Did you know that Americans fear public speaking almost as much as death?

I believe this could be a plot of the enemy to deceive believers into not speaking the Word that God has planted in their hearts.

The Apostle Paul emphasized the importance of hearing and speaking so others hear you in Romans 10:14-15 (*KJV*):

“How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?

“And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!”

There is power in speaking the Word!

The only reason people come to a living faith in Jesus is that they have heard it spoken by a preacher.

You are a preacher—whether you are called to the fivefold ministry or not!

When you declare the Word of the Lord to others, you bring peace to their chaos.

When you tell others about Jesus, you announce glad tidings to their saddened state.

When you speak God's Words, you speak beautiful things into ugly situations.

Just a couple verses later, Paul explained the critical role we all have in the faith process: “Faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God” (verse 17, *KJV*).

As we declare God’s Word to others, they will hear, and they will believe.

Look for opportunities to share the Word of God.

Your declaration of faith could bring someone else into faith, too.
