



## WE WALK BY FAITH AND NOT BY SIGHT

### DAY 1 – WE WALK BY FAITH AND NOT BY SIGHT

There is a law of faith, and the fundamental laws of faith are written in God's WORD. Law No. 1: Faith is a spiritual force. It is not mental. Law No. 2: Believe it in your heart and say it with your mouth. Faith prepares before it goes.

### STUDY IT

- I. There is a law of faith (Romans 3:26-27).
  - “Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ has made us free” (Galatians 5:1).
  - In our nation, our first president, George Washington, and the first elected officials went to St. Paul's Chapel in New York City (the chapel that survived 9/11).
  - Washington opened his Bible to the place where God made covenant with Abraham and prayed: “You will be our God, and we will be Your people” (Genesis 17).
    - There is a scripture from the book of Leviticus that is on the Liberty Bell “Proclaim Liberty throughout all the land unto all the inhabitants thereof” (Leviticus 25:10).
  - Remind God to remember His covenant with Abraham, Isaac, Jesus and George.
    - It was George Washington who insisted they put the words in the Declaration of Independence, “We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal.”
  - If you be Christ's, then are you Abraham's seed and heirs according to the blood promise (Galatians 3:29).
- II. The fundamental laws of faith are written in God's WORD.
  - A law is predictable if the elements are there according to the manufacturer's handbook.
  - A law will work every time it is put to work.
- III. Law No. 1: Faith is a spiritual force. It is not mental.
  - The blood of Abel cries out to God (Hebrews 11:4).



- The blood of Jesus cries out. When you speak an ugly word to or about someone, the blood of Jesus cries out. It is the pure, sinless blood of Jesus by which we are sanctified and made holy.
- IV. Law No. 2: Believe it in your heart and say it with your mouth.
- Jesus was coming from Bethany, and He was hungry. He saw a fig tree with leaves but no figs on it (Mark 11:12-13).
    - Jesus answered the tree, saying nine words: “No man eat fruit of thee hereafter for ever” (Mark 11:14).
    - The next morning, Jesus and the disciples passed the fig tree that had dried up from the roots.
  - Jesus said, “Have faith in God. Whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed and cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he says shall come to pass, he shall have whatsoever he says” (Mark 11:22-23).
  - Then Jesus applied what He said. “Therefore I say unto you, What things soever you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you shall have them. And when you stand praying, forgive” (Mark 11:24-25).
- V. Faith prepares before it goes.
- The man of Gadara was delivered, clothed and in his right mind, sitting at the feet of Jesus (Mark 5:15).
  - Where did they get the clothes?
    - Jesus had given instructions to the disciples. “I’m going to call a man to preach, and I want him to look good.”
  - We walk and live by faith and not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7).
  - Smith Wigglesworth said, “I’m not moved by what I see or by what I feel; I’m moved only by what I believe.”
  - Pray about everything.

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

The laws of faith work every time. Just put them to work.

Faith is so powerful, God used it to create the world. You can use faith to change your world. Write down what needs to be changed in your life, and the result you want. Speak God’s promise every day and watch it happen.

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### DAY 2 – APPLYING THE FUNDAMENTALS OF FAITH

Fundamental law of faith No. 2: Believe in your heart and say it with your mouth. When someone puts pressure on you to do something, wait. You can come to Jesus and be saved. Read the word of The LORD spoken through Brother Copeland.

### STUDY IT

- I. There are fundamental laws of faith.
  - Law No. 2: Believe in your heart and say it with your mouth.
    - “We look not at the things which are seen, but at the things that are not seen. For the things seen are temporal, but the things not seen are eternal” (2 Corinthians 4:18).
  - Law No. 3: Faith will not work in an unforgiving heart.
  - Law No. 4: Abraham’s BLESSING cannot be received with Thomas’ faith.
    - Thomas made a decision. “Unless I see the holes in His hands and put my hand in His side, I will not believe” (John 20:25).
    - Then Jesus came in and said, “You have believed because you have seen it. BLESSED are those that have believed and not seen” (John 20:29).
  - This is the way faith works.
- II. When someone puts pressure on you to do something, wait.
  - There is an aviation term: “Stop and wind your watch.”
    - Take a moment; get the checklist. What does it say; what are you to do first?
  - A call came that Brother Copeland’s great-aunt Eylie was in the hospital dying.
    - The Lord said, *Don’t ever let the devil see you sweat. You go over there; I will tell you what to do.*
    - When they got there, Eylie’s daughter was on the phone making funeral arrangements. Kenneth said, “Put the phone down.”
    - Brother Copeland walked over to Aunt Eylie and said, “Aunt Eylie, open your eyes.”
    - She did and said, “Kenneth, what are you doing here?”
    - Brother Copeland prayed for her and she recovered.



- Two years later, Kenneth's mother went to see her. She was ready to go on to heaven. She tucked Aunt Eylie in bed and laid hands on her. Aunt Eylie left this life speaking in tongues.
- III. You can come to Jesus and be saved (Revelation 22:17).
- If you have not before, take this opportunity to receive Jesus as Savior and LORD.
    - The easiest thing you can ever do is to ask Jesus into your heart.
  - Brother Copeland said: "Don't ever even think about committing suicide. Don't take your life; give it to Jesus. He'll do something with it."
  - It is that simple. Jesus did all the hard part. He went to the Cross where they beat Him nearly to death—by those stripes we were healed. They shoved a crown of thorns down on His head and nailed Him to the Cross. He bled, but they didn't kill Him. He gave up His life. Jesus went to hell so you and I don't have to go.
- IV. The word of The LORD spoken through Brother Copeland:
- *I bore all these things for you, sayeth The LORD, so you do not have to bear them. I went to that Cross for you, knowing beforehand what it would be like. And I prayed to My Father, and I said, LORD, if it be Your will take this cup from Me, but nevertheless not My will, but Thine be done. And so, I went to that Cross; and if you remember the Scripture says in the eighth chapter of Romans that the glory of God raised Me from the dead. So, the glory of God came into hell itself, embarrassed the devil and made him bow his knee. Jesus took his keys away from him. Glory to God! After three days and three nights, Jesus came up out of that grave.*

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

Write down ways you can apply the fundamentals of faith. It could be that a change is necessary in the words you speak; you may need to forgive; or you may need to develop your faith by rejecting unbelief. Whatever changes you need to make, write some here:

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### DAY 3 – A FULLY PERSUADED FAITH

God is a God of fundamentals. Abraham had a sure promise from God. Faith and patience are the power twins. The United States is coming to Jesus.

#### STUDY IT

- I. God is a God of fundamentals. We are talking about the fundamentals of faith.
  - There is a law of faith (Romans 3:27). Faith works by Love (Galatians 5:6).
  - During WWII, pilots were taught to fly beginning with the fundamentals.
    - All airplanes fly according to the fundamentals of lift over drag. You have to have lift to overcome the drag.
    - In the spirit, get the drag (the sin that so easily besets us, Hebrews 12:1) off you, and get some lift.
  - As there are fundamentals with an airplane, there are fundamentals in faith.
  - God has a book of destiny. If you will listen to Him, He will have you in the right place at the right time.
    - If you give God the praise and the glory, He will see to it that you are in divine health. There are no sicknesses or diseases in His Book of destiny.
  - We walk by faith, and we stay in faith continually and constantly.
- II. Abraham had a sure promise from God.
  - “It is of faith so that it might be by grace; so the promise might be sure to all the seed. As it is written...” (Romans 4:16-17).
  - Jesus said to the devil, “It is written” (Matthew 4:4, 7, 10).
  - Abraham called things that be not as though they were (Romans 4:17).
    - Abraham staggered not at the promise of God, being strong in faith (Romans 4:19-21).
    - He was fully persuaded that what God promised, He was able to perform.
  - Believe it in your heart then say it with your mouth.
    - “And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive” (Matthew 21:22).



- III. Faith and patience are the power twins.
- The trying of your faith works patience and endurance. Faith and patience will bring you to the place you want nothing (James 1:3-4, *Amplified Bible, Classic Edition*).
  - Write a petition for a heavenly grant.
    - Trust and be confident that it is granted to you, and you will get it (Mark 11:24, *AMPC*).
  - Jesus said, "My Father will grant you whatever you ask in My Name" (John 16:23).
  - Heavenly grants and petitions are fundamentals of faith.
  - The LORD said, *You have My written WORD; now you write down your words and I'll perform them* (Habakkuk 2:2).
- IV. What's this country coming to? Jesus! It belongs to Him! That's fundamental.
- In 1983, The LORD said to Brother Copeland, *There is coming a spiritual storm. I have been manifested as a cloud, as the rain and as lightning; but not all at one time. There is coming a move of God in the United States that will hit like a storm.*
  - Abraham was fully persuaded (Romans 4:21).
    - He had a blood covenant with God ratified in his own blood when he was circumcised at an old age.
    - God simply said, "Old woman and old man, your physical bodies don't count." Only what God says counts.
  - When Abram went against three kings, armed with his own household servants, he was victorious.
    - Abram said, "Never let it be said any man made me rich but Almighty God" (Genesis 14:23).

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

Fully persuaded faith is your belief that cannot be changed no matter what comes to tempt you to believe that God is not faithful and that He doesn't care for you.

Make this declaration with us.

*I declare that God's WORD is true in my life.*

*I declare that what God says I know, I know.*

*I declare that what God says I have, I have.*

*I declare that what God says I can do, I can do.*

*I won't have it any other way! In Jesus' Name. Amen.*



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### DAY 4 – SAY IT BY FAITH

BLESSED are those who believe having not seen. Learn from a day in the life of Jesus. Brother Copeland and Greg Stephens have a new book. The prophet comes to give you something to say. Words are spiritual containers.

### STUDY IT

- I. BLESSED are those who believe having not seen (John 20:29).
  - Thomas said, “I will not believe.” It was an act of his will (John 20:25).
  - Abraham’s BLESSINGS cannot be received with Thomas’ faith. Jesus said, “Stop being faithless.”
- II. Learn from a day in the life of Jesus (Mark 5).
  - Jesus delivered the man in the Gadarenes who was possessed by demons.
  - When Jesus came back to Capernaum, Jairus, the ruler of the synagogue in Capernaum, asked Jesus to come to his home and lay hands on his daughter so she may be healed and live. Jairus said it (Mark 5:23). Jesus went with him.
  - The woman with an issue of blood said it. “If I can but touch Jesus’ garment, I will be healed” (Mark 5:28).
    - Jesus knew *dunamis* (power) had gone out of Him.
    - Jesus spoke to the woman, “Your faith has made you whole” (Mark 5:34).
  - Someone from Jairus’ house came and said his daughter was dead (Mark 5:35).
    - Jesus said to Jairus, “Be not afraid, only believe.”
  - When they came to the house, Jesus said, “The damsel is not dead, but sleeps” (Mark 5:39). Jesus said it.
    - Jesus took the girl by the hand and spoke. She arose and walked.
  - Jesus said, “I only say what I hear My Father say, and I only do what I see My Father do” (John 5:19, 12:49).
- III. Brother Copeland and Greg Stephens have a new book.
  - *God, the Covenant, and the Contradiction* discusses biblical covenants and how Jesus is in every book of the Bible.



- Jesus was born in Bethlehem according to the word of prophecy Micah spoke (Micah 5:2). The prophet Micah spoke it.
  - When that word was spoken, it governed armies and regimes for 715 years.
    - When it came time, a roll call was called in Bethlehem, and there was no room in the inn for Mary and Joseph.
  - Heaven already had all this planned. God spoke it through a prophet.
- IV. The prophet comes to give you something to say. We are to obey the prophets by speaking what they say.
- Faith calls things that be not as though they were (Romans 4:17).
  - Confessions: *I am not moved by what I feel. I'm not moved by what I see. I'm moved only by what I believe. And I believe The WORD of God. I am a believer; I'm not a doubter. I'm strong in The LORD and in the power of His might. I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. The Anointed One and His Anointing dwell in me, and the Spirit that raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in me and quickens my mortal body. I'm saved by grace; I walk in grace. I believe God. He believes in me, and I believe in Him. I believe in His written WORD, and He believes in my written word, when it is His WORD that I write down.*
- V. Words are not primarily for communication. They are spiritual containers.
- The primary use for words is to release Love, power, joy and the goodness of God; but they can also release hate and sorrow.
    - Take authority over your own mouth and only speak kind and lovely words.
  - Brother Copeland saw a vision of a pipe that was clogged and only a little water was coming through. The LORD said, *That clog is unforgiveness.*
    - The LORD reminded him of the time when Gloria bought a sack full of cantaloupes. The top two were good and the rest were rotten. The LORD said, *You need to forgive the man who sold them.*
  - Unforgiveness is like grains of sand that clog the pipe that is your spirit.
    - Unforgiveness keeps you from the glory of God.

## MAKE IT PERSONAL

Be confident that God will keep His WORD to you. Find the promise you are standing on and speak it as if it were already done in your life. God wants to BLESS you!

Write the promise of God you are believing for your situation, and know it's done!

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### DAY 5 – SPEAK YOUR DESIRED END RESULT BY FAITH

In the beginning, God created the heaven and the earth. The purpose of faith is found in God's WORD. Every believer has a voice of victory. Cross the faith line and call it done.

### STUDY IT

- I. "In the beginning, God created the heaven and the earth" (Genesis 1:1).
  - God created the universe out of something you can't see. He spoke it into existence by faith (Hebrews 11:1, *AMPC*).
    - "Without faith, it is impossible to please God, for he that comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him" (Hebrews 11:6).
- II. The purpose of faith is found in God's WORD.
  - "By grace are you saved through faith" (Ephesians 2:8).
    - You can't be saved without faith.
  - "The just shall live by faith" (Romans 1:17; Galatians 3:11; Hebrews 10:38; Habakkuk 2:4).
    - You can't live the Christian life without faith.
  - We walk by faith and not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7).
    - You can't walk the Christian walk without faith.
  - Fight the good fight of faith (2 Timothy 4:7).
    - You can't fight the Christian fight without faith.
  - This is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith (1 John 5:4).
  - You can't quench the fiery darts of the enemy without faith (Ephesians 6:16).
  - You can't be BLESSED without faith.
- III. Brother Copeland was preparing to preach and asked The LORD what he should preach first.
  - Should he start on the new birth, faith, the Baptism in the Holy Spirit, healing or prosperity?



- The LORD said, *Is there victory in the new birth?* Certainly, we have victory over death, hell and the grave.
- *Is there victory in the Baptism in the Holy Ghost?* Yes, that's the gateway to the supernatural.
- *Is there victory in healing?* Yes.
- The LORD said, *Every believer has a voice and it is the voice of victory* (Mark 11:23-24).

IV. Cross the faith line and call it done. Call your body well.

- Go to the promise, choose it, stand on it and establish a relationship with your heavenly Father through the Name of The LORD Jesus Christ on that particular promise.
  - Speak The WORD and it is finished. Call things that be not as though they were (Romans 4:17), then walk away.
- Jesus said, "Have faith in God" (Mark 11:22).
  - He spoke the desired end result, then walked away. He did it by faith.
- Jesus spoke the end result and crossed the faith line.
  - He went from seeing the natural to seeing by faith the desired results.
  - The tree dried up from the roots.
- The WORD of God will go to the root of the problem and kill it.
  - As long as you are batting at the leaves, the tree will stand there and laugh at you. Sickness and poverty will laugh at you, until you take that stance.
- Say: "I am redeemed from the curse of the Law" (Galatians 3:13).
- Demand the mountain to move (Mark 11:23-24).
  - You have been given authority by the Master Himself to speak to that mountain and cast it into the sea.
  - Once it goes into the sea, there is no evidence it ever existed. It has disappeared out of sight forever.
