DAY 1 – FAITH TAKES PRACTICE, PRACTICE, PRACTICE

The fundamentals of this ministry include faith and victory. We preach the Word of Faith. Brother Copeland meditated that *Jesus is LORD*.

STUDY IT

- I. The fundamentals of this ministry include faith and victory.
 - The LORD said to Brother Copeland's spirit: *Every believer has a voice, and it must be the voice of victory. There is victory in the new birth. There is victory in the Baptism in the Holy Spirit. There is victory in faith.*

- II. We preach the Word of Faith.
 - "But what saith it? The WORD is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the Word of Faith, which we preach; that if thou shalt confess with thy mouth The LORD Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation" (Romans 10:8-10).
 - Confess that Jesus is LORD. Believe it in your heart. Say it with your mouth: You are saved, healed and prosperous.
 - Speaking is engaging faith. If you don't speak, your faith is not engaged.
 - No man can say Jesus is LORD except by the Spirit of God (1 Corinthians 12:3).

- III. Brother Copeland meditated that *Jesus is LORD*.
 - He thought about it, said it and wrote it on everything.
 - He took seriously the need to remember and put in practice The WORD of God.
 - This is his confession, and it can be yours also: "I'm not moved by what I see. I'm not moved by what I feel. I'm moved only by what I believe, and I believe The WORD of the living God."

- IV. A beggar sat at the gate to the Temple (Acts 3:2).
 - The priests had examined him and given him the legal right to beg because of his paralysis.



- Jesus and His disciples walked by him many times and each time gave him money.
- This time, he expected to receive money from Peter and John.
- Peter took him by the hand and immediately the man received strength and was healed.
- Peter preached to the crowd to explain how the man was healed.
 - Peter preached the blood covenant beginning with Abraham's circumcision.
 - They were sons of the covenant because they were descendants of Abraham.
 - He reached the point in the sermon that the precious blood of Jesus made a way that men could be BLESSED.
 - God had said to Abraham, "And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be BLESSED" (Acts 3:25).
 - The man was healed through Jesus and faith in His Name (Acts 3:16).
- Peter quoted a prophecy about Jesus' resurrection from the Old Testament: "Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption" (Psalm 16:10; Acts 2:27).
- God sent Jesus to BLESS you.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

The gift of healing is very important to God. The Name of Jesus and faith in the Name of Jesus made a crippled man whole, and they will work for you. Believe and speak your healing and expect God heal you.

Let's pray together:

"Father, I desire to be healed: spirit, soul and body. I commit myself to You. I believe You have healed me. Thank You, Sir. In Jesus' Name I pray. Amen."

DAY 2 – GOD AND HIS NAMES ARE ONE

God and His Names are one. God's Name can do anything He can do. Jesus' ministry grew to the place that 12 disciples were not enough. He ordained 70 more men. The door of trouble for our nation was opened by the Supreme Court in the '50s. In the Names of God lie power secrets.

STUDY IT

- I. God and His Names are one. God's Name can do anything He can do.
 - Peter preached, "In the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk" (Acts 3:6).
 - For the power of God to work through you, you have to have faith in the Name.
 - Faith in the Name of Jesus made the crippled man strong.
- II. Jesus' ministry grew to the place that 12 disciples were not enough. He ordained 70 more men (Luke 10:1).
 - Jesus told them the same thing that He had said to the 12 (Matthew 10:7-8).
 - He gave instructions to them to "say" (Matthew 10:7; Luke 10:9).
 - "He that heareth you heareth me; and he that despiseth you despiseth me; and he that despiseth me despiseth him that sent me" (Luke 10:16).
 - Teach people that judging the ministry is dangerous.
 - Judging opens the door to the devil, so go back and shut that door.
- III. The door of trouble was opened in our nation by the Supreme Court in the '50s, and no one shut it.
 - Several evil events subsequently happened.
 - President John F. Kennedy was assassinated.
 - Roe v. Wade was approved, and as a result, 65 million babies have died.
 - Bible reading and prayer were removed from public schools.
 - Madalyn O'Hare had a son and kept suing to remove prayer from the schools.
 - The Bible was taken out of the schools based on the phrase "separation of church and state." That phrase is not in the U.S. Constitution. It was in a





letter written to protect the Church from the State. That phrase *does* appear in the Russian constitution.

- The devil wanted to break this nation away from prayer.
- Now we are working to shut the door against evil.

IV. The Blue Letter Bible is based on Strong's Concordance with many translations and word studies to increase your understanding of God's WORD.

- The usual English translations are limiting unless you find one that points out the differences and definitions of some Hebrew and Greek words.
- The Blue Letter Bible gives you several languages and different translations of the words.
 - For example: *God* in Genesis 1:1 is the Hebrew word, *Elohim*. *El* means "God" and *Elohim* is the plural.
 - Another example: *God* in Genesis 1:26 is translated from the Hebrew words *Yahweh Elohim*. *Yahweh* which is "The LORD God," an individual.
 - Another example: *God* in Ezekiel 47:23 is translated from the Hebrew words *Adonai Yahweh* which means "LORD or Master."

V. In these Names of God lie power secrets.

- Peter and John were strong in the power of the Name.
 - Jesus said, "You go and preach in My Name" (Mark 16:15).
 - Christ in me is my hope of glory (Colossians 1:27).
- "Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 2:5).
 - You have to *let* the mind of Christ Jesus be in you.
 - You are created in the image of God, and made to be joint heirs with Jesus.
- At the Name of Jesus, every knee will bow (Philippians 2:9-11).
- There are two meanings of the word *ask*. One is "to make a request." The other is "to demand."
 - You can make a demand on the Name of Jesus. That's what Peter did for the crippled man at the Gate Beautiful (Acts 3:6).

Study the Name *God* found in Genesis 1:1 and write what you learn about God through that Name. What is the Hebrew Name of God in that verse and what specific attributes does it portray?

DAY 3 – WE ARE JOINT HEIRS WITH CHRIST

Those who believe in Jesus as Savior and LORD are seen as righteousness before God. The Holy Spirit will guide you into all truth. God told Joshua, “Meditate in My WORD day and night, and observe how to do what’s written therein.”

STUDY IT

- I. Those who believe in Jesus as Savior and LORD are seen as righteousness before God.
 - After Jesus died, was buried, rose again and ascended back into heaven, the sacrifice had been made for the sin of the world.
 - Believers were put back in the standing Adam and Eve had in the Garden of Eden.
 - Believers are born from above with the Name of Jesus giving us authority.
 - Believing in Jesus as Savior and LORD assures you a place in heaven. Not believing will send you to hell.
 - We have a job—preach salvation through Jesus Christ (Romans 10:8-10).
 - Faith comes by hearing The WORD of GOD (Romans 10:17).

- II. The Holy Spirit will guide you into all truth.
 - The Holy Spirit will speak what He hears from God and will show you things to come. He will glorify Jesus.
 - Jesus receives from the Father; the Holy Spirit receives from Jesus and shows it to us (John 16:13-14).
 - “For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus” (1 Timothy 2:5).
 - We are joint heirs with Christ—not sub heirs (Romans 8:17).
 - Being joint heirs with Jesus refers to the Jewish law that the firstborn in a family is the primary heir. We are joint heirs with Jesus so we share His place of being a primary heir.
 - All things the Father has belong also to Jesus; therefore all things the Father has are ours—healing, prosperity and more; however, they all have to be received by faith.



- All of these things are received in Jesus' Name and through His Spirit, who dwells in us at our new birth into the kingdom of God.

III. God told Joshua, "Meditate in My WORD day and night and observe how to do what's written therein" (Joshua 1:8).

- You will encounter diverse (different) temptations, tests and trials (James 1:2).
 - Temptations, tests and trials come in different forms and from different people.
- The trying of your faith works patience [endurance] (James 1:3).
 - Part of the fruit of the spirit is patience (Galatians 5:22-23) and faith works by Love (Galatians 5:6).
- Let patience have her perfect work that you may be perfect [complete], wanting nothing (James 1:4).
- If any of you lack wisdom, ask God for it. He won't criticize or find fault with you. He will give it to you (James 1:5).
- Ask in faith (James 1:6).
 - Faith is the glue; faith is the catalyst. This is a faith Book. Have faith in the Name of Jesus (Acts 3:16).
- Don't doubt, that's double-minded. The one who doubts will receive nothing from The LORD (James 1:7-8).
 - Peter said, "LORD, don't You care that we perish?" (Mark 4:38). He called Jesus LORD and then accused Him of not caring.
 - Don't be moved by what you see or feel.
 - With your words, you engage faith or fear. Words are spiritual containers.
- Have the faith of God (Mark 11:22).
 - The important thing is to have faith in God and say—speak. God used "say" three times but "believe" only once (Mark 11:23).
 - "Therefore, I say." Jesus put saying into motion right then.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Think about what it means to be a joint heir with Jesus. What rights and privileges does that standing give you? Meditate on Romans 8:14-17 and write what it means for you.

DAY 4 – WE ARE NAMED AFTER HIM

We are named after the Father. We can receive God's heavenly grant. God does what He says in His WORD. Jesus, as the firstborn, is the heir of all things.

STUDY IT

- I. We are named after the Father.
 - God wants the Church to know His wisdom which will, by faith, give us boldness and confidence.
 - “To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God, according to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our LORD: In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him” (Ephesians 3:10-12).
 - “For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our LORD Jesus Christ, of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named” (Ephesians 3:14-15).
 - We gladly bow our knees to our Father.

- II. We can receive God's heavenly grant.
 - Giving you this heavenly grant is God's will. He would not write something contrary to His will.
 - “That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might [*dunamis*; power] by his Spirit in the inner man; that Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend [have working knowledge]with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; and to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God” (Ephesians 3:16-19).
 - *Dunamis* is the Greek word meaning “explosive power”—like dynamite.
 - If several sticks of dynamite are tied together, it's even more powerful.
 - One can chase a thousand; two can put 10,000 to flight (Deuteronomy 32:30).
 - Whatever you bind on earth is bound in heaven; whatever you loose on earth is loosed in heaven. If any two of you agree and ask, it will be done by My Father in heaven. Where two or three are gathered together in My Name,





there is power to carry out the agreement with His Spirit
(Matthew 18:18-20).

III. God does what He says in His WORD.

- “I will hasten [watch over] My WORD to perform it” (Jeremiah 1:12).
- It is God’s WORD; it is His bond. It contains many exceedingly precious promises, and all of them in blood.
- Jesus said we would do greater works than He did (John 14:12).
- God can do more than we can ask or think through His power working in us—those are the greater works.
 - “Now unto him that is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us” (Ephesians 3:20).

IV. Jesus, as the firstborn, is the heir of all things (Hebrews 1:2).

- We are joint heirs with Jesus. We have an inheritance in Him (Romans 8:17).
 - To know what this inheritance is worth, we have to put a value on the Name of Jesus.
 - What is the universe worth? It’s still spreading at the speed of light.
- “Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end” (Ephesians 3:21).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Think about your name. Who were you named after? Think about what the title of this lesson means—you are named after God. He is your Father, and He’s a good Father.

If you desire to be the child the Father wants, are there any actions you should change in your life? Write your answers below.





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OCTOBER 24-28, 2022

DAY 5 – THE SIGNATURES OF GOD

When The LORD God raised Jesus from the dead, He said some powerful things. Jesus tasted death for every person, so those who believe in Him would not have to suffer death. Jesus has the Name that is above every name. It was conferred on Him. Jesus gave His disciples His Name and His power. Healings are signatures of Jesus.

STUDY IT

- I. When The LORD God raised Jesus from the dead, He said some powerful things.
 - “Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee...I will be to him a Father, and he shall be to me a Son...Let all the angels of God worship him” (Hebrews 1:5-6).
 - “Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom. Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows” (Hebrews 1:8-9).

- II. Jesus tasted death for every person, so those who believe in Him would not have to suffer death (Hebrews 2:8-9).
 - You can't taste it, see it, feel it or hear it when you die. Only your body dies.
 - Bob DeWeese, Oral Roberts' pilot, had a heart attack. He later described his experience in heaven.
 - He knew he was home in heaven and began to run toward the city.
 - As he ran, he felt sluggish, then faintly heard people saying, “In the Name of Jesus.”
 - He didn't want to come back, but suddenly he was back in his body.
 - He didn't taste death; Jesus tasted death for him.

- III. Jesus has the Name that is above every name. It was conferred on Him (Philippians 2:9).
 - Jesus inherited His Name (Hebrews 1:4).
 - There's power in Jesus' Name.
 - “And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory” (1 Timothy 3:16).





- Jesus was manifested in the flesh in Bethlehem. He was justified in the Spirit in hell.
- IV. Jesus gave His disciples His Name and His power.
- “All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you” (Matthew 28:18-20).
 - “And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and BLESSED them” (Luke 24:50).
 - “Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs [God’s signature] shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover” (Mark 16:15-18).
- V. Healings are signatures of Jesus.
- When you lay hands on the sick, you are saying, “God, sign Your Name here.”
 - God has signed off on us. He’s given us His Name, His inheritance and His signature.
 - Jesus will sign His Name wherever you put your hands.

DAY 5 – THE SIGNATURES OF GOD

The word of The LORD:

“My signature is valid. My checks will cash.” Glory to God! “I put My signature on you when you asked Me to be your LORD and Savior; and I re-created your spirit,” saith The LORD. I re-created your whole spiritual being. Then you yielded to Me and gave Me your tongue and allowed Me to give you utterance.

“My signature then came into a place where you could leave the weakness of your natural prayer life and your natural words in your mind and just [enter in] with all belonging because you’re in the family. You are named after Me. So you have the same signature in the spirit that I have. And as you speak in the spirit, then divine secrets can go between your spirit and Mine, and then you can touch My heart and I’ll give you those divine secrets. You’ll have My wisdom in things wherewith you need that wisdom.

“You call Me, LORD, and I say, ‘Thank you,’ and I call you, Child. I call you My brother and My sister for I’m not ashamed to be called your Brother because we are blood kin. We have a blood covenant between us in the precious blood of the Savior—His Name, that Name of Jesus of the tribe of Judah. On THE BLESSING mountain and the curse mountain, Ebal and Gerizim, the tribe of Judah was on THE BLESSED mountain—Jesus is of the tribe of Judah. The Apostle Paul was of the tribe of Benjamin. There are 12 tribes of Israel and 12 apostles of the Lamb.”
