DAY 1 – LIVING FREE FROM CONDEMNATION EVERY DAY

You can live free from condemnation every day. You are equal to Jesus because you have been born again and are a child of God. The WORD of God is a seed that produces life. The Name of Jesus is above every other name. You are not condemned if you are in Christ Jesus and live by the leading of the Spirit of God.

STUDY IT

- I. You can live free from condemnation every day.
 - Yesterday is gone. We wake up new every morning.
 - Don't carry the sorrows of yesterday, because God's mercy is new every morning (Lamentations 3:22-23).
 - It's possible to live without a sin consciousness.
 - The first Adam was very aware of his failures.
 - The last Adam was Jesus. He bore all the fault to bring us back into our rightful place as children of God.
 - The new birth of a human is the greatest success story of the ages. The born-again human spirit is destined for greatness.
 - The power of THE BLESSING of Adam, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and Jesus is born into us.
 - That truth will cause the joy of The LORD to spring up in you. But, it won't bring joy unless you allow the mind of Christ Jesus to be in you (Philippians 2:5-11).

- II. You are equal to Jesus because you have been born again and are a child of God.
 - At any time, you can think the way Jesus thought while He was on the earth.
 - Jesus is still a man.
 - He told His disciples to handle Him. He was flesh and bone. Instead of blood, He had the glory of God in His veins (Luke 24:39).
 - Jesus is the King of kings. We are the kings He is King of (Revelation 17:14).
 - "Let...." You have to choose to think this way. You have to let this mind be in you. If you still have all your failures on your mind, get them off your mind. Let the mind of Christ be in you (Philippians 2:5).





- Even in the valley of the shadow of death, we don't have to fear because God is with us (Psalm 23:4).
- What did God personally say to Joshua? He'd been to the Promised Land, and he ran from giants.
 - God said, *Meditate on My WORD day and night, and you'll see what to do* (Joshua 1:8-9).
 - Get those giants off your mind. Let God be the giant you have on your mind.

III. The WORD of God is a seed that produces life.

- Jesus came to earth as a man. He was in the form of God.
 - So are you! You are born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible seed—The WORD of God which lives and abides forever (1 Peter 1:23).
 - Our spiritual DNA is of God. This is the seed that got you born again.
- The spiritual seed that impregnated Mary was The WORD of God. It became the seed to birth the holiest One—Jesus (Luke 1:35).
 - The Holy Spirit hovered over Mary. The WORD that God delivered, she accepted—"according to Your WORD, be it done unto me" (Luke 1:38).
 - That WORD from God became the spiritual sperm that gave Jesus His flesh in Mary's womb. From a human woman was born a holy human being.
- Abraham said the same thing—"according to Your WORD" (Romans 4:20-22).
- Like Mary and Abraham, you heard The WORD.
 - You are a spirit being. You are as much like God as Jesus. You were created in His class.
 - A holy thing happened to you. You became a new creature in Christ Jesus—a species of being that never existed before.
- Brother Copeland was raised in a Christian home. He heard God's WORD, but he didn't pay attention.
 - All The WORD he had heard growing up was still in him; and in November of 1962, he received Jesus as LORD and Savior.
 - In one moment when he believed in Jesus, he was translated into the Kingdom of God (Colossians 1:13).

IV. The Name of Jesus is above every other name.

- Jesus came to earth, took the form of servant, but thought it not robbery to be equal with God.
 - He was made in the fashion of a man, and humbled Himself to the death of the Cross.
 - Therefore, God highly exalted Him and gave Jesus His Name, God's Name (Philippians 2:5-11).
 - "That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth" (Philippians 2:10).





- A better translation “of things” would be “names in heaven, names in earth, and names under the earth.”
 - We can choose to bow our knee to that majestic Name and confess that Jesus is LORD to the glory of God the Father.
 - Right now, people are being healed of lung cancer. *Cancer* and *lung* are names. Those names have to bow to the Name of Jesus. Rise up and take your healing.
 - You can apply this truth to any disease. Every disease is a name—asthma has to bow; allergies have to bow. Receive your healing!
 - Jesus cannot be sick with allergies. Therefore, you don't have to have allergies.
- V. You are not condemned if you are in Christ Jesus and live by the leading of the Spirit of God.
- “There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit” (Romans 8:1).
 - Stop, translate and meditate. *Christ* means *Anointed*.
 - Don't live based on the evidence presented by your five physical senses, but live based on the information presented by the Spirit of God.
 - The mighty Holy Spirit, the third person of the Godhead, can only obey The WORD of God.
 - Remember on Creation day, the Spirit of God was moving on the face of the deep and nothing was happening until God said a word.
 - “In the beginning was The WORD. The WORD was with God and The WORD was God” (John 1:1).
 - Nothing was created without Him, without The WORD.
 - God said, “Light be.” Light was. The Spirit of God that's living in you brought what God said into manifestation.
 - It's so important to become totally immersed in God's WORD—not just reading it, but also applying it to your life. Faith comes by hearing (Romans 10:8, 17).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Pray with us:

Father God, thank You that I can live free from condemnation. No matter what I did in the past, or didn't do, I'm free! The past cannot hold me, sin cannot condemn me, and the enemy cannot stop me from living free! Hallelujah! In Jesus' Name I pray. Amen.



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DAY 2 – SEE YOURSELF FORGIVEN NOW

A merry heart does good like medicine. Use your faith to believe that you are not condemned. What you say is important to your forgiveness. See yourself as forgiven!

STUDY IT

- I. A merry heart does good like medicine (Proverbs 17:22).
 - The joy of The LORD is your strength (Nehemiah 8:10).
 - Joy is a fruit of the spirit (Galatians 5:22-23).
 - The joy of The LORD is in your born-again spirit because that's the second fruit of the spirit: the same joy that's in the Father, in Jesus and in the Holy Spirit.
 - Stir up the gift that's in you (2 Timothy 1:6). Say it because you believe it, not because you feel it.
 - If you are weak and you don't have any strength, you're joy level is low. Dance around the room. Start laughing.
 - Brother Copeland knows a well-respected neurosurgeon who is a member of Bishop Keith Butler's church.
 - He said there is proof that your nervous system and your mind don't know the difference between a real laugh and an insincere laugh.
 - At the hospital where he practices, they have laughing classes. They practice laughing, and the pain leaves.
 - Just say, "Ha, ha, ha." You can laugh pain, sickness and disease out of your body.

- II. Use your faith to believe that you are not condemned.
 - "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit" (Romans 8:1).
 - We live our lives by faith, not by sight; that is, not by our five physical senses (2 Corinthians 5:7).
 - Faith comes by hearing and hearing by The WORD of God (Romans 10:17).
 - The justified, not the condemned, live by faith (Romans 1:17).
 - Faith is a spiritual force that's generated in the born-again spirit, the heart, of man.



- Condemnation is fear-based and fear-dependent. It doesn't change anything. It only makes things worse.
- Take your mind off the problem and set your mind on things above (Colossians 3:2).
- We have to train our thinking to look through the eyes of our spirit being, otherwise we will be sin conscious—being aware of the failure side of life (Hebrews 10:1-4).
- Roll your care over onto God. Jesus is your Care Taker (1 Peter 5:7-9).
 - Resist the devil. He's *like* a roaring lion, but he's not. All he has is a threat. He no longer has the power of death. Jesus took it away from him.

III. What you say is important to your forgiveness.

- Don't allow the five physical senses to dominate your thinking. What you think about will dominate your words. Whatever you say long enough will get into your spirit, and it will control your life.
- Brother Copeland recently had to change his words about exercise. It's never too late to change your words and your actions.
- Words are the most powerful thing on the planet. We live in a word-created, word-upheld environment.
- Words are not primarily for communication—that's secondary. Words are primarily for the release of power.
- Fear is faith that has been twisted.
- In the Bible the phrase, "Fear not" is used 95 times. In the Old Testament 72 times and 23 times in the New Testament (second covenant). It's said many times using different words; but the actual phrase is used 95 times.

IV. See yourself as forgiven!

- Get completely away from condemnation. There is none to those who are in Christ Jesus.
- Take the forgiveness of God. He doesn't remember your sin, and neither should you!
- Refuse to live a self-condemned life.
 - God told Cain what would happen to him because of his sin. Then, Cain added to what God said, and God didn't correct him. With his own words, Cain condemned himself. Cain said it, and God had given him the authority to have what he said (Genesis 4:11-15).
- "I, even I, am he that blotteth out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins" (Isaiah 43:25).
- If you have unforgiveness and choose to repent, God forgives you (Mark 11:25).
 - God forgave you when Jesus bore your sin, but you have to receive it.





- If you have held something against someone for a long time, your flesh is in the habit of unforgiveness.
- Speak that God has forgiven you, and let it go!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Laughter is like medicine and joy is your strength. So, start laughing!

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DAY 3 – REFUSE TO THINK THE DEVIL'S THOUGHTS

Sin and condemnation are gone! Give your worries to God. Refuse to think the devil's thoughts. We are children of God; and we need a revelation of God's WORD, and knowledge of how His kingdom works. Heaven is waiting for a man or woman to speak. Redirect your thoughts of condemnation by renewing your mind.

STUDY IT

- I. Sin and condemnation are gone!
 - *Now* continually updates to right now. "There is therefore *now*..." (Romans 8:1).
 - *Now*, sin and condemnation are gone; but you have to take your forgiveness by faith, and that includes training your mind to think godly thoughts.
 - You can't successfully fight thoughts with thoughts.
 - Anxiety comes from pride. Give your cares to Jesus (1 Peter 5:7). You are not qualified to carry them.
 - Medical science knows and has proven that the physical human body should last 120 years (Genesis 6:3).
 - God didn't set the limit to 70 or 80 years. That was a curse that came on the disobedient people in the wilderness (Psalm 90:10).
 - The main reason people don't live that long is they are damaging their brains with worry, fear and strife.
 - Watch yourself. This can happen to born-again people.
 - Take Communion to solidify your decision to stop worry, fear, anxiety, care or strife.

- II. Give your worries to God. Refuse to think the devil's thoughts.
 - The best thing you can do is roll the cares of life onto the Father. You can't heal, or change your life or your children with worry.
 - Brother Copeland's mother prayed for about 13 years for him to be saved. Finally, she told The LORD she was not going to pray for his salvation anymore.
 - She was exercising this scripture—cast your care onto Jesus (1 Peter 5:7). Two weeks after that decision, Gloria was saved; and Kenneth was saved a week later.





- III. Because we are children of God; we need a revelation of God's WORD and knowledge of how His kingdom works.
- Jesus didn't say, "Seek first God." No, He said, "Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness..." (Matthew 6:33).
 - Righteousness is God's way of being right.
 - We need to become proficient in the ways of the kingdom of God, because we are responsible for using them in our lives.
 - God created the first man and his wife, and He gave them the whole earth and all the authority in it. What God has given can't be reversed.
- IV. Heaven is waiting for a man or woman on earth to speak.
- God established a spiritual law, so that earth has to move before heaven can.
 - Whatever you bind or loose on earth is bound or loosed in heaven. If two of you shall agree on earth, it will be done by the Father in heaven (Matthew 18:18-19).
 - First, it's spoken on earth; then heaven makes it happen.
 - Heaven has already opened the door to anyone who will take the offer of help.
 - According to what we believe, that's what we say, and that's what we do.
 - Jesus said, "If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you" (John 15:7).
 - The answers to our prayers are found in abiding in Him.
 - Begging prayers won't work. They are based on fear and a lack of knowledge.
 - God is willing, but we must come to Him in faith.
- V. Redirect your thoughts of condemnation by renewing your mind (Romans 12:2).
- That's done with God's WORD. Find scriptures, promises and Bible facts that cover your situation. Put them in your heart, your eyes and your ears, and begin to meditate on them.
 - "Why take ye thought, saying...?" (Matthew 6:31). That's worry.
 - Take the thought that there is no condemnation in Christ Jesus. Take the thought of freedom from condemnation, and say it!
 - You seek first the Kingdom, and all these things will be added to you.
 - You know your mind is renewed when the truth of God's WORD comes out of your mouth without you thinking about it.
 - Continue to repent every time a thought against God's WORD comes up. Speak God's WORD only. Declare that you will think God's thoughts.
 - You stop thoughts by speaking. Your mind will stop thinking to hear what your mouth is saying.
 - Speak God's WORD. It works!





MAKE IT PERSONAL

God tells you what to think about in His WORD. Write some of the things you can think that will bring life and peace. (Hint: Philippians 4:8.)



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DAY 4 – THE WORD OF GOD SETTLES IT

The WORD of God settles every question. Forgiveness from sin and condemnation are available to everyone. Jesus takes it personally when His family is persecuted. Set your mind on things above and not on things of this earth

STUDY IT

- I. The WORD of God settles every question.
 - The WORD must have first place and be the final authority in the life of a believer.
 - The WORD says, “By His stripes you were healed” (1 Peter 2:24). That’s it! God said it; that settles it!
 - Condemnation will bring pressure, but you keep saying and believing what God said.
 - Don’t pray for The LORD to be with you. He’s already with you. He said He would never leave you nor forsake you (Hebrews 13:5). He’s in you. He’s going with you.

- II. Forgiveness from sin and condemnation are available to everyone.
 - Before the foundation of the world, God knew your name and the moment you would be conceived in your mother’s womb (Matthew 25:34).
 - The Copelands recently ministered about the forgiveness of God in a women’s prison.
 - They comforted those who have had abortions and included the young men who were involved in the conception.
 - They encouraged them to repent and receive forgiveness from God. It’s possible to supernaturally forget the shame and pain for wrong decisions and actions.
 - Jesus is with you, even in prison (Matthew 25:35-36). Maybe you *were* in prison, but that’s not you now.



- III. Jesus takes it personally when His family is persecuted.
- Jesus said, "Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me" (Matthew 25:40).
 - Saul imprisoned and persecuted Christians and held the coats of the men who stoned Stephen. Jesus didn't say, "Saul why are you persecuting My people?" He said, "Saul, why are you persecuting Me?" (Acts 9:4-5).
 - We have been made joint heirs with Christ Jesus. We have an equal inheritance with Him (Philippians 2:6).
 - The devil is not persecuting Christians, he is persecuting Jesus. Atheists are not against you; they are against Jesus. We are praying that they receive Jesus as Savior and LORD.
 - Brother Copeland's cousin had been preached to when he was a child. As an adult, he became addicted to drugs. He got saved by hearing himself preach the gospel to himself!
 - The doctors had said that even if he got free from drugs, he would never be in his right mind.
 - The man and his mother prayed and believed God for him to have a sound mind. He was healed and earned a degree in physical therapy. The WORD of God healed his brain.
- IV. Set your mind on things above and not on things of this earth (Colossians 3:2).
- Renew your mind to the fact that you are not the target—Jesus is the target. Let The WORD take its place in you, and you'll have peace of mind all the time.
 - Your mind belongs to you. You choose what you think and believe.
 - It's a divine appointment today that you are listening to these words.
 - Don't take your life! Give it to Jesus! Say, "Jesus, take my life and do something with it!" Today, Jesus is your life. Your life matters. You matter to God; and therefore, you matter to us.
 - You choose life and blessing or death and cursing (Deuteronomy 30:19). Don't choose death.
 - Death is not the end; it's the beginning of eternity. Death is only the end of the ability to choose. When you die, you have no more choice. Choose Jesus while you are still in this body. Choose Him, now!
- V. You can grow in holiness and faith. Your flesh is trainable.
- You don't grow in righteousness—you have been *made* righteous (2 Corinthians 5:21).
 - Righteousness is of the spirit. Holiness has to do with the flesh and the soul. You can grow in holiness and faith.





- Kenneth Copeland Ministries is all about helping Christians grow to spiritual maturity (Hebrews 5:14).
- Live in the place where you do not condemn yourself—you have no more sin consciousness—but you live in communion with Jesus.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

You are in charge of your thoughts. You can choose what to think and what not to think. Make a list of things you want to think about, like the goodness and freedom you can have in Christ Jesus. Add scriptures you can put in your mind and your mouth about your good God and your good life in Him!





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DAY 5 – RECEIVING DELIVERANCE FROM CONDEMNATION

Living a life free from condemnation and sin consciousness is obtainable by putting The WORD of God first place and making it the final authority in your life. You can be delivered from anything that's against God's WORD. The mission of Kenneth Copeland Ministries is to take people from milk to meat, from religion to reality. Everyone's sins have been purged; but each one of us has to receive the forgiveness.

STUDY IT

- I. Living a life free from condemnation and sin consciousness is obtainable by putting The WORD of God first place and making it the final authority in your life.
 - There is no condemnation to those in Christ Jesus who walk not by the evidence of the five physical senses, but by The WORD of God (Romans 8:1).
 - The devil wants to steal God's WORD of freedom from condemnation from you, so he can steal, kill and destroy. Keep speaking God's WORD about yourself.
 - What you say with your mouth is what you believe. Listen to what comes out of your mouth (Matthew 12:34).

- II. You can be delivered from anything that's against God's WORD.
 - When Brother Copeland was born again, he was delivered immediately from foul language.
 - But he had a struggle against drinking too much coffee (15-16 cups) each day. The ingredients in coffee were building up in his elbow joints and causing pain.
 - He prayed for wisdom about how to stop drinking coffee (James 1:5).
 - He took the scripture that said, cast your care on Him (1 Peter 5:7).
 - Brother Copeland put the things he was craving in front of him, took Communion over his decision and declared, "I have no need of you in my life." He had no withdrawal symptoms.
 - He used this same method to lower his intake of bread and sugar.
 - Use this method to get rid of anything your body is craving.





- III. The mission of Kenneth Copeland Ministries is to take people from milk to meat, from religion to reality (Hebrews 5:12-24, 6:1-3).
- This is more than religion—it's reality that Jesus purged your sins.
 - Before Jesus died and rose again, you couldn't be permanently forgiven with the sacrifice of animals because nothing in the spirit world had changed. No one could be born again.
 - God established animal sacrifices as a picture of the true Lamb of God, Jesus, who *would* take away the sin of the world (John 1:29).
 - The blood of bulls and goats could not take away sin. The animal blood only covered (atoned for) sin, and then only for one year.
 - In the Old Testament, the language makes some passages sound like God was to blame for what the devil was doing.
 - For instance, the curse of the law (Deuteronomy 28:15-68) says that God would smite a person who did or did not do a certain thing.
 - God doesn't smite someone. The judgment and punishment someone receives is the result of that person's own actions or a plan of the devil. It's the same principle as seedtime and harvest (Galatians 6:7-8).
- IV. Everyone's sins have been purged; but each one of us has to receive the forgiveness.
- Here's the process: Jesus purged your sins by dying and rising again. You repented of the sins and accepted the purging. You are a new creature in Christ Jesus.
 - Individually, each person has to agree to receive the purging of sin.
 - The devil attacks people with condemnation and shame about all kinds of sin.
 - Divorce is a sin, but it's not an unpardonable sin. God will forgive you for being in a divorce situation, whether the blame should be on you or someone else.
 - Abortion is a sin, but you can be forgiven. Let God cleanse you of the guilt and condemnation.
 - We would be condemned for every sin...except...Jesus took our punishment. *He* was crucified, *He* was buried, *He* went to the belly of the earth and was tormented for every sin any man or woman ever committed, so we wouldn't have to be.
 - Get condemnation out of your mind. In the eyes of God, you are forgiven as if you had never sinned! Praise God!
