DAY 1 – TODAY IS YOUR DAY TO RECEIVE HEALING

Jesus wants to be your Savior, Healer, Financier—your life. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever (Hebrews 13:8), and He's the same Healer for you. Jesus carried your griefs and sorrows. The same Jesus who healed Peter's mother-in-law is ready to heal you.

STUDY IT

- I. Jesus wants to be your Savior, Healer, Financier—your life.
 - Jesus wants you to have a well body, a well mind, and peace in your mind—free from grief and sorrows.
 - He wants the joy of The LORD to become your strength today.
 - Jesus wants you to be His witness everywhere you go (Acts 1:8-11).

- II. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever (Hebrews 13:8), and He's the same Healer.
 - There's no time or distance in and around the spirit. Jesus is the same wherever you are.
 - A man had a bad heart. He woke up in the night and a man (an angel) was standing over him with his hands in his chest.
 - He woke up the next morning perfectly healed.
 - That healing is for you today.
 - Divine healing has not passed away.
 - Don't listen to ignorance about healing.
 - If healing has passed away, then God would have to change His Name (Exodus 15:26).
 - God said, "I will never leave you, nor forsake you" (Hebrews 13:5).
 - Jesus has never changed. This same Jesus is ready to heal you now. Put your faith on it.
 - Make this declaration: "I'll never be sick another day in my life again forever."
 - Today is your receiving day. Receive healing every day. It's settled.



- III. Jesus carried your griefs and sorrows (Isaiah 53:4).
- If your husband or wife leaves you and commits adultery, you don't have to stop loving him or her.
 - If he's an unbeliever and you are a believer, the scripture says to let him go (1 Corinthians 7:15).
 - When you obey The WORD and turn him over to Jesus to fix him, then The LORD can bring him back.
 - You're a blood-washed child of God and you've been redeemed from the curse of the law; redeemed from the curse of grief and sorrow (Galatians 3:13).
 - Don't allow your feelings to control you.
 - If your marriage ends in divorce, you must not move over into hate. Stay in love.
- IV. The same Jesus who healed Peter's mother-in-law is ready to heal you.
- Peter's mother-in-law was sick with a great fever (Matthew 8:14-17; Luke 4:38-40).
 - Jesus spoke to the fever and rebuked it.
 - He didn't say she needed to keep this fever for a few days to teach her something. No!
 - Jesus took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses; and with the stripes that wounded Him, we are healed and made whole (Isaiah 53:4-5). Good news!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Today is your day to choose healing. Whatever symptoms you are experiencing, choose healing. Whatever doctor's report you have received, choose healing. God is greater than your doctor's report and your body's symptoms. He wants to heal you today. Choose to believe God over everything else.

Make this declaration:

"Today I am healed! Today I am delivered! No symptom can make me doubt. No thoughts, fears or words spoken contrary to God's WORD can change what I choose today. I am healed! Today!"





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DAY 2 – CHOOSE LIFE AND HEALING

THE BLESSING of The LORD can come on anyone who will receive it. We know, as believers, we are redeemed. Genesis 18:19 says The LORD chose Abraham because he would teach his children the ways of God. Keep God's commandments because they work.

STUDY IT

- I. THE BLESSING of The LORD can come on anyone who will receive it.
 - “But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of The LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee” (Deuteronomy 28:15).
 - If you don't obey God, “you will be smitten with consumption, fever, inflammation, extreme burning, and it will pursue you until you perish” (Deuteronomy 28:22).
 - It's not hard to understand. THE BLESSING is available to anyone who obeys God.
 - However, anyone who refuses to listen to God will be overtaken with the curse.

- II. We know, as believers, we are redeemed.
 - What are we redeemed from?
 - We are redeemed from the curse of the law (Galatians 3:13).
 - Brother Copeland gathered Gloria and their children, John and Kellie, and said, “We are going to take our flu shot this morning so we don't get the flu.”
 - Symptoms of the flu are under the curse (Deuteronomy 28:22). We have been redeemed from the curse (Galatians 3:13).
 - Say it again over and over: “Over there is the flu and every sickness under the curse; over here, we are redeemed from the curse.”
 - Again: “Over there is the flu and every sickness under the curse; over here, we are redeemed from the curse.”
 - You ought to believe and confess this and never have the flu again.
 - Kellie came home from school one day with symptoms of the flu.





- Brother Copeland told her, "You're not the sick trying to get healed. You are the healed, and the devil is trying to take your health away from you."
 - "I have put before you life and death, BLESSING and cursing. Choose life that both you and your seed may live" (Deuteronomy 30:19).
- III. Genesis 18:19 says The LORD chose Abraham because he would teach his children the ways of God.
- We need to teach our children. It's never too late to start loving them.
 - Brother Copeland was praying for his son, John. The LORD told Brother Copeland, *John thinks that you think that he's a bad boy because you magnify his sin.*
 - Brother Copeland told John, "I need to apologize to you, John. I have been magnifying your sin and I'll never do it again. We are brothers in The LORD."
 - Brother Copeland gave John a very nice engraved knife as a token of the covenant between them. They have become best friends.
 - It works between mother and daughter, too.
- IV. Keep God's commandments because they work.
- "My son, forget not my law or teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments; for length of days and years of a life [worth living] and tranquility [inward and outward and continuing through old age till death], these shall they add to you. Let not mercy and kindness [shutting out all hatred and selfishness] and truth [shutting out all deliberate hypocrisy or falsehood] forsake you; bind them about your neck, write them upon the tablet of your heart. So shall you find favor, good understanding, and high esteem in the sight [or judgment] of God and man. Lean on, trust in, and be confident in the Lord with all your heart and mind and do not rely on your own insight or understanding" (Proverbs 3:1-5, *Amplified Bible, Classic Edition*)
 - Kenneth's dad said, "If I found out there was no God and there wasn't any Jesus, I'd live this way anyway because it works. And because it works, I know there is a God and there is a Jesus and heaven is real."
 - The commandments work!

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Pray with us:

"Thank You, Father, for sending Jesus to redeem me from the curse and for forgiving my sin. I choose life and BLESSING. I choose healing. I choose You. In Jesus' Name. Amen."





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DAY 3 – GOD'S PROMISE TO RENEW YOUR YOUTH

The children of Israel in the wilderness were disobedient to God. If you say something long enough, it will get down into your spirit and it will begin to take over your life. God called Brother Copeland to preach the Word of Faith from the top of the world to the bottom and all the way around the middle. Declare THE BLESSING of The LORD.

STUDY IT

- I. The children of Israel in the wilderness were disobedient to God.
 - In Psalm 90, Moses was lamenting that the children of Israel were dying at 70 or 80 years old.
 - They murmured against God and accused Him of bringing them into the wilderness to kill them.
 - So God said, "You have said it, so shall you have it." They were covenant people. What they said is what they got (Numbers 14:26-29).
 - God originally said man's lifespan should be 120 years (Genesis 6:3). With long life He will satisfy you (Psalm 91:16). Long life is 120 years.
 - We're talking about healing in every area of life, including finances.

- II. If you say something long enough, it will get down into your spirit and begin to take over your life.
 - A young man, 39 years old, who worked for Brother Hagin's ministry, went into a coma.
 - As Brother Hagin prayed for him, The LORD said, *Certain spiritual laws have been put into motion that cannot be changed and stopped at this time.*
 - The doctors didn't know what was wrong with him.
 - Finally, the family laid hands on him and said, "Jim, we release you." He smiled and was gone.
 - Jim's brother confirmed that Jim had said all his life, "I'll never reach 40."
 - Check on what you have been saying.





- III. God called Brother Copeland to preach the Word of Faith from the top of the world to the bottom and all the way around the middle.
- Years ago, Brother Copeland realized he had a food addiction that was not good for his body. In addition, he hated to exercise.
 - He realized to complete the call of God, he would have to change his diet, and exercise.
 - Brother Copeland had to repent from saying he hated exercise.
 - He had to begin to say, "I love exercise."
 - All of this has to do with your health.
- IV. Declare THE BLESSING of The LORD.
- "BLESS The LORD, O my soul" (Psalm 103:1).
 - This scripture doesn't say anything about your heart; it's about the soul—your mind, will and emotions.
 - Brother Copeland's mother was diagnosed with pneumonia and was very sick in the hospital.
 - Brother Copeland heard in his spirit, *She doesn't need healing. She should have been saying, "The LORD renews my youth like the eagle's"* (Psalm 103:5).
 - She could have been declaring this verse all her life rather than being worried about others. She didn't take care of herself. Her body was worn out.
 - Brother Copeland began to encourage her to believe her youth was renewed, and she began to improve.
 - She lived several more years; all because of her faith in God's WORD as written in Psalm 103:5.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Part of receiving healing is to believe God's promise to renew your youth. Read the promises in Psalm 103 and apply them to yourself.

Write down Psalm 103:5, the promise of God to renew your youth, and Psalm 91:16, your promise of a long life. Then speak and believe them every day.



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DAY 4 – LIVE LONG AND STRONG

God is good to all. You can live long and strong. Healing is your property. Prayer changes things. Act, praise, move, see, hear, straighten up, be delivered now!

STUDY IT

- I. God is good to all (Psalm 145:9)
 - In Brother Copeland's younger years, he would eat a lot of fresh bread with lots of butter. Eating like that will damage your body.
 - When the doctor checked his heart, he had one blocked artery. It had bypassed itself so there wasn't any problem. However, his heart was out of rhythm.
 - He needed a pacemaker with a built-in defibrillator.
 - The LORD said, *I have given you a new heart*. He received a new heart by faith, and he took the pacemaker by faith.
 - He took a stress test and passed it with the defibrillator in the pacemaker.
 - His heart was good, and they decided he didn't need the defibrillator any more.
 - Brother Copeland had to go to work exercising to live long and strong.
 - He intends to die young at 120 years old.
- II. You can live long and strong. Healing is your property.
 - Healing is not a reward. It belongs to you.
 - God put His healing power in Brother Oral Roberts' right hand.
 - God's power to heal felt like fire in Brother Kenneth E. Hagin's hand.
 - Years ago, Brother Roberts developed appendicitis. He decided to receive his healing and not have any more surgeries.
 - As the doctor watched on the screen, Brother Roberts' appendix shrank down to normal size.
 - The power of God is healing you right now. Accept it. It's yours.
- III. Prayer changes things.
 - There's enough Holy Spirit power in you to heal your whole body.



- Plug in with your faith. Do something. Make an effort.
- We're going to pray the prayer of faith together.
- When you know you are healed, take off and run in the Name of Jesus.
- Brother Copeland declares: "I'm reminding you satan, you bow your knee to the Name of Jesus. The WORD of God is against you. The blood of Jesus is against you. The power of the Holy Spirit is against you. Jesus is against you, satan. We are against you. You are a defeated foe. Jesus took care of you in hell. I take authority over all sickness, disease and every demon."
- Make this declaration for yourself: "The gospel that I have heard is the power of God unto my salvation. I confess that Jesus Christ is LORD over my life, my soul and my body. I receive the power of God to make me sound, whole, delivered, saved and healed. I act on The WORD of God. I resist all sickness, disease and pain in the Name of Jesus. I enforce The WORD of God on you, satan. Leave my presence. My days of sickness and disease are over!"

IV. Now act, praise, move, see, hear, straighten up, be delivered.

- All kinds of problems are healed including mental problems, nervousness, those having a nervous breakdown—that doesn't belong to you.
- Receive your healing in your mind and body, now.
- You're strong in The LORD and in the power of His might (Ephesians 6:10).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

To live long and strong, we must align ourselves to God's WORD. Healing belongs to us; it is our property. Some of our thoughts and words need to change to receive the healing God has already provided.

Write down some instructions to yourself about areas in your life that need healing. Check yourself for anything you need to repent of, anyone you need to forgive, and words you need to change. Then believe it's your right to be healed and receive God's gift of healing.



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DAY 5 – ENCOURAGE YOURSELF IN THE LORD

To encourage yourself in The LORD and to inquire of Him is the prescription for life. Jesus taught in Nazareth but was rejected.

STUDY IT

- I. Encourage yourself in The LORD.
 - After returning to Ziklag, David and his men found that the Amalekites had invaded his camp and taken captive all the women and children and all their possessions (1 Samuel 30:1-25).
 - The men talked about stoning David because they were so grieved.
 - David encouraged himself in The LORD and inquired of The LORD what to do.
 - The LORD answered, *Pursue, overtake and recover all!*
 - David took 600 men on a forced march to find the Amalekites.
 - Two hundred of the men were exhausted and stayed behind at the brook Besor.
 - David and the remaining 400 men found the Amalekites, fought and defeated them. All was recovered.
 - When they all returned to the camp, David said, “The LORD preserved us and delivered the company that came against us into our hand.” God did this.
 - David said, “The one who goes to battle, and the one who carries by the stuff, shall share alike in the spoils of battle.”
 - He made it a statute and ordinance for Israel until this day.
- II. To encourage yourself in The LORD and to inquire of Him is the prescription for life.
 - Your faith is sitting there all the time, waiting for you to engage it.
 - Go to the Bible; find the scriptures; put them in your heart, eyes and ears; and speak them out of your mouth.
 - This prescription works as you pray for the sick.
 - First, encourage yourself in The LORD. Spend some time before God and inquire of Him. Get His instructions.
 - Then as you confront the problem, God will rise up in you.
 - God will do the same thing to the sickness, through you, that He did for David.



- God is the same powerful God, and the devil is the same devil.

- III. Jesus went to Nazareth into the synagogue on the Sabbath day and stood up to read (Luke 4:16-19).
 - They delivered to Him the book of Isaiah; and when He opened it, He read what we know today as Isaiah 61:1-2.
 - The people did not receive Jesus' words and essentially drove Him out of town (Luke 4:29-30).
 - Jesus left Nazareth and moved to Capernaum, which became His headquarters; a fulfillment of prophecy (Matthew 4:13-15).
 - Jesus taught the parable of the sower (Luke 8:1-15).
 - The seed is The WORD of God; and when it is sown on good ground, it brings an increase.
 - Jesus had partners traveling with Him, paying the bills. They fed everyone.
 - Jesus said to them, "To you it is given to understand" (Matthew 13:11).
 - His partners had revelation knowledge because they were His partners.

MAKE IT PERSONAL
