DAY 1 – PUT YOUR FAITH AND CONFIDENCE IN GOD

By becoming God-inside minded, we put confidence and faith in the Spirit of the living God who lives in us.

STUDY IT

- It's a miracle for God to lead a person to be born again and filled with the Holy Spirit!
- Blessings from God come into your life, if you will listen to and obey the voice of The LORD (Deuteronomy 28:1).
- All sin, sickness, poverty and suffering is a result of satan's hatred for the human race. God doesn't make people sick, nor put suffering on them.
- If a person doesn't listen and obey the voice of The LORD, curses will overtake him/her (Deuteronomy 28:15).
- Redemption is the result of the great love God has for all mankind (John 3:16, 10:10).
- Faith is confidence that God will do what He says.
- Feed your faith by reading, listening to and studying The WORD of God (Romans 10:17).
- Let God's WORD renew your thinking, speaking and actions (Romans 12:2).
- You are in training in the army of The LORD, so give attention to God's instructions (2 Timothy 2:3).

DAY 2 – ASK GOD IN FAITH

We are heirs with Jesus, and we are blessed with the same faith He uses. We shouldn't entertain words and thoughts of unbelief toward the promises of God, because we are strong in faith (Romans 4:17).

STUDY IT

- Jesus was anointed to be the High Priest, the High Administrator, over your profession, which is your verbal announcement of your belief (Hebrews 3:1).
 - The word *apostle* is a Greek word that means “sent one.”
 - The word *priest* comes from the same Greek root word as *administration*, *administrator* or *minister*.
 - Your faith works because Jesus is administering it, and He promises that what you say in faith will happen (Mark 11:22-25).
 - When you “demand” by faith, you are not demanding that Jesus do something—you are demanding that the problem leave.
- God sent you a Comforter, a Standby, who never sleeps and who lives with you forever. The Holy Spirit is working on your behalf all the time (John 14:16).
- When Saul said the word, “LORD” and repented in his heart, God received him into His family (Acts 9:5).

DAY 3 – FAITH NEVER CHANGES

Faith *always* calls things that are not yet as though they already were. Faith never changes its confession—no matter what the circumstances appear to be (Romans 4:16-17).

STUDY IT

- Your feelings shouldn't have anything to do with your faith.
- Resist the devil and he will leave in stark terror. He doesn't want you to find out who you are and who is inside you (James 4:7).
- When you are saved, God is delighted to give you the Holy Spirit (Luke 11:13).
- Confess your sins to God, and He will cleanse you (1 John 1:7-9).
 - God blots out your sins and doesn't remember them anymore (Isaiah 43:25).
 - In Christ, there is no condemnation. You are free from sin and its power (Romans 8:1-2)!
- No natural person can control his/her own tongue (James 3:8).
 - Your mouth speaks what's in your heart (Luke 6:45).
- The power and authority of your words bring life or death (Proverbs 18:21).
 - Give the Holy Spirit the right to speak words with your tongue—He'll speak life.

DAY 4 – WHAT ARE THE MANIFESTATIONS OF THE SPIRIT?

Supernatural gifts are available to every born-again child of God who has been baptized in the Holy Spirit. It is God's will to give you the gifts of the Holy Spirit and power (Luke 11:11-13, 10:19).

STUDY IT

- There are gifts for the believer to use as signs of the power of God (Mark 16:15-17).
 - There are also spiritual gifts from the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:1-11).
- To be effective in the use of spiritual gifts, pray in tongues for the leading of the Holy Spirit.
 - The purposes of speaking in tongues are to speak to God and to strengthen and build yourself up in faith (1 Corinthians 14:1-2, 4).
- Continue to stay in the love of God, because faith works by love (1 Corinthians 13; Galatians 5:6).
 - When people try to operate the gifts outside of love, faith and the Holy Spirit, there is no power (1 Corinthians 13:1-3).
- As you pray in tongues, sometimes you are praying instructions. The angels hear you pray what the Holy Spirit is putting into your mouth, and they carry out the instructions you prayed (Ephesians 3:10; Hebrews 1:14).
- When tongues are spoken in a church service, they need to be interpreted, so that the congregation understands what God is saying (1 Corinthians 14:13-16).

DAY 5 – WALKING IN THE LOVE OF GOD

As believers, we must seek to walk in His love and demonstrate His great love to others.

STUDY IT

- *Charity* is the *agape* love of God, and it's always selfless and ready to give (1 Corinthians 13).
- The gifts of the Spirit can be used without love, but they will be without power and ineffective (1 Corinthians 13:1-3).
 - Prophecies without love will fail; tongues without love will cease; and knowledge without love will vanish away.
- The more you walk in love, the clearer spiritual things will become and the more you will walk in light (1 Corinthians 13:12).
 - When God's WORD comes in, light, understanding and revelation come so you can see and obey the plan of God (Psalm 119:130).
- You are an instrument in the hands of the Holy Spirit, ministering the love of God.
 - You need wisdom, so ask God for it. He will give it to you (James 1:5-7).
 - To get the wisdom from your spirit to your mind, pray in the spirit and allow the gift of interpretation to operate.
