

THE LOVE COVENANT OF *EL SHADDAI*

DAY 1 – *EL SHADDAI* HAS EVERYTHING YOU'LL EVER NEED

The love covenant of *El Shaddai* God is the basis of our life with Him. When anyone calls on God, He will answer. He never fails, not one time. God forgave our sins for His own sake. The covenant between God Almighty and Jesus cannot be broken. God's covenant with us starts with salvation and continues on to healing.

STUDY IT

- I. The love covenant of *El Shaddai* God is the basis of our life with Him.
 - You can't preach faith without preaching covenant because that's what generates faith.
 - Jesus told us, "Have faith in God" (Mark 11:22).
 - God told Abram, "I am the Almighty God"—*El Shaddai* (Genesis 17:1).
 - The root word to the Hebrew word *Shaddai* actually refers to a nurse—a mother—and really pictures the nursing or feeding of her child. God, our Nurse, our Father, our Mother, the Giver of our life is our everything. He's the God who is more than enough.
 - "I am *El Shaddai*. I will make My covenant between me and you, and will multiply you exceedingly" (Genesis 17:2). Abram fell on his face and God talked to him.
 - When you fall on your face and call on God, He will talk to you.

- II. When anyone calls on God, He will answer. He never fails, not one time.
 - Ezekiel paints a picture of someone dumped beside the road and abandoned.
 - God saw that person and said, "I saw you in your blood and said, 'Live'" (Ezekiel 16:6). *El Shaddai* rescued that person—and He rescues us.
 - When anyone calls on God, He will answer. He never fails, not one time.
 - Brother Copeland and Gloria called on Jesus, were born again, accepted God's invitation to covenant with Him, and the course of their lives changed.
 - You can have a covenant with this same God. Accept Him right now. It's the easiest thing you will ever do in your life.

- III. God forgave our sins for His own sake.
 - He blotted out our transgressions and will not remember our sins (Isaiah 43:25).



- If God remembers our sin, He can't BLESS us. God desires to BLESS you and me.
 - The meaning of grace: God Almighty and The LORD Jesus Christ would like very much to treat us like sin never happened.
 - God has given us covenant promises. The blood of the new covenant—the blood of God Himself—entered into covenant with you and me.
 - It's an unbreakable covenant, because it's between God Almighty and Jesus.
 - If we walk in the Light, we fellowship with each other, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin (1 John 1:7-9).
- IV. The covenant between God Almighty and Jesus cannot be broken.
- Knowing you are in covenant with God may not make you feel any different, but your feelings don't have anything to do with it.
 - God's WORD will change your feelings. Receive your forgiveness.
 - If you let your feelings enter into it, it'll cost you dearly, because you'll spend a lot of time feeling sorry for yourself. That's a form of grief.
 - You'll get off into depression. You may think: *Nobody loves me.*
 - That's a lie! Jesus loves you, the Father loves you, and we love you.
 - You are in a blood covenant with God and Jesus.
- V. God's covenant with us starts with salvation and continues on to healing.
- Healing is like the dinner bell calling people to salvation.
 - When people get sick, they need to be healed, and they don't care whether you preach faith healing or medicinal healing. They just want to be well!
 - Then they get born again.
 - We have a healing God, and we have a healing covenant.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

God's love covenant has within it everything you need and will ever need!

Make a list of your needs, then rejoice in praise and worship to God that He has already provided for you. Use a red pen to mark "Done!" over each one. Remember: Nothing is too hard for God!



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DAY 2 – THE LOVE COVENANT IS A HEALING COVENANT

Almighty God, *El Shaddai*, made covenant with Abraham to be his God. God is very mindful of His covenant. The love covenant is a healing covenant. The new covenant is between God and an immortal Man—Jesus Christ.

STUDY IT

- I. Almighty God, *El Shaddai*, made covenant with Abram (whose name was later changed to Abraham) to be his God.
 - The Lord appeared to Abraham and said, “I am the Almighty God” (Genesis 17:1).
 - In the original Hebrew language, He said, “I am *El Shaddai*.”
 - “I am *El Shaddai*. I will make My covenant between Me and you, and will multiply you exceedingly.”
 - *El Shaddai* means: God, our Nurse, our Father, our Mother, the Giver of life. He’s everything!
- II. God is very mindful of His covenant (Psalm 111:5).
 - God’s covenant with Abraham was a national covenant. Ours is a salvation, healing covenant.
 - Jesus is the mediator of a better covenant which was established on better promises (Hebrews 8:6).
 - It’s an everlasting covenant established by our everlasting God, who everlastingly loves us and gave Himself a ransom for us (Hebrews 13:20).
 - We are redeemed from the curse of the law since Jesus has set us free! (Galatians 3:17).
- III. The love covenant is a healing covenant.
 - God didn’t intend for anyone to be sick.
 - Because of the covenant, you can declare: “I’ll never be sick again in my life hereafter forever.”
 - God’s covenant is powerful, because within the covenant is everything God offers, everything God has provided for us.



- “For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed, but my *chesed* shall not depart from thee, and neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed,” saith The LORD that has *chesed* on you (see Isaiah 54:10).
- IV. The new covenant is between God and an immortal Man, a resurrected Man—Jesus Christ.
- God is saying, “I love you. Stop whatever you are doing that’s wrong. Stop blocking My covenant provisions for you.”
 - It can be difficult to get this flesh under control to do God’s WORD.
 - To remove offense, sometimes surgery is required, and the surgical instrument is the two-edged sword of God’s WORD (Matthew 18:8; Hebrews 4:12).
 - God will not tell you to do anything that you cannot do, but you’re going to have to do it by faith in His strength. You’re going to have to do it through obedience.
 - God’s WORD will help you, because He loves you so much and He cares for you (1 Peter 5:7).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

There’s healing power in the love covenant of God.

Pray confidently that the healing of God is working for you and your family:

Thank You, my Father, for Your promise of healing. I receive Your miraculous power in the life of my family today and every day. Your covenant guarantees that You will heal us, no matter what the illness, disease or condition! Thank You for Your chesed! I pray in Jesus’ Name. Amen.





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DAY 3 – THE LOVE COVENANT WILL FIGHT FOR YOU

Jesus, as a perfect Man and the Son of God, was the embodiment of the love covenant. The love covenant contains *chesed*, an intangible concept that is difficult to express. The Almighty God Himself, the God of *chesed*, lives on the inside of you. Calling someone *Friend* is covenant talk. David called on the covenant, preparing to fight Goliath. Covenant love and *chesed* will build faith and do miracles.

STUDY IT

- I. Jesus as a perfect Man and the Son of God, was the embodiment of the love covenant.
 - Jesus wanted people to understand that He was the Messiah, the fulfillment of God's covenant promise.
 - Jesus asked the Pharisees a question: "Saying, What think ye of Christ? whose son is he? They say unto him, The son of David" (Matthew 22:42).

- II. The love covenant contains *chesed*, an intangible concept that is difficult to express.
 - *Chesed* is found in Psalm 23.
 - "Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me" (Psalm 23:4).
 - Notice David said *through* the valley; don't camp there!
 - "Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life" (Psalm 23:6).
 - Surely goodness and *chesed* follow me.
 - This psalm is a picture of the *chesed* that God has for us.
 - When the Almighty God made covenant with frail, helpless man, *chesed* was in action.
 - *Chesed* is like a big mother elephant and her baby. If you start getting too close to her baby, *chesed* is about to take place. The mother elephant is going to stomp you!

- III. The Almighty God Himself, the God of *chesed*, lives on the inside of you.
 - Jesus knew that and said, "I do nothing without the Father. He does the works" (see John 14:10).





- As you learn about the covenant of God, you realize you are bigger on the inside than on the outside, because the giant Almighty God is living right inside your spirit.
 - Don't fear the disease; seek The LORD.
- IV. Calling someone *Friend* is covenant talk.
- "There is a friend that sticketh closer than a brother" (Proverbs 18:24); a blood-covenant Friend.
 - Study covenant and learn the original covenant laws.
 - The original blood covenant was made when God cut covenant with Abraham (Genesis 17).
 - God and Abraham were Friends, blood-covenant friends (James 2:23).
 - Jesus made covenant with His disciples. He said, "I no longer call you servants, I call you Friends (covenant Friends)" (John 15:15).
 - We who believe in Jesus Christ are covenanted together with God, and we have become Friends in blood forever.
 - We can call on God our covenant Partner: "Whatever you ask the Father in My Name, He will give it you" (John 15:16).
 - Whatever God has and you need, call for it. Whatever you have and God needs, He will call for it.
 - Whatever you ask, God will give. Whatever you demand, He will do—because you are covenanted together!
- V. David called on the covenant, preparing to fight Goliath.
- He said, "I've killed the lion and the bear. They didn't have a covenant with God, and I killed them."
 - "It doesn't matter how big the giant is—the giant has no covenant with God. I'll take him down" (1 Samuel 17:36).
 - David was sure his covenant with God would give him the victory.
- VI. Covenant love and *chesed* will build faith and do miracles.
- A large army was coming against Judah. King Jehoshaphat was afraid, and set himself to seek The LORD (2 Chronicles 20:1-4).
 - He went straight to God, to God's WORD, and called on the right of covenant.
 - Jehoshaphat had the right to call on God for help. His faith was talking.
 - Jehoshaphat called on God who had covenanted with Abraham and had made promises over the nation of Judah (2 Chronicles 20:3-12).
 - God had given the land to the children of Israel many years before. Now the descendants of those nations who had left the land wanted it back.





- The LORD said to Jehoshaphat (and He says to you), “Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God’s” (2 Chronicles 20:15).
 - The king and the people worshipped and praised The LORD (2 Chronicles 20:19).
 - Jehoshaphat consulted with the people (not God) and they began to sing and praise God saying, “Praise The LORD for His *chesed* endures forever.” They were praising God for His covenant *chesed*.
- The LORD sent ambushments against the enemy and they were destroyed (2 Chronicles 20:22).
- That was *chesed* in action!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Receive and believe Jesus will fight for you!

Write what you are battling right now, and expect Jesus’ *chesed* to cause you to win!



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DAY 4 – THE LOVE COVENANT IS POWER

We are in the love covenant with the Most High God. We're talking about God's grace and *chesed*. The scar on Jesus' side was the cut of the covenant. Bartimaeus, a blind man, called on Jesus for *chesed* and you, too, can call on Jesus for *chesed*.

STUDY IT

- I. We are in the love covenant with the Most High God.
 - When it comes time to pray in spiritual warfare, we put on His armor and take up the weapons of our Covenant Partner.
 - The gospel is the power of God and is accessed by covenant. You need to be walking in that covenant power with the Almighty God.

- II. God's grace and *chesed* are powerful and available, and they work!
 - David and Jonathan cut covenant together (1 Samuel 18:3-4).
 - They gave each other covenant gifts: robes and armor.
 - They spoke covenant blessings to look after each other's family.
 - Later, Jonathan and his father, King Saul, were killed in battle.
 - David went to look for descendants of Jonathan to BLESS with covenant BLESSINGS.
 - David said, "Is there any that is left of the house of Saul that I may show *chesed* for Jonathan's sake?" (2 Samuel 9:1). He was a covenant partner to Jonathan.
 - David found Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan, the son of Saul.
 - David gave Mephibosheth the status of a son of a king (2 Samuel 9:7). That's *chesed*!

- III. The scar on Jesus' side was the cut of the covenant.
 - The spear pierced His heart, and water and blood poured out—the pure, spotless blood of God.
 - *Chesed* was performed for me and you.



- IV. The woman of Canaan who came to Jesus for healing and deliverance for her daughter demonstrated Jesus' *chesed* (Matthew 15:22-28).
- She said, "Have *chesed* on me, Son of David, Christ, Messiah!"
 - She was determined to receive *chesed*. She bowed down and worshipped Him.
 - Jesus told her, "O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt" (Matthew 15:28). That's *chesed*!
- V. Bartimaeus, a blind man, called on Jesus for *chesed* (Mark 10:46-52).
- Officials had certified that Bartimaeus was blind and gave him a coat as his license to beg.
 - Bartimaeus cried out to his Messiah for *chesed*!
 - When Jesus called him, Bartimaeus cast off his garment that signified he was blind—he didn't need it anymore.
 - Bartimaeus must have thought, *Jesus is going to do chesed for me. I know it. He's the Messiah!*
 - Bartimaeus was calling those things that are not as though they already were (Romans 4:17).
 - Jesus asked him, "What do you want Me to do for you?"
 - Bartimaeus said, "That I might receive my sight."
 - Jesus said, "Go your way; your faith has made you whole."
 - Immediately Bartimaeus received his sight.
 - *Chesed! Chesed!* Call Him your Messiah! Jesus is your Messiah!
- VI. You can call on Jesus for *chesed*.
- Say: "Son of David, have mercy on my sick baby!"
 - You don't call on mercy for mercy's sake. You call on Jesus because you *know* His mercy.
 - Be assured that Jesus will help you because He is the God of *chesed*! He is the Almighty God, and when you call for *chesed* for your baby, your baby will come right out of any problem.
 - You have a covenant with the Almighty God and Jesus, the Son of the living God.
 - Jesus, the Messiah, is your blood Brother. He does *chesed* for you and your family!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Call on Jesus right now for His power to meet your need! *Chesed! Chesed!* Call on Jesus, your Messiah, the Son of the living God!





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DAY 5 – THE POWER OF YOUR FAITHFULNESS TO GOD

The power of God's love covenant is available to you when you are faithful to Him, and it does not require money. Jesus taught that money cannot buy access to the kingdom of God. God looks for those who will hear and obey.

STUDY IT

- I. The power of God's love covenant is available to you when you are faithful to Him.
 - This is vitally important. When you are under a lot of pressure and you need to hear from heaven, don't do all the talking.
 - Rufus Mosely was lying on the floor in prayer, when he realized, *Here lies a fool who knows nothing, doing all the talking to Someone who knows everything.*

- II. The power of God does not require money.
 - Jesus said to Philip, "Where shall we buy bread, that these may eat?" (John 6:5-13).
 - Jesus already had it planned out. He already has your situation planned out too.
 - A lad shared his lunch of five barley loaves and two small fishes.
 - Yet when the whole multitude was full, there were 12 baskets full of fragments.

- III. Jesus taught that money cannot buy access to the kingdom of God.
 - The rich young ruler wanted to buy life.
 - He asked Jesus, "What shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?" (Mark 10:17).
 - He was talking about *zoe*, the God kind of life for the present and for eternity.
 - Jesus said, "One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me" (Mark 10:21).
 - The man turned away.





- Jesus said, “How hard it is for them that trust in riches to enter into the kingdom of God. It is easier for a camel to go through an eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God” (Mark 10:24-25).
- The disciples did not know any other way to get to God. They reasoned, “Who then can be saved?” (Mark 10:26).
- Jesus said, “With men it is impossible, but not with God. For with God all things are possible” (Mark 10:27).
- Jesus told Peter that whatever you give to honor God will be returned to you in great measure in this life and in the life to come.
 - “And Jesus answered and said, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, for my sake, and the gospel’s, but he shall receive an hundredfold now in this time, houses, and brethren, and sisters, and mothers, and children, and lands, with persecutions; and in the world to come eternal life” (Mark 10:29-30).

VI. God looks for those who will hear and obey.

- The devil hates it when believers get money, because they will use it to preach the gospel!
- Make this declaration: BLESSINGS happen to me all the time because I’m a believer, not a doubter. I walk in love. I keep the commandments of God.
- Jesus said, “He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him” (John 14:21).
- You have to listen to what God is saying.
 - God doesn’t respond to those who pray all night long. He responds to those who listen to Him and do what He says.
 - Be on call and obedient 24 hours a day.
- A close friend of Brother Copeland called him. Brother Copeland didn’t have an opportunity to call him back before the man passed away.
 - A woman who was part of Vinita Copeland’s prayer group talked to Brother Copeland at the friend’s home-going service.
 - The LORD had told her to go to the hospital in the middle of the night. She stopped at the room of Brother Copeland’s friend, prayed for him, and he accepted Jesus as LORD and Savior. He died the next day!
- Brother Copeland had another friend whom someone led to The LORD.
 - A few days later the friend dropped dead of a heart attack.
- God is faithful. People who are faithful to God have great victories.
