DAY 1 – BECOME GOD-INSIDE MINDED

It is vitally, wonderfully important for us to become God-inside minded. The introduction of the Spirit of power is found in the beginning of God's WORD. The same Holy Spirit who was involved in Creation has planned our lives. In the First Covenant we have all the Law and the prophets. It was the Spirit of God who raised Jesus from the dead.

STUDY IT

- I. It is vitally, wonderfully important for us to become God-inside minded.
 - God lives in you if you know Jesus Christ as The LORD of your life.
 - As you inquire of The LORD, He's in your spirit: not in the sky, or not out in the air somewhere, but in your heart—not your blood pump—in your spirit, because that's where He dwells.
 - We press into the Anointed One (Jesus) and His Anointing.

- II. The introduction of the Spirit of power is found in the beginning of God's WORD (Genesis 1:1-2).
 - "In the beginning, God..." (Genesis 1:1). The Hebrew word used for God is *Elohim* (God, plural).
 - We see in the beginning the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit were all there.
 - "The Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, "Let there be light;" or, "Light, be." There was light (Genesis 1:2-3).
 - The Spirit of God was moving. He's always moving. He's never static. But nothing happened until God spoke.
 - In Genesis 1 and in Hebrews 11:3, God created by faith.
 - "By faith we understand He created the world."
 - Here we have the first introduction of faith in God and the introduction to the Spirit of power.

- III. The same Holy Spirit who was involved in Creation has planned our lives.
 - That's the Spirit who already has 2024 planned. He always has a plan.
 - You can train yourself to listen to God the same way you can train your body or your mind.



- “Incline your ear unto My sayings.” (Proverbs 4:20). Incline means, “I’m bent in His direction. I want to know what He has to say.”
- The LORD said, *You’re making plans and asking Me to BLESS them. If you’ll find out My plan, it’s already BLESSED.*

IV. In the First Covenant we have all the Law and the prophets.

- In the Second Covenant there is only one sin: If you don’t believe on Jesus, you’re condemned to eternal punishment.
 - Jesus took care of the rest of sin. He bore our sin in His own body on the tree, that we being dead to sin should live unto righteousness; by whose stripes we were healed (1 Peter 2:24).
 - Jesus was made a curse for us; therefore, we are redeemed from the curse of the Law (Galatians 3:13).
- Most Christian people have never heard that we are redeemed from the curse.

V. It was the Spirit of God who raised Jesus from the dead (Romans 8:11).

- Jesus said, “My life is Mine to give or take up again. The devil has found nothing in Me” (John 10:17-18, 14:30).
 - Pilate was surprised that Jesus was dead so soon. They didn’t kill Him. He gave up the ghost, the spirit (John 19:30).
- Jesus made Himself obedient unto death. He never broke a commandment; they didn’t have any right to kill Him. He gave Himself for us.
 - “The Spirit of Him who raised Christ up from the dead makes alive, quickens, this mortal body” (Romans 8:11).
- That’s the reason it is so vitally important to be God-inside minded.
- Think about Him, talk and listen to Him in your spirit. Practice His presence.
- That’s what Kenneth Copeland Bible College® is based on—the Spirit of faith.
- First submit yourself to God. Draw nigh to God and He will draw nigh to you. Then, resist the devil, and he will flee (James 4:7).
- Those are Covenant words. Those are articles of the Covenant.

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DAY 2 – KEEP FEAR AND WORRY OUT OF YOUR HEART

Kenneth Copeland's connection with Oral Roberts birthed his healing ministry. Peter and John ministered healing to the crippled man at the gate Beautiful. On Nov. 2, 1965, Brother Copeland received Jesus as Savior. All of God's WORD is absolute truth. If God chose Abraham, then we believers should choose Abraham.

STUDY IT

- I. Kenneth Copeland's connection with Oral Roberts birthed his healing ministry.
 - Brother Roberts laid hands on the sick and emphasized, "Jesus is the Healer. He's the same yesterday, today and forever" (Hebrews 13:8). Jesus does the works.
 - "And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it" (John 14:13-14).
 - Another word for *ask* is *demand*.
 - We are not demanding something from God; we are demanding sickness and disease to leave.
- II. Peter and John ministered healing to the crippled man at the gate Beautiful (Acts 3:1-8).
 - Count how many times in the Gospels Jesus and His disciples entered the Temple. They passed the crippled man and gave him alms; but Jesus did not heal him.
 - Why? Jesus only did what He saw His Father do; and He didn't see His Father minister to the crippled man (John 5:19).
 - Peter and John were anointed to do what Jesus did. Their power was in the Name of Jesus.
 - They could do what Jesus did on the earth because the power is in the Name.
 - Jesus' Name can do anything He could do while He was on the earth. Jesus' Name has authority. His Name is a spiritual weapon and a spiritual BLESSING.
- III. On Nov. 2, 1965, Brother Copeland received Jesus as Savior.
 - Kenneth had just returned from work when he heard a voice inside him saying, *Kenneth, if you don't get right with Me, you're headed for a devil's hell.*





- Then in his spirit, he heard Mrs. Taggert's voice, his childhood Sunday school teacher. She said, *Boys, you have to ask Jesus to come into your heart.*
- The moment Kenneth did, profanity was gone from his mouth. That was his evidence that he was a new creature in Christ Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:17).

IV. Keep worry and fear out of your heart.

- Depend on God's WORD. All of His WORD is absolute truth.
- "You will know the truth and the truth will make you free" (John 8:32). Jesus did not say *set* you free. We have been *made* free.
- God's WORD has the authority to *make* you free immediately.
 - God told Abram, "I have *made* you, Abraham, the father of many nations" (Genesis 17:5). There was a covenant name change.
 - They were in covenant agreement through circumcision (Genesis 17:11).
 - Abraham didn't have to agree to be in covenant with God, but he did.

V. If God chose Abraham, we believers should choose Abraham.

- If we choose Abraham, we also choose his offspring.
 - The Scripture says we are the wild olive branch, grafted into Abraham's lineage (Romans 11:17).
 - According to The WORD, you and I are the seed of Abraham (Romans 9:8). That makes us Jewish in our hearts.
- The Pharisees hated Jesus because He preached prosperity and BLESSING. They preached the Law.
 - Jesus said, "If they hate me, they will hate you" (John 15:18).
- Receive your hundredfold with persecutions (Mark 10:30). Don't pay any attention to criticism.

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Fear promotes worry. It's up to us to refuse to fear and worry. God's WORD is the truth, and in it we are told, "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:6-7, *NKJV*).

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DAY 3 – THE SPIRIT OF TRUTH WILL SHOW IT TO YOU

Don't be offended. Offense is one of the devil's most successful tools. The Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Truth, will guide you into all truth. David gave his credentials and told of past victorious experiences. Bartimaeus cried out to Jesus, "Son of David."

STUDY IT

- I. Don't be offended. Offense is one of the devil's most successful tools (John 16:1).
 - The badge of unbelief is: "Yeah, but what if?"
 - A man stood in the prayer line for healing.
 - Brother Copeland said, "The Bible said, 'By His stripes you were healed'" (1 Peter 2:24).
 - The man said with disgust, "I know it says that."
 - Brother Copeland said, "Are you healed?"
 - The man said, "No." They went through this same conversation several times.
 - Finally, Brother Copeland said, "You never will be healed."
 - Brother Copeland continued, "As long as I agree with you, you will never receive your healing. If you will agree with me, according to Matthew 18, two of us agreeing together, you will receive your healing."
 - The man understood and said with fervor, "Lay your hands on me."
 - The power of God come on him and he was healed.
 - He had judged the Bible. "I know it says that." He should have said, "I know *He* said that."
 - The WORD of God is not an *it*. The WORD of God is God's bond. The WORD has power. The WORD *is* God (John 1:1). You can depend on God's WORD.

- II. The Holy Spirit, the Spirit of Truth, will guide you into all truth (John 16:13).
 - The Holy Spirit has all wisdom, knowledge and spiritual power; and He'll show you when you inquire of Him.
 - King David didn't do anything without inquiring of The LORD.
 - That's why David was a man after God's own heart (Acts 13:22).
 - He used his covenant, and he used it on purpose.
 - When he came up against Goliath, David was younger than 20 years old.





- We know that because if he were 20 years old or older, he would have been in the army.
 - David saw Goliath's size and heard his rantings.
 - Young David said, "What do I get if I kill him?"
 - They replied, "You'll get the king's daughter for your wife, and your family won't have to pay any more taxes."
- III. David gave his credentials and told of past victorious experiences.
- David said, "I killed a lion and a bear who tried to take my father's sheep. That Philistine doesn't have any more authority over me than that lion and bear. I'll kill him. He doesn't have a chance against me."
 - David picked up five smooth stones and put them in his shepherd's bag. He put one in his sling.
 - A stone from a sling can be as accurate and powerful as a rifle bullet.
 - David had practiced using his sling. But he had more than a sling. He said, "I come at you in the Name of The LORD of hosts."
 - David used his faith in the covenant of God. Goliath was as good as dead.
 - David hit Goliath with the rock in the only unprotected place—his forehead.
 - Goliath fell and David finished him off with Goliath's own sword.
 - The Philistines were scared and started running.
 - David never lost a battle and never was wounded.
- IV. Bartimaeus cried out to Jesus, "Son of David" (Mark 10:47).
- Bartimaeus knew who Jesus was. "Do *chesed* for me."
 - *Chesed* means the lesser is BLESSED by the greater.
 - Jesus stopped and healed him.
 - He will do the same thing for you. "He shall take of Mine, and shall show it unto you" (John 16:15).
 - Bartimaeus discarded his garment (Mark 10:50). That was his act of faith.
 - Jesus said, "Your faith has made you whole" (Mark 10:52).

MAKE IT PERSONAL

When offense comes to your mind, stop and remind yourself of the truth of God for that situation. Believe the truth. Don't fall for the devil's temptations.

Pray with us:

Father in heaven, I believe Your truth. I refuse to fall for the temptation to be offended. Thank You for delivering me from any and all offense. In Jesus' Name. Amen.





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DAY 4 – FAITH IS YOUR VICTORY

Welcome to your life of serving Jesus and people. Brother Copeland and Gloria learned to believe God for everything. We have divine access to all that the Father has. Brother Copeland starting a three-week meeting in Hereford, Texas.

STUDY IT

- I. Welcome to your life. Who are you going to serve? Serve Jesus and people.
 - That's what ministry means: Meet the needs of people.
 - Brother Copeland went to his first partner meeting while working for Oral Roberts.
 - He learned he could have Brother Roberts' anointing by being a partner for a donation of \$10 a month.
 - The only thing Brother Copeland owned was the wooden pencil in the partner package.
 - He put the pencil in the envelope and signed up to be a partner.
 - At the end of the service, a lady called out to Brother Copeland and gave him \$10. He put the money in the envelope and took the pencil out.
 - Kenneth and Gloria were now partners of Oral Roberts!

- II. Brother Copeland and Gloria learned to believe God for everything.
 - They learned about the curse of the Law and THE BLESSING of Abraham.
 - Since that time, they have not personally been in debt.
 - Their determination not to borrow began when they were a small ministry.
 - You can do it too. Stand on God's WORD and put on the whole armor of God (Ephesians 6:11-18).

- III. We have divine access to all that the Father has. He's the King of the universe.
 - The Holy Spirit will take of Jesus and show it to you. All that the Father has—spirit, soul, body, financially—belongs to Jesus (John 16:14-15).
 - Develop a God-inside consciousness; become God-inside minded.
 - The Holy Spirit is our Helper and our Comforter (John 16:7, AMPC).





- The Holy Spirit is our Advocate, our personal attorney. He stands there with the Father. The Spirit of God is between us and the Father. He is the Spirit of the Father.
- The Holy Spirit is our Standby, our Counselor, our Strengtheners and our Intercessor.
- You are of God, and you overcome the spirits that do not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh. That's the spirit of the Antichrist (1 John 4:1-4). That's the devil. He's against (anti) everything but himself.
 - "Greater is He who is in you, than he that is in the world" (1 John 4:4).
- "For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith" (1 John 5:4).
- If you are born of God, you are an overcomer. It's up to you.
 - If you are not overcoming, start believing The WORD to overcome.

IV. Brother Copeland learned faith is your victory.

- Brother Copeland was starting a three-week meeting in Hereford, Texas.
- He had outlines to preach the new birth, the Baptism in the Holy Spirit, healing and miracles.
 - He prayed for several hours in the spirit so he could hear the Holy Spirit and not his mind. He asked God which sermon to preach first.
- Brother Copeland heard in his spirit: *Is there victory in the new birth? "Yes, Sir!" Is there victory in the overflowing of My Spirit within you? "Yes, Sir!" Is there victory in miracles and healings? "Oh, yes, Sir! We have victory over death, hell and the grave."*
- The LORD continued, *Every believer has a voice, and it's the voice of victory!*

MAKE IT PERSONAL

Faith in God, faith in the blood of Jesus, faith in the Name of Jesus will give you the power to overcome every obstacle that gets in your way. You have been promised abundant life; and you have to believe it, claim it and receive it. Exercise your faith. God is with you; you cannot fail!

Write down something that is an obstacle that keeps you from living the healed, prosperous, abundant life God planned for you. Then speak to that thing and command it to leave in Jesus' Name.





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DAY 5 – BE STRONG AND COURAGEOUS IN THE LORD

The evidence that God is with us is in His WORD, His Covenant. As you study God's WORD, become knowledgeable about the events that went before what you are studying. The First Covenant was in two parts: the blood of animals and the blood of circumcision. We live by our thoughts and our words, not our feelings. Remember what God spoke to Joshua.

STUDY IT

- I. The evidence that God is with us is in His WORD, His Covenant.
 - God is life. God is not in the business of wanting people to die because of sin. He said, "Kill the animal, not the man."
 - The meaning of Passover was to take a lamb; it will be the sacrifice in your place (Exodus 12:21-23).
 - John the Baptist referred to the Passover lamb when he announced, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world" (John 1:29).

- II. As you study God's WORD, become knowledgeable about the events that went before what you are studying.
 - Once a prophet said something by the Spirit of God, there was no way the devil could get it out of the world.
 - Micah prophesied the Messiah would be born in Bethlehem. Seven hundred and fifteen years later, his prophecy came to pass.
 - The WORD of God through prophecy moved nations and controlled armies to get the birth of Jesus manifested at the exact time and place that had been prophesied.

- III. The First Covenant was in two parts: the blood of animals and the blood of circumcision.
 - When Isaac was born, he was a supernatural child.
 - The LORD told Abraham to sacrifice Isaac (Hebrews 11:17-19).
 - Abraham took his son and the wood, and he told the servant, "The lad and I will be back" (Genesis 22:5).
 - Abraham raised the knife, and the angel stayed his hand (Genesis 22:10-12).





- There was a ram stuck in a thicket, so he sacrificed the lamb instead of his son (Genesis 22:13).
 - Why? Because our good God, our Peace, the longsuffering God, knew the day would come when His only begotten Son would say, "If there's any way, take this cup from Me" (Matthew 26:39).
 - God couldn't do it. His covenant partner was willing to sacrifice his son. God couldn't back away from sacrificing His Son.
 - Jesus had to be born in Bethlehem, and He had to be from Nazareth (Matthew 2:6, 23). He was a Nazarene because He came from Nazareth, not because He had taken a Nazarite vow.
 - Samson was a Nazarite because of the vow (Judges 13:4-5).
- IV. We live by our thoughts and our words, not our feelings.
- Don't assume you know what people mean when they talk. The letters D-O-G could refer to an animal or be initials for a spiritual instruction: **Depend On God**.
 - "He will not fail thee, nor forsake thee" (Deuteronomy 31:6).
 - God has never forsaken anyone or any country. People have forsaken God.
 - "I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee" (Hebrews 13:5).
 - We may boldly say, "The LORD is my helper; I will not fear what man can do to me" (Hebrews 13:6).
- V. Remember what God spoke to Joshua.
- Be strong and courageous in The LORD! Don't fear (Joshua 1:9).
 - Joshua sent two men to spy out Jericho (Joshua 2:1).
 - Rahab said, "Where have you been? We have been afraid of you for 40 years. We heard about your God who opened the Red Sea so you could cross on dry land" (Joshua 2:9-11).
 - Rahab changed from a harlot to an ancestor of Jesus Christ through faith in God (Matthew 1:5). She is mentioned in the faith chapter (Hebrews 11:31).
