DAY 1 – FAITH CONNECTS TO GOD

Faith in God's Word is crucial to a successful life. All that we say and do must be birthed from the belief that God will do what He promised to do.

STUDY IT

- Doubt is sin (Romans 14:23, *KJV, AMPC*).
 - Whatever does not originate from faith is sin.
- Look at things the way God looks at them. It's impossible to please God without faith (Hebrews 11:6).
- In God's kingdom we must receive by faith the things He gives to us by grace (Romans 4:16).
- God promised Abraham that he would inherit the world because he believed God. He made a covenant with Abraham and all his descendants (Genesis 15, 17:7).
 - We are descendants of Abraham, because we were born again by the same faith Abraham had (Galatians 3:29).
 - Also, we are heirs of Abraham, because of God's covenant promise.
- Jesus is the heir of all things (Hebrews 1:2), and we are joint heirs with Jesus (Romans 8:16-17).

DAY 2 – FEAR NOT, BELIEVE ONLY

The first thing Jesus addressed when dealing with death was fear. As believers, we are delivered from being controlled by fear and death (Hebrews 2:14-15). The words of Jesus to Jairus (and to us) have the power to stop fear and even death.

STUDY IT

- Anything that doesn't originate from faith toward God is fear and sin (Romans 14:23).
- God laid all sin on Jesus. He took your sins on His own body and freed you from the curse. God did all this, so that you never again have to be connected to satan.
- Jairus asked Jesus to come to his house and heal his daughter (Luke 8:41-55).
 - The trip was interrupted by a woman with a blood problem. She had faith that if she touched Jesus' clothes, she would be miraculously healed. When she touched Him, she was immediately healed.
 - Jesus said, "Daughter, be made whole," meaning body, soul and spirit. Jesus was saying that even her finances would be restored; that is, made whole.
 - Meanwhile Jairus' daughter had died. Jesus told Jairus, "Stop the fear! Believe only and she shall be made whole." When they arrived at Jairus' house, Jesus raised his daughter from the dead.
- Get your heart full of The WORD of God, now, to be ready for every situation.

DAY 3 – WORRY IS SIN

Worry turns your attention away from God. If you try to mix fear and faith, your faith becomes contaminated.

STUDY IT

- Worry is a bad habit. Worry is the opposite of faith.
- God plans to help you do anything He calls you to do.
 - When God tells you to do anything, that's when He authorizes you to do it. When you agree to do it, that's when He empowers you to do it.
 - It's not just the presence of God that brings the answer, it's when you receive His WORD and make a decision to obey.
- The power Peter received to walk on water was inside Jesus' word, "Come" (Matthew 14:28-31).
 - Peter began to sink into the water, because fear separated him from God's power—the very power that he was walking on.
- What does not originate from faith is sin—worry disconnects you from God's help (Romans 14:23, *KJV, AMPC*).
- God made a covenant with Abraham to bless him (Genesis 15:18).
 - The second covenant God made was with Jesus, and you receive from that covenant because you are "in Christ" (Hebrews 10:16-23).

DAY 4 – ONCE AND FOR ALL

The cure for doubt and unbelief is to have faith in The WORD of God.

STUDY IT

- Every word in the Bible is part of the blood-sworn covenant that believers can access.
- To doubt is to sin (Romans 14:23, *KJV, AMPC*). If anything is not motivated by faith, it's fear. Why? Because doubt chooses to believe something other than what God said.
- The Greek word *care* is the same as *worry* and *anxiety*. Worry pushes out God's WORD.
- Faith connects you to God.
 - Without The WORD of God there is no faith, and without faith it is impossible to please God (Hebrews 11:6).
 - Satan, by accessing your mind, will keep you disconnected from the very power that will heal you and solve your problems.
- God resists the proud and gives grace to the humble (1 Peter 5:5-6).
 - Humble yourself before God, and He will lift you above poverty, sickness, disease and the curse. Don't try to exalt yourself.
- Cast your cares onto God—once and for all (1 Peter 5:7 *AMPC*).

DAY 5 – CAST YOUR WHOLE LOAD ONTO HIM

Find a scripture that fits your situation and pray it back to God. He will answer “Yes!” (2 Corinthians 1:20). God is not holding out on you. He loved the world and gave His Son to save us all (John 3:16).

STUDY IT

- There are laws that govern faith (Romans 3:27).
 - The spiritual laws that govern faith also govern fear.
 - When you constantly and continually worry, you are meditating on the lies of the devil (Romans 14:23) and fear comes to replace faith.
- The cares of this world enter in and choke out The WORD of God. The WORD doesn't produce what it should in your life. *Cares* can be translated “worry, concern or anxiety” (Mark 4:14-20).
- Satan is the enemy, and he comes to steal, kill and destroy (John 10:10).
- You have God's WORD, the sword of the Spirit, to defeat the enemy (Ephesians 6:17).
- Pride is ignoring The WORD of God and worrying about how to figure out how to fix it on your own. Worry has you disconnected from God.
- Walk in love, so you won't get into strife, confusion and every evil work (James 3:16).
- There's nothing in this world that your faith won't overcome (1 John 5:4).
