DAY 1 – GET OUT OF YOUR OWN MIND TO LIVE FROM THE INSIDE OUT

Faith works when you are God-inside minded. Jesus was continually aware that God, His Father, was inside Him. Watch out for critical and judgmental words. We have been given the mind of Christ—the mind of the Anointed One.

STUDY IT

- I. Faith works when you are God-inside minded.
 - To grow in faith, you must develop a God-inside consciousness.
 - The gateway to the supernatural and God's power is opened by praying in other tongues.
 - Practice praying, speaking and praising in your heavenly language.
- II. Jesus was continually aware that God, His Father, was inside Him.
 - Jesus was Anointed to do the works of God.
 - "The Spirit of The LORD God is upon me; because The LORD hath anointed me to preach" (Isaiah 61:1).
 - "How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him" (Acts 10:38).
 - The *good* that Jesus went about doing was teaching, preaching and healing (Matthew 9:35).
 - Everywhere Jesus went, He preached that He was Anointed (Luke 4:18), and then He preached His message for the day.
 - Simon, who previously had deceived people with sorcery, saw the apostles lay hands on people, and they received the Holy Spirit. They spoke in tongues (Acts 8:9-22).
 - Simon thought that the gift of God could be purchased with money.
 - He heard them speak in tongues, and he wanted to buy the gift of the laying on of hands.
 - God's gift cannot be bought.



- III. Watch out for critical and judgmental words.
- Remember: "When you have done it to the least of my brethren, you have done it unto me" (Matthew 25:40).
 - Don't gossip or judge. You're persecuting Jesus.
 - It could be a habit of criticism that needs to be broken. "If I'd been him, I wouldn't have done that." That's critical and judgmental.
 - Be cautious about talking back to the news and politicians.
 - We are commanded to pray for all men, kings and all that are in authority (1 Timothy 2:1).
 - Whether you like the governmental leaders or not, you are obligated to pray for them.
 - You don't have any right to hate any man. Pray for them in the spirit.
 - Brother Copeland prays: "I yield my spirit, soul, body; all the faculties of life to You, Father. I enter into Your rest, and I thank You. Whether I pray 15 minutes or an hour and a half, it matters not. I'm going to spend it worshipping You and praising You, praying for my president and the nation and for leaders of both parties."
- IV. We have been given the mind of Christ (1 Corinthians 2:16), the mind of the Anointed One.
- The power and the reason why praying in other tongues is so vitally important is that it allows you to step out of your mind into the supernatural.
 - You can step over into a place where you are literally out of your mind and with God where there's no time, distance or physical feelings.
 - Praying in the spirit is the first step into that timeless place.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Pray with us:

Heavenly Father, thank You for giving me the mind of Christ. I want to think and talk like You. Help me, please, to refrain from criticism and judgment of others. DAY 2 – PRAYING IN THE SPIRIT BRINGS ANSWERS FROM THE INSIDE OUT

Have you been filled with the Holy Spirit after you believed in Jesus? Stay in God's WORD and win every battle. Put your eyes on God's WORD of healing. Ask your Father for the Baptism in the Holy Spirit. It's yours, if you are born again.

STUDY IT

- I. Have you been filled with the Holy Spirit after you believed in Jesus?
 - Paul asked the new believers in Ephesians, "'Have you received the Holy Ghost since you believed?' They answered, 'We have not so much have heard whether there be any Holy Ghost'" (Acts 19:1-6).
 - They had been baptized in water.
 - Paul laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them, they spoke in tongues and prophesied.
 - Anyone who is born again has the Holy Spirit. They are *sealed* with the Holy Spirit.
 - The gifts of the Holy Spirit, or the manifestations of the Holy Spirit, are available to any believer (1 Corinthians 12-14).
 - People who have been born again but have not yet received being baptized in the Spirit, have the Holy Spirit, but they don't yet have the manifestations of the gifts of the Spirit.
 - Without the fruit of the spirit, you're not going to operate with the gifts of the Spirit.
 - The fruit comes first.
 - There are nine fruit of the spirit starting with love, joy and peace (Galatians 5:22-23).
 - If you're having physical weakness, check out your level of joy.
 - "Count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations," because you have access to the wisdom of God (James 1:2-5). You have victory!
- II. Stay in God's WORD and win every battle.
 - Brother Kenneth had flu symptoms long ago, and he was scheduled to preach that morning.



- When he got to the church pulpit, the room started spinning. He told the congregation "I'll be right back." He went into the choir room and shouted with a loud voice, "Take your hands off of my body, devil! This body belongs to Jesus and Gloria, not you!"
 - Brother Copeland came back into the meeting and preached on healing for two hours. The symptoms left. He got the victory in Christ Jesus!
 - The powerful WORD of God hurts the devil. Let The WORD fight its own fight.
 - Jesus defeated the devil in combat with words and power. "Having done all, stand" (Ephesians 6:13).
 - Never quit standing in faith.
- III. Put your eyes on God's WORD of healing.
- Dodie Osteen was diagnosed with stage 4 liver cancer. She and John Osteen called Kenneth and Gloria to agree that she was healed.
 - She took God's WORD and read healing scriptures every morning and every night out loud and continued her regular duties.
 - She said there were some days she felt like she was going to die, but she would not quit. She's still alive today!
 - The tab markers in Brother Kenneth's Bible mark healing scriptures that he got out of Sister Osteen's book.
 - This Bible is the victory book. Faith comes by hearing and hearing by The WORD of God (Romans 10:17). Faith is coming right now!
- IV. Ask your Father for the Baptism in the Holy Spirit. You can have it if you are born again.
- Jesus said, "If you then, being evil, (or being natural) know how to give good gifts unto your children; how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?" (Luke 11:13).
 - The Holy Spirit will guide you into all truth and show you things to come (John 16:13). By praying in the spirit, you can find out anything you need to know.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

The filling with the Holy Spirit is a gift from God, and it's available to you. Ask the Father to give you this gift, and He will, immediately!

The evidence that you are filled with the Spirit is a prayer language composed of words you haven't learned. Simply say, "I have received the Holy Spirit," and He will give you words of a new language to speak. You start speaking; God will provide the words!

DAY 3 – GOD'S PERFECT PLAN FOR YOU COMES FROM THE INSIDE OUT

God is the great Planner, and He's written His plan in two books. To access His plan, develop a God-inside-you-now consciousness.

STUDY IT

- I. God is the great Planner.
 - When God said, "Light be," Creation began (Genesis 1:3). In 24 hours, 16 billion miles of universe were created.
 - This is your God—the One who is planning your life.
 - God knew your name before the foundation of the world.
 - He's right there on the inside of you. He lives there, and He will abide with you forever.
- II. God writes His plan in two books.
 - One is the Lamb's Book of Life (Revelation 21:27). It contains the names of those who know Jesus as their LORD and Savior.
 - The other book is the Book of Destinies (Psalm 139:16). In that book, God has perfectly planned everyone's life and future.
 - God had a plan for Joseph. When Joseph was 17 and highly pampered by his father, God gave him dreams of his future.
 - His brothers were jealous because they had to do all the work with the sheep. Joseph went to check on them.
 - Even when Joseph was sold into slavery, and it seemed that God's plan for him was over before it began, the plan was still working.
- III. To access His plan, develop a God-inside-you-now consciousness.
 - Access your spirit and pray in tongues; that's when you pray out your destiny and your future.
 - The dust-weighting God is planning your life. Just seek Him, and praise Him for His plan.



MAKE IT PERSONAL

No matter your age, God's plan and purpose for you is still active. Seek Him for direction, and read His WORD for instruction.

Write down scriptures and thoughts about your destiny. Continue to stay hooked up to the Holy Spirit, and He will guide your life to fullness and satisfaction (Psalm 91:16).

DAY 4 – BRING THE LOVE OF GOD FROM THE INSIDE OUT

Faith in God is an inside-out action. The act of forgiveness is fulfilling the commandment of God. You don't have to be in fear or afraid to forgive someone. Make a decision to forgive and live in agape love.

STUDY IT

- I. Faith in God is an inside-out action.
 - When you believe that those things or words that you say shall come to pass, you shall (will) have whatever you say (Mark 11:22-23).
 - The word *will* is the strongest word of affirmation in our English language.
 - When you pray is when you start believing.
 - Believe you receive. *Receive* means “to take in order to carry it away; take it and walk away with it.”
 - The sower sows The WORD (Mark 4:14). The devil steals (The WORD), kills and destroys (John 10:10).
 - If he can't steal The WORD, he can't kill or destroy you.
 - His primary goal is to steal God's WORD. He's primarily a thief, as well as a killer and a destroyer.
- II. The act of forgiveness is fulfilling the commandment of God.
 - Loving God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength, and loving your neighbor as yourself, fulfills the Law.
 - Jesus said, “Love the brethren,” or one another, “even as I have loved you” (John 13:34). This is the way a believer lives.
 - Forgiveness is a command, not a suggestion.
 - There are those who are weak, sickly and die prematurely for not discerning Jesus' Body (the Church) correctly—for not forgiving someone (1 Corinthians 11:29-31).
- III. You don't have to be in fear or afraid to forgive someone.
 - There is no fear in love (1 John 4:18).
 - God's Love, perfect love, *agape* love is His gift to the whole world (John 3:16).



- To be perfect means to be developing in, walking in and speaking *agape* love.
- Practice walking in love. Think about and believe God's Love in your heart.
- You are born of love, born from above. Have the God kind of love.
- Perfected love casts out fear (1 John 4:18). It doesn't manage fear; love casts out fear!

IV. Make a decision to forgive and live in *agape* love.

- Jesus said to Peter, "Do you *agape* Me?" (John 21:15).
- *Agape* is an act of the will. It's not an act or feeling. *Agape* says, "I love you regardless of what you do."
- God is interested in your being free of fear, because fear, worry and unforgiveness have torment (1 John 4:18).
- An illustration of unforgiveness: You drink poison thinking it will kill the other person. It's killing you, not them.
- You have the mind of Christ, but if you don't forgive, you are not using it. All your tongue-talking is just a bunch of noise (1 Corinthians 13:1-3).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Be aware that God is within you, and He is willing to help and communicate with you at all times.

Pray this prayer of thanksgiving with us:

Heavenly Father, I am so glad You are in me, and with me at all times. Help me be aware of You and not depend on myself or circumstances. I love You, Father, and I know You love me. Thank You. In Jesus' Name. Amen.

DAY 5 – THE POWER OF FORGIVENESS AND LOVE

There is power in forgiveness and love. Desire the knowledge of God's will in all wisdom and understanding. The power of the gifts of the Spirit is hindered by unforgiveness. The door of the supernatural has been opened to us, and we need to keep it open with agape love.

STUDY IT

- I. There is power in forgiveness and love.
 - Stay *in the spirit*; it's a lovely place to be. Follow after love, and desire spiritual gifts.
 - If we have no love (*agape*), faith profits us nothing (1 Corinthians 13:1-3). Unforgiveness stops what we are trying to do, even though we have faith.
 - Several small unforgiving situations are more dangerous than one big event. The little ones don't seem to be as harmful, so we don't deal with them.
- II. Desire the knowledge of God's will in all wisdom and understanding.
 - Brother Copeland tells of a vision Roy Sprague had of an impending accident.
 - In the vision, Gloria was in the garage of their home using a paint spray gun. The water heater was also in the garage, and the garage door was shut.
 - In the vision, as Gloria used the paint spray gun, the water heater automatically came on. The gas to heat the water in the water heater ignited the fumes from the paint gun, and the garage exploded.
 - Immediately, Brother Kenneth called Gloria and told her what Brother Roy had seen in a vision.
 - Gloria said, "I was getting ready to go to the garage and paint, but I had a check in my spirit. I decided to wait until you got home."
 - Both Brother Sprague and Gloria heard God's warning in their spirits. They were walking in forgiveness and living the life of love. Consequently, the garage didn't explode, and Gloria was safe.
 - The knowledge of God's will in all wisdom and understanding are available to you (Colossians 1:9).



- III. The power of the gifts of the Spirit are hindered by unforgiveness.
- Brother Copeland had a vision of a pipe. Water was gushing into the top of the pipe, but the water coming out the other end was only a trickle.
 - The LORD told him the pipe was his spirit. The water was the power of God.
 - The pipe was clogged up with little grains of unrepented unforgiveness.
 - We must forgive even the little things—things we don't even think of anymore.
 - When you forgive, the power of love rises up and radiates throughout your life.
 - If someone said, "I killed somebody;" "I was a whoremonger;" "I was a prostitute," The Lord says, *I know it; I took care of it.*
 - The problem is not with Jesus. The problem can be with religious people not forgiving and choosing to judge others.
 - You and I are not judges. We're prosperity agents. We're the love-of-God arm of the Church.
- IV. The door of the supernatural has been opened to us, and we need to keep it open with *agape* love.
- We need to earnestly desire the supernatural and the best gifts—the gifts of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:7-11).
 - Desire the best gifts; that is, the gifts needed at the time.
 - Agape love never fails (1 Corinthians 13:4-8).
