DAY 1 – FAITH WORKS WHEN YOU ARE GOD-INSIDE MINDED

Faith works when you believe God's WORD. It's our choice to be God-inside minded. God desires and has provided for all of His children to be rich. It's available by faith. We should be blessed and operating in the good things of God all the time, giving God the praise and enjoying life to the fullest.

STUDY IT

- I. Faith works when you believe God's WORD.
 - Jesus gave us the method of using faith in Mark 11:22-24.
 - "Have faith in God," or "Have the God kind of faith."
 - Faith is the way we access God's promises—not by our works. Faith is the gift of God to us (Ephesians 2:9).
 - With faith, God created the heavens and the earth—mountain-moving, planet-creating faith.

- II. It's our choice to be God-inside minded.
 - Man does not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God (Matthew 4:4).
 - God provides food for your spirit, food for your mind and food for your body.
 - It's your choice to have faith in God.
 - Questions: What about my children? What about the economy?
 - Answer: Have faith in God.
 - Faith doesn't work in an unforgiving, judgmental or unwilling heart.
 - Every born-again child of God, everyone that's accepted Jesus Christ as LORD and Savior, has this faith born into their inner man.
 - We all start out with exactly the same measure of faith (Romans 12:3).
 - If people say faith doesn't work for them, it won't. Their own words stop faith from working.
 - Legally, you do have faith, but it's going to work according to what you say and think, and according to how you act on it.



- III. God desires and has provided for all His children to be rich (Deuteronomy 15:4). It's available by faith.
- God is not opposed to His children being rich; but He is opposed to them being covetous.
 - When you follow heaven's economy and the rules of prosperity that govern increase, you *will* prosper—mentally, spiritually, physically, socially and financially.
 - Finances are the lowest form of power. The highest form of power is prayer.
 - You can personally prosper right in the middle of the worst times financially.
 - The man, woman and family that live and walk by faith never have to change their lifestyles because of the times.
 - We live and walk by heaven's economy. All our needs are met abundantly so that we have enough to help other people, and can do whatever The LORD Jesus commands us to do.
 - We're soldiers in the army of The LORD (2 Timothy 2:3). Soldiers don't have to pay for their own equipment or supplies.
- IV. We should be blessed and operating in the good things of God all the time, giving God the praise and enjoying life to the fullest.
- The way the faith of God works is, "What things soever you desire, believe."
 - This is *the only* way to receive all your desires met. Believe that those words you say will happen.
 - It only works for those who believe they receive when they pray.
 - You need to have bulldog faith. Like a bulldog, don't let go, and refuse to quit!
 - Satan has been defeated.
 - If you know Jesus as your LORD and Savior, you've done all the dying you're ever going to do.
 - Be ready for your own homegoing. But don't go before you are finished with this life.
 - Prepare yourself and your family, so they won't allow grief to come into their hearts.
 - Brother Copeland tells of a pastor who took medical tests, but he didn't go back to hear the results.
 - He stood on The WORD of God for his healing.
 - He kept getting better, and over a period of time, he was well.
 - The care and worry about your health will kill you. Cast your care onto The LORD (1 Peter 5:6-7), because Jesus is the Healer.





- Dr. Avery Jackson, a leading neurosurgeon, has laughing classes for cancer patients.
 - The patients begin with saying, “Ha, ha, ha”—a fake laugh. It doesn’t seem like anything is funny, but they laugh anyway.
 - Soon, the comedy of the situation becomes funny, and they find themselves actually laughing.
 - This is helpful to their medical conditions, because God said, “A merry heart doeth good like a medicine” (Proverbs 17:22).

DAY 2 – WORDS OF FAITH COME FROM THE POWER OF GOD INSIDE YOU

There are some basics about spirit, soul and body that need to be understood. Harvest comes after you plant the seed, so plant words of faith. Faith-filled words dominate the laws of death.

STUDY IT

- I. There are some basics about spirit, soul and body that need to be understood.
 - Words of faith are a very fundamental component of the Christian life.
 - Faith is a powerful spiritual force that is not necessarily felt.
 - “Whatever thing you desire, believe when you pray....” When you pray is when you exercise faith (Mark 11:24).
 - When you pray, forgive (Mark 11:25).
 - Make it a practice to forgive, even if you think you don’t have unforgiveness.
 - As you forgive, The LORD will bring up other things you may have forgotten, or they have seemed unimportant, and you can forgive those things too.
 - There’s power in speaking faith with a loud voice.
 - Jesus spoke with a loud voice, “Lazarus, come forth” (John 11:43).
 - Shout your faith confession based on Scripture: “Greater is He that’s in me than he that’s in the world” (1 John 4:4)! That’s called stirring yourself up.
 - God works with words.
 - People get healed, saved and baptized with the Holy Spirit by hearing words—if they act on the words they hear.

- II. Harvest comes after you plant the seed, so plant words of faith.
 - Notice the order: It is seedtime and harvest (Genesis 8:22). It’s not harvest, then plant the seed.
 - Years ago, Brother Copeland had symptoms of the flu, so he took a flu shot out of Deuteronomy 28 and Galatians 3:13.
 - His body was shaking with chills, but he said, “I will not accept this. I am a forgiver; I walk in love and I keep the commandments of God. You don’t have a legal right to put this on me, satan, and I’m not taking it.”



- The symptoms were gone in 15 to 20 minutes.
- Some may say, "But that doesn't work for me." It's true, without faith it won't work for you, because you said it won't work.

III. Faith-filled words dominate the laws of death.

- Death-filled words and fear-filled words will dominate your life if you don't put them down with faith-filled words.
- You can't change the laws, but you can change the words. Speak words of faith, words of God. Don't allow things to come out your mouth you don't want to happen.
- Parents, be cautious about what you say to your children. Don't use words of the curse (fool, dummy, idiot) or death. They are not going to hell because they made a mistake.
 - The only sin that will send anybody to hell is not accepting Jesus Christ as LORD of his or her life.
- Jesus is Anointed to be the High Priest of His words spoken from our mouths.
 - Jesus is responsible for taking our words of faith and bringing them to pass, because we're standing on His WORD and doing things His way (Mark 11:23-25)!
- We're not living this life alone. Jesus is with us.

DAY 3 – RENEWING THE MIND TO BECOME GOD-INSIDE MINDED

The WORD of the living God is the source of our faith. God wants you to renew your mind to become God-inside minded and to know His Spirit of power. You can be filled with all the fullness of God—be God-inside minded to the full.

STUDY IT

- I. The WORD of the living God is the source of our faith.
 - Jesus said, “You shall receive power” (Acts 1:8).
 - John the Baptist spoke of Jesus saying, “He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire” (Luke 3:16).
 - Jesus will give you the Holy Ghost and His glory.
 - Holy Ghost power was moving on the face of the deep when God said, “Light be!” (Genesis 1:1-3).
 - Another translation says, “‘Let light be;’ and light is” (Genesis 1:3, *YLT*).
- II. God wants you to renew your mind to become God-inside minded.
 - Brother Kenneth with the help of the Holy Spirit and a whole lot of grace, wants to introduce you to the Holy Spirit of power.
 - We need to develop a God-inside-me-now consciousness—renewing our minds to become God-inside minded.
 - God is really IN you, by His Spirit!
 - God created the heavens and the earth.
 - At the end of the first 24 hours of Creation, there were over 16 billion miles of universe.
 - That Creator is the God who has planned your life.
 - Jesus said, “And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you” (John 14:16-17).
 - He shall be in you forever This was new information for the disciples!



- III. It is the Father who does the greater works (John 14:10).
- “Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father” (John 14:12).
 - Paul describes the greater works through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.
 - “For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our LORD Jesus Christ, of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, that he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; that Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; and to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God. Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen” (Ephesians 3:14-21).
- IV. You can be filled with all the fullness of God—be God-inside minded to the full.
- Faith works by love (Galatians 5:6), but if you’re not rooted and grounded in love, then Christ may be dwelling in your heart, but your faith isn’t working.
 - The Father said, “I’m going to send Him (the Comforter/the Holy Spirit), and He’s going to come, and dwell in you in fullness.”
 - “To him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think.” This is the greater work.
 - There are signs and wonders and miracles coming that this planet hasn’t seen in fullness before. Jesus started it, and we’re at the finish.
 - We will see greater miracles than we can ask or even think. God is in us—He is walking and operating in us. We need to stop limiting the God of glory.
 - The apostle Paul said, “Amen,” so be it (Ephesians 3:21).
 - We agree with Jesus and Paul, and we say: “So be it!”

DAY 4 – HOW TO USE THE POWER OF GOD INSIDE YOU

The powerful God dwells on the inside of you and me. People are raised in this world as outside-in people. Their source is something outside of themselves. Your body and your spirit are one, and your soul (mind, will and emotions) are part of your spirit; and God lives inside you!

STUDY IT

- I. The powerful God dwells on the inside of you and me.
 - Your God keeps the earth in balance.
 - He took one drop of water and weighed the oceans on this planet. He weighed the mountains with one speck of dust (Isaiah 40:12).
 - He knew exactly what the Pacific and Atlantic Oceans would weigh, and how to balance the earth taking into account the fluctuation of high waves and tides that occur daily.
 - Never has the earth gotten out of balance. Gravity is still working.
 - God did all of that with a piece of dust and a drop of water.
 - This same God, before the foundation of the world, knew you by your name.
 - This powerful God can certainly handle your needs. He has a plan already in place to BLESS you.

- II. People are raised in this world as outside-in people. Their source is something outside of themselves.
 - As Christians, we should be different. We should be inside-out people, knowing our Source, God, is inside us to lead and guide us.
 - We have an advantage—a supernatural way to communicate with God.
 - When we speak in tongues, we communicate with the Almighty God.
 - Paul said that without love our language and faith are worthless (1 Corinthians 13:1-2).
 - But, we *have* love, so we can speak in tongues and move mountains.
 - With this understanding, now you know what Jesus was referring to when He said, “The kingdom of God is within you” (Luke 17:21).
 - We are no longer outside-in people. We are inside-out people.



- God dwells and walks in us. God said we are to be separate from the world (2 Corinthians 6:16-17).

III. Your body and your spirit are one; your soul (mind, will and emotions) are part of your spirit; and God lives inside you.

- The whole kingdom of God is in you. Take the limits off your faith!
- Paul and Silas were in stocks, having been horribly beaten, but they were praising and singing to God (Acts 16:23-26).
 - There was an earthquake. Their handcuffs fell off, and the doors of the prison opened for them by their own accord.
 - That earthquake power came out of Paul and Silas' spirits. They were the ones doing the praising. The Spirit of God was in them!
- The curse that hit this planet came out of Adam (Genesis 3:17). The devil didn't have the power to curse a whole planet.
 - But when the devil got into a man, the authority that man had could curse the whole planet (Genesis 1:28).
- If you have been baptized in the Holy Spirit, you not only have God within you; you now have a supernatural way of communicating with Him that the devil absolutely cannot understand. That is outstanding!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Get in the habit of consulting God who is inside you before you make any decision, no matter how large or how small. Ask God, and He will answer you!

Make a list of your questions and His answers. As you remember how God helped you; it will encourage you in your journey.

DAY 5 – PRAYING IN THE SPIRIT BRINGS POWER FROM THE INSIDE OUT

God anointed Jesus with the Holy Ghost and power to develop a God-inside consciousness. Pray and worship in your supernatural prayer language. God created the heavens and the earth; then He gave it all to men. Jesus is God's gift to the world.

STUDY IT

- I. God anointed Jesus with the Holy Ghost and power to develop a God-inside consciousness (Acts 10:38).
 - God wants to speak to you.
 - Jesus is speaking every moment of every day about every thought, every word, everything that's going on around you—from the smallest to the biggest things. Listen to Him!
 - Every question that you asked God yesterday, He was already telling you the answer. He will show you things to come (John 16:13).
 - Everything the Father has, everything the Father knows, everything the Father wills, everything the Father does, it all belongs to Jesus (John 16:13-15).
 - That means we can find out the answer to anything if we just stay hooked up to Him long enough, particularly if we'll use our supernatural language.
 - Yield yourself to God, so He can tell you what to ask.

- II. Pray and worship in your supernatural prayer language.
 - Make this declaration: "I can refresh myself and build myself up on my most holy faith by praying in the Holy Ghost" (Jude 20).
 - Prophecy through Brother Kenneth: God will lead and guide you. Be praying in your supernatural language and praising and worshipping in your supernatural language. He will bring you rest and strengthen your mind. You will need to trust Him. The Holy Spirit will help you in times of trouble. You'll know things and understand things that you didn't know you knew.

- III. God created the heavens and the earth; then He gave it all to men.
 - Whatever you bind on earth is bound in heaven (Matthew 16:19).





- “Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost?” (1 Corinthians 6:19).
- The evidence that He is in you is not how you feel or don’t feel (Deuteronomy 31:6-8; John 14:16).
 - He will never leave you, forsake you nor fail you (Hebrews 13:5). Greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world (1 John 4:4); and He’s there in you forever!
- Whatever problem you run into next week, He already has it fixed. Whatever trouble your family gets into, He’s already got it fixed.
- Pray in the spirit until you get the answers.
- Brother Kenneth’s mother would say, “Hit it in tongues!”
- Acknowledge that God is in you. He loves you, and He’s more interested in your being delivered and healed than you are.

IV. Jesus is God’s gift to the world.

- If you’ve not been born again, say, “Jesus, take my life and do something with it. Come into my heart. I receive You as my LORD and Savior.”
- That’s it! You are born again into the family of God!
- Go ahead and receive your supernatural prayer language. It’s the easiest thing you have ever done in your life.
- Pray this prayer with us: “Now that I am born again, I’m asking You, Jesus, to fill me to overflowing with Your Holy Spirit.”
 - Jesus said, “If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?” (Luke 11:13).
 - “Well, I’m asking and I’m receiving. Now, I fully plan to speak with my new prayer language. Thank You, Holy Spirit, for giving me the utterance.”
- Confession: “I’ll make the noise. Holy Spirit, You make the words.”
