### DAY 1 – THE HOLY SPIRIT, THE GREATER ONE IN YOU

God sent His Holy Spirit, the Greater One, to live within you. He is accessible to you as Comforter, Helper, Guide, Teacher and much more.

#### STUDY IT

- Have the faith of God (Mark 11:22).
  - All humans have natural faith. To operate in the kingdom of God, you need the faith that God gives.
  - Everyone who is in the family of God is given a measure of faith (Romans 12:3).
  - Feed and exercise your faith, so it will become strong.
- What you say is the evidence of what you believe.
  - Speak your belief in God's WORD to problems, and expect change.
- Forgive, so your faith has no hindrances (Mark 11:25).
- You have overcome demons and evil spirits (1 John 4:2-4).
- Agree with God's WORD, and be strong in your beliefs.
- Declare that the Greater One lives in you (1 John 4:4).

### DAY 2 – BECOME GOD-INSIDE MINDED

God is inside you by His powerful Holy Spirit. Be continually aware of God's love and care.

### STUDY IT

- Whatever you ask God, He wants to grant it to you (Mark 11:24, *AMPC*)!
  - You have a heavenly grant (John 16:23, *AMPC*).
- You must spend time in God's WORD and in prayer.
- Listen to the Greater One who lives within you (1 John 4:4).
- God took Brother Copeland's list of needs and said He would take care of them.
- God kept Brother Copeland's car running when, mechanically, it was broken.
- Literally give your needs, your problems and your cares over to God. Expect Him to fix what's not right.
- Pray in the spirit and speak to those things you're believing to happen as if they already have (Romans 4:17).
- Talk to God continually, until you KNOW your situation is taken care of.

### DAY 3 – WHAT IS THE BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT?

Being filled with the Holy Spirit and speaking in an unknown language is a supernatural way to communicate with God and a way to use His power to minister to other people (Mark 16:15-18).

### STUDY IT

- It's important to receive Jesus as your Lord and Savior (Romans 10:9-11).
- When you receive Jesus, you receive the Holy Spirit and His character traits (Galatians 5:22-23).
- Jesus told the disciples that when He left, God would send them another "Comforter"—that's the Holy Spirit (John 14:16-17).
- The Holy Spirit is God's gift of power to the Church, so you can live supernaturally and go beyond your natural understanding and ability.
- God invites you to receive the Baptism in the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in an unknown language (Acts 1:8).
- Speaking in tongues will strengthen and build you up and prepare you to minister to others (1 Corinthians 14:4).

### DAY 4 – THE HOLY SPIRIT, YOUR STANDBY POWER

The Holy Spirit is your “Helper” and your “Standby”—the extra power you need in any situation.

#### STUDY IT

- Spend time listening to the Holy Spirit, the Greater One on the inside of you (1 John 4:4).
- To forgive may seem like a small thing, yet to God it is of massive importance (Mark 11:25).
  - Your faith works when you stay in the love of Christ (Galatians 5:6).
- Pray in the Holy Spirit to build yourself up and be ready (1 Corinthians 14:4).
- You have access to God, your Father, and Jesus by listening to the Holy Spirit.
- The Holy Spirit will remind you of what you have forgotten and reveal to you what you need to know.
- Inform yourself of the Holy Spirit's power and God's will by spending time in His WORD (John 16:13-15)!
- The Holy Spirit is always talking to you—turn on your listener!

### DAY 5 – PRAYING IN THE SPIRIT PREPARES YOU FOR YOUR FUTURE

As you pray in an unknown language, the Holy Spirit is praying through you. Ask Him to give you an understanding of what you are saying. The Holy Spirit will inform and instruct you concerning things to come (John 16:13).

### STUDY IT

- There are times in your private devotions when you pray in an unknown language. Ask The LORD to give you the interpretation of what you prayed (1 Corinthians 14:13).
- One of the gifts of the Holy Spirit is speaking in an unknown language and interpreting what has been said, so that it can be understood by others (1 Corinthians 12:4-11).
  - If you preach in an unknown language, the listeners will not understand without an interpreter.
  - Paul instructed the Church to preach in a known language so that the listeners could understand and be built up.
- The Holy Spirit will help you preach and teach in order to share God's WORD effectively.
- Rather than exalting yourself, allow the Holy Spirit to announce His plans for your ministry and your life.
