DAY 1 – ENERGIZE THE PRAY-ERS

Billye Brim believes God has called her to energize the pray-ers.

STUDY IT

- Billye Brim was told to energize the pray-ers.
- To *energize* is to act with force, operate with vigor or act in producing an effect.
- There is an outpouring of the spirit of prayer upon the Body of Christ.
- God needs the Church to pray, and He needs us to pray right now to support His plan for the last days.
- As you pray God can say things through you, and those words can change situations in the earth.
- God said that as a nation raises up an air force, He's raising up a prayer force.
- We pray beyond our understanding by praying in tongues.
 - *For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries* (1 Corinthians 14:2 NKJV).

DAY 2 – THE BODY OF CHRIST CALLED TO PRAY

We are the Body of Christ, and we are to do His will in this earth. God will use our bodies, our tongues and our voices.

STUDY IT

- Adam was given a six-day work week; since a day equals a thousand years (2 Peter 3:8), six days equal 6,000 years.
- The first and second thousand years are called the “Days of Chaos.”
- The third and fourth thousand years are called the “Days of the Law.”
- The fifth and sixth thousand years are called the “End of Days,” or the “Days of Messiah.”
- When Jesus returns He will set up His earthly kingdom, the “Millennial Reign,” for the seventh thousand years.
- God has angel armies, hailstone armies, the army of Israel and the Church, which is the army of God.
 - *And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean* (Revelation 19:14).

DAY 3 – WHY GOD NEEDS US TO PRAY

The Holy Spirit needs to work through people who have been given authority in the earth. That's why He is calling us to pray.

STUDY IT

- The Holy Spirit is waiting for us to say something He can make happen.
- The Church is the Body of Christ (Romans 7:4).
- Christ is the head—His body is the Church.
 - *And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence* (Colossians 1:18).
- The glory of God will be evident in us as we are praying in unity (John 17:11).
- Pray the prayer Paul gave us that describes our authority with Christ Jesus (Ephesians 1:15-2:10).

Let the eyes of my understanding be enlightened that I may know what is the hope of Your calling, what are the riches of the glory of Your inheritance in the saints and what is the exceeding greatness of Your power to us-ward who believe according to the working of Your mighty power which You brought in Christ, the Anointed One, when You raised Him from the dead!

DAY 4 – PRAYING THE GLORY INTO THE EARTH

Billye Brim received an assignment in 1981 to help the pray-ers. She was told that the Church will put on glorious garments of the gifts of the spirit, just before Jesus comes, and the Church will be adorned in glory.

STUDY IT

- God is searching for someone in the earth to pray.
- Prayer is a two-way conversation with God—speaking and listening.
- Billye Brim had a meeting in 1983 to record directions from seasoned pray-ers about how to pray in the end of days.
- By prayer, we bring the glory of God into the earth.
- God has gifts for the Church that will be even more glorious as we get closer to the return of Christ.
 - Gifts of the apostle, the prophet, the evangelist, the pastor and teacher (Ephesians 4:11-16).
 - Gifts of healings and miracles.

DAY 5 – PRAYER WILL MANIFEST THE GLORY

We, the Church, must bypass our minds and what we know in the natural, and get into the Spirit and pray the perfect will of God.

STUDY IT

- God wants us to pray the mysteries of God into the earth.
- One of the mysteries of God is the Church, the Body of Christ.
 - *The mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints. To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory (Colossians 1:26-27, NKJV).*
- By prayer, we bring the glory of God into the earth and stop the plans of the enemy.
- We don't know how to pray for the glory of God to be revealed, but the Spirit of God does.
 - *Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us (Romans 8:26).*
