B. Psalm 115:12-16—The Lord Shall Increase You More and More

1. Psalm 115:12-16 is the scripture the Lord gave me that Sunday.
2. "The Lord hath been mindful of us: he will bless us; he will bless the house of Israel; he will bless the house of Aaron. He will bless them that fear the Lord, both small and great. The Lord shall increase you more and more, you and your children. Ye are blessed of the Lord

which made heaven and earth. The heaven, even the heavens, are the Lord's: but the earth hath he given to the children of men."

3. I laid hands on everyone that morning.
4. They all received The Spirit of Increase.
5. That anointing has not lifted—it has increased since that time.

C. Romans 12:2—We Must Become “Increase-Minded”

1. “And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.”

2. AMPC: “Do not be conformed to this world (this age), [fashioned after and adapted to its external, superficial customs], but be transformed (changed) by the [entire] renewal of your mind [by its new ideals and its new attitude], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of

God, even the thing which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His sight for you].”

3. I began to meditate on increase scriptures.
 - a. Deuteronomy 16:15: “The Lord thy God shall bless thee in all thine increase.”
 - b. Psalm 85:12: “Yea, The Lord shall give that which is good; and our land shall yield her increase.”
 - c. 1 Corinthians 3:6: “I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase.”
4. I listened to CDs, read books and studied scriptures about increase.
5. Faith for The Spirit of Increase comes by hearing and hearing by the Word on increase.
 - a. We will spend 10 days renewing our minds to walking daily in supernatural increase.
 - b. Psalm 68:19: “Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah.”

INCREASE: GOD'S PLAN FOR MAN

A. Genesis 1:26-28—God's Original Plan

1. "And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion...."
2. The first thing God did after He created man was to bless him.
3. His original intent for mankind was that they should be blessed and increase in every area of their lives.
4. *Multiply* (HEB) = Increase
5. God's original plan for man was to demonstrate The Spirit of Increase by replicating the Garden of Eden all over the universe.

B. Genesis 1:28—God's Plan for Man

1. THE BLESSING was the first word spoken over man.
2. *Blessed* = Empowered to prosper and increase, as a result of having God's favor bestowed on your life
3. *Blessed* = Continually walking in The Spirit of Increase, in spite of the conditions
4. Proverbs 10:22: "The blessing of the Lord, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it."
5. The Spirit of Increase was perpetual.

- a. God’s plan to increase man continued in spite of Adam’s high treason in the Garden.
- b. Genesis 9:1: “And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply [increase], and replenish the earth.”
- c. Genesis 12:2 (to Abram):
“And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing.”
- d. Genesis 26:12-13: “Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received in the same year an hundredfold: and the Lord blessed him. And the man waxed great, and went forward, and grew until he became very great.”

C. Galatians 3:29—God’s Plan for Us

- 1. “And if ye be Christ’s, then are ye Abraham’s seed, and heirs according to the promise.”
- 2. The Spirit of Increase that was upon Adam, Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, David, Solomon and up through Jesus, is upon us today.
- 3. Jesus came and broke the curse of poverty and lack over mankind (Galatians 3:13-14).
- 4. He redeemed us from that curse and put us in position:
 - a. To walk in the same blessing
 - b. To walk in the same increase
 - c. To walk in the same favor
- 5. We should be walking in a greater degree of The Spirit of Increase because our covenant is a better covenant, founded upon better promises (Hebrews 8:6).
 - a. God’s plan was and is for us to cultivate the Garden of Eden everywhere we go.
 - b. Isaiah 51:1-3: “Hearken to me, ye that follow after righteousness, ye that seek the Lord: look unto the rock whence ye are hewn, and to the hole of the pit whence ye are digged. Look unto Abraham your father, and unto Sarah that bare you: for I called him alone, and blessed him, and increased him. For the Lord shall comfort Zion: he will comfort all her waste places; and he will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the Lord; joy and gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, and the voice of melody.”

INCREASE EVERYWHERE

A. 3 John 2—Increase in Every Area of Life

1. “Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.”
2. AMPC: “Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in every way and (WNT) in all respects.”
3. Don’t limit increase to money.
4. The Spirit of Increase covers everything.
5. 2 Peter 1:3 (NKJV): “His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness.”

B. Deuteronomy 29:9—Increase in All You Do

1. “Keep therefore the words of this covenant, and do them, that ye may prosper in all that ye do.”
2. Abraham increased in every area of his life.
 - a. Genesis 24:1: “The Lord had blessed Abraham in all things.”
 - b. MSG: “in every way”
3. Spiritual increase
 - a. 1 Peter 2:2 (NKJV): “As newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby.”
 - b. We are to increase in spiritual maturity.
4. Soul increase
 - a. Our minds renewed to God’s Word
 - b. Our wills conformed to God’s will
 - c. Our emotions controlled by God’s Spirit
5. Physical increase

- a. Psalm 103:3 (AMPC): “Who heals [each one of] all your diseases.”
- b. Proverbs 9:11: “For by me thy days shall be multiplied, and the years of thy life shall be increased.”
- c. Isaiah 40:29 (AMPC): “He gives power to the faint *and* weary, and to him who has no might He increases strength [causing it to multiply and making it to abound].”

C. Proverbs 11:24-25—Financial Increase

- 1. AMPC: “There are those who [generously] scatter abroad, and yet increase more; there are those who withhold more than is fitting or what is justly due, but it results only in want. The liberal person shall be enriched, and he who waters shall himself be watered.”
- 2. “So we know that we should increase spiritually, mentally, and physically. And God also expects as you serve Him and as you put His Word first place in your life, that there should be signs of financial increase.” —Jerry Savelle, *Increase God’s Way*
- 3. “For you to never experience financial increase in your walk with God is a violation of spiritual laws.” —Jerry Savelle, *Increase God’s Way*
- 4. Financial increase includes:
 - a. All bills paid
 - b. Debt freedom
 - c. Much left over
- 5. 2 Corinthians 9:10 (NLT): “For God is the one who provides seed for the farmer and then bread to eat. In the same way, he will provide and increase your resources and then produce a great harvest of generosity in you.”



HE WILL INCREASE US MORE AND MORE

Psalm 115:12-14

*The Lord hath been mindful of us: he will bless us;
he will bless the house of Israel; he will bless the house of Aaron.
He will bless them that fear the Lord, both small and great.
The Lord shall increase you more and more, you and your children.*

A. Verse 12—The Lord has been mindful of us.

1. Psalm 8:4 (NKJV): “What is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of man that You visit him?”
2. We are on God’s mind all the time.
3. He is thinking about how He can increase us, provide for us and grant us the very desires of our hearts.

B. Verses 12-13—The Lord has been mindful of us: He will bless us.

1. He is thinking about how He can bless us and, “do superabundantly, far over *and* above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams]” (Ephesians 3:20, AMPC).
2. He is thinking, *How can I bless them? How can I increase them? How can I manifest My favor on their behalf?*
3. To bless us is to empower us to prosper and increase.

C. Verse 13—He will bless the house of Israel; He will bless the house of Aaron. He will bless them that fear the Lord, both small and great.

1. Take note of how many times the word *bless* is used.
2. “The repetition of the word ‘bless’ shows that where God has once bestowed His favor, He continues it. His blessing delights to visit the same house often and to abide where it once lodged.” –Charles Spurgeon

3. “It is God’s nature to bless. It is His prerogative to bless. It is His glory to bless. And it is His delight to bless. Blessing us over and over and with more and more will not impoverish God.” –Charles Spurgeon

D. Verse 14—The Lord shall increase you more and more, you and your children.

1. *Increase* (HEB) = Exceed, grow, continue to add over and above.
2. *Augment* = Make something greater by adding to it
 - a. To supplement
 - b. To enlarge, expand and multiply
3. Psalm 115:14 Commentary from the *Tehillim*:
 - a. “May HASHEM add upon you, upon you and upon your children.
 - b. “These words provide a most accurate description of the true nature of *blessing*. Blessing means increase and abundance, whereas the closest definition of *curse*, is decrease and loss (*Ibn Ezra*).”
4. God has no problem with increasing us.
 - a. Psalm 35:27: “Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.”
 - b. Luke 12:32: “Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father’s good pleasure to give you the kingdom.”
5. God has no problem with increasing our children.
 - a. Proverbs 13:22: “A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children’s children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just.”
 - b. Psalm 112:1-2 (NLT): “Praise the Lord! How joyful are those who fear the Lord and delight in obeying his commands. Their children will be successful everywhere; an entire generation of godly people will be blessed.”

GOD IS ALL ABOUT INCREASE

A. Multiplication

1. Genesis 9:7: "And you, be ye fruitful, and multiply; bring forth abundantly in the earth, and multiply therein."
2. Leviticus 26:9 (AMPC): "For I will be leaning toward you with favor and regard for you, rendering you fruitful, multiplying you, and establishing and ratifying My covenant with you."
3. 2 Corinthians 9:10: "Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness."

B. The Double

1. Isaiah 61:7: "For your shame ye shall have double; and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion: therefore in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting joy shall be unto them."
2. Exodus 22:7: "If a man shall deliver unto his neighbour money or stuff to keep, and it be stolen out of the man's house; if the thief be found, let him pay double."
3. Job 42:10: "And the Lord turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also the Lord gave Job twice as much as he had before."
 - a. HEB: "...Added all that had been to Job unto the double."
 - b. Verse 12: "So the Lord blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning: for he had fourteen thousand sheep, and six thousand camels, and a thousand yoke of oxen, and a thousand she asses."
4. Zechariah 9:12 (NKJV): "Return to the stronghold, you prisoners of hope. Even today I declare that I will restore double to you."

C. The Hundredfold Return

1. Genesis 26:12-13: “Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received in the same year an hundredfold: and the Lord blessed him. And the man waxed great, and went forward, and grew until he became very great.”
2. Mark 4:20: “And these are they which are sown on good ground; such

as hear the word, and receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred.”

3. Mark 10:28-30: “Then Peter began to say unto him, Lo, we have left all, and have followed thee. And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel’s, but he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and

mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life.”

D. One Thousand Times More

1. Deuteronomy 1:11: “The Lord God of your fathers make you a thousand times so many more as ye are, and bless you, as he hath promised you!”
2. Isaiah 60:22: “A little one shall become a thousand, and a small one a strong nation: I the Lord will hasten it in his time.”
3. How will God make you a thousand times more?
(See Oral Roberts’ original notes, attached.)
 - a. You shall possess the land.
 - b. You shall be the head and not the tail.
 - c. No weapon formed against you shall prosper.
 - d. God’s miracle and healing power will increase.
 - e. You shall renew your strength like the eagles.
 - f. You are God’s property.
 - g. As you seed your tithes to God, you shall “Prove the Lord.”
 - i. He will pour you out a blessing.
 - ii. He will rebuke the devourer.
 - h. God will never leave you or forsake you.
 - i. You shall call those things that be not as though they are.

E. Ezekiel 16:7—Bonus Scripture

1. AMPC: “I caused you [Israel] to multiply as the bud which grows in the field, and you increased and became tall and you came to full maidenhood and beauty.”
2. HEB—I have made thee a million.

MARKED FOR INCREASE

A. Genesis 1:28—THE BLESSING Imparted to Man

1. “And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.”
2. *Blessed* (HEB) = Empowered to prosper and increase
3. THE BLESSING is an empowerment that comes upon our lives which can be seen by others.
4. We are marked for increase.
5. Psalm 67:5-7 (MSG): “God! Let people thank and enjoy you. Let all people thank and enjoy you. Earth, display your exuberance! You mark us with blessing, O God, our God. You mark us with blessing, O God.”

B. Genesis 14:18-20—Abraham Was Marked for Increase

1. “And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God. And he blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth: And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all.”
2. Melchizedek recognized that Abraham was blessed.
3. There were obvious results in his life that indicated the blessing of increase was upon him.
4. The Spirit of Increase was all over Abraham.
5. Genesis 24:1: “Abraham was old, and well stricken in age: and the Lord had blessed Abraham in all things.”

- a. Verse 35 (NIV): “The Lord has blessed my master abundantly, and he has become wealthy. He has given him sheep and cattle, silver and gold, male and female servants, and camels and donkeys.”
- b. Genesis 13:2: “Abram was very rich in cattle, in silver, and in gold.”

C. Genesis 26:12-14—Isaac Was Marked for Increase

1. “Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received in the same year an hundredfold: and the Lord blessed him. And the man waxed great, and went forward, and grew until he became very great: For he had possession of flocks, and possession of herds, and great store of servants: and the Philistines envied him.”
2. The Spirit of Increase was so evident that it caused his enemies to envy him.
3. Verses 26-29 (NLT): “One day King Abimelech came from Gerar with his adviser, Ahuzzath, and also Phicol, his army commander. ‘Why have you come here?’ Isaac asked. ‘You obviously hate me, since you kicked me off your land.’ They replied, ‘We can plainly see that the Lord is with you. So we want to enter into a sworn treaty with you. Let’s make a covenant. Swear that you will not harm us, just as we have never troubled you. We have always treated you well, and we sent you away from us in peace. And now look how the Lord has blessed you!’”

D. Zechariah 8:13—We Are Marked by Increase

1. NLT: “I will rescue you and make you both a symbol and a source of blessing.”
2. If The Spirit of Increase is on us, we will succeed no matter where we live and in spite of the economy.
3. We could live in the darkest, most remote part of the world, but if The Spirit of Increase was upon us, we would flourish.
4. People may not know what to call it, but they would know there is something different about us.
5. Psalm 1:3 (AMPC): “Everything he does shall prosper.”

POSITIONED FOR INCREASE

A. Deuteronomy 8:10-14—Keep Covenant With God

1. “When thou hast eaten and art full, then thou shalt bless the Lord thy God for the good land which he hath given thee. Beware that thou forget not the Lord thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command thee this day: Lest when thou hast eaten and art full, and hast built goodly houses, and dwelt therein; and when thy herds and thy flocks multiply, and thy silver and thy gold is multiplied, and all that thou hast is multiplied; then thine heart be lifted up, and thou forget the Lord thy God, which brought thee forth out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.”
2. 2 Chronicles 26:5—As long as King Uzziah sought the Lord, he prospered.
3. Deuteronomy 28:2: “And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God.”

B. Isaiah 1:19—Walk in Obedience

1. “If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land.”
2. Job 36:11: “If they obey and serve him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures.”
3. Obedience to the written and specific Word opens the door to supernatural increase.

C. Psalm 1:1-3—Give God’s Word First Place

1. “Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the

rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.”

2. Putting God’s Word first place in your life will create an inner image of increase.
3. “If you can conceive it, then you can receive it.” –Jerry Savelle, *Increase God’s Way*

D. Proverbs 10:4—Hard Work and Diligence

1. “He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich.”
2. Proverbs 13:11 (NKJV): “Wealth gained by dishonesty will be diminished, but he who gathers by labor will increase.”
3. Proverbs 12:24 (AMPC): “The hand of the diligent will rule, but the slothful will be put to forced labor.”
4. Deuteronomy 28:8 (AMPC): “The Lord shall command the blessing upon you in your storehouse and in all that you undertake.”
5. “God don’t bless lazy Christians.” –Norvel Hayes

E. Proverbs 3:9-10—Give to God

1. AMPC: “Honor the Lord with your capital and sufficiency [from righteous labors] and with the firstfruits of all your income (KJV=*Increase*); so shall your storage places be filled with plenty, and your vats shall be overflowing with new wine.”
2. How do we honor God with our finances?
 - a. Malachi 3:10 (AMPC): “Bring all the tithes (the whole tenth of your income) into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and prove Me now by it, says the Lord of hosts, if I will not open the windows of heaven for you and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.”
 - b. Proverbs 11:24-25 (AMPC): “There are those who [generously] scatter abroad, and yet increase more; there are those who withhold more than is fitting or what is justly due, but it results only in want. The liberal person shall be enriched, and he who waters shall himself be watered.”
3. We must honor God with our finances right where we are.
 - a. Don’t wait for your ship to come in.
 - b. Begin today.
 - c. Open the door for The Spirit of Increase by tithing and sowing.

THE LAW OF INCREASE

A. Mark 4:24-25—The Law of Increase

1. “And he said unto them, Take heed what ye hear: with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given. For he that hath, to him shall be given: and he that hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he hath.”
2. These verses are absolutely crucial for those who desire a life of prosperity.
3. They capture a law that governs everything in the kingdom of God.
4. We will never experience increase unless we understand this law.
5. First, we must understand the significance of the word, *hear*.

B. Luke 6:46-49—How Do You Measure the Word?

1. “And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say? Whosoever cometh to me, and heareth my sayings, and doeth them, I will show you to whom he is like: He is like a man which built an house, and digged deep, and laid the foundation on a rock: and when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for it was founded upon a rock. But he that heareth, and doeth not, is like a man that without a foundation built an house upon the earth; against which the stream did beat vehemently, and immediately it fell; and the ruin of that house was great.”
2. Two people heard the same Word.
 - a. One valued the Word and acted on it.
 - b. The other didn't value the Word and ignored it.
3. Both received exactly what they expected.

4. Jesus basically said, “Be careful how you hear, because when I deal with you, I will be using your measuring stick—not Mine.”
5. How you measure the Word is how it will be measured back to you.
 - a. If we hear the Word of increase and measure it with faith, we will increase.
 - b. If we hear the Word of increase and measure it with skepticism and doubt, we will decrease.

C. Mark 4:20—The Parable of the Sower

1. “And these are they which are sown on good ground; such as hear the word, and receive it, and bring forth fruit, some thirtyfold, some sixty, and some an hundred.”
2. Why is it that some receive one kind of return and some another?
3. Does God just arbitrarily give greater blessings to one person than He gives to someone else?
4. Absolutely not!
 - a. He measures the blessing back to us according to the way we measure the Word.
 - b. Mark 4:24 (AMPC): “And He said to them, Be careful what you are hearing. The measure [of thought and study] you give [to the truth you hear] will be the measure [of virtue and knowledge] that comes back to you—and more [besides] will be given to you who hear.”
5. Our increase depends on how much thought, study and attention we give God’s Word in this area.
 - a. We must give God’s Word first place in our heart.
 - b. We must receive it by faith instead of doubt.
 - c. We must be willing to defend it when the devil tries to steal it.

INCREASE THROUGH WEALTH TRANSFER

A. “Financial Inversion Shall Increase in These Days”–Word from the Lord through Charles Capps, February 1, 1978

1. “Financial inversion shall increase in these days. For you see, it is My desire to move in the realm of your financial prosperity. But release Me,” saith the Lord, “release Me that I may come in your behalf and move on your behalf.
2. “For yes, there shall be in this hour financial distress here and there. The economy shall go up and it will go down; but those who learn to walk in the Word, they shall see the prosperity of the Word come forth in this hour in a way that has not been seen by men in days past.
3. “Yes, there’s coming a financial inversion in the world’s system. It’s been held in reservoirs of wicked men for days on end. But the end is nigh.
4. “Those reservoirs shall be tapped and shall be drained into the gospel of Jesus Christ.
5. “It shall be done in the time allotted and so shall it be that the Word of the Lord shall come to pass that the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just.”

B. “The Largest, Most Significant Wealth Transfer”–Word from the Lord through Kenneth Copeland, March 8, 2012

1. “The largest, most significant transfer of property, goods, wealth and people from the hands of the devil into the hands of God’s people who are prepared to receive it....

2. "I am telling you, the biggest transfer of property in the history of mankind has just begun and it is swinging into...."
3. "It has moved over into its final stage, saith The LORD."
4. "And those who will listen to Me and follow Me and trust Me—those who I have taught My WORD and have given the authority to walk in these things, it is the most outstanding thing that human eyes have ever seen."
5. "And the time is now. Your time has come. Your hour has come. So rise and do those things by faith that you know to do and all that belongs to heaven will come into your hands for your joy."

C. Excerpts from *Supernatural Wealth Transfer* by Bill Winston

1. "[God is] restoring the earth back into the hands of its rightful owners, as well as restoring the power or Blessing to govern it. Because of Adam's sin, the earth was not in the hands of God's family. Now, God is working His redemptive plan to get it all back...what I refer to as a SUPERNATURAL transfer of wealth."
2. "One of the major things coming in this hour is an EXPLOSION OF WEALTH in the Body of Christ. Through divine favor, witty inventions and the grace of giving, we are at the season of the greatest WEALTH TRANSFER in the history of this planet. There will be inventions that make the iPhone seem like child's play."
3. "We are even going to see money supernaturally transfer into the bank accounts of the people of God. Why the transfer of wealth? Mainly for the advancing of the kingdom and bringing in the end-time harvest of souls. God needs the wealth in our hands to fulfill the call that is on our lives for this generation—to reclaim what Jesus redeemed."

D. Wealth Transfer Scriptures

1. Proverbs 13:22 (AMPC): "A good man leaves an inheritance [of moral stability and goodness] to his children's children, and the wealth of the sinner [finds its way eventually] into the hands of the righteous, for whom it was laid up."
2. Ecclesiastes 2:26 (NLT): "God gives wisdom, knowledge, and joy to those who please him. But if a sinner becomes wealthy, God takes the wealth away and gives it to those who please him. This, too, is meaningless—like chasing the wind."
3. Proverbs 22:22-23 (NIV-84): "Do not exploit the poor because they are poor and do not crush the needy in court, for the LORD will take up their case and will exact life for life."

4. Job 27:16-17 (NLT): “Evil people may have piles of money and may store away mounds of clothing. But the righteous will wear that clothing, and the innocent will divide that money.”
 - a. Verse 19 (NLT): “The wicked go to bed rich but wake to find that all their wealth is gone.”
5. Proverbs 28:8 (AMPC): “He who by charging excessive interest and who by unjust efforts to get gain increases his material possession gathers it for him [to spend] who is kind and generous to the poor.”

E. Wealth Transfer Testimony

1. A pastor was believing for the land next to his church.
2. The owner purchased it for \$1,200,000 in 2007.
3. He would sell it to the pastor for \$600,000.
4. The pastor faithfully sowed seed for the purchase of the property for two years.
5. Recently, the owner came to the pastor and said, “I am older now and don’t want the property. I decided to donate it to your church (complete with a hotel!).”

INCREASE BY ASSOCIATION

A. Proverbs 13:20—The Spiritual Law of Association

1. NKJV: “He who walks with wise men will be wise, but the companion of fools will be destroyed.”
2. AMPC: “He who walks [as a companion] with wise men is wise, but he who associates with [self-confident] fools is [a fool himself and] shall smart for it.”
3. Who we associate with has a profound impact on our life.
 - a. When we walk with negative people, we will be negative.
 - b. When we walk with positive people, we will be positive.
4. It has everything to do with our destiny.
5. It also directly impacts the kind of increase we will experience.

B. Numbers 11:28—Moses and Joshua

1. Joshua was a faithful servant to Moses.
2. NIV—Joshua son of Nun, had been Moses’ aid since youth.
 - a. NLT—Assistant
 - b. NASB—Attendant
 - c. DRB—Minister
3. Exodus 33:11: “And the Lord spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend. And he turned again into the camp: but his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, departed not out of the tabernacle.”
4. Numbers 27:18-20 (AMPC): “The Lord said to Moses, Take Joshua son of Nun, a man in whom is the Spirit, and lay your hand upon him; and set him before Eleazar the priest and all the congregation and give

him a charge in their sight. And put some of your honor and authority upon him, that all the congregation of the Israelites may obey him.”

5. Joshua’s association with Moses caused the same anointing, wisdom and leadership skills to come upon him.

C. Philippians 1:3-7—Paul and the Church at Philippi

1. “I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine for you all making request with joy, for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now; being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ: Even as it is meet for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart; inasmuch as both in my bonds, and in the defence and confirmation of the gospel, ye all are partakers of my grace.”
 2. Verse 5—*Fellowship* can also be translated *partnership* or *association*.
 3. Because of their association from the beginning of his ministry, the Church partook of Paul’s grace and anointing.
 4. Philippians 4:19: “But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.”
 - a. This scripture was birthed out of an association.
 - b. Paul was writing to his partners—people to whom he had ministered.
 - c. They valued and appreciated what he taught them.
 5. They experienced The Spirit of Increase through their association with the Apostle Paul.
