### DAY I—The God of Plenty

#### A. Deuteronomy 28:11—The Lord Will Make You Plenteous in Goods.

1. *Plenteous* (HEB) = To exceed, have excess; to have more than enough
2. *Plenty* = A more than adequate supply
3. *Goods* (HEB) = Good in the widest sense; prosperity, wealth, benefits, good things
4. (AMPC) The Lord shall make you have a surplus of prosperity.
5. (MEV) The Lord will make you overflow in prosperity.

### DAY 2—Filled With Plenty

#### A. Deuteronomy 28:11—The Lord Will Make You Plenteous in Goods.

1. *Plenteous (HEB)* = To exceed, have excess; to have more than enough.
2. *Plenty* = A more than adequate supply.
3. Deuteronomy 28:8 (NKJV) The LORD will command THE BLESSING on you in your storehouses and in all to which you set your hand.
4. God wants to command THE BLESSING on our storehouses.
5. *Goods (HEB)* = Good in the widest sense; prosperity, wealth, benefits, good things.
6. *(AMPC)* The LORD shall make you have a surplus of prosperity.
7. *(MEV)* The LORD will make you overflow in prosperity.

#### B. “The God of Plenty” Words from the Lord through Brother Copeland.

1. “I have a great storehouse. Much more has been stored up in the storehouse of riches beyond your wildest dream that I laid up for you before the foundation of the world. 4. Ephesians 1:22 (TPT) He alone is the Leader and the Source of EVERYTHING needed in the church.
5. Some people talk about not wanting to ask God for too much. That’s false humility.
6. 3 John 2 (NKJV) Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers.
7. 2 Chronicles 16:9 (NKJV) For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show Himself strong on behalf of *those* whose heart *is* loyal to Him.
8. 2 Peter 1:2-4 (NKJV) Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, as His divine power has given to us all things that *pertain* to life and



godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption *that is* in the world through lust.

9. The God of PLENTY has enough in His storehouse to supply every need we would ever have—with MUCH left over.

### C. "The God of Plenty" Scriptures.

1. Genesis 41:46-49 (MSG) Joseph was thirty years old when he went to work for Pharaoh the king of Egypt. As soon as Joseph left Pharaoh's presence, he began his work in Egypt. During the next seven years of PLENTY the land produced bumper crops. Joseph gathered up the food of the seven good years in Egypt and stored the food in cities. In each city he stockpiled surplus from the surrounding fields. Joseph collected so much grain—it was like the sand of the ocean!—that he finally quit keeping track.
2. 2 Chronicles 31:6-10 (NLT) The people who had moved to Judah from Israel, and the people of Judah themselves, brought in the tithes of their cattle, sheep, and goats and a tithe of the things that had been dedicated to the Lord their God, and they piled them up in great heaps. They began piling them up in late spring, and the heaps continued to grow until early autumn. When Hezekiah and his officials came and saw these huge piles, they thanked the Lord and his people Israel! "Where did all this come from?" Hezekiah asked the priests and Levites. And Azariah the high priest, from the family of Zadok, replied, "Since the people began bringing their gifts to the Lord's Temple, we have had enough to eat and PLENTY to spare. The Lord has blessed his people, and all this is left over."
3. Joel 2:23-26 (NKJV) Be glad then, you children of Zion, and rejoice in the Lord your God; for He has given you the former rain faithfully, and He will cause the rain to come down for you—the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month. The threshing floors shall be full of wheat, and the vats shall overflow with new wine and oil. "So I will restore to you the years that the swarming locust has eaten, the crawling locust, the consuming locust, and the chewing locust, My great army which I sent among you. You shall eat in PLENTY and be satisfied, and praise the name of the Lord your God, Who has dealt wondrously with you; and My people shall never be put to shame.
4. Proverbs 3:9-10 (NKJV) Honor the Lord with your possessions, and with the first-fruits of all your increase; so your barns will be filled with PLENTY, and your vats will overflow with new wine.
5. Psalms 23:1, 5 (NIV-84) The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.

### DAY 3—El Shaddai—The God Who Is More Than Enough

#### A. Genesis 17:1-2 — El Shaddai — The Almighty God.

1. Verses 1-2 (NLT) When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to him and said, "I am El-Shaddai—'God Almighty.' Serve me faithfully and live a blameless life. I will make a covenant with you, by which I will guarantee to give you countless descendants."
  - a. "'Serve Me.' It's interesting that He said to do that first. It doesn't say much for disobedience. We don't have a promise for disobedience." —Gloria Copeland
2. The meaning of El Shaddai.
  - a. *El (HEB)* = God's power and might.
  - b. *Shaddai (HEB)* = Multiple Names:
    - i. God on the Holy Mountain
    - ii. God of the Wilderness
    - iii. God the Destroyer of Enemies
    - iv. God the Almighty
    - v. The Sovereign God
3. His Names in regards to provision.
  - a. God the All-Sufficient One
  - b. God the Nurturer of Babies (The Breasted One).
  - c. The God Who Is More Than Enough.
4. He who called Abraham was all mighty to supply ALL his needs.
5. "I know you are too old to have a child, but I am El Shaddai!!"

#### B. Genesis 17:1-2—The God Who Is More Than Enough

1. Verses 1-2 (NOG) When Abram was 99 years old, Yahweh appeared to him. He said to Abram, "I am El Shaddai [the God who is more than enough]. Live in my presence with integrity. I will give you my promise, and I will give you very many descendants."
2. El Shaddai is more than enough to meet all our needs in every situation.
3. "El Shaddai will demonstrate provisional miracles that are contrary to natural events" Rev. Creflo Dollar, 1999 New Year's Eve sermon.
  - a. He will cause things to happen that are not supposed to happen.
  - b. He majors on the impossible.





- c. Anything and everything we need to accomplish our faith projects can be found in El Shaddai.
4. Our situation is subject to change when El Shaddai shows up.
5. El Shaddai is more than capable of superseding all natural laws and events.

### C. John 6:11-13—More Than Enough Provision

1. Verses 11-13 And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would. When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost. Therefore they gathered them together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten.
2. That's El Shaddai showing up in an impossible situation—a provisional miracle took place!
3. Jesus spoke THE BLESSING over the fish and loaves.
  - a. "Thank You, El Shaddai, for the miracle of multiplication."
  - b. Genesis 1:28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.
4. There was more than enough food for 50,000 people to be completely satisfied with much left over.
5. "More than enough" is "over and above" what is needed.
6. Deuteronomy 28:11 (*VOICE*) The Eternal (El Shaddai) will give you more than enough of every good thing.
7. Whatever it is that you need right now, call on The God of More Than Enough. Call on El Shaddai!

### DAY 4—Covenant of Wealth

#### A. 2 Chronicles 16:9—For the Eyes of the Lord Run To and Fro Throughout the Whole Earth to Show Himself Strong in Behalf of Them Whose Heart Is Perfect Toward Him.

1. *Show Himself Strong (HEB)* = Bestow, grant, extend His Covenant Wealth towards.
2. Our covenant with God is His total commitment to support, defend, protect and provide for us.
3. God's consuming passion and determination is to locate His covenant people and bless them.
4. It is an undying covenant devotion that propels Him to extend Himself to us with everything He is and with everything He has.
5. "As soon as we began to hear the truth, we turned toward it. When we turned toward it, prosperity and THE BLESSING turned toward us because we were doing what the Bible said." —Gloria Copeland
6. "God will take any area you let Him have. He will be there to meet you, if you'll just turn toward Him and get in His Word." —Gloria Copeland
7. It is a covenant love that won't give up or quit until the extension of that love is satisfied.
  - a. 2 Samuel 9:1-3 David was consumed with locating an heir of Jonathan to bestow Covenant Wealth upon.
  - b. The eyes of David ran to and fro throughout the whole earth searching for an heir of his covenant brother to lavish Covenant Wealth upon.
  - c. How much more is God searching for us?

#### B. Deuteronomy 8:18—But Thou Shalt Remember The Lord Thy God: For It Is He that Giveth Thee Power to Get Wealth, That He May Establish His Covenant Which He Swore Unto Thy Fathers, as It Is This Day.

1. Verse 18 (NLT) Remember the Lord your God. He is the one who gives you power to be successful, in order to fulfill the covenant He confirmed to your ancestors with an oath.
2. Prosperity is a sign of our covenant with God.
3. Zechariah 8:13 (NLT) Among the other nations, Judah and Israel became symbols of a cursed nation. But no longer! Now I will rescue you and make you both a symbol and a source of blessing.
4. Genesis 17:1-8 God entered into covenant with Abraham and made him rich.







5. Galatians 3 We are heirs of this covenant.
  - a. Verse 13 (NLT) But Christ has rescued us from the curse pronounced by the law. When he was hung on the cross, he took upon himself the curse for our wrongdoing. For it is written in the Scriptures, "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree."
  - b. Verse 14 (NLT) Through Christ Jesus, God has blessed the Gentiles with the same blessing he promised to Abraham, so that we who are believers might receive the promised Holy Spirit through faith.
  - c. Verse 29 (NLT) And now that you belong to Christ, you are the true children of Abraham. You are his heirs, and God's promise to Abraham belongs to you.

### C. Covenant of Wealth Scriptures

1. Deuteronomy 28:2 And all these (covenant) blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee.
2. Psalms 35:27 Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the (covenant) prosperity of his servant.
3. Psalms 37:25 I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous (God's covenant people) forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.
4. Psalms 68:19 (NKJV) Blessed be the Lord, Who daily loads us with (covenant) benefits.
5. Ecclesiastes 5:19 (NLT) It is a good thing to receive (covenant) wealth from God and the good (covenant) health to enjoy it.

### DAY 5—His Riches in Glory

#### A. Philippians 4:19—My God Shall Supply All Your Need According to His Riches in Glory by Christ Jesus.

1. "My God shall supply all your need."
  - a. (AMPC) And my God will liberally supply (fill to the full) your every need.
  - b. God is the Source of everything we need—not people.
  - c. Matthew 6:11 (TPT) We acknowledge You as our Provider of all we need each day.
2. "According to:"
  - a. God's covenant provision is in correspondence to and in proportion with His supply.
  - b. He has the supply to back whatever we need.
  - c. Haggai 2:8 The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the Lord of hosts.
3. "His riches."
  - a. *Riches* (GK) = Wealth, money, possessions, abundance, richness, valuable bestowment.
  - b. God's riches are beyond natural, human comprehension.
  - c. Ephesians 3:8 (AMPC) To me, though I am the very least of all the saints...this grace...was granted and graciously entrusted: to proclaim to the Gentiles the unending (boundless, fathomless, incalculable, and exhaustless) riches of Christ [wealth which no human being could have searched out].
4. "In glory."
  - a. Heaven is a place of vast wealth.
  - b. Revelation 21 describes it as a city made of pure gold with gates fashioned from pearl and foundations of precious stones.
  - c. James 1:17 (AMPC) Every good gift and every perfect (free, large, full) gift is from above; it comes down from the Father of all [that gives] light.
  - d. "Heaven is OVERLOADED with things that I have prepared for your enjoyment. I paid for it. Come and get it. This is a feast of abundance" Word of The LORD through Kenneth Copeland, August 7, 2009.
  - e. The glory of God is the presence of God heavy with everything good.
  - f. The first mention of "glory" in the Bible is connected to wealth.
  - g. Genesis 31:1 Jacob hath taken away all that was our father's; and of that which was our father's hath he gotten all this glory.



5. "By Christ Jesus."

- a. Everything that belongs to the Father is ours through our blood covenant with Jesus.
- b. John 16:15 (AMPC) Everything that the Father has is Mine. That is what I meant when I said that He [the Spirit] will take the things that are Mine and will reveal (declare, disclose, transmit) it to you.
- c. God has a covenant determination through Christ Jesus to transmit His riches to us.

B. Philippians 4:19—Rick Renner Translation.

1. "But my God will supply your needs so completely that He will eliminate all your deficiencies. He will meet all your physical and tangible needs until they are so full, you have no more capacity to hold anything else. He will supply all your needs until you are totally filled, packed full and overflowing to the point of bursting at the seams and spilling over."
2. Our needs will be completely supplied.
3. All shortage and insufficiency will be eradicated.
4. We won't have the capacity to contain it all.
5. His riches in glory reach far beyond our own needs; they reach over into supplying the needs of others.

C. Word From The LORD Through Kenneth Copeland, November 10, 2011.
