DAY 1 – SPIRITUAL LAWS WORK FOR THOSE WHO PUT THEM TO WORK

Mylon Le Fevre and Kenneth Copeland met in Florida when Mylon was very ill and seeking healing. This is a basic truth: Continue in God's WORD, and you will know the truth and the truth will make you free. The first fundamental in the Christian life is to live by faith. After you believe God in your heart, then it's time to speak. You start believing when you pray—not when you see it come into your life. Continue to remind yourself of these basics of Christianity.

STUDY IT

- I. Mylon and Kenneth met in Florida when Mylon was very ill. He had just had a heart attack and was seeking for God to heal him.
 - Mylon was fasting, just drinking water, praying, walking the beach and seeking God for healing.
 - Gloria and her mother saw Mylon walking on the beach, and the Lord revealed to them that he needed healing.
 - Gloria told Kenneth, and the next day Kenneth did something that changed Mylon's life.
 - Many people had prayed for Mylon to be healed, but Kenneth didn't ask God to heal him. Kenneth took authority over Mylon's physical heart, and commanded his heart to be healed.
 - Mylon realized Kenneth knew something about authority, and Mylon wanted to know about faith.
 - Mylon claimed Kenneth as his spiritual father, moved to Texas, and sat under Kenneth's ministry to be trained in the things of God.
 - Kenneth performed the marriage ceremony for Mylon and Christi, and set her apart for ministry.
- II. This is a basic truth: Continue in God's WORD, and you will know the truth and the truth will make you free (John 8:31-32).
 - There are basic fundamentals of faith, and you've got to work with them to be successful.
 - If things are not working for you, go back and review the fundamentals.





- The fundamentals of authority are based in faith. You need to know how these things work.
- When you watch professional sports, you are watching masters of the fundamentals. The rules of the game are the same, but the players have developed their determination to keep going and not quit.
- That's how we must be as Christians. We must not fold under the pressures of the devil.

III. The first fundamental in the Christian life is to live by faith.

- God is the Source of faith.
- Jesus didn't say, "Ask for faith." He said, "Have faith in God."
 - Another translation reads, "Have the faith of God." (Mark 11:22, *Douay-Rheims 1899 American Edition*).
 - We were born again by faith (Ephesians 2:8).
 - Every man has a measure of faith (Romans 12:3).
 - Faith comes by hearing (Romans 10:17), not by trials and troubles.
 - As we continue in faith, it will grow (2 Thessalonians 1:3).
- Everyone who is born again receives the measure of faith, just like Peter. We have "like precious faith" (2 Peter 1:1).
- "Whosoever" (Mark 11:23-24). That means anyone who puts faith to work. That man will have what he says.
- Believe it in your heart and say—do not doubt.
- God used faith in Creation.
 - The Father said, "Light be;" light was. God created by faith (Genesis 1:3).
 - Jesus said, "It's the Father who dwells in Me who does the work" (John 14:10).
 - The Spirit was over the face of the deep (Genesis 1:2), and when God spoke, the Spirit worked.
- The Spirit lives within us waiting for words to work with.

IV. You start believing when you pray—not when you see it come into your life.

- "Therefore I say, what you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you shall have them" (Mark 11:24).
- Thomas made up his mind what he was going to do. He said, "**I will not believe** until I put my finger in those holes." Jesus said, "Thomas, don't be faithless" (John 20:25-27).
 - The faithful believe when they start praying. Even though they have not seen it in the natural, they do see it already done in the spirit.
- Jesus has given us a way to have our desires met. Believe you receive, and you will have. Jesus did all the hard work. He did everything for you.
- The only thing Jesus can't do is pray your prayer for you.



- Don't let your past hold you back from receiving from God. Your past is not who you are now; you're a new creature (2 Corinthians 5:17).
- V. Continue to remind yourself of these basics of Christianity.
 - The beginning of wisdom is reverence to God (Proverbs 9:10, *TLB*).
 - The people who are not believers try to figure things out intellectually.
 - Determine to believe that whatever God says is the truth. There's not one lie in His WORD.
 - When God speaks, the facts can change, but the truth remains.
 - We do not alter God's WORD to fit our lifestyles; we alter our lifestyles to fit God's WORD.
 - There's judgment that's good for us and contains mercy; and there's judgment that brings undesirable consequences.
 - Say what Kenneth says, "LORD, judge me in this. I'm looking for correction."
 - The process of correction is a lifetime process, because our destiny is to be changed into the image of God (Proverbs 19:20).
 - The teachable heart is key to growing up in faith.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

DAY 2 – SPIRITUAL LAWS PUT THE LAWS OF MATTER IN MOTION

God is in love with you, and He wants to prove it to you. The basic fundamentals of faith are spiritual laws, and they never change. Get your mind renewed to trust God. Our service to God is crucial, because we are living and working in the last days.

STUDY IT

- I. God is in love with you, and He wants to prove it to you. He wants to do magnificent things for you.
 - Jesus prayed that your life—your house, marriage and children—should be like things are in heaven (Matthew 6:10).
 - Continue in God's WORD and you will be a follower of Jesus who acts and reacts like Jesus. Hear His voice, and you'll understand the truth, live by faith and be free (John 8:31-32).
 - Paul told Timothy to follow him as he followed Christ (1 Corinthians 11:1; 2 Timothy 1:13). That's what Mylon has done; he has followed Brother and listened, watched and learned how to minister the life of Jesus to others.
- II. The basic fundamentals of faith are spiritual laws.
 - God is a Spirit. He put all laws, spiritual and natural, into motion. He created the laws of matter and the way things work.
 - When we were born again, we were put into the kingdom of God—the love kingdom (Colossians 1:13).
 - The currency of the kingdom of God is faith. You'll never function successfully without faith.
 - God is a faith God; He moves by faith. It pleases Him when His children step out in faith without seeing. You can't please God without faith (Hebrews 11:6).
- III. The fundamentals never change. They work on the positive and negative sides.
 - Your words are your faith speaking (Mark 11:23-24). Your words reflect what you believe.
 - To receive what you desire, when you pray, start believing. Don't wait until after you see something to believe.





- You cannot receive Abraham's BLESSING (Deuteronomy 28:1-14) with Thomas' faith (John 20:25).
 - Abraham called those things he didn't see as if he did see (Romans 4:17).
- Mary said, "I don't understand, but be it done to me as you have said" (Luke 1:38).
- "If you abide in Me and My words abide in you, ask what you will and it will be done for you" (John 15:7).
 - Count how many times the word *you* is used. The emphasis is on *you*.
- Your believing and speaking are not up to God. He's already answered your prayer. The Bible has all the answers. Find the Bible promise and start with that.

IV. Get your mind renewed to trust God.

- We walk through the shadow of death, not death itself (Psalm 23:4).
- The devil does not have power or any business in your life unless you give him strength. When you live in fear, he'll continue to try to attack you.
- Jesus, the Lord General of the Church, has totally defeated the devil.
 - Say to The LORD, "I'm Yours to command."
- If you don't believe God is honest, you'll keep thinking the old way and leaning on your own understanding (Proverbs 3:5). God is not asking you to think about this or vote on it.
- God doesn't have problems with the devil. He wants to teach you how to depend on the powerful God who raised Jesus from the dead. Let God change your mind.
- Every word in the Bible is backed in blood.
 - God was standing in blood when He promised Abraham, "So shall your seed be" (Genesis 15:5). Think about the covenant God cut with Abraham (Genesis 15:9-18). If the blood of animals was powerful, how much more powerful is the blood of Jesus?
 - Jesus said, "Seek first the kingdom of God. All these things will be added" (Matthew 6:33). That's backed in His own blood, the blood of the Lamb.
 - By His stripes we were healed (1 Peter 2:24). That's a Bible fact backed by Jesus' blood.

V. The first fundamental of faith is to believe in your heart and say it with your mouth (Mark 11:23-24).

- Next, when you are praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive (Mark 11:25). God will give you the grace to do it, but you have to make the decision to forgive. God will help you.
- It is a command. We are soldiers in the army of The LORD (2 Timothy 2:3). God told you to forgive, so you must forgive.





- If you have held unforgiveness for some time, your flesh is in the habit of being angry. Take authority over the problem, and you can change that habit of unforgiveness to forgiveness.
- VI. You are spirit, soul and body (1 Thessalonians 5:23).
- Your spirit is the you that got born again. Your soul is inside your spirit, and you live in a body. You can live without your body, but your body can't live without you.
 - The rich man who went to hell still had his memories and ability to think (Luke 16:25). His memory wasn't in his brain—that part was dead and buried.
 - You, that is your spirit, was born again. But you have to renew your soul—mind, will and emotions (Romans 12:2).
 - Your body was not born again. It must be crucified or subjected to the will of God (Galatians 5:24).
 - For several years, Kenneth called his body a living sacrifice (Romans 12:1). That helped him renew his mind to the correct authority of his body.
 - The LORD asked Kenneth if he would agree to live 120 years (Genesis 6:3). He agreed.
 - Kenneth had already renewed his mind to the fact that his body is his sacrifice to The LORD.
 - Jesus told him, *I sacrificed My body for you, and you are sacrificing your body for Me.*
- VII. Our service to God is crucial, because we are living and working in the last days.
- The time you spend reading and meditating on God's WORD, building your faith, renewing your mind and forgiving others, is building up your soul and body to do the job God has called you to do.
 - We are the last of the "glorified ones." Life will go on, but the devil and his demons will be gone. The ones who come after this age will ask us what it was like to live the Christian life and fight the enemy.
 - Stay in The WORD of God every day, and it will keep you on the road to freedom where Jesus is LORD.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Make this declaration with Brother Kenneth:

My mind is my mind. I tell it what to think, and I tell it what to do. My body is my body. It doesn't tell me what to do. I tell it what to do, and Jesus tells me what to do. I am not mind, body and spirit. I am spirit, soul and body according to 1 Thessalonians 5:23.

DAY 3 – FIND YOUR VICTORY IN THE BASICS OF FAITH

Make it your lifestyle to continually read, believe and speak God's WORD, and the truth will make you free. Get saved, fight victoriously, and walk the Christian life by grace and faith. A woman received her healing using the fundamentals of faith: Believe, speak and act. We can find victory in the fundamentals of faith. Pray in unity with what God says, and nothing can stop your prayers from being answered.

STUDY IT

- I. Make it your lifestyle to continually read, believe and speak God's WORD, and the truth will make you free (John 8:31-32).
 - Your words have power when they agree with God's WORD.
 - You hear, "Tell it like it is." No! If we want change, we must watch what we say. We speak the things that are not as though they were (Romans 4:17).
 - What you say is your faith talking. Talk on purpose. Speak words of faith, and you will see change.
 - Fear-filled words empower the destroyer.
 - Faith-filled words dominate the law of sin and death.
- II. Get saved, fight victoriously, and walk the Christian life by grace and faith.
 - You don't want to try to live without grace.
 - "Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure" (Romans 4:16).
 - God cannot do anything for you apart from faith.
 - The devil cannot do anything to you apart from fear.
 - Trust God's WORD more than your feelings. You can't get heat from a wood-burning stove unless you first put in wood. Believe first, then your feelings will follow.
- III. A woman received her healing using the fundamentals of faith: Believe, speak and act (Mark 5:27-34).
 - Jesus knew power had gone out of Him, and He wanted to know who had touched Him.





- The woman told Him all the truth about her situation and her healing.
- Jesus said, "Your faith has made you whole."
- It was Jesus' power that healed her, but her faith activated it.
- She fully intended to touch Jesus, get her healing and get away.
- She had some great excuses to not go and get her miracle.
 - She was a shut-in, because it was against the law for her to go in public with her disease.
 - You can find excuses, too. Your mind can talk you out of your miracle.
- She believed she would be healed, and she kept saying what she believed. She was building faith.
- She said it, and she kept saying it. She acted on it. Then she told what had happened.
- We know she forgave the doctors and everyone else, because faith will not work in an unforgiving heart.
- Jesus said, "Your faith has made you whole."
 - Wholeness meant she got her healing and her wealth back.
 - After spending all her money for 12 years on doctors, she got it all back.
 - She received total restoration.

IV. We can find victory in the fundamentals of faith.

- First fundamental of faith: Believe in your heart and say it with your mouth.
- Second fundamental of faith: Corresponding action.
 - Radical Christians *act* on God's WORD (Hebrews 11:6).
 - Without action, what you believe doesn't have any power and won't do you any good.
 - Believe it, say it and act on it.
- Don't quit! No matter what, continue to believe and speak what God says.
- Honor The LORD, and He will give you the desires of your heart (Psalm 37:4).
- Don't be ashamed of the gospel, for it's the power of God (Romans 1:16). Talk about what God has done for you.
- You have to forgive, and you can do it. Forgive as an act of your will, instead of as an emotional response to anger, hurt and pain.
 - Begin praying for those whom you have forgiven. God will put a love in your heart for them.

V. Pray in unity with what God says, and nothing can stop your prayers from being answered.

- Receive the Holy Spirit and your prayer language.
- Pray in your native language and pray in the spirit.



- God will give you the Holy Spirit if you ask Him (Luke 11:13). He'll give you the fullness of the Holy Spirit, including the ability to speak in tongues (Acts 2:1-4). He will not fail.
 - It takes faith to receive. Open your mouth and begin to speak.
 - If you ask God, He will also give you the interpretation (1 Corinthians 14:13).
- It's easy to jump out and do what you've never done before if you know God's in it.
- Don't be afraid to obey God because you might make a mistake. God will fix mistakes.
- In the middle of trouble and pain, start praising God...and laugh! Laugh because God is taking care of you.
 - The mind and body cannot distinguish between real and fake laughter; so laugh! Your body will respond.
- Laugh by faith, have restful sleep by faith (Psalm 127:2), and live by faith!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

The basics of faith start with believing and speaking, followed by corresponding action.

Your words reflect what you believe, so listen to yourself with an ear to hear faith.

List a few phrases of what you say from your heart to reflect your belief in God's power in your life.

DAY 4 – FAITH-FILLED WORDS MAKE YOU A FAITH CHAMPION

Faith-filled words make you a faith champion and cause you to dominate the law of sin and death. Think about what God says in His WORD. The devil is a liar; don't agree with him. Cast all your care over onto The LORD, once and for all.

STUDY IT

- I. Faith-filled words make you a faith champion.
 - You will know the truth, and when you act on that truth, you will be really free (John 8:32). That's the will of God.
 - God wants to raise the quality of your life. God wants to do wonderful stuff in your life, and the people around you will want what you have.
 - People will see what God does at your house, and they'll know it was God because you couldn't have done it.
 - This is the victory—our faith (1 John 5:4).
- II. Faith-filled words dominate the law of sin and death (Romans 8:2).
 - Your faith will grow as you take time to study and look up scriptures that pertain to your situation: healing, prosperity, family relationships.
 - Use the scriptures in your prayer. Pray the answer, not your problem.
 - Believe it in your heart, say it with your mouth, and you will have it.
 - Forgive, because faith doesn't work in an unforgiving heart. Pray and allow God to put love in your heart for those you have forgiven.
- III. Think about (meditate on) what God says in His WORD.
 - Heaven says you're debt free. Don't let go of God's promises. Focus on praising God.
 - Totally immerse yourself in the Scriptures and words of faith, until the doubt, unbelief and unforgiveness are washed out of you by the washing of the water of The WORD (Ephesians 5:26). You will be a champion!
 - Get in agreement with God.
 - Serve the holy One who loves you and is not trying to take anything from you.





- God asks you to tithe to see if He can trust you with something that belongs to Him.
 - God is not greedy. He spends your tithe on your spiritual development.
- IV. The devil is a liar. He says that God is not honest. Don't agree with the devil.
- The devil wants to steal The WORD; he's a thief (Mark 4:15).
 - Hang onto God's WORD. Don't let the devil steal it, because if he does, he has your life, your family and your money.
 - The devil has no future. He will continue to try to defeat God Almighty and defeat God's WORD in you. Remind him that he *must* flee (1 Peter 5:9; James 4:7).
 - Let the Scripture fight its own fight. The WORD of God is a sword, so let it work against the enemy (Hebrews 4:12).
 - To hurt the devil, don't do anything he says.
 - He is fear personified. He's afraid of every born-again believer.
 - You have the power to defeat the devil's whole operation if you stay in The WORD of God and love His people. Walk in love and forgiveness.
- V. Cast all of your care over onto The LORD, once and for all (1 Peter 5:7).
- Say, "LORD, do I have any care today? I roll it over onto You. You are my Care Taker. I refuse to walk in care."
 - Train your flesh to The WORD of God (Hebrews 5:12).
 - Obedience in the little stuff determines whether you get in on the big stuff.
 - If you don't love, you cannot succeed. You are blocking God from helping you.
 - Let love be strong in your life (1 Corinthians 13).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

You have been given authority over the enemy, so use it. Speak with authority in the Name of Jesus, and command the devil to leave. Then, cast all worry and care onto The LORD, and don't pick it back up!

It takes commitment and practice, but expect results! Praise God for what He has provided and take it as yours!

DAY 5 – FAITH OBEYS SPIRITUAL LAWS

Jesus died to give us freedom from sin, sickness and poverty. If you get distracted from God's WORD, go back to the fundamentals. Cast all your care onto The LORD—that's humility and it takes faith. Being humble is easy when you realize how much God loves you and how much you need His help every day.

STUDY IT

- I. Jesus died to give us freedom from sin, sickness and poverty.
 - The suffering of the born-again believer is to resist everything that doesn't agree with what Jesus died to give us.
 - Kenneth believes this so strongly that when he was attacked with sickness, he refused to cancel a meeting. He preached even though he was sick, and healing came. He refused to quit because of an attack of the enemy.
 - Mylon continued to preach even though he was having severe chest pains.
 - The Anointing on God's WORD destroyed the yoke on him and released him from the burden of pain.
 - After the service, Mylon went to the doctor and got things fixed.
 - When you leave your body in death, you simply step over into heaven. You will see Jesus as He is, and you'll be just like Him.
- II. If you get distracted from God's WORD, go back to the fundamentals.
 - The WORD will work if you work it—if you obey it.
 - Everything God has for you is free. He's teaching you how to get it.
 - Living by faith for healing and prosperity is for now. You won't need to be healed or have your bills paid in heaven.
 - God has given you the sword of the Spirit, and you can defeat the attacks of the enemy!
 - Look at your commitment level. If you give 10% of your time to The WORD, you'll have 10% success. If you give 100% of your time to God's WORD, total immersion, you'll have 30-60-100% success!



- III. In 1979, Mylon heard Kenneth preach a series called "War on Debt" at a Believers' Convention in Florida.
- Mylon didn't know it was possible to get out of debt.
 - He totally immersed himself in The WORD by going to meetings in the morning, afternoon and evening.
 - He absorbed what Kenneth preached, took Communion, and dedicated to pay off all his debt.
 - God gave him a plan. He tithed first, put a certain amount in a savings account, and lived on what was left.
 - The banker said it would take five years and 10 months to get out of debt. After 19 months Mylon was out of debt! He determined to stay out of debt forever.
 - Your dedication and obedience to God creates a supernatural atmosphere.
 - In that atmosphere of faith, what was impossible becomes possible.
 - Faith makes a way.
- IV. Cast all your care onto The LORD (1 Peter 5:7). That's humility. That takes faith.
- "Be clothed with humility. Humble yourself under the mighty hand of God" (1 Peter 5:5-6). Humility is not self-debasement.
 - The *Amplified Bible* phrases it this way, "Set aside self-righteous pride" (1 Peter 5:6).
 - If God says you can do it, you can do it.
 - Believe you receive when you pray.
 - Say, "I believe that this care and anxiety are lifted off of me. It is my desire to be worry-free, free from debt and pain. Jesus said it, so I know I can do it."
 - You're going to have to meditate, study and listen to what God says. Continue to think about God's answers in His WORD, and you'll have it.
 - Roll your care onto The LORD.
 - Kenneth had a \$6 million deficit on the ministry's TV bill. He had to cast the care onto The LORD.
 - Pull down the stronghold of carrying the care (2 Corinthians 10:4). The habit of worry and carrying the care needs to be destroyed. God's WORD in your heart and mouth will do it.
- V. Being humble is easy when you realize how much God loves you, and how much you need His help every day.
- God is good, He loves you, and that's why your future is amazing.
 - You need people you respect who can tell you no. Give them a place of authority in your life.
 - When God tells you something, His only agenda is to fix what's wrong in your life.



- If you give God something, He will either fix it and give it back to you, or He will give you something better.
