### DAY 1 – LEARNING TO LIVE WELL

Jesus, the Healer, is here! You need to be both willing and obedient to receive from God. Gloria Copeland began Healing School in 1979, and in every meeting, people get healed. The Hebrew word translated *health* can also be translated *medicine*.

### STUDY IT

- I. Jesus, the Healer, is here!
  - Thank You, Jesus, for being here and for sowing Your life into us. You are still giving Your life for us because You ever make intercession for us.
  - Because of You, we will live in good health.
  - Quote from Gloria Copeland: “If you do what’s right in the natural and supernatural, you can live in divine health.”
  - Hold up your Bible and make this confession:
    - “This is my Bible. This is God speaking to me. I have what it says I have. I can do what it says I can do. It says, ‘By His stripes I was healed.’ If I *was* healed, then I *am* healed. I thank my God, especially Jesus, who bought my healing and put this covenant in my hand.”
  - Continue to praise God.
    - Brother Hagin said: “If you praise long enough, the Spirit of worship will come—then the glory falls.”
- II. You need to be both willing and obedient to receive from God.
  - “If you are willing and obedient, you will eat the good of the land” (Isaiah 1:19).
  - “My son, forget not my law or teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments; for length of days and years of a life [worth living] and tranquility [inward and outward and continuing through old age till death], these shall they add to you” (Proverbs 3:1-2, *AMPC*).
    - God says, “I’ve done this for you, now receive and accept it.”
    - It will be a life worth living; a BLESSED life; a healed life.
  - It’s important to spend time every day putting your eyes on God’s WORD.



- “Let my WORD, my sayings, not depart from your eyes. Keep them in the midst of your heart for they are life” (see Proverbs 4:20-22).
  - Keep God’s WORD in your eyes and ears because that’s God speaking to you.
- III. Gloria Copeland began Healing School in 1979, and in every meeting, people get healed.
- Jerry Savelle suffered a massive stroke and the doctors said he would not fully recover.
    - We prayed for him and stood on The WORD of God.
    - Brother Jerry spent his life finding and preaching healing scriptures that were health to his flesh.
    - God’s WORD was inside him, even though his mind couldn’t get ahold of it.
    - The WORD continued to work in him until he just walked out of that stroke and all of the aftereffects.
- IV. The Hebrew word translated *health* can also be translated *medicine*.
- The Bible is your medicine.
  - Gloria says: “You can’t overdose on it, and the side effects are marvelous. Take it three times a day. If you need more, double the dosage.”
  - You can then have a life worth living, healed and well.
  - “Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever” (Hebrews 13:8)! He never changes.
    - Ten thousand years from now, God will be the same loving, good, wonderful, kind Jesus that He is today.

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

To live well is to live healed and healthy. God promised you health whether your condition seems small and unimportant or huge and totally impossible!

Follow these steps on a continual basis and expect God to work on your behalf.

1. Believe God wants you well.
2. Speak that God wants you well.
3. Find verses in God’s WORD that reinforce your belief.
4. See yourself well.
5. Be thankful to God even before you receive your healing.
6. Refuse to think any thoughts of doubt or speak any words of doubt about your wellness.

### DAY 2 – GOD'S HAND OF HEALING IS OPEN TO YOU

God's hand of healing is open to you. God blesses everything in creation with favor. The prophet Isaiah, by direction of the Spirit of God, introduced Jesus as the Healer. Great multitudes followed Jesus, and He healed them all.

### STUDY IT

- I. God's hand of healing is open to you.
  - "Every day will I BLESS thee" (Psalm 145:1).
  - Have you BLESSED The LORD today?
  - This is the "God is good" Psalm.
  - The LORD is good to all. His tender mercy is over everything He has created.
  - God is a good God, and He is good to all, sinner and saint alike.
    - John Copeland and Markus Bishop have built and operate a recovery center for men with addiction problems called Recovery Bay.
- II. God blesses everything in creation with favor (Psalm 145:16).
  - God is not stingy. His hand is open to you.
  - God is THE BLESSER, not the destroyer (Psalm 145:20). The wicked in this Psalm are the enemies of Israel.
  - The Bible speaks to us today. David's psalms speak to us.
  - According to the Jews, Psalm 23 begins with, "The Psalm of David. The LORD is my Shepherd."
  - We're living in Psalm 23 right now.
    - It was written for us, the born-again believers.
    - "I shall not want." We have no lack, no want, because it is God's desire for us to prosper and be in health, even as our intellectual part prospers (see 3 John 2).



- III. The prophet Isaiah, by direction of the Spirit of God, introduced Jesus as the Healer.
- “Surely He has borne our griefs (sicknesses, weaknesses, and distresses) and carried our sorrows and pains [of punishment],” (Isaiah 53:4, *AMPC*).
    - Pastors and ministers should believe and teach that Jesus bore our griefs and sicknesses, sorrows and pains so we don’t have to bear them.
  - “Sorrow not” (1 Thessalonians 4:13) is the same word for *grief*. “Grieve not”: That’s a commandment.
    - We are not a people without hope. We have hope to see our believing loved ones again.
- IV. Great multitudes followed Jesus, and He healed them all.
- Jesus healed all who were sick, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: “Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses” (Matthew 8:17).
    - He did that to prove the will of God to the people.
    - No person ever came to Jesus for healing who didn’t receive his/her healing.
  - Jesus would always say, “I will come and heal him/her.”

### DAY 3 – THE HEM OF HIS GARMENT IS HERE FOR YOU

Jesus healed them all. The woman with the issue of blood believed she was healed before the manifestation of that healing came. Jesus is the Healer! The people came to hear Jesus. God told Jehoshaphat, “You don’t need to fight in this battle.”

#### STUDY IT

- I. Jesus healed them all.
  - “And great multitudes followed him; and he healed them there” (Matthew 19:2).
  - Jesus didn’t look at people through the eyes of condemnation or the eyes of the law and the curse.
    - Jesus looked at them through the eyes of the God who so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son (John 3:16).
  - Jesus just touched people, and they were healed and made whole.
  - The word *whole* in Greek—*sozo*—means “made sound, healed, delivered and saved.”
- II. The woman with the issue of blood believed she was healed before the manifestation of that healing came (Mark 5:27-28).
  - She knew if she touched Jesus’ prayer shawl, she would be whole. The Anointing of God was in that garment.
  - Obviously, she had forgiven all those doctors who took her money and could not make her well, because faith doesn’t work in an unforgiving heart.
  - The hem of His garment, or Jesus’ Anointed presence, is available to you now.
  - The Spirit of Healing, the Holy Spirit of God, is literally the hem of His garment.
  - The Bible is the promise of healing and the promissory note that it is available.
- III. Jesus is the Healer!
  - “The Spirit of The LORD is upon me, because He’s anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor, heal the broken hearted, preach deliverance to the captives, recovering of sight to the blind, set at liberty them that are bruised, and preach the acceptable year of The LORD” (Luke 4:18-19).



- The gospel of Luke gives account of people talking about Jesus' power to heal and cast out demons (Luke 4:40).
  - Jesus was the first man to ever be born from death to life.
    - Jesus had to undo what the devil brought to pass through Adam, and He did it for us.
    - The devil has lost his authority. Jesus has already defeated him.
- IV. The people came to hear Jesus.
- "Faith comes by hearing and hearing by The WORD of God" (Romans 10:17).
    - Hearing brought faith—faith for healing.
  - The words that are entering into your ears, your eyes and your heart are bringing faith. Faith is coming.
  - When you got born again, you received the faith of God, the God kind of faith. It works by the God kind of love.
  - If you need healing, get in His presence.
- V. God told Jehoshaphat, "You don't need to fight in this battle.
- The LORD said, "The battle is Mine, the victory is yours" (see 2 Chronicles 20:15).
  - The LORD is good. *Good*, sometimes translated *mercy* in English, is *chesed* in Hebrew.
    - The word *chesed* means "lovingkindness and tender mercies."
  - The Israelites sang of God's goodness and His covenant *chesed*, and God defeated the enemy (see 2 Chronicles 20:21).
  - God's mercy still endures forever, and He is a good God!

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

Pay attention to this key for healing:

Faith comes by hearing (and hearing and hearing and hearing) The WORD of God.

God cannot do the hearing part for you. You have to do it. You have to *read* God's WORD and *focus* on what you are reading.

It's up to you to hear. Then faith—belief—will come, and you will be healed!

### DAY 4 – A LIFE WORTH LIVING PLANS TO LIVE LONG AND STRONG

Keep The WORD in your eyes, ears and heart for a life worth living. The healing power is working here and now. Brother Copeland plans to live a life worth living—no matter what his age is.

#### STUDY IT

- I. Keep The WORD in your eyes, ears and heart for a life worth living.
  - Bartimaeus said, “Jesus, Son of David, Messiah, have mercy on me, have *chesed* on me.”
    - He was calling for the *chesed* of the Father.
    - *Chesed* means lovingkindness and tender mercies.
  - Jesus asked him, “What do you need?” Bartimaeus answered, “I need my eyesight.”
  - Jesus said, “Your faith has made you whole.”
    - That meant he had his family, money and everything back, because *chesed* had been delivered to him. He had been made whole.
  - Faith in Jesus and the Anointing of Jesus healed him.
- II. The healing power is working here and now.
  - Jesus is the same today as He was when He healed on earth (Hebrews 13:8).
  - Jesus touched the two blind men, they received their eyesight, and they followed Him (Matthew 20:30).
    - The word got out that Jesus preached recovery of sight to the blind.
  - Get ready; start checking yourself for healing.
  - Years ago, Brother Copeland had a sprained ankle.
    - At that time, Brother Hagin was in town preaching a meeting, and Kenneth and Gloria attended. He preached faith.
    - When Kenneth stood up to praise The LORD, he walked out with no pain. He got his healing!



- III. Brother Copeland plans to live a life worth living—no matter what his age is.
- He is in his 85th year, and he intends to live out his life with no sickness or disease and stay strong all the way to the end.
  - “Rejoice and pray without ceasing (see 1 Thessalonians 5:16-17). You can pray in the grocery line and in the car.
  - Brother Copeland claims Holy Ghost immunity, and he takes vitamin and mineral supplements.
  - Quench not the Spirit. Despise not prophesyings. Give thanks (see 1 Thessalonians 5:18-20).
  - Don’t give thanks for the mess; the giving of thanks is the will of God for you.
    - “The very God of peace sanctify you wholly, and I pray God your whole spirit, soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our LORD Jesus Christ. Faithful is He who promised who also will do it” (1 Thessalonians 5:23-24).
  - That’s the way you stay well!

### DAY 5 – A LIFE WORTH LIVING PUTS FIRST THINGS FIRST

It is so wonderful to understand and to know how to live by faith. The kingdom of God should be your priority. In 2004, a disk exploded in Brother Copeland's back. Jesus said, "Greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father."

### STUDY IT

- I. It is so wonderful to understand and to know how to live by faith.
  - We are learning more and more how to live and walk according to the laws of faith, and we never have to change our lifestyle because of the economic times.
  - We must stay steady on God's WORD.
  - God gives us the victory. He always causes us to triumph!
  - The LORD ministered to Brother Copeland: *I want your desires to be met, and I have provided a way for your every desire to be experienced.*
    - "Therefore I say unto you, what things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them" (Mark 11:24).
- II. The kingdom of God should be your priority.
  - You are a citizen of the kingdom of God.
  - You can't serve God and the money system.
  - "Take no thought for your life: what you shall eat, drink or wear" (see Matthew 6:25).
  - "Take no thought, saying..." (Matthew 6:31).
    - The way you take a thought is by saying it.
    - If the devil gives you a thought, let it die. If you say it, repent.
  - That's a very important rule of faith.
- III. Seek first things first.
  - Food, clothes and family are not first. The kingdom of God is first.
    - "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you" (Matthew 6:33).
  - God has given you the Kingdom; so, come to the King!
  - Don't start worrying about tomorrow. Don't start your day seeking other things.



- Go straight to the kingdom of God. Spend time first in God's WORD and praise Him. Every day, seek God's kingdom.
- IV. In 2004, a disk exploded in Brother Copeland's back. He was in excruciating pain.
- Jesus said, "Take no thought, saying..." (Matthew 6:31).
    - As he sat in his backyard believing for healing, he praised and thanked God for anything he could think of. The pain would subside.
    - The LORD said, *Don't take the pain, saying!*
    - Brother Copeland said in faith, "Thank God I'm healed. I call myself pain free." It wasn't long until he was completely pain free.
  - It's time we began to live and to think like citizens of God's kingdom—the Love kingdom.
- V. Jesus said, "Greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father" (John 14:12).
- Think about the greatest miracle you've ever seen. Jesus can do even better.
    - You'll say, "That's the best I've ever seen"—until next time. Then come the greater works, and then more greater works will you do.
  - We are walking into those greater works right now. We're going to see limbs put back on people's bodies.
  - There was a lady who was crippled, and she had never had a new pair of shoes.
    - She listened to Brother Hagin's tapes for six months, her foot straightened out, and she grew a little toe.
    - She is now wearing shoes!
  - In healing school, a woman brought up her 12-year-old boy who had been born without any nostrils.
    - Jesus gave the boy nostrils in that service, and he started breathing through them!
