking in love one to another (Ephesians 4:12), not using guile or deception.
 - You must act like Jesus and talk like Jesus. You are going to have to confess healing like you confessed salvation.
- IV. Your healing is tied to your mouth.
- Healing is spiritual, mental and physical.
 - The healing anointing is available to you right now. Hook your words up to it, and see yourself with it.
 - Jesus paid a huge price for you to be healed.
- V. Forgiveness is important.
- The Father doesn't hear you when you pray, if you haven't forgiven someone in the Body of Christ (Mark 11:25). Rebuking the devil won't work.
 - The devil doesn't have to listen to you and leave, because you are not walking in forgiveness (James 4:7).
 - You have a fuss on the way to church and in the middle of church you give a word from The LORD and even interpret it. That's just a lot of noise—no power because there's no love (1 Corinthians 13:1-2).
- VI. Your words are important to the plan of God.
- An angel appeared to the father of John the Baptist and told him his prayers had been answered.
 - Zacharias began to speak doubt. The angel had to shut him up. His words of doubt and unbelief would negate the promise, and they needed to not be spoken.
 - Zacharias was a priest. He was anointed, his words were powerful, and the angel had to stop him from speaking.



- By the time John was born, Zacharias couldn't hear, either. Take heed to what you hear. It was important that he meditate on God's answer to his prayer.
- At the same time, a man and woman were at the Temple praying knowing something was close at hand.
- The pray-ers know, it's time to forgive and walk in health.
- Forgiveness is an act of the will. It is a commandment. It doesn't have anything to do with feelings. Don't wait until you feel better; repent and forgive, now.
 - It's important for you to deal with any offense and forgive with all your heart and mouth.
- Faith is an act of the will. It has to have corresponding action.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Faith comes by hearing and hearing The WORD of God. Make a plan of what scripture you will hear each day as you prayerfully read and study God's WORD, expecting Him to teach you more about covenant. Here are some suggestions:

Monday: Read all of the book of 1 John—5 chapters.

Tuesday: Read all of the book of Ephesians—6 chapters.

Wednesday: Read Deuteronomy chapters 27 and 28.

Thursday: Read John chapters 14, 15 and 16.

Friday: Read Romans chapter 8.





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DAY 4 – ACTIVATING YOUR COVENANT PUTS YOUR ANGELS TO WORK

As a covenant Partner, you are prayed for every day by Kenneth Copeland, Kenneth Copeland Ministries and Eagle Mountain International Church. We are instructed to bless The LORD and not forget His benefits. Our spiritual authority can be found all through the Bible.

STUDY IT

- I. As a covenant Partner, you are prayed for every day by Kenneth Copeland, Kenneth Copeland Ministries and Eagle Mountain International Church.
 - Brother Copeland writes Psalm 103 on every Covenant Partner Letter because he wants us to remember what God has promised us through covenant.
 - Psalm 103 was written by David. He is talking to his mind, will and emotions, and memory.
- II. We are instructed to bless The LORD and not forget His benefits (Psalm 103:1-4).
 - One benefit is God's lovingkindness, His *chesed*, His mercy.
 - Jesus responded to *chesed*. Bartimaeus, before he was healed from blindness, shouted, "Son of David, [Messiah] have *chesed* on me!" Jesus healed him.
 - "Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's" (Psalm 103:5).
 - The Hebrew root to the word *things* is "word," so all things were created by words.
 - He satisfies my mouth with good *words*.
 - "But the mercy, the *chesed*, of The LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children" (Psalm 103:17).
 - The angels hearken to the voice of The LORD—coming out of your mouth (Psalm 103:20)! That's what angels are listening for—The WORD of God spoken by you.



- III. Pastor Ed Dufresne, who is in heaven now, had a balloon loan on the church building and \$300K was due.
- He was in a hotel room getting ready to preach when he saw two very big, armed angels. They said, "We are your prosperity angels." They were waiting for his command, so he said, "Go!"
 - A few days later, a lawyer came to his office and said, "I don't like you, but I was out jogging and something told me to bring you \$300K—so here!"
 - The church owed \$500K, but the \$300K was to satisfy the immediate need.
 - Soon after, a preacher was receiving an offering to pay the remaining \$200K owed on the building.
 - The same lawyer who gave \$300K said, "I missed God. He told me to give \$500K, and I didn't obey him. Here's the other \$200K." The angels kept putting it in his mind until he obeyed.
 - The reverse of the ministry of angels is the work of the devil. He tries to get you to sin by continually putting thoughts of sin in your mind.
- IV. Our spiritual authority can be found throughout the Bible.
- We have authority over devils and angels.
 - The gift of discerning of spirit includes seeing and hearing angels as well as demonic forces (1 Corinthians 12:10).
 - Brother Kenneth E. Hagin saw angels who would give him instructions.
 - At one camp meeting, there were angels that flew from one side of the building to the other, back and forth, telling Brother Hagin what to preach.
- V. King David understood covenant.
- He hosted the Holy Spirit in the "Tabernacle of David," and praise and worship were given to God every day for 33 years.
 - As a young man, David understood covenant. When he grabbed the stones to kill Goliath, he picked up five—not because he thought he would miss. David was preparing to kill Goliath's four brothers.
 - When David became king, there was a famine in the land. God told David it was because the previous king, Saul, had broken covenant with the Gibeonites.
 - To stop the famine, David gave some of Saul's descendants to the Gibeonites to be hung, to satisfy the injustice (2 Samuel 21:1-6).
 - David, God's covenant man, turned things around and healed the land.
 - David did not give anyone from Jonathan's family to the Gibeonites; not Mephibosheth or his family (2 Samuel 21:7).



- David knew and understood blood covenant.
 - Jonathan and David entered into an actual blood covenant (1 Samuel 18:3-4).
 - When Jonathan was killed, the *chesed*, the mercy in that covenant, drove David to take care of Jonathan's family (2 Samuel 9).
 - Mephibosheth, Jonathan's crippled son, believed that David would kill him. It was a lie.
 - David didn't kill him; David moved Mephibosheth into the palace, and he ate his meals at the king's table.
 - Sitting at the table of the king, Mephibosheth's crippled feet could not be seen.
- We have been seated at our Father's table in the presence of our enemies (Psalm 23:5) where no one can see our faults and weaknesses.

VI. It's important who your leaders are.

- President Donald Trump has done something in his peace plan that no one else has ever done.
 - He suggested Israel increase their land holdings instead of giving land away.
 - That biblical stand is enough to cause Brother Copeland to vote for Trump.
- Trump openly demonstrated our nation's position of support to Israel when he moved the U.S. Embassy to Jerusalem. He is not politically afraid.
- Be at peace in your soul about our country. Stop watching the bad news.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Activate your covenant with God by doing something He has asked you to do.

Suggestions:

Love one another as Jesus loves you (John 13:34).

Tithe and give offerings (Malachi 3:10-11).

Give to the poor (Proverbs 19:17).

Pray for the lost (Matthew 9:38).

Go into your world and preach the gospel (Mark 16:15).





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DAY 5 – WALKING IN YOUR COVENANT BENEFITS

We are aware of the importance of covenant, especially the blood covenant that we are part of between the Father and Jesus. There is a vision for America in the heart of the Father. For the world, healing is the wake-up call for their salvation. Jesus is offering covenant. Every reward that happens in a ministry is shared with the partners.

STUDY IT

- I. Professor Greg Stephens has been with us for five weeks as we have studied covenant.
 - We are aware of the importance of covenant, especially the blood covenant that we are part of between the Father and Jesus.
 - The LORD took Brother Copeland in a vision back to the past. He could see George Washington walking down to the chapel where he would be sworn in as our first president.
 - That building, in New York City, survived the 9/11 attack.
 - The first act of Congress was to dedicate this nation to Almighty God and Jesus.
 - On his inauguration day, George Washington was heard to say, “You will be our God, and we will be Your people.”
- II. There is a vision for America in the heart of the Father.
 - Brother Copeland heard the word of The LORD ask him, *Do you think the Founding Fathers knew what this nation would look like in 100 years?* Of course not.
 - The LORD continued, *All of this trouble (political) and turmoil are the birth pangs to the rebirth of this nation. You have no idea what it will look like when I get through with it, because you’ve never seen it reborn.*
 - It’s happening right now.
 - When WWII broke out, our soldiers were training with wooden rifles.
 - Four years later, we had more equipment than we knew how to use. We became the most prosperous nation in the world.



- III. For the world, healing is the wake-up call for their salvation.
- Jesus is standing there smiling, saying, "I am The LORD who healed you;" past tense. It is already done. You need to be covenant-minded.
 - Creflo Dollar said, "God healed you 2,000 years ago. Grace receives it and says, 'It is mine now.'" That is absolutely true.
 - Everything that was promised to you on earth is now yours.
 - On one side of the Cross, the curse was threefold: spiritual death, sickness and poverty. On our side of the Cross, we are redeemed from the curse, born again, connected to God, healed and prosperous—because of a King who hung on a tree.
 - We are walking in covenant with God. Don't forget His benefits (Psalm 103).
 - God can heal you and forgive you.
- IV. A woman who had had 11 operations and still wasn't well, stopped by Brother Kenneth E. Hagin's healing school in Tulsa where *the* Physician was healing.
- Brother Hagin preached on the importance of receiving (taking) God's healing. He said, "It's not yours until you take it."
 - At that time, the woman had a feeding tube in her nose down to her stomach.
 - She believed God's WORD, reached up and pulled that tube out of her nose. She knew she was healed.
 - She had not eaten solid food for two months, but she went across the street and ate two Mexican dinners.
 - She returned to testify of her healing. That's when Brother Keith Moore wrote the song, "The Glory Is Here."
 - Jesus taught that what He had to give was greater than the manna Moses gave them in the wilderness. He said, "I AM the bread of life" (John 6:32-35).
 - When you make covenant with God, He is bound at that point to be your Provider.
- V. Jesus is offering covenant. "Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me" (Revelation 3:20).
- If there ever was a covenant statement in the Bible, it is right there.
 - In the Eastern culture, one of the oldest covenants was the covenant of salt.
 - Salt was a precious commodity. In Rome, salt was often given as part of a soldier's pay.
 - In the salt covenant, one person takes some of his salt and puts it in another person's bag of salt. Then the second person takes some of his salt and puts it in the first person's bag. This represents that they are one. The salt grains cannot be separated as to original ownership.



- If you are a guest, the host offers some of his food to you. Just like Jesus did with Judas, Jesus offered food from His plate to Judas. Eating from another's plate makes them one in covenant.
 - Like salt on a raw steak, you can't get it out; it's in the steak.
 - This covenant with Jesus is in you, and no one can take it out. No one can take Jesus out of you (Romans 8:35-39).
- VI. Every reward that happens in a ministry is shared with the partners.
- If you're not a Partner with Kenneth Copeland Ministries, you need to be. Brother Copeland blesses you with his rewards.
 - Paul told the Philippians, "You are partakers of my grace."
 - Brother Copeland heard that he and Gloria could have Oral Roberts' anointing for \$10 a month. They shared in his ministry.
 - David instituted this himself. Those who stayed with the stuff shared with those who went to battle (1 Samuel 30:24).
 - Brother Copeland takes Communion almost every day.
 - He says, "Once I drink this cup of His blood, His blood and my blood become one. It's impossible to give me a blood disease. Once that bread goes into me, those stripes have gone into me, how can I be sick?"
 - If you're a Christian in covenant with Jesus Christ, how can you stay sick?
