DAY 1 – GOD’S WILL IS ALWAYS TO HEAL

God’s will is always to heal. The account of healing the leper is found in three of the Gospels. God has many Names; one of which is Jehovah Rapha—“I am The LORD who healeth thee.” Brother Copeland’s mother believed in praying for God to heal.

STUDY IT

- I. God’s will is always to heal.
 - It’s a marvelous study to see how people were healed by Jesus.
 - In the Gospels, we can count 19 individual healings, not including the multitudes who were healed.
 - People know Jesus can heal, but they wonder if it is His *will* to heal. The answer is, yes! Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever (Hebrews 13:8).
- II. The account of healing the leper is in three of the Gospels.
 - In Matthew, a leper came to Jesus for healing (Matthew 8:2-3).
 - Jesus said, “I will.”
 - Jesus is no respecter of persons (Acts 10:34). If Jesus healed anyone, He will heal everyone who asks.
 - Jesus is the will of God in action for all men for all time!
 - In Mark, the man with leprosy knelt before Jesus and made his request (Mark 1:40-42).
 - Jesus was moved with compassion, put forth His hand, touched him and said, “I will; be thou clean.”
 - Immediately, the leprosy departed.
 - In Luke’s gospel, we have more information about the sick man, because Luke was a doctor (Luke 5:12-13).
 - This man was full of leprosy—he was close to death.
 - The man knelt, worshipped and fell on his face before Jesus. We don’t know how long the man worshipped Jesus.
 - Jesus had compassion, and touched him. Jesus said, “Of course I will heal you.” (Luke 5:13, *TLB*). “Of course it’s My will,”



- Jesus says the same thing to you, “Of course I will heal you.” He bore your sickness; He carried your pain (Isaiah 53:4).
 - It is God’s will to heal, today!
- III. God has many Names; one of which is Jehovah Rapha—“I am The LORD who healeth thee” (Exodus 15:26).
- God’s Name is Healing. He never changes!
 - God promised healing to the descendants of Abraham. We are the seed of Abraham, so healing is ours (Galatians 3:29)!
 - The New Covenant is a better covenant with better promises (Hebrews 8:6), and we are in it!
- IV. Kenneth Copeland’s mother believed in praying for God to heal.
- She prayed for Brother Copeland to be healed of asthma when he was a little boy—and he was! Thank God for mothers who pray.
 - When Brother Copeland showed symptoms of polio, she didn’t stop praying until he was totally free of paralysis.
 - Another time, Brother Copeland had severe pain on the inside of his leg. He prayed, quoted Scripture and shouted, “You’re not doing this to me, satan, in the Name of Jesus!”
 - Brother Copeland took his stand for healing. Gloria calls it having “bulldog faith.”
 - His mother prayed in the spirit until every symptom was gone!
 - Brother Copeland’s mother prayed for his grandfather who had malignant tumors across the back of his shoulders. The grandfather got up from the bed and literally shook the cancer from his body. He received his total healing!
 - It is the perfect will of God to heal the sick!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Pray this prayer with us:

Heavenly Father, I am praying in faith for healing, because I believe Your WORD. You sent Jesus to be crucified for my sicknesses, diseases and weaknesses. I receive Your healing power in my body, now! Thank You, Sir, for using Your power on my behalf. I pray in Jesus’ Name. Amen.





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DAY 2 – THE ONLY EVIDENCE YOU NEED FOR HEALING

It is easy to receive healing from Jesus, and it is the perfect will of God. The same account is expressed by Luke. When Jesus was preaching in His home, He was not speaking to a hostile crowd. Jesus preached The WORD of God, so the power of The LORD was present to heal them.

STUDY IT

- I. It is easy to receive healing from Jesus, and it is the perfect will of God.
 - A centurion told Jesus his servant was sick. Jesus offered to come and heal the servant (Matthew 8:5-10).
 - The centurion knew he was not a Jew, and he also knew that Jesus could heal. He said to Jesus, "Speak the word only."
 - The same account is expressed by Luke (Luke 7:1-10).
 - This Roman centurion was a Jewish proselyte, spending time in the synagogue where Jairus was a leader.
 - He knew he was not under the Abrahamic covenant; therefore, he was not covenant-worthy of Jesus coming into his house.
 - Don't call yourself unworthy; that's a strong confession of unbelief.
 - If you are born again, you are a new creature, and no born-again creation of God is unworthy.
 - Jesus bore our sins in His own body on the tree (1Peter 2:24).
 - "Any man who is in Christ is a new creature" (a new creation). "Old things are passed away, behold, all things are become new, and all things are of God" (2 Corinthians 5:17-18).
 - The centurion told Jesus, "You don't have to come and heal him. Speak the word, and my servant shall be healed."
 - Jesus marveled at the centurion's faith, because he demanded no evidence other than The WORD. The man recognized the authority of The WORD of God.
 - We not only have the authority of The WORD, we have the authority of the Name of Jesus.



- You need to make a decision to be a doer of The WORD and not just a hearer only (James 1:22).
- II. When Jesus was preaching in His home, He was not speaking to a hostile crowd.
- The people had come to Jesus' house.
 - Jesus preached The WORD.
 - Four men carried a man sick of the palsy to Jesus. Jesus saw their faith and said to the man, "Cheer up. Your sins are forgiven" (Matthew 9:1-8).
 - This saying distracted the people from faith. They moved from listening to what Jesus said with their spirits to analyzing with their minds, using their previous religious training.
 - We know what Jesus was preaching to the crowd: "The Spirit of The LORD has anointed Me" (Isaiah 61:1; Luke 4:18).
 - Jesus used His words as tools. He told the man, "Arise."
 - For the man to receive his healing, he had to act on what Jesus said.
 - The man got up, took his bed, and walked. The crowd was amazed and glorified God (Mark 2:1-12).
- III. Jesus preached The WORD of God, so the power of The LORD was present to heal those who were there (Luke 5:17).
- Jesus *is* The WORD. They were hearing The WORD, Jesus! So, the power to heal was there.
 - It was Jesus' will for all of the listeners to be healed.
 - Jesus was preaching and teaching THE BLESSING of Abraham, not the requirements of the Law. Since The WORD was going forth, we know faith was coming (Romans 10:17).
 - Jesus is the Healer, and He's the same—yesterday, today and forever (Hebrews 13:8). *But* He needs someone to be a receiver.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

What evidence do you need to receive Jesus' healing? Write some concerns you may have. Then cross them out with the notation, "Speak The WORD only, and I am healed."



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DAY 3 – FORGIVE AND BE HEALED

The power of The LORD will heal you. A man sick with palsy was brought to Jesus for healing. While there can be many hindrances to faith, Jesus talked about the hindrance of unforgiveness. Brother Copeland tells the story of the salvation of a serial killer named Steven Moran. The same spiritual force that forgives you, heals you.

STUDY IT

- I. The power of The LORD will heal you (Luke 5:17-26).
 - Jesus was preaching and teaching THE BLESSING of Abraham. The WORD of God—the power of God—Jesus—was present to heal.
 - Faith was coming, because the people were hearing The WORD (Romans 10:17).
- II. A man sick with palsy was brought to Jesus for healing.
 - They couldn't get in because of the crowd, so they let the sick man down through the roof.
 - Jesus saw their faith and said to the sick man, "Cheer up! Your sins are forgiven!"
 - Obviously, this man had a sin burden. He was under condemnation, and that had to be dealt with before he could receive healing.
 - The Pharisees were angry because Jesus said He could forgive sin. They knew that only God could forgive sin.
 - When the man was healed, the crowd began to glorify God.
 - Did anyone else get healed in addition to this man? Yes.
 - The power of God was present to heal. The crowd began to glorify God, and faith had come, so many could have been healed.
 - The power that forgives is exactly the same power that heals.
 - Healing comes by the power of the living God. He is a forgiving God. He is a healing God, and we praise Him!
- III. While there can be many hindrances to faith, Jesus talked about the hindrance of unforgiveness.
 - Faith won't work in an unforgiving heart.





- Jesus said, “Forgive if you have ought against any, that your Father in heaven may forgive you your trespasses” (Mark 11:25).
 - If you don’t forgive, your faith won’t work for you to receive forgiveness.
 - Receiving forgiveness is an absolute promise of God. He is faithful and just (and righteous) to forgive us of our sins (1 John 1:9).
 - You’re going to have to do your part and receive your forgiveness and cleansing.
 - “There is no condemnation for those who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit” (Romans 8:1-2). If you’re walking in obedience to your feelings, you’re walking after your flesh.
- IV. Brother Copeland tells the story of the salvation of a serial killer named Steven Moran.
- Steven stole a car with one of Brother Copeland’s Partners inside.
 - He was a serial killer, and he threatened to kill her. She began to witness to him about Jesus.
 - He shouted at her to be quiet, so she asked if she could listen to her tape. It was Kenneth Copeland preaching. He agreed to let her listen.
 - While listening, Steven heard a voice say, “Steven, this is your last chance, Son.”
 - He accepted Jesus as LORD and Savior right then.
 - Steven ended up being caught and sentenced to death. Before his execution, Brother Copeland spent time with him and said, “Steven, let me know if God’s grace is sufficient.” Brother Copeland asked him to give a thumbs up sign.
 - During his execution, right before he took his last breath, Steven gave Brother Copeland the sign—two thumbs up—God’s grace is *more than* sufficient!
- V. The same spiritual force that forgives you, heals you.
- It is vitally important that we obey The LORD Jesus by forgiving anyone we have issues against.
 - This is not optional. It’s a commandment to love The LORD your God and to love your fellow Christians, whether you feel like it or not.
 - Feelings will change; but for now—forgive, and mean it with all your heart.
 - Choose to forgive and receive your healing; receive your forgiveness.
 - You have the same power to forgive that Jesus has. You have it, because He has authorized and commanded you to forgive!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Make this declaration:

I am forgiven from all my sins, and I am healed of all my diseases, in Jesus’ Name!

DAY 4 – TODAY IS YOUR DAY FOR HEALING

We are the seed of Abraham. Our instruction is to meditate on God's WORD continually. Today is the day of deliverance. Today is the day of salvation! Jesus will set you free from addictions, habits and sins right now.

STUDY IT

- I. We are the seed of Abraham (Galatians 3:29).
 - It's very important to not quit using your faith.
 - Years ago, Dodie Osteen, Joel Osteen's mother, was diagnosed with liver cancer. She refused to go to bed. She refused to stop doing her responsibilities. Even though she had pain, she would not quit.
 - She made a list of healing scriptures and read them out loud three times a day. She received her complete healing, and she is still well today.
- II. Our instruction is to meditate on God's WORD continually.
 - Read, listen, speak and agree with what God says (Proverbs 4:20-22).
 - We must receive what God tells us.
 - Jonathan, Brother Copeland's grandson, is a college freshman and is the quarterback on the football team. He's a very good player; but to be a successful passer, he needs receivers.
 - Jesus is the Healer, and He's the same yesterday, today and forever (Hebrews 13:8). Jesus needs a receiver—that's you!
 - God is ready. The glory is here. You be a ready receiver.
- III. Today is the day of deliverance. Today is the day of salvation!
 - Jesus was teaching in the synagogue on the Sabbath (Luke 13:10-16).
 - A woman was there who could not stand up straight. Jesus said, "Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity."
 - The leader of the synagogue was angry that Jesus had healed on the Sabbath.
 - Jesus said, "You take care of your animals on the Sabbath, why would you deny this woman healing?"
 - A man who lived in the cemetery needed deliverance and healing (Mark 5:1-20).





- There is a rank and order in the demonic realm (Ephesians 6:12):
 1. Principalities.
 2. Powers.
 3. Rulers of the darkness of this world—these are the ones in this world who possess people.
- This passage of Scripture is talking about one spirit plus 3,000-6,000 principalities and powers—all in one man.
- The spirit said, “What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God?”
- The spirit said his name was Legion and begged Jesus to not send him and the principalities and powers out of the country.
- Jesus cast out the main spirit. Then all the other evil beings begged Jesus that they might leave the man and go into the pigs. They entered the pigs, and immediately, the pigs ran off a cliff and drowned in the sea.
- This man got delivered, healed, dressed and called to preach all in one day.

IV. Jesus will set you free from addictions, habits and sins right now.

- This man used to cut himself. If that’s your problem, God will deliver you of that and all other kinds of physical and shameful addictions.
- Brother Copeland knows a man who preached to young women with addictions. They received Jesus and were baptized. When they came out of the water, the scars were gone from their bodies and from their souls.
- God is our Healer! Jesus is the Healer!
- If you believe this gospel, you are ready to receive the power of God.
- Take authority over all sickness and disease, and over all demons.
- Let your actions follow your faith, and act on what you’ve heard. Act as if you are healed. Do what you couldn’t do before.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Say this with Brother Copeland:

The gospel that I have heard is the power of God unto my salvation. I confess Jesus Christ as LORD over my life: my spirit, my soul and my body. I receive the power of God to make me sound, whole, delivered, saved and healed now. I act on The WORD of God. I receive the power of God. Sickness, disease, pain, I resist you, now, in the Name of Jesus. You are not the will of God for me. I enforce The WORD of God on you. I will not tolerate you in my life. Leave my presence, right now. I will never allow you back. My days of sickness and disease are over. I am the saved, the healed. The power of sickness has been forever broken over my life. Jesus bore my sickness, weakness and pain. I am forever free. Sickness, sin nor fear shall no longer lord it over me. I have been redeemed from the curse of the law. I proclaim my freedom in Jesus’ Name. Today, the gospel is the power of God for me unto salvation. I receive the gospel. I act on the gospel. I am made whole in Jesus’ Name!





HEALING 101

DAY 5 – USE YOUR AUTHORITY FOR HEALING

Use your authority for healing. The reason you can get healed is because of the goodness of God. Remember God's benefits, including forgiveness and healing. Not only can you be healed, but also your sins can be forgiven. God has always been good.

STUDY IT

- I. Use your authority for healing.
 - This teaching was recorded on Nov. 11, during the 1995 Tallahassee Victory Campaign.
 - You can't believe beyond what you actually know. If you don't know it, you can't believe for it.
 - Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by The WORD of God (Romans 10:17). You must *keep* faith stirred up by hearing.
 - To keep something in your heart, you must continually feed on it. Take the medicine of The WORD of God, and keep taking it. You can't overdose on God's WORD!
- II. The reason you can get healed is because of the goodness of God (Psalm 145:8-9).
 - Once you get a revelation of the goodness of God, it will change your life forever.
 - God is not getting glory from sickness or any other work of the devil. Sickness is not evangelistic; it doesn't bring God glory.
 - Jesus said God gets glory when you bear fruit (John 15:8), and His will is done in your life.
 - When you walk in love, you're going to do the right thing.
 - God is good to all, disposed to show favors, full (no room for anything else) of compassion and of great mercy. His mercy endures forever (Psalm 136), and it is for you, today!
 - A definition of *mercy*: "to suffer with another; eager yearning for another."
 - God doesn't have to be talked into helping you; He's already done it. Just believe what God has already done and said. That's faith.
 - God considers healing good (Acts 10:38).





- III. Remember God's benefits, including forgiveness and healing (Psalm 103:1-5, 8).
- Don't forget *any* of His benefits.
 - The LORD *daily* loads us with benefits (Psalm 68:19). Expect good things from God every day.
 - God forgives *all* iniquities. God is good and full of mercy and compassion.
- IV. Not only can you be healed, but also your sins can be forgiven.
- If you are afflicted, that means troubled (James 5:13-15).
 - If you are in trouble, you ought to pray for yourself.
 - Don't let people pray for you who say, "If it be God's will," or they pray in unbelief. Take hold of your answer by faith.
 - The devil condemns, but God eagerly yearns to save and heal you.
 - If you believe God made you sick or He is punishing you, you're not going to be able to believe He will heal you.
 - Sin's lifestyle brings sickness, disease, defeat and death; but according to the mercy of God, you can get forgiven from sin and healed at the same time.
 - God wants you to be free. He loves you.
- V. God has always been good.
- You can see the perfect will of God done in three places in the Bible:
 1. In the Garden of Eden, there was no sickness, no disease, no pain, no lack—there was plenty. It was good. That's what a good God does, He does good.
 2. In heaven, there is no pain or sorrow, no sickness or disease, and no lack.
 - Don't grieve over loved ones in heaven. They don't want to come back.
 - Grief is not of God; it's one of the things Jesus died to free you from (Isaiah 53:4).
 - Death and grief run together. Grief ruins the rest of the family who have not died. It suppresses the life of God.
 - That's one reason some people don't get healed. They try to live under the spirit of grief. Rebuke it, and tell it to go!
 3. The will of God was done in Jesus' ministry. Jesus said, "If you've seen Me, you've seen the Father" (John 14:9). Jesus didn't say or do anything unless He heard and saw the Father do it.
- VI. At this point in today's teaching, there was a loud noise.
- Tornadoic winds tore off portions of the roof of the convention center during Healing School! Gloria Copeland looked up, rebuked the storm, and commanded lights to stay on. She called on the Name of Jesus for their deliverance.
 - Mr. Barry Tubbs gave directions for people to move from the main auditorium to the exhibition hall.
 - No one was hurt, and many received the healing they came for.



- Gloria Copeland continued to speak and pray for people to receive healing.
