# DAY 1 – THERE IS POWER IN THE NAME OF JESUS

When Jesus was raised from the dead, God spoke. Adam was the god of this world, but then, he gave his lease to the devil. Go to God's WORD and the original author of The WORD, the Holy Spirit, to get the exact understanding of the Name. The power of God is in the Name of Jesus.

- I. When Jesus was raised from the dead, God spoke (Hebrews 1:6, 8).
  - God said, "Let all the angels of God worship him."
  - "But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of thy kingdom."
    - o A scepter is a staff or baton used by a sovereign as an emblem of authority.
    - When the king pointed his scepter at a common person, he or she became an equal in the king's court.
  - When Brother Copeland cried out to God, Jesus came into his heart on Nov. 2, 1962.
    - Jesus pointed the scepter of righteousness at Brother Copeland, and he became equal to Jesus.
  - Our words in the court of heaven count because we have been named after Him.
- II. Adam was the god of this world, but then, he gave his lease to the devil.
  - Mankind lost THE BLESSING, and God immediately sought to get that BLESSING back into the earth in full power.
  - We have a weapon, the Name of Jesus.
  - They didn't have the Name of Jesus as a weapon in the first covenant, but David used it because he was a covenant-minded man.
    - He said to Goliath, an uncircumcised Philistine, "I come to you in the Name of The LORD God of Hosts" (see 1 Samuel 17:45).
    - David invoked the angelic armies of God. He came at Goliath with God's Name—the Name that is above every name.





- III. Go to God's WORD and the original author of The WORD, the Holy Spirit, to get the exact understanding of the Name.
  - The Old Testament gives several names of God that show His character and power.
    - Jehovah Ropheka, Jehovah Jireh, Jehovah Rapha, Jehovah Tsidkenu and Jehovah Shalom.
      - Some Christians thought God and poverty were tied together with a short rope. That's an absolute lie.
      - *Shalom* means "nothing missing, nothing broken." God is absolute good.
    - The names of God continue with Jehovah Shamma, Jehovah Nissi and Jehovah Sabboath.
    - o Those are the redemptive Names of the Most High.
  - "He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty" (Psalm 91:1).
    - o There is no higher office, no higher place.
  - Jesus was exalted from hell to the throne, and that's what has happened to us.
- IV. The power of God is in the Name of Jesus.
  - The beggar at the gate of the Temple expected to receive something from Peter and John (see Acts 3:5-10).
    - o Peter said, "In the Name of Jesus rise up and walk."
    - o The man who had been crippled walked, leaped and praised God.
    - o Through faith in Jesus' Name, this man was made strong.
    - o The power was in that Name.
  - Miracles don't cause faith; they cause people to wonder and investigate.
  - The Name of Jesus can do anything He says He can do.
    - o Faith in that Name is having faith in Jesus!

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## DAY 2 - THE NAME OF JESUS IS THE MASTER KEY

Jesus *inherited* His Name from God. His Name was *conferred* upon Him by the Father. Jesus achieved the authority in His Name by *conquest* over the devil. The Name of Jesus is the Master Key.

- I. Jesus *inherited* His Name from God (see Hebrews 1:4).
  - The power in His Name can only be measured by the power of the One from whom He inherited it.
    - You can't measure the power behind the Name of Jesus because you can't measure God's power.
  - Jesus humbled Himself even to death on the cross and became a sacrifice for us (see Philippians 2:8).
  - He was *made* to be sin for us, that we might be *made* the righteousness of God in Him (see 2 Corinthians 5:21).
- II. Jesus' Name was *conferred* upon Him by the Father (see Luke 22:29, *AMPC*). The Father called Him by His Name.
  - Let the mind of Christ be in you (see Philippians 2:5).
  - You have to *let* Jesus' mind be in you.
  - We are joint heirs with Him (see Romans 8:17).
  - Jesus sits at the right hand of the Father; we sit at the right hand of Jesus (see Ephesians 1:20, 2:6).
- III. Jesus achieved the authority in His Name by *conquest* over the devil (see Colossians 2:15).
  - Jesus had to become obedient to death.
  - Jesus' conquest over satan in hell ended in the defeat of the devil (see Hebrews 2:14).
  - The devil is a fallen angel and all of his emissaries are fallen beings.
    - o At least one-third of the angels followed him—the angels of death.





- Jesus had to have faith to die.
  - He never did anything wrong. He had to yield and humble Himself and become obedient to death because of you and me.
  - o He had to go to hell and pay the price.
- We had to have faith in Jesus to be born again.
- IV. The Name of Jesus is the Master Key.
  - The keys of the Kingdom give us access to everything—and they are all in God's WORD.
    - There are covenant keys and revelation keys that open treasure vaults of different kinds—because the Name will open every heavenly door.
  - Your spirit has been circumcised by the sword of the Spirit (see Colossians 2:11; Ephesians 6:17).
    - o In the spirit, you have a cut, a scar, where you died.
    - You were killed with The WORD of God; nevertheless you live. Christ in you is the hope of glory (see Galatians 2:20; Colossians 1:27).
  - God has freely forgiven us and blotted out the ordinances that were against us (see Colossians 2:14). They are canceled—wiped out.
  - The devil trusts in fear; that's his weapon. Jesus stripped him of everything else.

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# DAY 3 - THE NAME OF JESUS COVERS IT ALL

There is only One who is your champion and older blood brother—it's Jesus. The Name of Jesus covers it all. Jesus locked onto Psalm 22 and didn't let go. It got Him through hell. The Name of Jesus, given among men and women, is the power weapon.

- I. There is only One who is your champion and older blood brother—it's Jesus.
  - E.W. Kenyan's book *The Blood Covenant* describes in detail what the blood covenant, sealed with the blood of Jesus, did for the believer.
  - Brother Copeland got so excited when he realized that Jesus Christ is his blood brother by covenant. It changed his entire existence.
- II. The Name of Jesus covers it all.
  - Jesus went to the depths of the pit and was tortured. He took it all and suffered there (see Acts 2:24).
  - At that time, heaven was in the bosom of Abraham, protected in the upper regions of the dead.
  - The words that raised Jesus from the dead: "Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee. And again, I will be to him a Father, and he shall be to me a Son" (see Hebrews 1:5).
  - The Name is with us. Jesus doesn't need it in heaven, but we on earth need it.
    - It is a weapon in the hands of the Church against all wickedness, the devil and everything he stands for.
  - When a born-again child of God who has faith in that Name begins to speak it, all
    of hell trembles.
    - o The devil will never forget it. In hell, Jesus stripped satan of everything.
    - o Jesus made the devil bow before Him and took satan's keys away.
- III. Jesus locked onto Psalm 22 and didn't let go. It got Him through hell.
  - "My God, why has thou forsaken Me?" (Psalm 22:1).
    - Jesus was praising God in hell (see Psalm 22:22).





- o He said, "It is finished" (see John 19:30).
- Redemption wasn't finished when Jesus entered hell from the cross. It had three days and three nights to go.
- So, what was finished? The Abrahamic covenant was complete.
  - A new covenant was being put in place right then.
  - It was the second covenant, the power covenant, where all the rest of us could come in with Jesus.
- IV. The Name of Jesus, given among men and women, is the power weapon (see Acts 4:10).
  - Prayer is a great weapon—but not without the Name of Jesus. Prayer has no authority without the Name.
  - Believe on and in the Name.
  - The Name of The LORD is a high power where you look down on the devil.
  - You have the power of attorney to use the Name of Jesus.
  - Jesus' Name can do anything Jesus can do.

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# DAY 4 – GOD'S GREAT AND ABUNDANT GOODNESS

God is a good God. He is all good. God's great and abundant goodness is for all who will receive it. You can drive cattle, but you must lead sheep. They follow a shepherd. God's goodness was evident at Creation. God's glory *is* His goodness.

- I. God is a good God. He is all good.
  - Jesus responded to the young man who called Him good Rabbi, saying, "Why do you call Me good? There's none good but One" (Matthew 19:17).
  - Jesus did not take any praise that belonged to His Father.
    - Jesus said, "I can do nothing of Myself" (John 5:30). "It is the Father within Me, He does the works. I only say what I hear Him say, and only do what I see Him do."
  - Oral Roberts said all the time, "God is a good God."
    - o That was his theme song at all his meetings.
    - Brother Roberts would say, "Something good is going to happen to you today!"
- II. God's great and abundant goodness is for all who will receive it (see Psalm 145:6-9).
  - The children of Israel had been in captivity for over 400 years and had almost no knowledge of their covenants.
  - Moses took the 12 tribes to two mountains (Deuteronomy 27:12-13). This was responsive shouting.
    - One group on one mountain would shout THE BLESSING, and the other group on the other mountain would shout the curse.
    - When people discovered and began to preach THE BLESSING and curse in Deuteronomy 28, they didn't go back and read Deuteronomy 27.
- III. You can drive cattle, but you must lead sheep. They follow a shepherd.
  - Jesus is the Shepherd. He won't drive you; He'll lead you and love you.
  - When The LORD wanted Brother Copeland to speak prophetically, he wouldn't
    do it because he didn't want to make a mistake.





- The LORD told him he was making a bigger mistake by not doing what He told him to do. The mistake is: not trusting The LORD; not stepping out in faith.
- IV. God's goodness was evident at Creation.
  - There is an untold amount of time between Genesis 1:1 and Genesis 1:2.
  - "The Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters" (Genesis 1:2).
    - o God did not create this earth in a flooded state. It was flooded in judgment before the Creation we read about in Genesis 1.
    - Noah's flood wasn't the first one; this one was.
  - The Genesis account says, "God saw that it was good" (see Genesis 1:4,10, 12, 18, 21, 25, 31).
    - o God is a good God, and He didn't create anything but good.
    - But there was something not good (see Genesis 2:18). It was not good that the man be alone.
  - Adam was exactly like God. He was as smart as God; he was in God's image before he fell.
    - o Adam named every living thing (see Genesis 2:19).
  - God took one of his ribs and made a woman. She was handmade by God for Adam (see Genesis 2:21-23).
  - When they fell, their faith in God turned into fear (see Genesis 3:10).
  - The first covenant in animal's blood was God providing clothes for His family (see Genesis 3:21).
- V. God's glory is His goodness.
  - Moses spoke to God face to face (Exodus 33:11).
  - Moses said to God, "I want to see Your *glory*" (see Exodus 33:18-19).
    - o God said, "I will make all My *goodness* pass before you"
    - o His goodness is His glory, and His glory is His goodness.
  - God is absolute goodness and there is no badness in Him—none!

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# DAY 5 – THE NAME OF GREATNESS IS OURS!

We need to have knowledge of the Name of Jesus and our authority in that Name. God has given us authority and His armor. Cherokee artifacts have been found with pictorial writing in the ancient Paleo-Hebrew language. God's Name is so powerful. His power and glory are so awesome.

- I. We need to have knowledge of the Name of Jesus and our authority in that Name.
  - Everything God created was perfect, including Lucifer, an archangel.
  - He is described as the *prince* of Tyrus and the *king* of Tyrus (Ezekiel 28:2, 12-15).
  - Iniquity was found in Lucifer, and he became the devil.
    - o He had no tempter. He invented the lie; he is the father of lies.
  - There is another description of Lucifer, son of the morning (Isaiah 14:9-16).
    - He was here on earth and when he sinned, God changed his name to satan.
    - o Lucifer, the devil, wanted to be in charge and rule in God's place.
  - The fossil records that support beings on this earth before mankind are true.
    - There was another race of people on this earth. They were under the rule of Lucifer and were destroyed as a result of the devil's sin.
- II. God has given us authority in the Name of Jesus and His armor.
  - "Finally, my brethren, be strong in The LORD, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand" (Ephesians 6:10-13).
  - Daniel was told of these demons of spiritual wickedness in high places (Daniel 10:2-3, 10-13, 19-20).
    - o Daniel was fasting to know God's will concerning the Jews.
    - The demon prince of Persia held back Gabriel, the messenger angel, until Michael, archangel of the armies of God, came to help him.





- III. Cherokee artifacts have been found with pictorial writing.
  - Professor Greg Stephens shares that this writing is in the ancient Paleo-Hebrew language.
    - o It depicts the Name of The LORD—the pictures that represent the Hebrew letters *Yud, Hey, Vav, Hey.*
    - o The pictures are: Behold, the Hand, Behold, the Nail. It's a picture symbol so they would recognize Him when He came.
- IV. God's Name is so powerful. His power and glory are so awesome.
  - The Name of Jesus is above all the names in heaven and earth.
  - Every part of creation must bow its knee to that Name.
  - We know that Name!
    - It is the Name of goodness, the Name of power, the Name of wonders, the Name of greatness, and it's ours!
