

# KENNETH COPELAND FEBRUARY 7-11, 2022

## DAY 1 - I CHOOSE LIFE

Faith is our everyday way of life. When you are born again, you are regenerated, born again, no longer just flesh. It is appointed to human beings to die once. We have the option to choose life or death, BLESSING or cursing. God is interested in life.

- I. Faith is our everyday way of life.
  - Bible faith brings things (whatever is needed, whatever you want) out of the unseen world and causes them to manifest in the seen world.
  - We live by faith, and we die by faith.
  - We're not afraid of death because we've already died.
    - If you know Jesus as your LORD and Savior, you've done all the dying you're going to do.
    - o Your body will die, but that's not you. It's just where you live.
  - Your soul and spirit will live forever.
- II. When you are born again, you are regenerated, born again, no longer just flesh.
  - Your days can be 120 years (see Genesis 6:3).
  - Things in heaven were purified with the blood of Jesus (see Hebrews 9:23).
    - o Adam's sin polluted everything in heaven except the throne of God.
  - When Jesus rose from the dead, He took His blood into heaven to cleanse the heavenly utensils, and to be placed on the heavenly mercy seat of God.
- III. It is appointed to human beings to die once (see Hebrews 9:27).
  - There's not a set time for your death.
  - You can add to your lifespan, and you can take away from it.
    - "My son, forget not my law or teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments; for length of days and years of a life [worth living] and tranquility [inward and outward and continuing through old age till death], these shall they add to you." (Proverbs 3:1-2, AMPC).
  - Sin will kill you early because the wages of sin is death (see Romans 6:23).





- The LORD asked Kenneth if he would live to be 120 years old, and when Brother Copeland agreed, it became impossible for him to die before then. He is in covenant with The LORD.
  - The commitment to live long changed Brother Copeland's life—the way he thinks, the way he speaks, his physical activity and his exercising.
- IV. We have the option to choose life or death, BLESSING or cursing (see Deuteronomy 30:19).
  - We have been redeemed from the whole curse of the Law which includes sin, sickness, disease, poverty and spiritual death.
  - Humans were clothed originally with the glory of God.
  - Adam died spiritually when he ate of the fruit of the tree in the Garden of Eden.
    - Adam and Eve were clothed in glory until they sinned and the light of God's glory went out. Then, they were naked.
- V. God is interested in life.
  - "See, I have set before thee this day life and good, and death and evil; in that I command thee this day to love The LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and The LORD thy God shall BLESS thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it" (Deuteronomy 30:15-16).
  - Death is in the earth. The choices are death and life. We choose life.
    - o "I call heaven and earth to record this day against you that I have set before you life and death, BLESSING and cursing." (Deuteronomy 30:19).
  - Choose life.

#### MAKE IT PERSONAL

When you choose God's life to be in you, you become a new creature. We call it being saved. That's the beginning of a wonderful journey of being changed to be like God in the earth. It's a faith walk, because you won't see the whole plan at once.

Renew your desire to be pleasing to God. Get to know your precious LORD by reading and thinking about His WORD. Find out His motives and His way of doing things. Soon, you will see changes in yourself in the way you think, the way you talk, and the things that interest you. Give authority over your life to Jesus, and you will find true Love and joy.





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#### DAY 2 - FAITH CHOOSES LIFE WORDS

We live by faith, we walk by faith, we sleep by faith. Everything we do, we do by faith. It is appointed to men to die once, but after that the judgment. You must choose to speak life words.

- I. We live by faith, we walk by faith, we sleep by faith, everything we do, we do by faith. Faith is our way of life.
  - The days of man shall be 120 years (see Genesis 6:3). It's the first mention of the will of God for man's lifetime.
    - o God promises to satisfy you with long life (see Psalm 91:16). That promise is based on a 120-year life span.
    - All the food laws in the Bible are based on living 120 years. Eat God's way because it works.
  - God's will is that man live 120 years without sickness or disease, prospering spirit, soul, body, socially, in every way of life regardless of background or skin color.
- II. It is appointed to men to die once but after that the judgment (see Hebrews 9:27).
  - Everyone in this earth dies once. A believer dies when he accepts Jesus as his LORD. He dies to sin and to his old self.
  - When the believer leaves his body, he simply steps over into eternity.
  - How long you live is influenced by your obedience to Jesus Christ.
    - You can add to your lifespan: "For length of days and years of a life [worth living] and tranquility [inward and outward and continuing through old age till death], these shall they add to you" (Proverbs 3:2, AMPC).
    - You can take away from your lifespan: "For the wages of sin is death" (Romans 6:23).
  - Moses made intercession for the children of Israel to live and enter the Promised Land (see Psalm 90:1-10).





- They had grumbled so much against God and accused God of trying to kill them in the wilderness.
- Because of their sin and their words, God said they would die at 70 or 80 (see Psalm 90:10).
- Keep God's WORD so that you may live and multiply.
  - o God said, "I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, BLESSING and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live" (Deuteronomy 30:19).
- III. You must choose to speak life words.
  - Human beings have authority in this earth whether they know it and use it, or not.
  - Choose God's life!
  - God has already chosen. He chose you. He chose all mankind.
  - God is life and He is your life.
    - His life is in the spirit man of every believer to give supernatural life to your memory, your brain, your eyesight, all parts of *you*.
  - There is a sin unto death (see 1 John 5:16-17).
    - It's born-again people, filled with the Spirit, operating in the gifts of the Spirit who make the decision to trample underfoot the blood of Jesus that saved them.
    - o It's impossible to bring them back to repentance.

#### MAKE IT PERSONAL

To have the abundant life God promised, you must believe and speak life words. Words of life are found in God's WORD. Begin to speak what He says.

Write two scriptures you can speak. For example: "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me" (Philippians 4:13).

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#### DAY 3 – CHOOSE LIFE BY FAITH

We have the privilege of learning, knowing and understanding the force of faith in God. Keep God's commandments because you love Him and because you want to. Put God's WORD first in your life. Speak words of life. Faith in God and God's Anointing filled John G. Lake with the life of God.

- I. We have the privilege of learning, knowing and understanding the force of faith in God. It's an invisible force—the creative force of Almighty God.
  - As believers, we have been created in Christ Jesus; we are His workmanship. We are new creatures in Christ.
  - God is our life.
    - o God said, "I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, BLESSING and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live: That thou mayest love The LORD thy God, and that thou mayest obey his voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto him: for he is thy life, and the length of thy days" (Deuteronomy 30:19-20).
  - You choose. Choose life by faith. To choose life, you choose Jesus.
- II. Keep God's commandments because you love Him and because you want to.
  - We have a new commandment. Jesus said, "Love one another as I have loved you" (see John 13:34-35).
  - He took our sins, our sicknesses and our poverty, and gave us life. We live in Him and He lives in us.
  - Jesus said we should eat His flesh and drink His blood to have His life in us (see John 6:53).
    - We do that by taking Communion (see 1 Corinthians 11:23-26).
- III. Put God's WORD first in your life (see Proverbs 4:20).
  - The Bible, God's WORD, contains promises and facts.
    - o "With his stripes we are healed" (Isaiah 53:5) is a promise.





- o "By whose stripes ye were healed" (1 Peter 2:24) is a fact.
- If we were healed, we are healed.
  - o If you *are* healed, you are healed *now*, no matter the symptoms.
  - o If you believe that, get out of bed, get dressed and eat something. *You* tell your body what to do, not the other way around.
- Read and meditate God's WORD night and day until the symptoms are gone.
- IV. Speak words of life. Jesus said, "My words are spirit and they are life" (see John 6:63).
  - Faith-filled words dominate the law of sin and death.
  - Brother Copeland had a cancer spot on his hand that needed to be healed.
    - o First, he read James 1-4 to make sure he was in faith and was not wavering.
    - Next, he called his pastors, George and Terri Pearsons. His other children were listening on the phone in agreement.
    - Pastor George touched the cancer spot on Brother Copeland's hand. A shock went through Kenneth and he started laughing. He knew he was healed.
  - Brother Copeland's body is full of God's life.
- V. Faith in God and God's Anointing filled John G. Lake with the life of God.
  - He lived in an area of South Africa where the bubonic plague broke out and people were dying.
    - The British medical teams were looking for people to help with the sick.
    - o Brother Lake's team ministered to the sick and were never infected.
  - Doctors and scientists came in to find out why he didn't get sick.
    - He told them to take a sample of the virus and look at it under the microscope. It was teeming with the virus.
    - o They put a sample in Brother Lake's hand and saw the virus die.
  - Brother Lake's faith in God caused him to overcome sin, the curse and death for himself and many others.
  - Read about John G. Lake. Get his book of sermons and life experiences.

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#### DAY 4 – LIVING BY FAITH ON PURPOSE

Brother Copeland has a mandate from God to teach faith. Several years ago, Brother Copeland knew his mother's time on earth was ending. The just shall live by faith, and their lives are sustained by faith.

- I. Brother Copeland has a mandate from God to teach faith. He learned faith from Oral Roberts and Kenneth E. Hagin.
  - Kenneth Hagin had a supernatural heart.
    - When he was born, the doctor thought he was dead, but his grandmother noticed a spark of life.
    - His chest cavity was deformed inside. His heart was deformed.
  - Reading and meditating on Mark 11:22-25, Brother Hagin saw how to receive divine healing.
    - He realized that he had to believe and say he had it before he physically had
       it.
    - The Spirit of God asked him, *So, you believe you're well?*
    - o Brother Hagin said, "Yes, I do."
    - o The Spirit said, *Well people ought to be up and out of bed at this time of day*.
    - He threw his paralyzed legs off the bed and announced to all the angels and demons that he was healed.
    - o Immediately, he was walking around and his organs were whole.
  - Later in life, after a meeting, he ate breakfast, smiled, left his body and went on to heaven.
    - However, his heart continued to beat.
    - Kenneth Hagin Jr. called Brother Copeland and asked him what they should do. Kenneth told Ken Jr. and his team to lay hands on Brother Hagin's body and turn off his heart. It was a faith heart and it was still beating.
    - They did that and his heart stopped.
    - Brother Hagin wasn't sick, but he was satisfied and went on to be with The LORD.





- II. Several years ago, Brother Copeland knew his mother's time on earth was ending.
  - She began to see things happening in heaven.
    - She said, "I want to go home." She meant to heaven. She told Kenneth she had seen Jesus, and The LORD said, *Come home.*
  - The WORD says man's normal life span shall be 120 years (see Genesis 6:3).
    - o The LORD asked Kenneth to live to 120 years because of the anointing.
    - He was to give the credit for long life to living by faith on purpose.
- III. The just shall live by faith, and their lives are sustained by faith.
  - The word of the covenant and the Name of Jesus are absolute final authority in their lives.
  - Jesus is *the Name* that's above every name that's named.
    - Cancer, poverty and death are names, and they have to bow their knees to the Name of Jesus.
    - We die when we say, not when someone else says. We choose life (see Deuteronomy 30:19).
  - Whosoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God. By this we know that we love the children of God, if we love God (see 1 John 5:1-2).

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### DAY 5 - WHEN YOUR FAITH ISN'T WORKING

Hebrews 11 is the "Faith Hall of Fame." To love God, we must keep His commandments. The Hebrew scribes counted the Name of The LORD as precious. We stand in faith believing the gospel of Jesus Christ.

- I. Hebrews 11 is the "Faith Hall of Fame."
  - Read God's working definition of faith:
    - "Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses]" (Hebrews 11:1, AMPC).
  - Faith is the title deed.
    - o I have the title deed to my healing before anyone ever pronounces me well.
- II. To love God, we must keep His commandments (see 1 John 5:1-3).
  - You are a *whosoever* who believes in God and keeps His commandments.
    - We have the new commandment of love that Jesus gave (see John 13:34-35).
    - He who has and keeps Jesus' commandments loves Jesus and is loved by Him (see John 14:21).
      - We know if we keep the commandments Jesus gave, He will manifest Himself to us (see John 14:21).
      - We all want Jesus to manifest Himself to us.
  - You are also a *whatsoever* who overcomes the world and has victory through faith (see 1 John 5:4).
  - When things are not working like you think they should, check how much you love God.
    - Go back to the last thing He told you to do, and do it. Loving God includes obeying Him.







- III. The Hebrew scribes counted the Name of The LORD as precious.
  - Before they wrote the Name of The LORD, they would bathe. If they wrote it five times, they would bathe five times.
    - o The Name of The LORD should be that precious to us.
  - The Name of Jesus is *The* Name above every name that's named in heaven, earth and hell.
    - Every knee will bow and every tongue will confess that Jesus is LORD (see Philippians 2:9-11).
  - Your faith defeats the devil.
    - o "This is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith" (1 John 5:4).
- IV. We stand in faith believing the gospel of Jesus Christ.
  - "Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand" (1 Corinthians 15:1).
    - This is the gospel: "For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; and that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures" (1 Corinthians 15:3-4).
  - "But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our LORD Jesus Christ" (1 Corinthians 15:57).
    - We have victory over life, death, sin, sickness and disease!
    - That's the reason we have the Victory Channel®. That's why this Bible college teaches victory!
  - We are not the victims; we are the victors!
