DAY 1 – YOUR FAITH IS YOUR ECONOMY

Have the faith of God. Your economic situation can prosper right in the middle of a national financial crisis. All our desires can be met through believing and speaking God's WORD in faith.

STUDY IT

- I. Have the faith of God (Mark 11:22).
 - As Kenneth E. Hagin used to say, "Have the God kind of faith."
 - This is the way God's faith works: We have His faith; it is the gift of God.
 - It's the same faith with which God created the heavens and the Earth—mountain-moving, planet-creating faith.
 - Everyone who is a born-again child of God starts off with exactly the same measure of faith (Romans 12:3).
 - In the court of heaven, you have the same faith as the Apostle Peter (2 Peter 1:1).
 - Your faith is going work according to what you say and think, how you take it, how you hear it, and how you act on it.
- II. The Bible compares spiritual growth to physical growth.
 - As a child grows to become an adult, he needs something more than milk.
 - It's not God's responsibility to cause us to grow spiritually, and He's not responsible for the frequency or quality of the spiritual food we eat.
 - He provides food for your spirit, mind and body. It's your choice to take it, or not.
 - God set before you life and death; you choose (Deuteronomy 30:19).
 - Choosing life includes daily physical exercise and a healthy diet.
 - Just because you're in your 80s doesn't excuse you from daily exercise.
 - For a long time, Brother Copeland says he was disobedient to the discipline of exercise; and he paid the price of having pain in his body.
 - Since he has begun regular exercise and good food choices, he's in the best physical condition he's ever been.



- III. Any question you have can be answered by “Have faith in God.”
- For example: What about my children? What about the economy? Have faith in God.
 - If you’re obeying God and praying for all men, kings and those in authority (1 Timothy 2:2), God will take care of your personal finances.
 - You’re not required to like a leader’s politics, but you are required to pray for him or her.
 - Don’t hate them just because you don’t like them.
 - Faith will not work in an unforgiving, judgmental or unwilling heart.
- IV. Your economic situation can prosper right in the middle of a national financial crisis.
- In the past, the big, personal fortunes were made when the national economy was struggling.
 - Those men and women listened to God and made investments when the economy was bad.
 - When things improved, they sold their investments—for a nice profit.
 - If you will walk by faith, live by faith and listen to God, you will prosper.
 - Money is the lowest form of financial power. The highest form of power is prayer and praise.
 - Poverty doesn’t benefit God. It steals from His Church and His people.
 - God has provided for you, and it’s available to you by faith.
 - When you follow heaven’s economy and the rules of prosperity, you will increase and prosper—spiritually, mentally, physically, financially and socially.
- V. The person who lives and walks by faith never has to change his or her lifestyle because of the times.
- We should be like Jesus: the same yesterday, today and forever (Hebrews 13:8).
 - We live and walk by heaven’s economy. All our needs are met abundantly so we can help others and do what Jesus commands us to do.
 - We are soldiers in the army of The LORD, and no soldier has to purchase his own weapons when he goes to war.
 - We have an abundance so we have enough to give to those in need (2 Corinthians 9:6-8).
 - Give and it shall be given to you (Luke 6:38).
 - Our own personal finances should be BLESSED and increase in the good things of God all the time. We should be enjoying life to the fullest—healed, well and strong.



- VI. All our desires can be met through believing and speaking God's WORD in faith.
- Jesus told us, "Whosoever shall say..." (Mark 11:23). The principle works on both sides of the spectrum—good or bad.
 - Jesus told His disciples how the faith of God works. Then He demonstrated it—He *said* it.
 - It doesn't work for everyone; but it does work for those who believe and receive when they pray.
 - When you stand praying, believe you receive at the same moment you forgive.
 - There's power in a loud voice, so shout: "Greater is He that is in me, than he that is in the world!" (1 John 4:4).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Your faith calls THE BLESSINGS of God from heaven to you. Make a list of your needs; then begin calling on God, by faith, to meet those needs. Remind The LORD of His WORD, and let your words reflect your confidence that He will hear and BLESS you.



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DAY 2 – FAITH WORDS TURN YOUR VICTORY LOOSE

To get the victory, we must speak words of faith. We live in a word-created, word-upheld universe. Three persons speak in Psalm 91: a man, Jesus and the Father. The heavenly Father finishes the Psalm on a victorious note by saying, “With long life will I satisfy him.”

STUDY IT

- I. To get the victory, you must speak words of faith.
 - Whatever you ask the Father, He will give you. Ask and receive (John 16:24).
 - “If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done. And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive” (Matthew 21:21-22).
 - We’re not in this alone. Jesus is responsible for taking these words of faith and bringing them to pass, because we’re standing on God’s WORD (see Mark 11:22-25; Matthew 21:21).
 - You can exercise the joy of The LORD which is your strength (Nehemiah 8:10) in the middle of pain. Your joy becomes full when you experience total healing.
- II. It’s good to have a faith partner to help you speak according to God’s WORD.
 - Gloria and Brother Copeland would say, “If that’s your confession, I believe it.”
 - Think of how the devil taught us to talk: “Scared me to death, thrilled me to death, I’m afraid....”
 - The laws of faith-filled words dominate the laws of death.
 - Death- and fear-filled words will dominate the words of life.
 - These are spiritual laws. They work on THE BLESSING and the cursing sides.
- III. We live in a word-created, word-upheld universe (John 1:1).
 - You can’t change the law, but you can change the words. Speak words of faith. Speak The WORD of God.
 - Jesus loves you in spite of your sin. There’s nothing you could do to make God love you any more or less, because He’s all-in.





- He even loves everyone in hell. God didn't intend for any human to go to hell.
 - The only man God sent to hell was Jesus, and He went in our place.
 - The only sin that will send anyone to hell is not accepting Jesus Christ as LORD of his or her life.
- IV. There are three people in Psalm 91: a person (you and me), Jesus and the Father.
- The way to get into the secret place of the Most High and under the shadow of the Almighty is by speaking.
 - Nothing happened until the man said something.
 - The only statement this man made was: "He is my refuge and my fortress; my God; in Him will I trust." Then the man shut his mouth.
- V. Jesus made The LORD His refuge when He went to hell.
- There was no other guarantee that He could get out of there; no one had ever gotten out of that place.
 - He had to take His deliverance by faith, and He took it on based on Psalm 22.
 - Jesus locked onto Psalm 22 that begins with, "My God, My God why hast Thou forsaken me?" and He ended with, "It is finished."
 - That's what He was quoting. He had to die by faith—we have to live by faith.
- VI. The heavenly Father finishes the Psalm on a victorious note by saying, "With long life I will satisfy him" (Psalm 91:16).
- Every time you find "long life" in Scripture, it means 120 years. The days of man shall be 120 years (Genesis 6:3).
 - The fullness of the gifts of the Spirit and the fullness of the fivefold ministry have not yet been manifested in the Earth. They have to come to pass.
 - The LORD asked Brother Copeland if he would live to be 120-years old.
 - This ministry is touching people all over this planet for God. We're going to see it through.
 - God will use you, but you have to be all-in—spirit, soul, mind and body.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Let's pray together in faith for victory.

Father, I come to You, praising and thanking You for all You are and all You have done for me. I ask You in faith, believing Your WORD, for victory in the area of _____ (make the prayer personal for yourself). I know You will meet my needs according to Your WORD in Philippians 4:19 that says, "My God shall supply all my needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus." Thank You, Sir. In Jesus' Name I pray. Amen.





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DAY 3 – FAITH OVERCOMES ANY SITUATION

Faith in God's power overcomes any situation. God is with us; He's in us by the Holy Spirit. The Apostle Paul wrote about the greater works that we will do. They're coming! Signs and wonders are coming that this planet has not seen in fullness before.

STUDY IT

- I. Faith in God's power overcomes any situation.
 - Jesus promised, "Ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me" (Acts 1:8). The Greek word for power is *dunamis* meaning "explosive power."
 - The same Greek word, *dunamis*, is used to describe the power Jesus used, "How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him" (Acts 10:38).
 - The Holy Spirit used Luke, the physician, to write both the Gospel of Luke and the book of Acts.
 - Luke said, Jesus "shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and fire" (Luke 3:16). This is the Holy Spirit's purging, burning fire of God.
- II. The first mention of the Spirit of God describes Him moving upon the face of the waters (Genesis 1:2).
 - This is the Spirit of Power; Power Himself. He is always moving. This is the Holy Ghost of fire and power.
 - "God said, 'Let light be,' and light is" (Genesis 1:3, *YLT*). The Holy Spirit's power went to work.
 - At the end of the first 24 hours, there were 16,094,764,800 miles of universe.
 - The universe has been expanding at the same rate ever since.
 - It almost unfathomable what's out there that began from one statement: "Light be!"
 - That's the God who's planning your life.
 - The sun, moon and stars were not created until the fourth day (Genesis 1:14-19).





III. God is with us; He's in us by the Holy Spirit.

- We need to develop a God-inside-me-now consciousness.
- It's a process to renew your mind to become God-inside minded—the awareness that God is really inside you.
- With the powerful Holy Spirit living inside you, a 120-year lifespan is a snap. Without Him, there's no way you could live that long. The good news is that you are not without Him.
- Jesus promised that He would give you another Comforter to abide with you forever (John 14:16-17). That's the Holy Spirit.
- God is the Beginning and the End, the Alpha and the Omega, and He is with you, forever.
- The world can't see Him, but you know Him.
- The Holy Spirit was in Jesus, and He dwells within you. "The Father that dwells in Me, He does the work" (see John 14:10).
- Jesus said that because you have the Holy Spirit, you will do greater works (John 14:12). This was startling information to the disciples.

IV. The Apostle Paul wrote about the greater works that we will do.

- "That He would grant you according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might by His Spirit in the inner man" (Ephesians 3:16).
 - Believe that you receive the strengthening of the Holy Spirit.
- "That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith that you being rooted and grounded in love...." (Ephesians 3:17).
 - "Faith works by love" (Galatians 5:6). Without love, faith isn't working.
- With faith in God's love, you "may be able to comprehend the breadth, length, depth, height and to know the love of Christ" (see Ephesians 3:18-19).
 - God is Love (1 John 4:8). You need a working knowledge, not just a mental understanding, of God's love.
- "That you might be filled with all the fulness of God" (Ephesians 3:19).
 - That you be fully God-inside minded, continually conscious of God inside.
- "Now unto Him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power (*dunamis*) that worketh in us" (Ephesians 3:20).

V. They're coming! Signs and wonders are coming that this planet has not seen in fullness before.

- Jesus started it, and we are at the finish.
- Moses and the children of Israel saw many miracles: water from a rock, daily food from heaven, their clothes didn't wear out.
 - We've read about those miracles, so we can ask or think about them.



- We will see greater miracles than what happened with Moses—things we cannot now imagine.
- We must desire God to develop this understanding on the inside of us, where we have a God-inside-me-now consciousness. Stop limiting the God of glory.
- God has been waiting on us all this time.
- “Unto Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen” (Ephesians 3:21). Paul ends with *Amen* which means, “So be it,” or “It will be.”

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Use your faith and expect the *dunamis* power of God to take care of every situation in your life. Write out two scriptures that assure you of God’s desire to use His *dunamis* power on your behalf (for example: Acts 1:8, 10:38.)



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DAY 4 – ARE YOU WALKING BY FAITH OR BY SIGHT?

Let's look at our great God. People in this world are taught to be "outside-in" people. They believe everything they need is outside of them, and they are walking by sight. We are no longer outside-in people. We are inside-out people, and we walk by faith.

STUDY IT

- I. Let's look at our great God: "Behold your God!" (Isaiah 40:9).
 - He feeds His flock as a wise and kind Shepherd.
 - He measured the waters and the heavens of the whole planet with the span of His hand (9 inches). That's your God.
 - God took one drop of water and weighed the oceans of the planet.
 - He took one piece of dust and weighed the mountains.
 - Before the foundation of the world, before He said, "Light be" and light was, He had it all figured out.
 - He knew what the oceans would weigh, even with the tides going in and out.
 - This planet is still going in spite of things man has done to it. It has never gotten out of balance. Gravity is still working.
 - God did all of that with a piece of dust and a drop of water.
 - This Almighty, all-powerful God can certainly handle your needs.
- II. People in this world are taught to be "outside-in" people. They believe everything they need is outside of them, and they are walking by sight.
 - They think, *Maybe my boss has what I need, or God has it and I need to get it from Him. It's all out here somewhere, if I can just find it.*
 - If you're born again, especially if you're baptized with the Holy Spirit, you find everything you need in God, and He's inside you.
- III. You have God within you and a supernatural way of communicating with God that the devil can't be a part of.
 - The devil cannot understand what you're saying.
 - You can communicate with God! Talk about an advantage.
 - No wonder satan has fought tongues like he has.





- IV. We are no longer outside-in people. We are inside-out people, and we walk by faith.
- Your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 6:19).
 - The Holy Spirit lives in your spirit. Your spirit is the real *you*, and your body looks like your spirit.
 - That's what Jesus meant when He said, "The kingdom of God is within you" (Luke 17:21).
 - The whole kingdom of God is in you—God is in you. Take the limits off.
 - Stop thinking of the physical confines of this natural planet. In the spirit, there are no limits.
 - John, on the Isle of Patmos, was in the Spirit, and he saw much more than that little island (Revelation 1:10).
 - God could have filled you with an angel, but He didn't. He wouldn't trust you to anyone but Himself. He said, *They're My children. I want to be everything to them. I will fill them with My Spirit.*
 - Fall in love with Jesus because He loves you so much.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Pray with us:

Heavenly Father, Thank You for Your WORD. I ask You today to help me live my life by faith in You, not by sight. Please help me use spiritual eyes to see You in Your WORD, and to live my life according to Your instructions. I determine to not live based on what I see, which may lead to fear. Instead, I will base my life on what I see in Your WORD, so I talk like You and even think like You! Thank You, Sir. I pray in Jesus' Name. Amen.





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DAY 5 – FAITH HAS A RIGHTEOUSNESS CONSCIOUSNESS

Jesus had a God-inside consciousness. Praying, speaking and praising in a language that you haven't learned is the gateway to the supernatural. Saul/Paul was headed to Damascus, not realizing he had an appointment with Jesus. Everywhere He went, Jesus preached the message of His Anointing.

STUDY IT

- I. Jesus had a God-inside consciousness.
 - Everywhere He went, Jesus preached, "The Spirit of The LORD God is upon Me because The LORD has anointed Me to preach" (Isaiah 61:1-2).
 - He preached it more than once because the people needed to hear that Jesus was Anointed, so they would believe on Him.
 - Peter preached that Jesus was the "Christ" just like Jesus did.
 - That's what Philip was preaching at a revival in Samaria (Acts 8:4).
 - That's all the early preachers knew. They preached in the Name of Jesus.
 - You can develop a God-inside consciousness, also.
- II. Praying, speaking and praising in a language that you haven't learned is the gateway to the supernatural.
 - Simon, a sorcerer in Samaria, was born again (Acts 8).
 - When the apostles came to verify and certify that God was saving the Samaritans, they laid hands on the new converts to receive the Holy Spirit.
 - Simon heard and saw the miracles from the hands of the apostles, and he offered them money to give him that same power.
 - Simon was not trying to pay for the gift of the Holy Spirit, he wanted the gift of laying on of hands for others to receive the Holy Spirit.
 - Simon had been a sorcerer and performed signs and wonders by the power of the devil.
 - When he got born again, he could no longer call on the power of evil, but he still wanted miraculous power.



- Peter told Simon, “you have no part in this matter” (See Acts 8:21).
 - *Matter* translated in the Greek is “logos,” or “utterance.”
- III. Saul/Paul was headed to Damascus, not realizing he had an appointment with Jesus.
 - Jesus spoke to Saul on the way to Damascus and said, “Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?” (Acts 9:4, *NKJV*).
 - Jesus said, “Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me” (Matthew 25:40).
 - Don’t gossip or judge. You’re persecuting Jesus.
 - Stop it. You may find it has become a habit that needs to be broken.
 - Saul answered, “LORD!” (Acts 9:5)—and that got him born again (Romans 10:9-10).
 - The LORD told Ananias to lay his hands on Saul to receive his sight and receive the Holy Spirit.
 - At that moment, Saul was filled with the Holy Spirit.
 - We know he spoke in tongues because he later wrote, “I speak in tongues more than all of you put together” (see 1 Corinthians 14:18, *AMPC*).
- IV. For 10 years after the Day of Pentecost, the Church was made up only of Jewish people.
 - One day, Peter fell into a trance and three times saw a sheet from heaven come down with all kinds of animals on it (Acts 10).
 - The LORD told Peter to eat, but Peter refused saying he only ate what was permitted in the Mosaic Law.
 - Then, The LORD sent Peter to a gentile’s house (Cornelius) to preach about Jesus. They were all born again and filled with the Holy Spirit.
- V. Everywhere He went, Jesus preached the message of His Anointing (Luke 4:18-19).
 - Jesus was The WORD which God sent to the children of Israel preaching peace by the Anointing.
 - Jesus is LORD of all, “How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good...” (Acts 10:38).
 - The good that Jesus did was to go about teaching, preaching and healing (Matthew 9). We are to follow His example.
