DAY 1 – PRAYER THAT AGREES WITH GOD'S WORD BRINGS GOD RESULTS

Meditate on wisdom scriptures. The basis for the wisdom of God is found in His WORD. A double-minded man is a man with two minds. Brother Copeland had a vision of the glory of God.

STUDY IT

- I. Meditate on wisdom scriptures (Joshua 1:8; 1 Corinthians 1:30-31; Proverbs 3:5).
 - You have a Blood Covenant with Jesus that provides for healing.
 - Pray in agreement with that Blood Covenant and make a petition based on His Covenants both the Old and the New.
 - “I will send My angel with you. You will serve The LORD Your God with gladness of heart and your angel will BLESS your bread and water; I will remove sickness from the midst of you, and you will have no miscarriages in your land” (Exodus 23:20, 25-26).
 - When you go to a restaurant, ask the ministering spirits to watch over the preparation of your food.

- II. The basis for the wisdom of God is found in His WORD.
 - “We pray for you that you might be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding” (Colossians 1:9).
 - Brother Copeland had an infection in his right toe plus all the symptoms of the flu. He stood on James 4:7: “Submit to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee.”
 - He said to the devil over and over again, “You can’t put that on me; I will not take that; I’ll not have that; it’s not mine.”
 - He wasn’t concerned about how many times he had to say it. He just wanted to see how long the devil would hang on.
 - All of a sudden, the power of God started at the bottom of his feet and came up his back; and sickness and pain were gone based on God’s WORD!
 - Like Brother Kenneth E. Hagin said: He had insider information from inside the Book. It has all the answers.
 - God’s WORD is His will.
 - Out of your heart spring the issues of life (Proverbs 4:20-23).





- III. A double-minded man is a man with two minds (James 1:7-8).
- Look at Peter when the storm hit. He called Jesus, "Master," but accused Him of not caring. He was double-minded.
 - You have not because you ask not, or you ask amiss (James 4:1-3).
 - The LORD said to Kenneth, *Christian people lie.*
 - If someone asks if you're going to the meeting tonight, and you make up excuses why you're not going instead of telling them the truth, that's lying.
 - A man asked Brother Copeland to come preach for him. He prayed about it and The LORD said not to go.
 - Brother Copeland told him, "No, I'm not coming. I don't want to; and The LORD said no." He didn't give the excuses the man was used to hearing.
- IV. Brother Copeland had a vision of the glory of God.
- In the vision, there was a pipe above him and a flow of water gushing down, but only a little bit of water sprayed on his face. He asked, "LORD, what is that?"
 - The LORD said, *The pipe is your spirit and the water is My glory and power. Your spirit is clogged full of unrepented unforgiveness; a lot of little stuff over the years.*
 - He remembered years ago when Gloria came home with a sack full of cantaloupes she bought from a man on the corner. The top two cantaloupes were good and the rest were bad. Right then he forgave that man.
 - Brother Copeland gets up in the morning forgiving everyone; then if someone says something unkind, they're already forgiven.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

It's possible you have prayed for something and not gotten an answer. We all have. Examine your prayer to make sure it agrees with God's WORD. That's why it's important to use a scriptural promise as a basis for each prayer. Then you know your prayer is in agreement with God's WORD and you will get God's results.

Pray this prayer of agreement with us:

Father, Your WORD says, if any two of us agree as touching anything, You will do it for us that You may be glorified. So, my _____ (husband, wife, friend) and I agree that it is Your will to save our children. We ask You to send laborers to tell them the good news of what Jesus did for them to save them from eternal destruction, in a way they will hear, believe and accept Jesus as their Savior and LORD. Thank You, Sir. In Jesus' Name. Amen.

DAY 2 – THE POWER OF FAITH-FILLED WORDS

Jesus taught the prayer of agreement. First words count. The first words you say set the course of your situation. If you say something long enough for it to get down into your spirit, it will control your life.

STUDY IT

- I. Jesus taught the prayer of agreement (Matthew 18:19-20).
 - A number of years ago, a woman asked for help understanding why her husband had died.
 - She said a car had broadsided them with such force that it broke their car in half, and they were scattered over the area.
 - She had broken bones, her children were injured, but her husband had no injuries; however, he was the only one who died. Why?
 - After hearing Brother Copeland preach on the first words that come out of your mouth, the woman came back to him and said, "I've got it. Right after the accident, my husband walked around and looked at all of us lying there hurt. He came over to me and said, 'I am a dead man.'"
 - He was under the pressure of that wreck; those first words came out of him, and he died.

- II. First words count.
 - Brother Copeland had an appointment to look at and purchase a 1959 Skylane airplane.
 - The night before, he turned out the light and started toward the bedroom.
 - Walking in the dark, he kicked the large, heavy, green ottoman in their living room and heard his toe crack.
 - His first words were, "Praise God, thank You, Jesus, I'm healed, Hallelujah!" Oh, it hurt!
 - The next morning, he was getting ready to go to the airport, and the devil said, "Look at your toes. They're black and blue." He said, "No I'm not going to do it."
 - At the airport, Brother Copeland told Mr. Spinks he wanted to purchase the airplane, but he didn't believe he should borrow money.





- Brother Copeland said he had \$5,000 cash and The LORD would get him the rest; he just didn't know when yet.
 - He drove to the hanger to see the airplane and noticed his toe didn't hurt—it was healed!
 - When Brother Copeland got home, Olin Savelle called to say he and Mary were sending \$3500 toward the airplane.
 - Brother Copeland turned right around, went back to the airport and told Mr. Spinks, "I got the money."
- III. The first words you say set the course of your situation.
- In 2004, Brother Copeland bent over and felt a disk explode in his back.
 - His first words were, "Glory be to God, I'll never be operated on a day in my life!" He didn't have to stop and think; that was what was in his heart. Those were His first words, and he said them with boldness.
 - Brother Copeland had no surgery and today he is healed and pain free.
 - Put God's WORD in your heart, believe it and say, "That's mine."
 - "For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks" (Matthew 12:34). Whatever is in your heart in abundance is going to come out in your words.
- IV. If you say something long enough for it to get down into your spirit, it will control your life.
- A young man who worked for Kenneth Hagin suddenly fell into a coma and the doctors didn't know why.
 - Brother Hagin was praying over him and the word of The LORD came to him that certain spiritual laws had been put into place and could not be changed at this time.
 - Finally, the family gathered and said, "Jim, we release you."
 - In a few moments, he was gone.
 - At the homegoing fellowship, the man's brother told Brother Hagin that ever since they were young, he would say, "I'll never live to be 40." He said that all of his life. The man died a few months before he turned 40.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Learn to say nothing until your first words mirror God's will for your situation. It's good to start your first sentence with, "God's WORD says..." then speak His WORD to the situation.

For example, you can say: "God's WORD says me and my family are saved, healed, whole, prosperous, full of life and following the plan of God for victory." Then read and declare out loud 3 John 2; 1 John 4:4, 5:4-5; and Psalm 103:1-5.

DAY 3 – THE PRAYER OF AGREEMENT

First words are spoken because they are what is in your heart in abundance. Brother Copeland and Gloria pray and set themselves in agreement over everything. The angels have a part in answering your prayer. The first words of agreement bring results. The Name of Jesus is the foundation of prayer.

STUDY IT

- I. First words are spoken because they are what is in your heart in abundance.
 - If you're going to make an agreement, you need to read the whole 18th chapter of Matthew. It has a lot to do with forgiveness.
 - "For where two or three are gathered together in My Name, there am I in the midst of them" (Matthew 18:20).
 - Why? To carry out that agreement. He's there with you!
- II. Brother Copeland and Gloria pray and set themselves in agreement over everything. For years, they have taken the time to talk about things.
 - A husband and wife ought to be the most powerful two in agreement.
 - The devil should not be able to get away with anything in your household, particularly, anything financial.
 - Receiving the money you need is the easy part if you know the spiritual laws of tithing, sowing and reaping, and how the angels are involved.
- III. The angels have a part in the answer to prayer.
 - Ed and Nancy Dufresne's church was sitting on property that had become very valuable, and the bank wanted to foreclose. As a result, the bank would not give the church any more loan extensions; they wanted that property back.
 - In his hotel room, Brother Dufresne saw two huge angels.
 - The angels said, "We are your prosperity angels. We've come to help you get the money to pay off the church loan." They were waiting on the command. He said, "Go!"
 - Soon, a lawyer gave him the \$500,000 the church needed.



- IV. The first words of agreement bring results.
- “Again I tell you, if two of you on earth agree (harmonize together, make a symphony together) about whatever [anything and everything] they may ask, it will come to pass and be done for them by My Father in heaven. For wherever two or three are gathered (drawn together as My followers) in (into) My Name, there I AM in the midst of them” (Matthew 18:19-20, *Amplified Bible, Classic Edition*).
 - The first thing you hear from the orchestra at a symphony concert is the instruments tuning up. It’s nasty-sounding like most Christians’ agreement.
 - But when the orchestra begins to play, the sounds they make together are beautiful. That’s how agreement sounds.
- V. The Name of Jesus is the foundation of prayer.
- Brother Copeland and Joe Mumford made a covenant agreement for the money to purchase the Skylane airplane.
 - They wrote it on paper, agreed with one another, and prayed. It worked.
 - Jesus said whatever *they* shall ask. It’s important that both ask and both agree.
 - You can set yourself in agreement on household matters.
 - As parents, be a solid front of agreement when it comes to your children.
 - Teach this agreement to the family. Kellie and John Copeland agreed and believed for a boat—and they got two boats.
 - “It shall be done of My Father.” It will be done (Matthew 18:19).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Praying a prayer of agreement means there are at least two of you in unity on the answer you want from God. It’s better to write down what you are praying for, and the scriptures you are using, to ask God for the answer. Put the written agreement in a place you can see it and rejoice in the answer until it is done!

Write down your prayer and the scriptures you are using to solidify in your heart that God will answer.

DAY 4 – HOW THE PRAYER OF AGREEMENT WORKS

The prayer of agreement starts with submitting yourself to The LORD. “The LORD created you, O Jacob, and formed you, O Israel.” God made a covenant with Israel. Here is the key to the whole thing—be willing and obedient.

STUDY IT

- I. The prayer of agreement starts with submitting yourself to The LORD. Draw closer to God and He'll draw closer to you (James 4:7-8).
 - Resist the devil and he'll flee (James 4:7).
 - Believe and say this: “Devil, you are gone! I don't care what it looks like or feels like; thank God, I'm free. I'm close to my Father, and He's close to me.”
 - Jesus spoke to that fig tree, turned and walked away. He said, “No man eat fruit of you again hereafter for ever” (Mark 11:14).
 - He didn't care how it happened. His word went to the root of the problem and dried up the tree completely.
 - Jesus spoke to the fig tree and walked away.
 - He expected His disciples to operate the same way.
 - Jesus told the disciples, “Have faith in God. Have the faith of God” (Mark 11:22).
 - Brother Copeland's household has been doing that for a long time.
- II. “The LORD created you, O Jacob, and formed you, O Israel” (Isaiah 43:1).
 - Esau sold his birthright to Jacob, but Jacob didn't become a patriarch until he swore before God, “Everything You give me, I will tithe on it” (Genesis 28:22).
 - When Jacob made that covenant agreement with God, he became a patriarch.
 - God changed Jacob's name to Israel. “You will no longer be called Jacob, but Israel” (Genesis 35:10).
 - That's why today it is the nation of Israel, not the nation of Judah.
- III. God made a covenant with Israel.
 - “I, even I, am He who blotteth out your transgression for My own sake, and will not remember your sins” (Isaiah 43:25).



- The LORD said to me, *If I remember your sins, I can't BLESS you. You've got a clean slate.*
 - God wants us to plead our case and speak His exceedingly great and precious promises as a basis for our request.
 - First, we plead the blood—we repent. By faith we walk in the light as He is in the light. The blood of Jesus forgives us and cleanses us from all sin (1 John 1:7).
 - We have the right to petition our Father based on the Covenant we have in Christ Jesus (John 16:23; Mark 11:23-25).
 - The petition has to be something on which the heavenly court can agree.
 - The petition must be in line with God's righteousness. Your request cannot be based on human desires to covet, lie or steal.
- IV. Here is the key to the whole thing—be willing and obedient (Isaiah 1:19).
- Brother Copeland was praying about some things, and The LORD said to him, *You don't qualify. You have not had anything good to say about daily television since the day I told you to do it. You were obedient but not willing.*
 - "You did not serve The LORD God with joyfulness and gladness of heart, for the abundance of all things" (Deuteronomy 28:47).
 - Brother Copeland changed his words. He started saying, "I love daily TV. I am willing and obedient."
 - The next time he came to record a daily TV broadcast, the joy of The LORD came on him. He ran around that table saying, "I love daily television!" He's been in love with daily television ever since.
 - The prayer of agreement won't work unless Jesus is a Partner in the agreement.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

The purpose of the prayer of agreement is to ask the Father something in the Name of Jesus, and He will give it to you (Matthew 18:19-20).

The prayer of agreement works! Make Jesus your prayer Partner. He will agree if you use His WORD as the basis of your prayer.

Write down your request. Bring it to God. Partner with Jesus using Scripture. Believe you receive it, and you will have it. Give God praise because He is faithful to His WORD.

DAY 5 – COME INTO AGREEMENT WITH GOD'S PLAN

David was a man after God's heart. He was in agreement with God. Jesus said, "I do the will of Him who sent Me, and finish His work." Paul greeted the believers in Philippi, his partners. He lived his life for Christ.

STUDY IT

- I. David was a man after God's heart (Acts 13:22). He was in agreement with God.
 - David and his men won a victory over the Amalekites (1 Samuel 30:1-25).
 - Some of David's men stayed at the river Besor and kept watch over the animals and packs.
 - After the battle, David said all the men alike shall take part in the spoils of the fight; he who goes down to the battle and he that carries the stuff.
 - Because those men stayed back to watch the stuff, David insisted they shared equally with those who won the battle.
 - From that day forward, David made it a statute and an ordinance for Israel.
 - David used God's covenant to defeat Goliath.
 - You can use it, too, because you have the blood of Jesus that assures you are in Covenant with God.
 - David and the Israelite army chased the Philistine army back to Goliath's hometown.

- II. Jesus said, "I do the will of Him who sent Me, and finish His work" (John 4:34).
 - As a Partner of this ministry, you enter into Brother Copeland's labor, and into Gloria's, Pastors George and Terri's labor.
 - "He who receives and welcomes and accepts you receives and welcomes and accepts Me, and he who receives and welcomes and accepts Me receives and welcomes and accepts Him Who sent Me. He who receives and welcomes and accepts a prophet because he is a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward" (Matthew 10:40-41, *AMPC*).
 - We receive, welcome and accept the leaders God has chosen, and we receive the reward. It's a wonderful exchange.





- III. Paul greeted the believers in Philippi, his partners.
- “I thank God upon every remembrance of you, always in every prayer for you making request with joy, for your fellowship, being confident that he who has begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ” (Philippians 1:3-6).
 - *Fellowship* can be translated as *partnership*.
 - A partnership is when two or more people get together and do together what they could not do individually.
 - T-E-A-M represents, “Together Everyone Accomplishes Much.”
 - We partner together to do the work of preaching the gospel.
 - If we seek ways to get The WORD out, the money will come.
- IV. Paul lived his life for Christ.
- Paul told Christians not to be ashamed but to continue to be bold for Christ (Philippians 1:20).
 - Living means living for Christ; dying is even better.
 - Paul said, “I long to go and be with Christ, but for your sakes it is better that I continue to live to help all of you grow and experience the joy of your faith” (Philippians 1:23-25).
 - Live as citizens of heaven, standing together with one spirit and one purpose. Don’t be terrorized by your enemies (Philippians 1:27-28).
 - Be blameless and harmless; shine as lights in the world, holding forth The WORD of life (Philippians 2:15). That’s who we are.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

To have a BLESSED life, we must come into agreement with God’s plan. Our prayers must agree with God’s WORD.
