



THE PRESCRIPTION FOR HEALING

DAY 1 – REACH OUT AND TAKE YOUR HEALING

God is the Healer. Faith is a powerful, spiritual force that is more powerful than natural, seen forces. Your faith is expressed first in your words.

STUDY IT

- I. God is the Healer.
 - God has healing mercies. He always provides healing for His people. He gave us a healing covenant.
 - We also have a forgiveness covenant. He is faithful to forgive us our sins.
 - If you have anything in your life that you need to repent of, do it right now.
 - Forgiveness is not based on feelings—it's based on that law of covenant.
 - Say, "I'm forgiven. I receive it by faith. I receive my cleansing."
 - If you yield to your feelings and worry, it will interfere with your health and interfere with you receiving healing.

- II. Faith is a powerful, spiritual force that is more powerful than natural, seen forces.
 - Faith always speaks. When we believe, we must exercise corresponding action.
 - The WORD has to be believed in the heart, spoken with the mouth, and accompanied by corresponding action. That puts faith on the job!
 - "It is The WORD of faith which we preach"
(Romans 10:8, *New King James Version*).
 - The WORD of God is anointed and brings faith when it is preached.
 - "Whosoever shall call on the Name of The LORD shall be saved" (Acts 2:21).
 - When you call, faith comes, and healing is there.
 - Faith is not something you feel. It's an inevitable result of teaching and preaching The WORD and the covenant of the living God.

- III. Your faith is expressed first in your words.
 - Make this declaration and believe it in your heart:
 - "This is my Bible. This is God speaking to me. I can have what it says I have. I can do what it says I can do. God loves me, He heals and prospers me."





- The fear of death can hinder your healing.
- God does not put physical sickness on anyone.
 - If God touches something, it's healed.
 - When God removes His hand, all the curse comes on it, including sicknesses and plagues.
- Your angel blesses your bread and water and takes sickness from the midst of you (see Exodus 23:25).
 - You can believe God's WORD, take the promise and say: "I will never be sick again in my life hereafter forever. Sickness has been taken from me."
- God's promise is also there to have children (see Exodus 23:26).
 - You'll never be barren. God has taken sickness and it's gone.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

You take your healing by believing and speaking. Your words are crucial, not just when you are battling sickness, but also when you are *not* sick.

Practice speaking in agreement with God's WORD—every day!

Consider using these faith-phrases in your daily life.

- Jesus healed me, and I am healed.
- Because of Jesus, I'll never be sick another day of my life.
- Everything I eat and drink is blessed!
- God loves me. He heals and prospers me every day.
- I can have what God's WORD says I can have.
- I can do what God's WORD says I can do.

Add to the list your own faith-phrases, and let them saturate your heart and mind.



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DAY 2 – THE HEALING PRESCRIPTION

As you listen to faith being preached, faith comes on the inside of you. The directions for the healing prescription are found in Proverbs 4:21-23. The Bible is a healing covenant.

STUDY IT

- I. As you listen to faith being preached, faith comes on the inside of you.
 - The book of Proverbs is a book of covenant promises.
 - Length of days is part of the first covenant. Living according to God's design is a life worth living even through old age—even to death (see Proverbs 3:2, *Amplified Bible, Classic Edition*).
 - You can stand on, believe, love and walk in these covenant words that are backed in blood.
 - Part of the covenant is a name change.
 - It started with God renaming Abram to Abraham (see Genesis 17:5).
 - An example of the covenant name change is marriage. The wife takes the husband's name when they make covenant.
 - God is a covenant-making God. The covenant is the promise that led to the coming of Jesus.

- II. The directions for the healing prescription are found in Proverbs 4:20-23.
 - "My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh. Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life (Proverbs 4:20-23).
 - The word *health* in the Hebrew can be translated *medicine*.
 - Remember: A prescription does you no good unless you take it.
 - The whole thing about salvation and healing is to believe it in your heart, say it with your mouth, and you shall be saved—the Greek word for *saved* is *sozo*.
 - Salvation and healing can happen at the same time; healing, salvation and deliverance for the spirit, soul and body.



III. The Bible is a healing covenant.

- Years ago, Brother Copeland had a tightness in his left leg. He believed it to be a blood clot.
 - He quoted the scripture, “Let them not depart from your eyes. Keep them in the midst of your heart” (see Proverbs 4:21).
 - He was *quoting* the healing scriptures, but he needed to *read* the words—put his eyes on them.
- Remembering a potato and what it tastes like will not nourish your body. You have to get the food inside the system.
- Put your eyes on God’s WORD. Believe it and get it into the spiritual system, inside of you, where it can work.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

The spiritual prescription is yours for the taking. It’s a matter of believing and speaking God’s WORD. He responds to your faith, and He never fails.

Based on Proverbs 4:20-23 you can make this faith declaration. Speak it three times a day; and in an emergency, double the dose!

I read, listen and obey God’s WORD with joy and expectation. I refuse to let His WORD leave my eyes or my heart, for I know His WORDS are life and health to me. I guard my heart from evil distractions. Every issue in life is addressed in God’s WORD, and I seek His direction so that my life is full of abundance.



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DAY 3 – HOW TO STAY WELL

Stay well by taking the spiritual healing prescription. The little tabs in Brother Copeland's Bible mark healing scriptures. The way we stay well, the way we live, is by taking the prescription. You have to receive by faith.

STUDY IT

- I. Stay well by taking the spiritual healing prescription (Proverbs 4:20-23).
 - Once, a disk exploded in Brother Copeland's back. The pain was extreme. He spoke healing scriptures but was still in pain.
 - Gloria called Dr. Weeter for treatment, then Brother Copeland was flown to see Dr. Colbert.
 - Brother Copeland asked The LORD why he was still in pain.
 - The LORD answered that he was not spending time in The WORD to receive healing. He was only studying to build his faith to preach.
- II. The little tabs in Brother Copeland's Bible mark healing scriptures.
 - He puts those scriptures in his eyes and in his heart, and will not let them escape, in order to see himself well—healed.
 - When pain comes, don't take it by saying what the pain is. Say instead, "I'm healed in the Name of Jesus."
 - One night, while walking through the living room in the dark, Brother Copeland kicked a footstool and broke his toe.
 - Immediately, he hollered, "Thank You, Jesus. I'm healed!"
 - He went to bed and to sleep by faith, declaring he was healed and refusing to acknowledge the pain.
 - The next day, he went about his business, closed a deal on an airplane and realized his toe was healed.
- III. The way we stay well, the way we live, is by taking the prescription.
 - If you need medical help, get it; but go to faith first.



- Believe God before you ever call a doctor. Believe God before you say anything to anyone else.
 - “In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you” (1 Thessalonians 5:18, *NKJV*).
 - Brother Copeland didn’t give thanks that he broke his toe, but he did give thanks in the middle of the pain.
 - The power of thanksgiving in that time of trouble brought the power of God into that toe immediately.
- IV. You have to receive by faith.
- Jesus healed all who were sick (see Matthew 8:16, 12:15).
 - Jesus is so easy to receive from. He heals all who will receive it.
 - “Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today and forever” (Hebrews 13:8).
 - This same Jesus who healed and raised the dead yesterday, you can know today.
 - “Great is The LORD and greatly to be praised. The LORD is gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger, abounding in mercy and lovingkindness. The LORD is good to all” (see Psalm 145:3, 6-9).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Jesus healed all who came to Him while He was on earth, and He will heal you!

Let’s pray together:

Jesus, I come to You asking for healing. In Your WORD, You said You healed all who came to You for healing if they came in faith. I call on You now, Jesus. I believe You are the Healer. I believe You shed Your blood to save, heal and deliver me. You took stripes so that I can be healed. I believe You want me well. Now, in Your Name, I receive my healing! Thank You, Sir. You are gracious and full of compassion. You are abounding in mercy and lovingkindness; and You are good to all and good to me! I pray in Jesus’ Name. Amen!



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DAY 4 – LIVING IN THE RIGHT KIND OF DENIAL

Great multitudes followed Jesus, and He healed them. Brother Copeland has been accused of being in denial, and it's true. Multitudes came to hear Jesus and be healed. Jesus was the Son of David in genealogy, and He was the Messiah, the "Son of David."

STUDY IT

- I. Great multitudes followed Jesus, and He healed them (see Matthew 19:2).
 - Jesus healed because of His calling and His compassion.
 - Jesus preached: "The Spirit of The LORD is upon me for He has anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor and the acceptable year of The LORD"—which was debt cancellation (see Luke 4:18-19).
 - Jesus went to Simon's house, and his wife's mother had a great fever similar to typhoid (see Luke 4:38-39).
 - Jesus spoke to the fever, and Peter's mother-in-law was healed.
 - You can speak to sickness and fever, too, and see people healed.

- II. Brother Copeland has been accused of being in denial, and it's true.
 - He doesn't deny that the disease exists—he denies its right to exist in his body.
 - Years ago, Brother Copeland brought his family into the living room, and told them they were going to take their flu shots.
 - He went back and forth several times proclaiming the *effects* of the curse and the truth that they were *redeemed* from the curse of the law (see Deuteronomy 28:22; Galatians 3:13).
 - After examining and praying the scriptures together, Brother Copeland announced, "Now, you have been vaccinated against the flu."
 - One day, his daughter Kellie came home from school with symptoms of sickness.
 - Brother Copeland told her, "You are not the sick trying to get healed. You are the healed and the devil's trying to take your health away from you."
 - She went to her bedroom, prayed and came out healed.



- III. Multitudes came to hear Jesus and be healed.
 - Our sweet Jesus, our Savior didn't stop until all of them were healed. Sometimes, He healed through the night until daylight of the next day.
 - In talking to Rick Renner, our friend who is a Greek scholar and an apostle to Russia, said that anywhere from 20,000 to 50,000 people followed Jesus everywhere He went.
 - Jesus told His disciples to preach, teach, heal, cast out devils and raise the dead. Freely you have received, freely give.
 - That's also your job—preach, teach, heal, cast out devils and raise the dead.

- IV. Jesus was the Son of David in genealogy, and He was the Messiah—the “Son of David.”
 - The phrase, “Son of David,” is key to getting Jesus’ attention. Watch for it all the way through the gospels.
 - When a blind man, Bartimaeus, heard that Jesus was walking by, he said, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy, have *chesed*, (covenant mercy) on me (see Mark 10:46-52).
 - Jesus heard him and stood still.
 - Blind Bartimaeus had on a legal garment that allowed him to beg. He had been tested by the priests for the right to beg.
 - Bartimaeus got up, took off his coat and said, “I don't need this coat anymore.” It was an act of faith, and Jesus saw it.
 - Jesus said to him, “What wilt thou that I should do unto thee?” It ought to have been obvious—the man couldn't see.
 - Bartimaeus needed to say it! “I want to receive my sight!” And he did!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Ask and you shall receive! Just like Bartimaeus, ask Jesus for what you want.

Write your request, and what your corresponding action of faith will be:



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DAY 5 – WALKING THE LOVE LINE

The law of faith—I believe, therefore, I speak, and then I know God will perform His WORD. God changed Abram's name to Abraham—the covenant name change. Unforgiveness is a BLESSING blocker. The love walk is walking in faith and forgiveness.

STUDY IT

- I. The law of faith—I believe, therefore, I speak, and then I know God will perform His WORD.
 - “We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak; knowing that he which raised up The LORD Jesus shall raise up us also by Jesus, and shall present us with you” (2 Corinthians 4:13-14).
 - Brother Copeland demonstrates the line of faith. On one side is faith; on the other is the curse.
 - We are part of the second covenant established in the blood of Jesus.
 - Look in the covenant, and find the scriptures that cover your situation—that's the answer to your prayer.
 - Alter your lifestyle to fit whatever you see in The WORD.
 - Take it as final authority in your life, and don't try to change it. That's where the victory is.
 - Once you step across that line into faith, what you say is done.
 - Say: “I believe in my heart based on God's WORD. I believe I receive my healing when I pray. I'm healed.”
 - That's what Brother Copeland did in that crisis with his back.
 - Confess your healing every morning.
- II. God changed Abram's name to Abraham—the covenant name change.
 - Abraham's new name established him as the father of many nations (see Genesis 17:5).
 - Abraham is our father. He fathered the faith, calling things that be not as though they were (Romans 4:17).



- Say, by faith, what you want.
- Brother Copeland spoke a word from The LORD:
 - *When you no longer have understanding and your mind no longer has words, switch over into My land, saith The LORD. Come over into the Spirit with Me and begin to speak My language. I will give you the utterance, and you speak it out. As you do so and as you call things in the Spirit, the devil hears you and he understands certain things that you say, and you'll stand up and say "It's finished, it's over," and I'll back you up, saith The LORD.*
- Brother Copeland speaks in the spirit by faith as much as he does in his natural language. He sings in the spirit.
 - Brother Copeland prays in the spirit for his Partners and this nation, and he ministers in the spirit by faith.
- Pray in tongues by faith, and The LORD will agree, and you'll get what you prayed for.
 - Say, "I believe that I receive what I prayed in English and in other tongues in Jesus' Name."
 - God will answer your prayers—whether you pray in your native language or with other tongues.
- Jesus said His burden is light (see Matthew 11:30), because He's going to carry them for you.
- This is a life worth living!

III. Unforgiveness is a BLESSING blocker.

- Faith will not work in an unforgiving heart.
- Forgiveness is already bought and paid for by the blood of Jesus.
 - It is there for the taking, but if you won't forgive someone else, God *can't* forgive you.
- Stay in faith, and stay in repentance all the time.

IV. The love walk is walking in faith and forgiveness. Everything outside of the love walk is the curse.

- Put on the armor of God, that's God's suit. With the faceplate down, the devil can't tell if it's God or you (Ephesians 6:13, 17). Suit up!
- Faith demands corresponding action.
 - The woman healed of the issue of blood believed if she touched the hem of Jesus' garment, she would be healed. She said it, and she did it—*before* she felt it (Mark 5:25-28).
- Say this: "I'm not moved by what I feel or what I see. I'm moved only by what I believe, and I believe The WORD of God."
