DAY 1 – BECOMING FLUENT IN FAITH: TOTAL IMMERSION IN THE WORD

Immerse yourself in God's WORD. Walking by faith in God and living by faith works effectively in you for your good. It's important to be taught about the spirit, soul and body. A major part of the faith life is knowing and thinking about the wonderful truth that born-again people *are not* condemned. Take command of your soul: your mind, will and emotions. Jesus said, "Have the God kind of faith."

STUDY IT

- I. Immerse yourself in God's WORD.
 - Brother Copeland learned the concept of total immersion when he heard about a language school set up during World War II.
 - The students at the school were not allowed to speak English. Within six weeks of total immersion in another language, the students were conversationally fluent, and in less than a year they were qualified to be interpreters.
 - Kenneth and Gloria began their Christian walk by immersing themselves in God's WORD as shared by Oral Roberts and Kenneth E. Hagin.
 - They were totally immersed in God's WORD. They didn't take time to watch TV or read the newspaper.
 - Brother Copeland was traveling with Brother Roberts, watching him preach faith; and at home, he was hearing Kenneth Hagin teach faith.
 - Brother Kenneth's faith grew rapidly. In a short time, professors from the college were asking for his help, because his faith was working.
 - Years ago, at a meeting, Brother Copeland's book table was set up next to Brother Hagin's.
 - Kenneth E. Hagin looked over at the preaching materials. He said, "You could have at least changed the titles when you preach my message."
 - Brother Copeland said, "No, that's the name of the message, and I'm not changing it."
 - Often, Kenneth and Gloria still listen to Brother Hagin's teaching via the internet. They are still immersing themselves in God's WORD.





- II. Walking by faith in God and living by faith works effectively in you for your good.
- Faith is a spiritual force, generated in the reborn human spirit, not in the mind.
 - We need to major on living by faith.
 - There are spiritual forces that hinder your growth. In some cases, your faith can be stopped by not walking in love.
 - This is one subject that is not talked about enough. Jesus is The LORD of our lives. We are new creatures (2 Corinthians 5:17).
 - God's WORD is more powerful than any two-edged sword, dividing the spirit and soul (Hebrews 4:12).
- III. It's important to be taught about the spirit, soul and body.
- Every human being, saved or unsaved, is a three-part, integrated system.
 - You are a spirit, you have a soul, and you live in a body (1 Thessalonians 5:23).
 - The spirit and soul are not the same thing.
 - The spirit is the person; that is, you. You have a soul, made up of your will, mind and emotions—the intellectual part of you. You live in a body. You can live without your body, but the body can't live without you. A person dies, but his soul (mind, will and emotions) and spirit are still intact.
 - The only reason a person goes to hell is because he didn't make Jesus his LORD and Savior. No one goes to hell for lying, cheating or stealing.
 - Even if you wait to receive Jesus until right before you die, you will go to heaven.
- IV. A major part of the faith life is knowing and thinking about the wonderful truth that born-again people *are not* condemned.
- "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus who walk not after the flesh, but after the spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death" (Romans 8:1-2).
 - Every time you say *now*, it's now.
 - Condemning yourself has never fixed anything; it just creates depression.
 - The Bible says to judge yourself—don't condemn yourself.
 - When you sin, you should repent right then.
 - When you miss it, it hurts you emotionally, but don't allow it to trouble your heart. Don't allow yourself to be afraid. Jesus took and bore your sin, and went to hell for you.





- V. Take command of your soul: your mind, will and emotions.
- Say this by faith: *I am not moved by what I feel, I am not moved by what I see, I am moved only by what I believe, and I believe The WORD of God.*
 - It's easy to make a positive confession in a group. But when satan tries to put pressure on you, his goal is to steal God's WORD from you.
 - The devil steals, kills and destroys. He wants to steal God's WORD from you, so The WORD will not be effective in your life. He is not trying to steal your money, your children or your ministry—just God's powerful WORD.
 - Faith comes by hearing and hearing The WORD of God (Romans 10:17). Choose to walk by faith and keep the commandment of love.
 - Kenneth and Gloria just celebrated their 57th wedding anniversary. They choose to walk in forgiveness. When something comes up that would cause strife between them, together they refuse it.
 - You can't allow the devil to steal The WORD of God, which is your power.
- VI. Jesus said, "Have the God kind of faith" (Mark 11:22).
- Condemning yourself is not going to get rid of unrepented sin.
 - To erase sin, depend on Jesus' blood to cleanse you (1 John 1:7-8).
 - "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us" (1 John 1:9). We are forgiven when we confess it, not when we feel better about it. This is huge in the life of faith.
 - Forgiveness has nothing to do with feelings, but it has everything to do with obedience.
 - Obedience is greater than sacrifice (1 Samuel 15:22). It may take a little time for your flesh to get over your sin, but your spirit is instantaneously over it. There is *no* condemnation—that's what we are talking about.
 - The law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus is spiritual life (Romans 8:2). It's a spiritual law that works all the time. Activate faith-filled words to dominate the law of sin and death.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Total immersion in God's WORD is the way to get fast results in prayer and greater understanding and revelation of His WORD. Let God shine His light on your life to identify things that may be taking unnecessary time away from your attention to God's WORD and prayer. He will guide you!

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DAY 2 – THE WORD SEPARATES YOU FROM YOUR FLESH

Exercise faith instead of condemnation. The WORD of God will separate you from sin. You are a spirit, you have a soul, and you live in a body. When your spirit is born again, you are a new creature. God has forgiven you of all transgressions, blotting out the handwriting of the notes against you. Brother Copeland prays Colossians 1:9-11 for his Partners, and you can pray it for yourself.

STUDY IT

- I. Exercise faith instead of condemnation.
 - “There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit” (Romans 8:1).
 - You are told to grow up in the things of God (Hebrews 5:12-14).
 - You are supposed to be teachers, but because you are immature, you have need that someone teach you again. You still need milk, not strong meat.
 - Everyone using milk is unskillful in God’s WORD. Strong meat of The WORD is for those of full age.
 - You need to be able to discern good and evil.

- II. The WORD of God will separate you from sin.
 - When Brother Copeland was born again, he was instantly delivered from speaking profanity. He also was addicted to smoking cigarettes.
 - On the way to a meeting, he put his cigarettes behind his car’s sun visor. After spending several days in the meeting, he realized he didn’t have one thought about smoking or an urge to smoke. The addiction was just gone. God’s WORD separated him from sin.
 - On another occasion, Brother Copeland felt he was to fast newspapers—stop reading them for a time. God’s WORD separated him from that habit. The desire was gone. God wanted his time and attention.
 - This is how you grow up in Jesus.
 - All of his life, Brother Copeland had disliked exercise, and the disobedience to take care of his body had cost him over the years. Now, at 82 years old, he’s in a strong workout program.





- If you say something with your mouth, it will control your life.
 - As he began to exercise, before he could stop his words, he said, "I hate this!" He had been saying the same thing for over 50 years.
 - He immediately repented (1 John 1:9). He said, "No, no, no. I love this exercise because I love You, Jesus; and I receive my forgiveness and the cleansing of this sin." When he repented, he physically felt a change.
- III. You are a spirit, you have a soul, and you live in a body. When your spirit is born again, you are a new creature (2 Corinthians 5:17).
- Say this: *I'm a new creature. I've been re-created, not just forgiven. I'm not just a forgiven sinner. I'm not just an old sinner saved by grace. I was an old sinner. I got saved by grace, and now I'm a new creature.*
 - Because of Brother Copeland's words against exercise, he opened the door for the devil to influence his flesh and his mind.
 - The moment he repented, he was free! Thank God for victory in Christ Jesus!
- IV. God has forgiven you of all transgressions, blotting out the handwriting of the notes against you (Colossians 2:13-14, *AMPC*). They are gone! God nailed them to the Cross.
- See yourself standing beside a river, a river of blood. Take the sin that has plagued you, throw it into the river and watch it fall into that blood. Don't let the devil bring it back up again.
 - God has forgiven you from all sin.
 - You may have caused someone to get an abortion, or you may have had one yourself. Cast that thing into the blood as far as you can, and remember, your child is waiting for you in heaven. You'll see him or her again.
 - Find the forgiveness scriptures and meditate on them. Your sin does not exist anymore. It's gone!
 - Just a few days ago, Kenneth and Gloria ministered in a women's prison, where he preached on forgiveness.
 - He saw the women's faces light up when they saw the Scriptures were true.
 - Let these truths get down into your spirit being, and renew your mind.
 - Speak this confession: *That's not who I am. That's who I was. I'm not that person anymore.*
- V. Brother Copeland prays Colossians 1:9-11 for his Partners. You can pray it for yourself.
- This scripture is God speaking to you.
 - "For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all





- pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness" (Colossians 1:9-11).
- The Holy Spirit wrote this through the Apostle Paul, so it's the Holy Spirit's desire.
 - If it's the Holy Spirit's desire, it's Jesus' desire, and He's our LORD and Savior.
 - Put in your name as you read this scripture.
 - It's Jesus' desire that _____ (put your name) might be filled with the knowledge of His will.
 - Notice three of the fruit of the spirit are named in this scripture: love, joy and patience.
 - "Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son" (Colossians 1:12-13).
 - The Greek word *dear* is the same as the word *agape*.
 - "In whom (in Jesus), we have Redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sin" (Colossians 1:14).
 - The moment you said, "Jesus, take my life; I give You my life," you were translated from darkness to light. You were put into the kingdom of God with full rights and authority. You have "firstborn rights."
 - Jesus was the first born from the dead. We are joint heirs with Him, so we have the same status.
 - In the first covenant, the adopted child was always heir with the firstborn. We have been adopted by God.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Fear is a strong force. But, you have a stronger force inside you—the force of faith in God's WORD. Don't be afraid of making a mistake. Depend on God's never-ending forgiveness and remind yourself there is no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus!

Pray with us:

Father God, thank You for Your constant forgiveness and love. I receive Your help and cleansing from every sin. I refuse condemnation, even if the fault was mine. I receive the love of God that passes all understanding, and I will live as if I'm forgiven—because I am! Thank You, Sir! In Jesus' Name. Amen.



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DAY 3 – TAME YOUR FIVE SENSES WITH THE WORD

We are not to be led by our five physical senses, but by The WORD of God. You can train your physical senses with God's WORD. *You* put God in remembrance. *You* declare your position in Christ that you may be justified. *You* remind God of the good stuff you want Him to remember. God hears your case based on His WORD.

STUDY IT

- I. We are not to be led by our five physical senses, but by The WORD of God.
 - “There is therefore *now* no condemnation” (Romans 8:1).
 - It's so important to forget the past. The past is gone
 - Hope is in the future. Faith looks toward the future. “*Now* faith is...” (Hebrews 11:1).
 - God's WORD is just as much a manifestation of Jesus in the earth as the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The Bible is God speaking to you.
 - Romans 8 is one of the most informative chapters in the Bible. It's pregnant with revelation from heaven.

- II. You can train your physical senses with God's WORD.
 - You can teach yourself to stop worrying once and for all by casting your care onto Jesus (1 Peter 5:7).
 - Worry is sin. It's a mental exercise, an over-engrossing thing, that is deadly.
 - We are learning how to live and walk, not with a sin consciousness, but rather having a righteousness consciousness.
 - There is no sin horrific enough to cause God to not love you. He loves everyone, including terrorists and wicked human beings.
 - Also, there's nothing you could possibly do to make Him love you more. He loves you with everything He has. He *is* Love (1 John 4:8). He has faith, but He is Love. And He has a Name; His Name is Jesus.
 - God said, “I, even I, am he that blotteth out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins” (Isaiah 43:25).



- You should not remember your sins, either. Confess them, then forget them, and enjoy your freedom.
 - Soldiers don't act on their feelings; they act on orders. If not, there's trouble.
 - We are soldiers in the army of The LORD.
 - It's the devil, not God, who steals, kills and destroys (John 10:10).
- III. *You put God in remembrance of His WORD. You declare your position in Christ that you may be justified. You remind God of the good stuff you want Him to remember.*
- God said He took care of you and forgave you for *His* sake (Isaiah 43:25-26).
 - God does not want to remember bad things about his children. If He remembers your sins, He can't bless you.
 - Jesus is the Christ. He is born of God and overcomes the world. Our faith in Jesus overcomes the world (1 John 5:1-4).
 - This is the confidence we have in Him, that if we ask Him according to His WORD, He will do it (1 John 5:14-15).
 - His WORD is His will. In order to know what God is really like, look at Jesus.
 - It is still God's will to heal today. Faith begins where the will of God is known.
 - In the New Testament, you see God manifested in the flesh.
 - Jesus didn't tell anyone to wait for healing, so God doesn't want anyone to wait for healing. Jesus told the leper, "I will" (Matthew 8:3).
- IV. *God hears your case based on His WORD.*
- Kingdom law, God's legal WORD, is what we pray. Apply the promises of God to your situation.
 - All of the promises of God in Jesus are "yes and amen" (2 Corinthians 1:20).
 - "By His stripes we are healed" (1 Peter 2:24) is a Bible fact, not an empty promise.
 - Plead your case. Take your evidence (God's WORD); this is case law (the Bible).
 - Judgment is wonderful if you're on the right side of it. Judgment is a function of seed, time and harvest (Genesis 8:22).
 - Judge yourself, repent, take Communion and receive forgiveness. If you judge yourself, you won't be judged with the world.
 - Judge yourself. Don't be condemning, but be brutally honest. Don't sugarcoat sin by calling it "your problem." Call it what it is—sin. Then repent of it.
 - Don't mess up a good confession with an excuse, like you sinned because you were overly tired.
 - When you forgive people, forget what they did to you. Every time you see them, treat them as if they never sinned against you.
 - Brother Copeland shared Keith Moore's story of the correct attitude when attending Thanksgiving and Christmas family parties. You've forgiven yourself





and your family; and once they are forgiven, it's done. Don't let the memory of sin enter your thinking. Simply say, "It's so nice to see you."

- It's your flesh that makes you fuss. Renew your mind that there is now no condemnation to those who walk *not* after the five physical senses. You have to practice the presence of God.
- Force your flesh to submit under the command of your spirit. Control your mind and emotions. Instead of being fussy, be the bright spot in someone's day.
- Practice! Start your day in love. Say: *LORD, I forgive everyone I come in contact with today.* Be prepared to love.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

It takes training to believe God and His WORD above the physical evidence presented by your senses, but it's possible! Spend time every day with The LORD. Read and think about His WORD. Soon, the power of God's promises will jump to the forefront of your mind, and your faith in His WORD will be stronger than the natural report. It takes practice, but you can do it!

DAY 4 – THE WORD IS ANOINTING AND DELIVERANCE

Happy 243rd birthday, United States of America! In 1977, Brother Copeland was separated into the office of a prophet. All of the judgment of God is merciful. When you were born again, a living anointing came inside you—not condemnation—you were transformed! God's WORD is Anointing and deliverance.

STUDY IT

- I. Happy 243rd birthday, United States of America!
 - This is the only nation ever created that was founded by a people who loved God and for the purpose of worshipping Him.
 - Jesus appeared to Kenneth and Gloria's friend, Rose Whiner, and said, *I created Israel because I love them, but America was created for people who loved Me, and I will never forget it.*

- II. In 1977, Brother Copeland was separated into the office of the prophet.
 - He has heard the voice of The LORD on many occasions since.
 - Not long ago, Brother Copeland heard the strong voice of The LORD about our nation.
 - The LORD said: *All the trouble you're seeing is birth pangs for the renewing of your nation, especially the severe persecution against our president. It's not people; we are not wrestling against flesh and blood, but wicked spirits in the heavenlies.* (Daniel 10; Ephesians 6:12).
 - *Do you think the Founding Fathers had any idea what this country would look like in 100 years? No. They had no mental concept.*
 - *In the same way, you have no idea what this country is going to look like once this new birth process is finished. It will be miraculous, and the awakening will change everyone in this nation. Glory to God!*

- III. All of the judgment of God is merciful.
 - Judgment is part of seedtime and harvest (Genesis 8:22).
 - If God didn't judge you, the devil would destroy you.
 - If judgment is coming on you, receive the correction and seek wisdom.





- Open your heart and mind to receive wisdom (James 1:5).
 - Ask in faith, believing God will help you (Mark 11:23-24).
 - We have been given wisdom, righteousness and sanctification (1 Corinthians 1:30).
 - Determine that you are going to believe God's WORD and laugh your way out of trouble. Your Father sits in the heavens laughing at the devil and everything he does (Psalm 37:13).
 - We have been raised up to sit with Jesus in heavenly places, and laugh at the enemy. Laugh at everything he has done to destroy you and your family. He can't destroy you, because you're not going to let him.
 - Every born-again believer has the still small voice of God inside him. Your part is to practice listening.
 - There is a deeper place stronger than just hearing the small voice of God, but reaching it starts with the personal anointing promised by the Holy Spirit who has come to live in you (1 John 2:20).
 - You received the Anointing from Jesus when you were born again.
- IV. When you were born again, a living anointing came inside you—not condemnation.
- There is no condemnation for those in Christ Jesus (Romans 8:1).
 - *Christ* is not Jesus' last name. It is a translation of the Hebrew word *Messiah*.
 - Jesus' Anointing is *in* and *on* you. The anointing is the power to walk not after the flesh (Romans 8:1).
 - When you are baptized in the Holy Spirit, that's when the power comes *on* you to anoint you for life and service. That's when you step over into the supernatural and function as the Body of Christ.
 - That's the power: to be baptized with the Holy Spirit and speak with other tongues.
 - The Holy Spirit is the bedrock of the Anointing power that is used to renew the mind.
- V. When you were born again, you were transformed—born again!
- Your spirit man was born again. Next, you have to train your mind—that's where the battleground is. You must cast down every vain imagination that tries to exalt itself above God's WORD (2 Corinthians 10:4-5).
 - You do that by faith. God has given you the measure of faith (Romans 12:1-3).
 - The LORD surprised Brother Copeland by saying: *Healing always comes. It's just not always received. Healing is there right now, because I'm there, and it is My will that everyone gets healed.*





VI. God's WORD is Anointing and deliverance.

- We're talking about there being no condemnation for those in Christ. There's power in God to renew the mind to have no sin consciousness.
- We need to look at sin through God's eyes.
- Jesus and the disciples came to the country of the Gadarenes. Immediately, they met a man with an unclean spirit (Mark 5:1-2).
 - Remember, we wrestle not against flesh and blood but against principalities (the lowest form of demon), against powers (a rank up), against rulers of the darkness of this world (they possess people—see Ephesians 6:12).
 - He had an unclean spirit. One demon controlled him. No man could bind or tame him. He didn't sleep. He was a cutter (Mark 5:2-5).
 - The unclean spirit talked using the man's voice. He had to obey Jesus and come out of the man (Mark 5:6-7).
 - Now, the principalities said, "My name is legion." There were thousands of them (Mark 5:8-9).
 - Only Jesus heard the principalities ask to be sent into the swine. The torment of those principalities was so horrible, the swine jumped into the sea (Mark 5:10-13).
 - The townspeople came to Jesus and saw the man seated, clothed and in his right mind (Mark 5:15-19).
 - If there was ever a man that the devil could keep from worshipping Jesus, it would have been that man, but the devil couldn't stop him.
 - Jesus delivered that man from demonic oppression immediately. Jesus was there to get that man free (Mark 5:20).
- If you have ever been troubled enough to cut yourself, that torment is over. Brother Copeland declared, "You are delivered right now. You are delivered from cutting, from cancer, from lung disease, right now! Reach out and take it!"
- One of the things that bothered the Apostle Paul was what he had done in the past to Jesus (Acts 26:9-11).
 - Jesus asked, "Why are you persecuting Me?"
- Be very cautious about persecuting one another. Jesus said, "Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me" (Matthew 25:40).
- How you treat people is how you treat Jesus. Repent, take Communion and receive your forgiveness.





MAKE IT PERSONAL

God's WORD is not condemnation; it is faith, hope and love. If you need deliverance in any area of life, go to The WORD. God, through the Holy Spirit revealing His heart in His WORD, will comfort, guide, encourage and love you to victory and peace.

Write down your successes in God, and rejoice that He cares for you.

DAY 5 – THERE IS NO RECORD OF YOUR SINS

There is no record of your sins. You are complete in Jesus Christ. The blood of Jesus is so powerful that it has removed all sin and sin consciousness. There is a compassion of the spirit that's so intense it comes out as groaning. Jesus only did miracles *after* He was baptized in the Holy Spirit; He was not Anointed with power before then.

STUDY IT

- I. There is no record of your sins.
 - The Bible says there is therefore now no condemnation (Romans 8:1).
 - Our transgressions have been blotted out (Isaiah 44:22).
 - Confess your sin to get it cleansed out of your conscious (1 John 1:9).
 - The LORD told Brother Copeland, *I am willing to do the things I tell you to do.*
 - We are told to forgive 490 times (Matthew 18:21-22).
 - The LORD said to receive forgiveness and get the guilt out of your own being, particularly out of the influence of your mind and emotions. Settle it forever—you are forgiven!
 - The life of faith is to not be moved by the reports of the five physical senses.

- II. You are complete in Jesus Christ. In Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily (Colossians 2:9-10).
 - You have received circumcision of the spirit, of the heart. All spiritual beings can see the circumcision of the spirit (Colossians 9:11).
 - By identifying with Jesus by faith, you went to the cross with Him, were buried with Him, went to hell with Him, were raised from the dead with Him, and are now seated with Him in heaven on the throne of grace (Colossians 2:12-13)!
 - God cancelled and wiped away the handwriting on the note that was against you (Colossians 2:14, *AMPC*). It's blank! There's no record of it anymore. Jesus triumphed over evil.
 - What did you receive when you made Jesus LORD? The blotting out!! All sin completely wiped out.
 - That's what God was looking forward to (Isaiah 43:25). This is where He was headed all the time.



- III. The blood of Jesus is so powerful that it has removed all sin and sin consciousness.
- The utensils of worship in heaven had to be cleansed with the blood of Jesus (Hebrews 9:22-23).
 - You need to see how powerful Jesus' blood is, and how awful and terrible Adam's sin was.
 - Adam was not deceived; he knew what he was doing it. See the gravity of his decision and the power it took to cleanse it.
 - The blood of Jesus removed sin, so that there exists no more sin consciousness (Hebrews 10:1-2).
- IV. Jesus continually pointed to the truth that there is no condemnation to those who believe in Him.
- Jesus told them to remove the stone from Lazarus' tomb (John 11:38-39).
 - He was illustrating the fact that sin and death were no longer limitations for those who believe in God, representing Adam *before* the Fall; a righteousness consciousness.
 - Martha's response was, "No, LORD, it'll stink."
 - She was, in effect, representing Adam *after* the Fall; a sin consciousness.
 - There is a compassion of the spirit that's so intense it comes out as groaning.
 - When Mary met Jesus and told him that Lazarus was dead, Jesus groaned in the spirit with compassion, not grief (John 11:33, 38).
- V. On earth, Jesus healed those who came to Him in faith.
- Jesus went about teaching and preaching God's WORD and faith came. When faith came, those who received His WORD got their healing.
 - Put sin consciousness far away from you. Let faith in God rise in your heart.
 - Make this confession: *In the Name of Jesus, I've been made the righteousness of God. I'm a new creature!*

MAKE IT PERSONAL
