DAY 1 – TRUST JESUS WITH EVERY STEP OF FAITH

When you begin to hear God's words and believe, say, obey and receive His promises, life becomes full and good! You need faith for what He's calling you to do now and for what He will call you to do in the future.

STUDY IT

- Believe God for a bright future.
- One obedient step at a time will take you to the fullness of God's plan for your life. It will be better than you can imagine.
- Your heavenly Father, Jesus and the Holy Spirit are speaking to you all the time.
 - What the Father is saying to Jesus, Jesus is saying to the Holy Spirit, and the Holy Spirit tells you.
 - Jesus promised that the Holy Spirit will reveal the gifts of God to you, spiritual and natural, and cause you to understand all the things God wants you to know—things of heaven and of earth.
- Not only do you serve Jesus as a Christian, humble yourself to allow Jesus to serve you (John 13, *NLT*).
- God has called the Church to unity, and it is increasingly becoming more unified.

DAY 2 – FAITH THAT WON'T FAIL

Faith in God will not fail, because your faith is based on God's Word. His promises are true, and He will always do what He said He would do.

STUDY IT

- Jesus promised to send another Comforter, so the believers could continually be in God's presence (John 14:16).
- Listen to God's Word. Even if you think you know and understand what He is saying, there's always more to learn.
- God has equipped you to have an impact on others (Ephesians 4:12, *NLT*).
 - Our motive for living is to enjoy the love of God and demonstrate that love to others.
 - Jesus gave His disciples examples of how to love each other (John 13, *NLT*).
 - When people see our love for one another, they are going to see that Jesus loves them also (John 17:23).
- Jesus reassured the disciples not to be troubled after He was gone, but to trust God.
- Jesus is the way, the truth and the life (John 14:6).

DAY 3 – THERE IS UNITY IN GOD'S PRESENCE

Jesus said that when believers experience unity, people will see Him and see that the Father loves them (John 17:20-21, *NLT*).

STUDY IT

- Jesus told His disciples He was going away. Jesus promised to send an Advocate, a Comforter to help them (John 14:16, 26).
 - The disciples didn't want to hear what Jesus was saying, because they did not want Him to go away. They were afraid of life without Jesus' physical presence.
 - When Peter expressed resistance to the plan of God, Jesus rebuked him. Jesus was determined to do what the Father asked Him to do (Matthew 16:23).
- Jesus prayed for the disciples and for all who would follow them and believe—that's you and everyone else who's put their faith in Jesus ever since (John 17:20-21)!
- In the Garden of Gethsemane, Jesus asked the disciples to watch and pray with Him in order to resist the enemy. They fell asleep (Matthew 26:41, *AMPC*).
- It's never too late to repent! God will still take care of you and help you fix the problem. Plus, you can learn from your mistakes.
- God lives in you. He is always with you to help in every way when you call on Him.

STUDY IT

- Put your trust in the Lord for today and for your future.
 - Believe God to get you ready for what's coming, whether you know what it is or not.
- Pray and believe that God will help you. It doesn't work to worry and pray.
- Trust in God's love for you.
- Receive the presence of God into your life (John 12:44-50).
- God has given you special abilities to share with people and help them in their need (1 Corinthians 12:1-28, *NLT*).
 - Love one another and allow God's gifts to flow to others.
 - Focus on and draw from God's presence in each other.
 - Be open and listening for God's voice as He is present in your life.
- Paul wanted the people of Athens to open their hearts to the love of God and be saved (Acts 17:16-28, *NLT*).
