DAY 1 – GOD'S WAY OF DOING THINGS

God's way of doing things is motivated by love (God **IS** love), in agreement with His WORD, accessed by faith and directed by His Holy Spirit.

STUDY IT

- Outline of Isaiah 53-55:
 - Isaiah 53 prophesies Jesus' work on the Cross.
 - Isaiah 54 contains prophecy to the Body of Christ from the Spirit of God.
 - Isaiah 55 speaks of faith, the everlasting covenant, seeking God and a description of God's way of doing things.
- All of God's ways of doing things are found in His WORD.
 - God's way is the way Jesus operated in the earth.
- God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit are consistent in the way They do things (Hebrews 13:8).
- Ask, seek and find God's ways, and change to fit His ways (Matthew 7:7-8).
- Find the promise of God that covers your situation. Search the scriptures. All promises in Christ are "Yes" and "Amen" (2 Corinthians 1:20).
- Get God's wisdom before you pray, before you speak and before you act (Proverbs 4:7).

DAY 2 – HOW TO DO THINGS GOD'S WAY

God's WORD will produce His way. Speak His WORD in faith, and you will become fruitful and multiply (Genesis 1:28).

STUDY IT

- God's way is the love way, The WORD way, the faith way, the Holy Spirit way and Jesus' blood way.
- Jesus preached the kingdom of God, and God's way of doing things (Matthew 6).
- Every promise in the Old Covenant is no longer ratified by the blood of animals—but is now ratified by the blood of Jesus.
- Because the payment of Jesus' sacrifice was accepted, the curse has been removed from the Covenant; however, all of the promises are still available to you!
- The difference between the results of your faith and Jesus' faith is your continued development. Believing God's WORD will change you from the inside out, so you are conformed to the image of Jesus (Romans 12:2).
- As you develop, your faith will begin to grow, your mind will become renewed, and your desires will follow your mind. You will begin to have a deeper understanding of what is good and what is evil (Hebrews 5:14).

DAY 3 – THE NATURAL WAY OF DOING THINGS

Our natural thoughts limit us to what this world can accomplish. God's thoughts are on a higher spiritual plane where God is the Source. We can know His thoughts, because they are written in His WORD (Isaiah 55:11).

STUDY IT

- The natural way is to “look” and “feel” to find out how things are going.
- God's way is the love way, The WORD way, the faith way, the Holy Spirit way and the blood of Jesus way.
- God said what He sends to earth (His WORD) will prosper in what He sent it to do (Isaiah 55:7-11).
- Seek God's way and believe His promises instead of worrying (Matthews 6:33, *AMPC*).
- God will take care of your needs when you endeavor to do things God's way (Matthew 6:28-33).
- The word *meek* means, “subject to authority.” Being subject to God's authority makes you strong.
- “THE BLESSING” wall will only break down if you are in fear. Turn your thoughts to God's ways, and you will have whatever you need.

DAY 4 – THE FAITH WAY OF DOING THINGS

Put God's WORD into your inner man, so faith will come. Soon, scripture will come out of your mouth without you even having to think about it. You are full of faith, and your mind has been renewed.

STUDY IT

- God's way is always the love way, The WORD way, the faith way, the Holy Spirit way and the blood of Jesus way.
- God wants you to be conformed to the image of Jesus and do things His way (Romans 12:1-2).
 - Jesus, the Son of God, was the firstborn among the brethren (Romans 8:29).
 - You are joint heir with the Firstborn, so take The WORD of God and let it change your thoughts into His image (Romans 8:17).
- Look at the unseen, spiritual things by looking at God's WORD.
- When your spirit believes you are healed, your mind and body still need to be trained to receive the healing (1 Peter 2:24).
 - Refuse to say anything except what God says in His WORD.
- Choose the renewed way, God's way, rather than the natural, human way.

DAY 5 – THE HOLY SPIRIT WAY OF DOING THINGS

The Holy Spirit, who lives within you, is greater than the enemy (1 John 4:4).

STUDY IT

- Live God's way, the faith way, so you can receive from Him (Luke 11:9-11).
- God's way is greater than man's way (Isaiah 55:8).
 - The faith way is that your thoughts, words and expectations in God are not changed by what you see in the natural world.
- God works by His Spirit (Zechariah 4:6-7).
- The Spirit of God does the miraculous work—you do the believing. Put God's WORD into your heart and mouth.
- Jesus lived in this earth, not as God, but as a man—a sinless man who had faith in God.
- God is pleased when He sees your faith in action (Hebrews 11:6).
- Spend your time immersed in God's WORD.
