DAY 1 – FINDING WISDOM

Wisdom is the principal thing. Get it! Go after it! The wisdom of God is stored up for us. When we ask God for something, we are acknowledging He is our Source. When you are born again, you have the Spirit of The LORD in you.

STUDY IT

- I. Wisdom is the principal thing. Get it! Go after it!
 - God will give you what you ask for *if* you ask in faith, nothing wavering (see James 1:6-7). Otherwise, you won't get anything from The LORD.
 - Keep one hand on faith and the other on the Love of God. Everything is received by faith.
 - "Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses]" (Hebrews 11:1, *AMPC*).
 - If it isn't *now*, it isn't faith.
 - Faith provides the title deed; the proof of what we do not see; proving as fact to our physical senses.
 - Jesus is made unto us wisdom, righteousness and sanctification (see 1 Corinthians 1:30).
 - God offers you His wisdom. We have two witnesses: James, and Paul in 1 Corinthians.
 - Out of the mouth of two witnesses let it be established (see Matthew 18:16).
- II. The wisdom of God is stored up for us (see Proverbs 2:7).
 - We have to receive it by faith.
 - When we were born again, we received Jesus by grace through faith (see Ephesians 2:8). Jesus *is* the gift of grace.
 - We receive the gift of Jesus only by grace through faith.
 - We receive wisdom the same way—by grace through faith.





- The LORD told Sarah Pearsons, *My grace is sufficient for you, and your faith is sufficient for Me.*
 - Ask in faith knowing God wants you to have what you ask for (see James 1:5-6).
- III. When we ask God for something, we are acknowledging He is our Source.
- If we ask and don't receive, it's because we ask amiss.
 - That is, we ask in fear, or we act unworthy to receive from God.
 - We *were* unworthy before we were born again.
 - Now, we have been made the righteousness of God in Him (see 2 Corinthians 5:21).
 - We own the things of God, because He gave them to us.
 - Jesus is at the right hand of the Father and we are at the right hand of Jesus because we are one spirit with Him (see Ephesians 1:20, 2:6).
 - The kingdom of God is within us. We have been raised up together in Him in heavenly places.
 - God made it so easy for us to lay hold of His wisdom. It is a valuable, precious thing. Yet, God made it easy for us to access.
 - He put His wisdom on the inside of us, if we will take it.
 - What grace has deposited is revealed to us, then we draw it up by faith, like from a deep well.
- IV. When you are born again, you have the Spirit of The LORD in you (see Ephesians 1:13).
- The Holy Spirit is *the* very important gift to every born-again believer.
 - You need the Holy Spirit upon you that opens the door to the supernatural, where the anointing is.
 - It gives your Father great pleasure to give the Holy Spirit to those who ask (see Luke 12:32).
 - Ask, knock, seek—and you will have it (see Matthew 7:7-8).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Wisdom doesn't just fall on your head. You must seek it!

If you need wisdom, ask God for help. Read and study His WORD, and listen for His voice to guide you. Trust The LORD with all your heart. Don't lean to your own understanding or experience. The more success you have with following the leading of The LORD, the more confident you will be to continue following Him.



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DAY 2 – FREEDOM FROM ALL GRIEF

Every good gift comes from the Father of lights. When ministering to people who have lost a loved one, agree to put the care over onto The LORD, expecting to hear from Him. The wisdom of God is found in Mark 11:22-25. There's no wisdom in staying in grief and sorrow. When Jesus rose from the dead, He defeated death.

STUDY IT

- I. Every good gift comes from the Father of lights (see James 1:17).
 - When there's trouble, fear will wipe the wisdom of God out of people's minds.
 - People start doing things that they would never do normally.
 - Be ready with the wisdom of God in every situation.

- II. When ministering to people who have lost a loved one, agree to put the care over onto The LORD, expecting to hear from Him.
 - Put the question, "Why, LORD?" away from you. Agree together that we will have the wisdom of God over every situation.
 - There are reasons why someone dies. Usually, it is tied to something they continuously said.

- III. The wisdom of God is found in Mark 11:22-25.
 - "For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith" (Mark 11:23).
 - If you say something long enough, it will get in your spirit and control your life.
 - Brother Copeland physically felt the spirit of fear of the pain of exercise leave when he SAID, "I love to exercise."
 - Even a fool seems wise when he keeps his mouth shut (see Proverbs 17:28).
 - Don't speak the fear or hatred of something. Keep your mouth shut until you have God's wisdom about what to say.

- IV. There's no wisdom in staying in grief and sorrow.
- Sarah's mother passed to heaven in 2021.
 - They had to decide how to respond to death.
 - We have been given the oil of joy for mourning (see Isaiah 61:3).
 - The LORD told Sarah to rejoice with those who rejoice (see Romans 12:15). Her mother in heaven is rejoicing—Sarah rejoices with her.
- V. When Jesus rose from the dead, He defeated death.
- Now we don't have to mourn and be sorrowful. We have died to self in Christ, so stepping into heaven is a glorious thing.
 - "Rejoice in The LORD always: and again I say, Rejoice" (Philippians 4:4)!
 - Sorrow not even as others who have no hope (see 1 Thessalonians 4:13). A better translation is: *grieve not*. That is a commandment to a believer.
 - Grief comes from a sense of loss. Your loved one who was born again is not lost. He or she is in heaven.
 - The spirit of grief and loss is from the spirit of death.
 - Grief and loss are selfish and come from thinking about self.
 - Depression comes by being afraid of losing something in the future.
 - The LORD will give you joy, knowing your loved one is with Him.
 - We look at things, including eternity, through the eyes of faith.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

This lesson has taught us that grief is an evil spirit that tries to make us doubt the wisdom of God. As you face grief or loss, repeat God's WORD of Love.

- 1 Thessalonians 4:13: Sorrow not even as others who have no hope.
- Isaiah 61:3: I have been given the oil of joy for mourning.
- John 11:25: "Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live."
- John 14:2-3: "In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also."
- 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17: "For The LORD himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet The LORD in the air: and so shall we ever be with The LORD."

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DAY 3 – HELP FOR AN ANXIOUS MIND

Love is the primary commandment. Spiritual gifts are manifestations of the Spirit of Love, who is the Spirit of God. Find out what you are worth in the sight of God. Jesus promised you could have whatever you say—especially when you say what God told you to say. The answer to an anxious mind is a thankful heart.

STUDY IT

- I. Love is the primary commandment.
 - Let your thought be, *What would Love do?*
 - Paul relates what The LORD told and taught him about receiving Communion. If we would judge ourselves, we would not be condemned (see 1 Corinthians 11:23-26, 31).

- II. Spiritual gifts are manifestations of the Spirit of Love, who is the Spirit of God (see 1 Corinthians 12:7-11).
 - Remember: No one speaking by the Spirit of God calls Jesus cursed (see 1 Corinthians 12:3).
 - There are various gifts worked by the Spirit of God for the profit of all.
 - The first one listed is the word of wisdom. It's the word of God's wisdom.
 - He has wisdom and knowledge of the future, the nations and the Church.
 - Next in the list of spiritual gifts is the word of knowledge.
 - Brother Copeland operates mostly in the word of knowledge, sometimes about a specific person's life.
 - God said, *I want My Church back. I want the gifts of the Spirit upfront where everyone can see.*
 - The gifts are manifestations of God; they flow together.
 - Kenneth E. Hagin said: "Praying in other tongues is the gateway to the supernatural manifestations of the Spirit."



- III. Find out what you are worth in the sight of God.
 - Do not fear, you are of more value than many sparrows. If you confess Jesus before men, He will confess you before God (see Luke 12:7-8)
 - God can tell you, not only how many hairs are on your head, but also what number each hair has. They are not just numbered; each one has a number (see Luke 12:7). He loves us that much.

- IV. Jesus promised you could have whatever you say—especially when you say what God told you to say (see Mark 11:23-24).
 - Do not worry about what you are going to say in front of governmental judgment (see Luke 12:11).
 - The Holy Spirit will literally put words in your mouth (see Luke 12:11-12).
 - Both God and the enemy are working to get their words in your mouth.
 - If you worry, you will stop the gifts of the word of wisdom and the word of knowledge.

- V. The answer to an anxious mind is a thankful heart.
 - “Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus” (Philippians 4:6-7).
 - Instead of taking the anxiety, substitute thanksgiving.
 - Jesus said, “Why take ye thought, saying?” (Matthew 6:31).
 - Don’t say it. Refuse to think it. Your mind is *your* mind; it doesn’t belong to the devil.
 - Take *God’s* thought and say it.
 - Don’t take pain in your mind. Pain notifies you of problems. “I do not take the pain by saying it.” The LORD bore the pain. He bore our sicknesses and our pains (Isaiah 53:4, *AMPC*).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

The LORD tells us not to worry. Make a list of things that worry you, then using a red pen, write over them “I refuse to worry. I am thankful! Philippians 4:6-8.”



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DAY 4 – YOU'LL KNOW WHAT TO DO

God and His attributes are clearly seen. In 2022, you'll know what to do—you'll know the will of God. God thinks thoughts of peace and good concerning you. Find the answers in God's WORD, and speak them to yourself.

STUDY IT

- I. God and His attributes are clearly seen (see Romans 1:20-22).
 - Unbelievers are without excuse. They are unthankful to God. They have become vain and their foolish hearts darkened.
 - People don't realize the connection between the wisdom of God and the giving of thanks.
 - We are to follow that which is good; rejoice; pray and in everything give thanks (see 1 Thessalonians 5:15-18).
 - Don't give thanks for the problem or trouble, give thanks for God's deliverance.
 - Give thanks because your faith in God's WORD will make you whole.
 - First words are so important. When something happens, make sure your first words are words of praise and faith in the power of God to help and deliver you.

- II. In 2022, you'll know what to do—you'll know the will of God.
 - Start with scriptures that tell you: "This is the will of God."
 - Say, "I know this much, I'm supposed to be giving thanks." That will open the door to know what to do next.
 - When you do what you're told to do, it will open up a deeper understanding of what to do next.
 - Guard your tongue! Train it to speak God's will and His WORD.
 - Jesus said, "Continue as My disciples. You will know the truth and the truth will make you free" (see John 8:31-32).
 - When you know the truth about disease, it will make you free.
 - Refuse to be afraid of diseases or viruses.
 - Get on the joy side. Always stay on the God side of everything. God is Truth and He is Wisdom.



- Prophecy is more than words about nations and people. You are actually the prophet of your own life. You can have a word of wisdom and knowledge about yourself.
- III. God thinks thoughts of peace and good concerning you.
- “For I know the thoughts and plans that I have for you, says The LORD, thoughts and plans for welfare and peace and not for evil, to give you hope in your final outcome. Then you will call upon Me, and you will come and pray to Me, and I will hear, and heed you” (Jeremiah 29:11-12, *AMPC*).
 - God planned your future before the foundation of the world.
 - Don’t make plans for yesterday. Plans belong to the future, not the past. If the past is not on God’s mind, don’t let it be on your mind.
 - God’s thoughts are higher than your thoughts (see Isaiah 55:8-9). He extends an invitation to come up to His way. Start thinking the way He’s thinking.
 - Find out the mind of The LORD for you—the mind of Christ.
 - Say consistently, “Father, I thank You that I have the mind of Christ. I know all things. I have an unction from the Holy One and I know what to do.”
- IV. Find the answers in God’s WORD, and speak them to yourself.
- Kenneth misplaced his car keys so he borrowed Gloria’s car. When he started her car, there was a message: “Battery in smart key low.” He was able to replace the battery. It was good to know her key battery needed to be changed.
 - He said, “Ministering angels, you know where my car keys are” (Hebrews 1:14). He kept looking and found his keys in his coat pocket.
 - A doctor friend called Brother Copeland to pray for his wife, who was diagnosed with a tumor on her brain, and anoint her right before she went into surgery.
 - The doctor wasn’t worried; he depended on the wisdom of God.
 - Kenneth anointed her with oil as his friend requested.
 - Soon, the surgeon came in and reported that the tumor was not to be found. An indentation was there where it had been, but the tumor had disappeared.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Let’s pray together:

“Thank You, Father, for the promise that I will know what to do as I face every situation. Your wisdom is perfect, and I receive Your guidance for my every move in life. I love You, Sir. In Jesus’ Name. Amen.”



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DAY 5 – THE MERCY OF THE LORD

Jeremy and Sarah Pearsons' story has been used many times as a witness to the mercy of God. Paul said what you sow, you will reap. The mercy of God is so rich and pure, and He is ready to give it to you.

STUDY IT

- I. Jeremy and Sarah Pearsons' story has been used many times as a witness to the mercy of God.
 - Sarah was living in Arkansas with her family. She was hungry to know God more and more.
 - Sarah went to a Kenneth Copeland Ministries Victory Campaign in Branson, Mo. and The LORD ministered so much to her.
 - The atmosphere in that campaign allowed her to open her heart in a new way to the faith and Love of God.
 - In that meeting, she sowed into the offering for KCM. But her sowing was so much more than money. She sowed out of the overflow of love in her heart in faith and in an abundance of love.
 - Soon after, her family moved to Branson to go to Faith Life Church pastored by Keith Moore. She learned so much about faith and reaped the wisdom of God about faith.
 - The LORD told Sarah to go to the Southwest Believers' Convention in Fort Worth, Texas. She didn't have any vacation time, and The LORD said, *Quit your job.*
 - The daughter of the family she was with asked Sarah to take her to the youth service. Jeremy happened to be preaching that morning. Sarah thought, *That's my husband*, even though they had not met.
 - It wasn't long until she was introduced to Jeremy. Sarah has reaped love, a love she had never known.
 - Sarah has realized that Jeremy loves her perfectly just like Father God loves her.
- II. Paul said what you sow, you will reap (see Galatians 6:6-7).
 - This scripture has been used by churches to bring fear and condemnation, but it actually refers to the good things we sow and reap from The LORD.



- “Knowing that whatsoever good thing any man doeth, the same shall he receive of The LORD, whether he be bond or free” (Ephesians 6:8).
 - Years ago, there was persecution for preachers who preached that God was good; the abundant life; and prosperity. Religious people would get mad.
 - Brother Copeland decided to forgive everyone for everything. That’s part of the love walk. God is good and forgiving.
 - Live your life with forgiveness and mercy flowing through you all the time.
 - The only thing that will stop grace from flowing *to* you is when you stop grace from flowing *through* you (see Mark 11:25). Let mercy flow through you all the time.
- III. Jeremy was living in Texas working with Kenneth & Gloria Copeland and Pastors George & Terri Pearsons.
- On March 7, 2007, this girl came walking in, and it was Sarah. The LORD said to Jeremy, *I want you to meet My mercy.*
- IV. The mercy of God is so rich and pure, and He is ready to give it to you.
- If you don’t know what to do and your life is a mess, take God’s mercy that endures forever.
 - Your loving heavenly Father wants to be your LORD and Savior. Receive Him today. Let Him fix your life. Find His plan; it’s a plan full of Love, and it’s already BLESSED.
 - Jesus went to the whipping post to take your punishment and give you healing.
 - Then, He died on the Cross, went to the belly of the earth and rose again so you can be free from the pain in your life.
 - Jesus prayed for everyone (see John 17:20-21).
 - God is Love. He sent Jesus because He Loves us.
